### CARD CLASHES WITH COUGARS IN NIT WEDNESDAY

Returning to the postseason for the first time in three seasons, Stanford has earned the No. 3 seed in the National Invitation Tournament and will face No. 6 seed BYU in the first round on Wednesday at 7 p.m. PT at Maples Pavilion.

### STANFORD IN THE NIT

- Making ninth appearance
- Owns an 18-5 all-time record in the postseason tournament
- Won its last five and 11 of its last 12 tournament games
- Won its last eight NIT games played at Maples Pavilion
- Captured the NIT championship three times (1991, 2012, 2015)
- Last appearance was in 2015, when Stanford defeated Miami (66-64) in 2OT to win the title
- Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens, Michael Humphrey and Robert Cartwright part of 2015 NIT title
- BYU is Stanford's second West Coast Conference opponent in the NIT (Gonzaga, 1994)



### HAASE INCREASES TEAM WIN TOTALS EACH SEASON

Jerod Haase has led his teams to increased win totals in each of his six seasons as a head coach. In his first season as a head coach in 2012-13, Haase guided UAB to 16 wins, eventually posting 26 wins and a second consecutive postseason berth in his final year with the Blazers in 2015-16. After Stanford earned 14 wins in his first season on The Farm in 2016-17, he has already led the Cardinal to 18 wins and an NIT berth this season.

## AGAINST BYU

Stanford and BYU have met eight times previously, with the Cougars owning a 6-2 advantage. Wednesday will be the first postseason meeting between the two teams. In Jerod Haase's final game as the head coach at UAB before being hired at Stanford, his Blazers squad dropped a 97-79 decision at BYU in the first round of the NIT on March 16, 2016. Stanford and BYU last met on Dec. 20, 2014 in Provo, Utah, with BYU winning, 79-77. Dorian Pickens, Michael Humphrey, Reid Travis and Robert Cartwright, then freshmen, are the lone current members of the Cardinal to have played in that game. Travis collected 15 points and six rebounds in the contest.

## CARDINAL RECORDED MOST CONFERENCE WINS, HIGHEST FINISH IN 10 SEASONS

Stanford finished with 11 conference wins, its most in 10 seasons (13-5 in 2008) and five more than last season's league win total. The Cardinal tied for third in the conference, its highest finish in the standings since a second-place finish in 2008. Stanford has posted 10 or more conference wins just three times over the last 10 seasons. Stanford opened Pac-12 play with a 5-1 mark for the second time in the last 14 seasons. In January, the Cardinal won five consecutive conference games for the first time in 10 seasons and posted its first conference road sweep (Washington/Washington State) in eight seasons.

## PAC-12 HONORS CARDINAL TRIO

Junior Reid Travis was a First Team All-Pac-12 selection for the second consecutive season, while senior Dorian Pickens was an honorable mention All-Pac-12 pick and freshman Daejon Davis was one of five members on the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team as selected by the coaches. Travis, the conference's only repeat first-team pick, is the first Cardinal repeat First Team All-Pac-12 selection since Chasson Randle (2014 and 2015). Davis is the first Cardinal to make the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team since Randle was selected to the squad in 2012.

## PICKENS VOTED SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

Senior Dorian Pickens was named the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year. The senior was also a First Team Pac-12 All-Academic selection for the third consecutive year. Pickens, an All-Pac-12 pick for his performance on the court as well, owns a 3.42 cumulative grade-point average in communications. He was recently voted to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team.

## R2T2

Fresh off his second consecutive First Team All-Pac-12 selection, All-America candidate Reid Travis has established himself as one of the top players at his position in the nation. The forward was recently named to both the NABC and USBWA All-District teams. He ranks in the top-three in the Pac-12 in 10 categories. The junior has registered seven double-doubles in his last nine games, including each of the last five contests. In Travis' last seven games, he is averaging 21.3 points and 11.6 rebounds in leading Stanford to 5-2 record during that span. He is ninth on Stanford's single-season scoring list with 643 points so far this season.

Reid Travis is third in the Pac-12 in both scoring (19.5 ppg) and rebounding (8.5 rpg). Travis and Arizona's DeAndre Ayton are the lone players to rank in the top five of the conference in both categories. Travis ranks in the top three in the Pac-12 in 10 categories. ## PICKENS EIGHTH ON CAREER THREE POINTERS LIST

Dorian Pickens, who missed 11 games with a foot injury this season, ranks eighth in school history with 193 career threes. The senior has totaled 34 threes in the last 10 games, with multiple threes in each of his last 15 games. He led the Pac-12 in threes per game (3.1), was sixth in three-point percentage (.455) and eighth in scoring (15.9 ppg) during conference play. Despite missing the 11 contests, Pickens leads the team with 65 threes. Pickens, the 46th all-time and one of three active members of Stanford's 1,000-point club, enters Wednesday's NIT game with 1,158 career points.

## HOME SWEET HOME

Stanford completed the 2017-18 regular season 13-4 at Maples Pavilion. The 13 wins are tied (2014-15) for the most regular-season home victories in the past six years. The 2011-12 team won 17 home games during the regular season and 20 overall with three NIT victories at Maples Pavilion.

## WINNING THE BATTLE OF THE BOARDS

Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey have helped Stanford win the rebounding battle in 26 of 33 games, including 22 of the last 26 contests. The Cardinal is second in the Pac-12 in rebounding at 38.4 rpg. Only four opponents (Arizona's DeAndre Ayton (12 pts., 10 rebs.), Washington's Noah Dickerson (14 pts., 13 rebs.), USC's Chimezie Metu (12 pts., 10 rebs.) and UCLA's Thomas Welsh (18 pts., 11 rebs.)) have recorded a double-double against Stanford in the last 38 games.

## LAST TIME OUT

Junior Reid Travis posted his seventh double-double in his last nine games and freshman KZ Okpala scored a career-high 23 points, however, No. 5 seed Stanford came up short in an 88-77 defeat to No. 4 seed UCLA in the quarterfinals of the Pac-12 Tournament last Thursday at T-Mobile Arena in Las Vegas. The Cardinal fell behind early, trailing by as many as 13 points midway through the first half. That deficit was quickly erased, however, as Stanford used an 8-0 run in a minute span to climb back into it. However, UCLA, led by Aaron Holiday's 34 points, stretched its advantage to 11 with five minutes to play and held on for the 11-point win.

## YOUTH MOVEMENT

One of the top recruiting classes in school history has played a big role in its first season on The Farm. Each of the Cardinal's four freshmen have started at least one game and three - Daejon Davis, Oscar da Silva and Isaac White - started together in six games. At least two freshmen have started in 31 games and at least one freshman has started in all 33 games.

All four average at least 17 minutes per game. Davis leads the Cardinal in assists (4.8 apg), White is second on the team in three pointers (38) and da Silva is second on the Cardinal roster in blocks (28). KZ Okpala, who made his collegiate debut 21 games ago, is averaging 10.2 ppg in 28.0 mpg.

In the win in Stanford's first meeting with Arizona State this season, the Cardinal's final 16 points were scored by freshmen. In the victory at Washington St., Stanford's four freshmen scored the first 23 points of the second half during a 21-3 run to erase Stanford's deficit en route to the road win.

## POST PRESENCE

Stanford's starting post players, Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey, have combined to average 29.3 points and 15.3 rebounds per game. The duo is second in the conference among starting post players in combined rebounding and fourth in combined scoring. Travis is third in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.5 ppg) and rebounding (8.5 rpg). Humphrey is 10th in the conference in rebounding (6.8 rpg).



**DAVIS DIRECTING THE OFFENSE**

Freshman Daejon Davis has started all 31 games he has played in. He's averaging 11.0 points, 5.0 assists and 4.4 rebounds in his last seven contests.

Davis' 149 assists so far are one shy of Brevin Knight's (1993-94) Stanford freshman record.

Highlighting his play is the 50-foot heave to win it at the buzzer against USC. The freshman registered career-highs in points (23) and assists (10) against UCLA on Jan 27. He has posted two double-doubles with 16 points and 10 rebounds in the win at Washington and the 23-point, 10-assist performance at UCLA. The freshman recorded 22 points seven rebounds and five assists in the win at California in February.

**OKPALA'S LAST FIVE GAMES**

After missing all but the final nonconference game, freshman KZ Okpala made his collegiate debut in late December. He has played 21 games with 19 starts. The forward is fourth on the team in scoring at 10.2 ppg in 28.0 minutes per contest. Okpala is averaging 14.6 ppg in the last five contests. He recorded his first career double-double in the regular-season finale at Arizona State with 18 points and 10 rebounds. Last time out against UCLA in the Pac-12 quarterfinal, the freshman scored a career-high 23 points in a career-long 37 minutes.

**DAVIS FOURTH FRESHMAN ALL-TIME TO WIN PLAYER OF WEEK**

Freshman Daejon Davis, who averaged 15.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists to lead Stanford to road wins at Washington State and Washington, was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week Jan. 15. Davis was the fourth Stanford freshman to win conference Player of the Week honors in school history and the first since Jan. 29, 2007, joining Brook Lopez, Jason Collins and Howard Wright.

**THE CAPTAINS IMPACT**

Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens and Michael Humphrey were each voted to the role of the Peter Sauer Captainship, honoring the legacy of the late Peter Sauer, a team captain and leader of Stanford's 1998 Final Four team. The three captains account for 58.6 percent of the scoring average (44.5 out of 75.9 ppg) and 49.5 percent (19.0 out of 38.4 rpg) of the rebounding average.

**FLOOR BURNS STAT COMES TO THE FARM**

During his standout collegiate career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court, diving for loose balls and taking charges, whatever he could do to help his team win. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" stat was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 in the 1996-97 season. For the second season, Stanford is tracking floor burns as an official stat throughout the year.

**DAVIS' BUZZER-BEATER WAS FIRST IN 14 SEASONS**

Daejon Davis' 50-foot shot to defeat USC at the buzzer Jan. 7 was the first game-winning buzzer-beater for the Cardinal in 14 seasons. On March 3, 2004, Matt Lottich hit a desperation three-pointer as time expired to give No. 1 and undefeated Stanford a 63-61 victory over Washington State at Beasley Coliseum. Davis' buzzer-beater was the first for the Cardinal at Maples Pavilion since Nick Robinson connected on a 35-foot running jumper at the buzzer to give No. 2 Stanford an 80-77 victory over No. 12 Arizona on Feb. 7, 2004.



**TRAVIS COLLECTS FIRST PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

Junior Reid Travis was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week after the forward averaged a double-double in leading Stanford to a sweep of the Washington schools in late February. Travis averaged 26.5 points and 10.0 rebounds, while shooting 60 percent (18-of-30) from the field in the Cardinal's two wins. He scored a career-high 33 points and collected nine rebounds in the 16-point victory over Washington, posting 23 points in the first half against the Huskies. The forward recorded his 10th double-double of the season with 20 points and 11 rebounds in the win over Washington State.

**MOST POWER FIVE OPPONENTS IN FIVE YEARS**

Stanford's challenging nonconference schedule included four opponents from power five conferences. The Cardinal played North Carolina (ACC), Florida (SEC), Ohio State (Big Ten) and Kansas (Big 12), with all but the UNC contest taking place away from Maples Pavilion. It's the most power five conference opponents in five years, since the Cardinal faced Missouri (SEC), Minnesota (Big Ten), NC State (ACC) and Northwestern (Big Ten) during its 2012 slate. Stanford went 1-3 in those games, defeating Northwestern (70-68) on the road.

**WIN NO. 100 FOR HAASE**

The Dec. 17 victory over San Francisco was head coach Jerod Haase's 100th career coaching victory. He is in his sixth season as a head coach and second with Stanford, following four successful seasons at UAB. He is 32-32 in his second season as head coach of the Cardinal.

**WHITE POSTS BEST DEBUT MARK SINCE 1977**

Freshman Isaac White's 17-point performance against Cal Poly in the season opener on Nov. 10 was the second-most points by a true freshman in his collegiate debut in the 103-year history of the program.

**PETER SAUER CAPTAINSHIP**

Jerod Haase announced the establishment of the Peter Sauer Captainship this season, naming Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens and Michael Humphrey captains. The three wear patches on their uniforms honoring the legacy of the late Peter Sauer, a team captain and leader of Stanford's 1998 Final Four team. Stanford celebrated the 20-year anniversary of the 1998 Final Four team in the regular-season home finale against Washington State on Feb. 24.

**THE FOURTH-YEAR CLASS**

The four members of Stanford's fourth-year class - Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens, Michael Humphrey and Robert Cartwright - accounted for 62.6 percent of the team's scoring and 55.4 percent of the team's rebounding last season. Pickens and Humphrey are true seniors, while Travis and Cartwright have each had their medical hardship waivers granted and are redshirt juniors with another year of eligibility remaining after this season. Cartwright missed the entire 2015-16 season with a compound fracture of his right forearm sustained in preseason practice on Nov. 2, 2015. Travis was forced to miss the final 22 games of the 2015-16 season with a right leg injury.

**TOP-TIER RECRUITING CLASS**

After signing a consensus top-25 national recruiting class last season, the Cardinal once again inked one of the nation's top classes for 2018. On Nov. 8, Stanford announced the signing of 6-5 guard Cormac Ryan from New York, New York, and 7-0 forward Keenan Fitzmorris of Overland Park, Kansas. Fitzmorris is the younger brother of Stanford women's volleyball All-American Audriana Fitzmorris.

**CARDINAL FINISH THIRD, DESPITE PRESEASON PICKS**

Stanford was selected fifth in the Pac-12 Conference media preseason poll. The Cardinal totaled 182 points to place fifth in a vote of the media members. The Cardinal completed the conference season tied for third in the Pac-12 with UCLA and Utah. Stanford was also picked fifth in the 2014-15 preseason poll. The Cardinal finished ninth in the conference in 2016-17.

**CARDINAL DOUBLE-DOUBLES**

Stanford individuals have totaled 23 double-doubles in 33 games, with 14 from Reid Travis, four Michael Humphrey, two from Daejon Davis and one each from Dorian Pickens, Oscar da Silva and KZ Okpala.

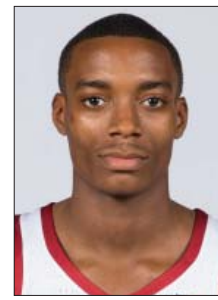

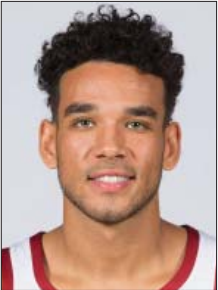

After being introduced as the Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball by Jaquish & Kenninger Director of Athletics Bernard Muir on March 25, 2016, Jerod Haase developed a strong relationship with his program and instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude among his student-athletes.

In his first year at the helm of the Cardinal program, Stanford posted 14 wins against one of the toughest schedules in the nation. Redshirt sophomore Reid Travis earned First Team All-Pac-12 and NABC All-District honors, developing into one of the top players in the conference on both ends of the court. His program finished in the top-10 percent among men's basketball programs nationally in the classroom as well.

Haase and his staff signed a top-tier recruiting class that is rated as high as No. 10 nationally in the 2017 rankings, welcoming the four-member class to The Farm for the 2017-18 season.

Haase arrived on The Farm prior to the 2016-17 season after completing his fourth season as the head coach at UAB, where he led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament appearance in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Tabbed the 2016 Gene Bartow Conference USA Coach of the Year, Haase led the Blazers to a 26-5 overall record and a 16-2 conference mark while capturing their first regular-season title since 2011. Along the way, UAB established school records for overall victories (26), conference wins (16), road wins (10) and consecutive victories (14). Also named the 2016 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Coach, Haase directed the Blazers to an NIT berth for the 12th time in school history. UAB also finished 16-0 at home in his final season at the helm of the Blazers, extending the nation's fifth-longest home winning streak to 25, while ranking among the nation's best in field goal percentage (.478 - 24th), assists per game (18.4 - 4th) and blocks per game (4th - 6.1).

Under Haase's guidance, UAB returned to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, shocking No. 3 seed Iowa State, 60-59, in the second round for the Blazers' first NCAA victory since 2005. UAB reached the Big Dance after claiming the program's first Conference USA Tournament title despite being seeded No. 4. The triumph marked UAB's first league tournament title since 1987, when the Blazers won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. More impressively, Haase successfully developed a roster comprised of 10 underclassmen - all players recruited by Haase and his staff - and finished 20-16 overall while guiding the third-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

The Blazers made impressive strides under Haase's leadership during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing 18-13 overall while notching three victories against teams that qualified for the NCAA Tournament. Of UAB's 18 victories, perhaps none were more impressive than the Blazers' 63-59 home win against No. 16 North Carolina. UAB was ranked in the top five nationally in rebounding throughout the season and finished the year ranked second in the country at 44.5 boards per game.

During Haase's first year with the Blazers in 2012-13, UAB won six of its final nine regular-season Conference USA games and collected a victory in the conference tournament.

Prior to arriving at UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. A 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration, Haase got his start as Kansas' Director of Operations from 1999-2003. During that time, the Jayhawks reached the 2002 Final Four and the national championship game in 2003.

When Williams was named head coach at North Carolina prior to the 2003-04 season, he brought Haase with him as an assistant coach and director of operations, a title Haase held from 2003-09. Haase then served exclusively as an assistant coach during his final three seasons with the Tar Heels.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, Haase attended California in 1992-93 before transferring to Kansas. He helped lead the Jayhawks to three consecutive conference titles and finished his career ranked in the school's top 10 in assists, three-point field goals and steals. Haase started 99 of 101 games at Kansas and scored 1,264 points, averaging 12.5 per game and reaching double figures 74 times. While at Kansas, Haase was a candidate for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.

As a senior in 1996-97, Haase started alongside Jacque Vaughn, Scot Pollard, Paul Pierce and Raef LaFrentz as Kansas finished with a 34-2 record while averaging 12.0 points per game despite playing with a broken wrist. As a sophomore in 1994-95, Haase averaged 15.0 points and was named the Big Eight Conference Newcomer of the Year and also tabbed a second-team all-conference selection.

Haase was a first-team GTE Academic All-American as a senior, a second-team Academic All-American as a junior and a three-time academic all-conference pick. The Jayhawks' Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 1997, Haase later earned a master's degree in business at Kansas in 2000.

Haase started 23 games in 1992-93 as a freshman at California, teaming with Jason Kidd in the backcourt.

In 2017, Haase joined the National Advisory Board of the Positive Coaching Alliance, the organization that uses the power of positive reinforcement to pursue winning and the more important goal of teaching life lessons through sports.

Haase, 42, and his wife, the former Mindy Meidinger, have three children: Gavin (11), Garrett (7) and Gabrielle (4).
