K JOSHUA KARTY

• Karty finished 18-for-18 on field goals for the season, tied for the fourth-most in a single season in program history

OB TANNER MCKEE

- Finished 31-of-40 for 313 yards and a touchdown
- Recorded fourth career 300-yard passing game
- Ended season with the ninth-most passing yards by a Cardinal quarterback in a single season (2,947 yards), tied for 5th-most pass completions in a single season (264), and third-most pass attempts in a single season (426)

WR BRYCEN TREMAYNE

- Led team with a career-high 11 receptions for a career-best 130 yards
- First career 100-yard receiving game

RB MITCH LEIGBER

- Rushed 12 times for 40 yards and a touchdown
- Second-straight game with a rushing touchdown

TE SAM ROUSH

• Caught just his second career reception for a career-long 23 yards
