RIGHT AWAY

• Long Beach State is coming off back-to-back narrow victories at home. The Beach were able to survive one-score games against both Pepperdine and Colorado State to improve to 4-1 at Walter Pyramid this season. LBSU will be seeking its first road win of the season on Saturday.

• Senior guard Deishuan Booker had a team-high 14 points for the Beach, scoring half of those points in the final 2:12 of the game to lead the Beach to victory in crunch time. Temidayo Yussuf added 12 points, seven rebounds and three assists in the win and Mason Riggins posted season highs in points (9) and rebounds (10).

•The Beach went just 13/21 at the free throw line, but went 8/8 as a team over the final three minutes to preserve the win. KJ Byers made two key defensive plays down the stretch, recording a steal and a blocked shot in the final 25 seconds to deny the Rams a shot at tying the game.

SCOUTING THE CARDINAL

• Stanford is unbeaten at home this season, going 4-0, while three of its five losses have come against ranked teams. One defeat came on the road against then-No. 2 Kansas on Dec. 1 as the Cardinal pushed the Jayhawks to overtime before falling 90-84. Stanford is coming off a 74-65 loss at San Francisco last Saturday.

• Sophomore forward KZ Okpala leads the Cardinal in both scoring (16.3 ppg) and rebounding (6.3 rpg) this season. Classmate Daejon Davis averages 11.3 points per contest and 3.6 assists per game as well. Freshman guard Cormac Ryan adds 11.0 points per game, but he has missed the last two contests. The Cardinal are a very young team with just one senior on the roster and nine underclassmen playing significant minutes.

• Long Beach State defeated Stanford for the first time ever in last season's meeting in Long Beach. Jordan Griffin put up a career-high 21 points and Deishuan Booker had eight assists in LBSU's 76-68 victory over the Cardinal. This is the fifth all-time meeting between the two programs.

TOUR OF THE PAC-12

- Long Beach State will play nearly half of the teams in the Pac-12 this season, with the game against Stanford representing the fifth game against a member of the conference, with four such contests coming on the road. LBSU had strong performances at UCLA and USC, taking the game down to the final minutes, along with a close home loss to Oregon State.
- Long Beach State has defeated a Pac-12 foe in each of the last two seasons, including a pair of Pac-12 victories last season over Stanford and Oregon State.

FREE MASON

- Senior forward Mason Riggins has been in the starting lineup in each of the last three contests and has gotten more involved for the Beach. He has made multiple field goals and has at least five rebounds in each of those games, culminating in a season-best performance against Colorado State with nine points and a team-leading 10 rebounds.
- Riggins leads the Beach in field goal percentage this season, making 58.5 percent of his shots from the floor.

TEMI ENGINE

- Senior center Temidayo Yussuf has been a beast inside over the last six weeks. The Oakland native has scored in double-figures in nine of his last 10 contests, averaging a team-leading 15,9 points per game in that stretch with four double-doubles. He has also recorded double-doubles in three of his last five games and in back-to-back contests against Pacific and Pepperdine.
- Yussuf established a new career high with 28 points at San Diego on Dec. 1. He was an impressive 10/13 from the floor and 8/10 at the free throw line to lead the Beach.
- With 180 points scored through 14 games this season, Yussuf now has 883 points scored in his career as he seeks to become the 24th member of the 1,000-point club at Long Beach State. With 18 games left on the regular season schedule, Yussuf would need to average just 6.5 points per game to reach the milestone this season.

SIX SENIORS

- Long Beach State boasts a six-player senior class, giving LBSU an older roster, but not necessarily one with a ton of experience. Only two of the six seniors (Temidayo Yussuf and Mason Riggins) have spent more than two seasons at the Beach, with the other four transferring in from other schools.
- LBSU returns a pair of All-Big West honorees from a season ago. Both Yussuf and Booker were Honorable Mention All-Big West selections.
- Yussuf is in his fifth season at Long Beach State, after redshirting his sophomore campaign. Entering the season, the Oakland native had appeared in 97 games during his career and has a chance to become the 24th member of the 1,000-point club at Long Beach State, needing to score 297 points during his final season to reach that mark.
- Also in the senior class, Bryan Alberts should be one of the leading perimeter weapons for the Beach in his second and final season in Long Beach. The Gonzaga transfer had an immediate impact at the start of last season before an injury caused him to miss a month of action. The three-point marksman was second on the team in scoring last season, averaging 11.3 points per game and was in double-figures a dozen times.
- Fellow senior Mason Riggins is in his fourth year at the Beach, making him another frontcourt mainstay to go with Yussuf. His first game of the 2018-19 season represented his 100th appearance for the Beach and he's made 42 starts over his previous three years. Riggins led the team with a field goal percentage of 62.4 percent, a statistic he's improved each season in Long Beach.

THIS AND THAT

- With a 70-69 win at UC Santa Barbara on Mar. 1, 2018, Long Beach State earned the 1,000th win in program history. Dan Monson is responsible for 185 of those wins, making him the winningest head coach in Long Beach State history.
- Departed senior Gabe Levin was a First Team All-Big West selection after leading the Beach in scoring (18.5 ppg) and rebounding (7.2 rpg) in 2017-18. Levin is set to begin his professional playing career in Israel with Bnei Rav-Bariach Herzliya.
- On Thursday, Nov. 8, Long Beach State basketball legend Casper Ware entered the Long Beach State Athletics Hall of Fame. Ware was at the Beach from the 2009-12 seasons, helping the Beach to the NCAA Tournament as a senior. He was a two-time Big West Player of the Year and is currently a member of Melbourne United in the National Basketball League in Australia

Long Beach State 64, Colorado State 61

LONG BEACH, Calif. -- Late-game execution was key once again for Long Beach State (5-9) during Saturday afternoon's 64-61 victory over visiting Colorado State (5-7) at Walter Pyramid. The Beach protected a late lead with some crucial defensive plays from KJ Byers, clutch free-throw shooting, and a late scoring surge from senior point guard Deishuan Booker.

Booker led Long Beach State with 14 points, scoring half of them over the final 2:12 of the game. Booker's triple at that juncture turned a one-point lead into a 58-54 advantage that LBSU would never relinquish. Temidayo Yussuf added 12 points and seven rebounds, missing out on his third consecutive double-double due in part to some foul trouble in the second half.

Senior Mason Riggins has season-highs with nine points and 10 rebounds in a solid effort inside. Byers had seven points and six boards, but his one steal and one block helped Long Beach State secure its second straight win. The Beach now sits at 4-1 in home games this season having won three in a row at Walter Pyramid.

LBSU's largest lead was nine in the second half, using a 13-2 run to lead 51-42 on a Bryan Alberts three-pointer with 10:25 to go. The Rams would respond with an immediate 12-2 run, however, edging in front 54-53 with a little over four minutes to play.

Booker's big shot from deep gave the Beach some breathing room, but CSU pulled within one on a triple from Kris Martin with 1:11 to go. After a miss on the Long Beach end, the Rams got the ball back with a chance to take the lead. That's when Byers intervened with a crucial steal, setting up Booker with a pair of free throws to put the lead back at three. LBSU shot just 13/21 (61.9%) at the free-throw line for the game, but went 8/8 in the final three minutes of the game to seal the win, getting a pair of makes from Edon Maxhuni and Jordan Roberts, along with four free throws from Booker in the final 21 seconds.

Colorado State had a look to tie the game down 62-59 with under 20 seconds to go, but Byers again got involved with a blocked shot on a three-point attempt from Martin. The Rams would eventually get a layup on the possession, but with just 3.3 seconds left, they never got another shot to tie it after two Booker free throws and a steal by Drew Cobb on the ensuing inbounds pass to half court.

Also of note, redshirt freshman Milos Apic made his Long Beach State debut with 1:26 to go in the first half. The 6-foot-10 center missed all of last season and the first 13 games of this season with injury, and he received a nice ovation from the home crowd as he made his way onto the floor.

Long Beach State will take the court again next Saturday, traveling up to Northern California to take on Stanford at 7:30 p.m. Dec. 29 on Pac-12 Network.



Dan Monson has rebuilt the Long Beach State basketball program in his 11 seasons with the Beach. The winningest coach in LBSU history, Monson has piled up 185 wins at LBSU and led Long Beach State to three Big West Championships, six top three finishes, three NIT appearances as well as a trip to the 2011-12 NCAA Tournament.

Monson's success at Long Beach State has been rewarded with three Big West Coach of the Year awards, as well as back-to-back NABC All-District Coach recognition from 2010-11 and 2011-12. The conference coaching award following the 2011-12 season marked the fourth time that Monson has been recognized as a league's top coach, previously winning the honor as the West Coast Conference Coach of the Year in 1998 following his first season at Gonzaga.

Success at the collegiate level hasn't been the only measure of what Monson has accomplished at Long Beach State. Two-time Big West Player of the Year Casper Ware reached the NBA with the Philadelphia 76ers, becoming the first 49er to enter the NBA since 2003. 2013 Big West Player of the Year James Ennis also became the first LBSU player picked in the NBA Draft since 1992, a second-round selection of the Atlanta Hawks. Ennis is entering his fifth NBA season and, during this past offseason, signed a free-agent contract with the Houston Rockets.

In 2017-18, the Beach finished fifth in the Big West after posting a 9-7 conference mark. Senior Gabe Levin was a First Team All-Big West selection for Long Beach State after leading the team in scoring (18.5 ppg) and rebounding (7.2 rpg). The Beach picked up its biggest win of the season on Dec. 3 with a 76-68 home victory over Stanford.

Monson had no returning starters in 2015-16 but still led Long Beach State to the Big West Tournament Finals and an NIT appearance, the fourth postseason appearance in his tenure at Long Beach State. Playing the nation's toughest non-conference schedule, the Beach went 7-9 against Top 100 teams, and picked up signature wins over Seton Hall and BYU. Let by Big West Newcomer of the Year Nick Faust the Beach went on to face Washington in the first round of the NIT.

In 2014-15, Monson recorded his 300th win as a head coach when the 49ers defeated Cal State Fullerton on the road, winning 91-85. With that milestone win, Monson became the second skipper in the league to reach 300 victories. His 96 wins in conference play at the Beach are tied for 7th in the history of the Big West, dating back to

In 2012-13, Monson directed a squad that lost four starters from the 2011-12 NCAA Tournament team, and guided them to a another Big West championship, a third-consecutive regular season championship, the first time in over 40 years The Beach had won three straight conference titles.

LBSU's championship season in 2012-13 came on the heels of a four-year run based on a nucleus of solid recruiting in his first few years on campus. His first recruiting class featured Greg Plater, the second-leading all-time 3-point shooter at the school, while his second recruiting class of Larry Anderson, Eugene Phelps, T.J. Robinson and Casper Ware may go down in school history as the best recruiting class of all-time at Long Beach State.

Anderson, Phelps, Robinson and Ware all rank among the all-time leaders in school history in at least two categories and all four have earned all-league honors at least twice.

Three of the four own a school record. Ware is the school's all-time assist leader, Anderson has more steals than anybody in LBSU history, and Robinson is not only the all-time leading rebounder at Long Beach State, but the leading rebounder in the history of the Big West Conference.

Ware established himself as not only one of the top players in the conference, but one of the best players in the nation. Named a finalist for the Bob Cousy Award, honoring the top point quard in Division I, as both a junior and a senior, Ware won Big West Conference Player of the Year awards and was named an honorable mention Associated Press All-American in 2011 and 2012, while also being named the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) District IX Player of the Year as a senior.

In 2010-11, Ware became the first player in Big West history to be named both the league's player of the year and its defensive player of the year. His first-team all-league selection made him the third Monson recruit at LBSU to be named first-team all-league. Ware also was named first-team All-District 9 by the NABC and first-team All-District IX by the USBWA as both a

junior and senior. Monson's team also picked up two wins over nationally-ranked teams in 2011-12, handing No. 9 Pittsburgh an 86-76 defeat on the road before knocking off No. 14 Xavier 68-58 at the Diamond Head Classic in Honolulu. The two wins over ranked teams marked the first time a LBSU team had beaten multiple top 25 teams since the 1992-93 season.

Monson was tabbed as the 16th head coach in Long Beach State men's basketball history

on April 7, 2007. He inherited a depleted roster but still managed to be competitive in his first season at LBSU. Monson has been a Division I head coach for 20 years, during which he has compiled a career record of 340-282 (.546), with 11 trips to postseason play, including a trip to the Elite Eight in 1999 with Gonzaga University.

Monson was the head coach at the University of Minnesota for seven-plus years, compiling a 118-105 mark and reaching postseason play in five of his seven seasons

In 2004-05 he led the Gophers to a memorable year. He engineered the second-best Big Ten turnaround in the previous 20 seasons, finishing with a 10-6 conference mark after posting just three league wins the previous campaign. Minnesota reached the 20-win plateau for the first time since 1992-93 and Monson led the Golden Gophers to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1999. In 2005-06 the Gophers advanced to their fifth postseason appearance in six years. Senior guard Vincent Grier was named All-Big Ten and All-District for the second straight year. In 2002-03 Minnesota went 19-14 and earned the program's first trip to the NIT semifinals in Madison Square Garden.

Monson reached two personal coaching milestones in 2004-05. With a victory over Indiana in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals, he earned his 100th victory at Minnesota. When he defeated Purdue on February 26, 2005 he picked up his 150th career head-coaching victory. With 100 victories in his first six years at Minnesota, Monson ranks second all-time at the school behind Jim Dutcher (1975-85) in wins during his first six years as head coach.

Monson stepped into the Minnesota job on the heels of NCAA sanctions against the school. Those NCAA violations during the mid-1990's severely limited scholarships and put strict recruiting sanctions on the program since the summer of 1999, coinciding with Monson's arrival at Minnesota. The summer of 2005 was the first Monson and his staff could recruit on par with every other college basketball program and that season concluded with a trip to the NCAA Tournament, the programs first year off probation.

Prior to accepting the Minnesota job on July 24, 1999, Monson was the head coach at Gonzaga for two years. In 1998-99 he led the Bulldogs to within a breath of the Final Four.

Gonzaga, which went 28-7 on the year and won the West Coast Conference regular season and tournament championships, defeated such notable NCAA powers as Minnesota (75-63), Stanford (82-74) and Florida (73-72) before bowing out to eventual national-champion Connecticut (67-62) in the Elite Eight.

His first year as head coach at Gonzaga resulted in a 24-10 mark, as the Bulldogs advanced to the second round of the NIT. Monson had a sparkling 52-17 (.754) record in his two seasons as the head coach of the Bulldogs.

Monson spent 11 years helping build the Gonzaga program. He began at GU as an assistant coach in 1988 and spent six years laying the groundwork. In 1994-95 he was elevated to associate head coach under head coach Dan Fitzgerald.

Three years later he took over full control of the Gonzaga program. He led Gonzaga to a West Coast Conference title in 1998 and was named the WCC Coach of the Year. The squad set a school-record with its 24 wins and Monson was also named the National Rookie Coach of the Year by Basketball Times.

Monson was a key figure in the Bulldogs turnaround in the 1990's. Gonzaga had a record of 223-89 over 10 seasons and he was responsible for recruiting many of the key players in Gonzaga's NCAA Sweet 16 appearances from 1998-2001. From the time Monson was named associate head coach in 1995, Gonzaga averaged 22 wins per season and reached postseason play every year but one.

Prior to joining the Bulldogs' staff, Monson spent two seasons as a graduate assistant coach under Gene Bartow at the University of Alabama-Birmingham.

Monson played one year of football at Idaho, but turned his attention to coaching when a knee injury cut short his gridiron career. He coached the boys' basketball team at Oregon City (Ore.) High School for one year prior to taking the UAB graduate assistant post.

A 1985 graduate of the University of Idaho with a bachelor degree in mathematics, Monson earned his master's degree in education with a concentration on athletic administration from UAB in 1988. In addition to his 20-plus seasons coaching Division I basketball, as either a head or assistant coach, Monson has served on two coaching staffs for USA Basketball representing the United States in international competition.

Monson gained valuable experience by coaching on the international level with USA Basketball. He was an assistant coach for Kelvin Sampson on the gold medal

winning 20-and-Under World Championships for Young Men Qualifying Tournament squad in the summer of 2004 in Halifax, Nova Scotia. He also assisted Oliver Purnell at the 1999 Men's World University Games in Mallorca, Spain where the U.S. won the gold medal. With Team USA, Monson had the opportunity to coach future NBA players Sean May, Brendan Haywood, Bracey Wright, Chris Paul, Michael Redd, Mark Madsen, Kenyon Martin and Charlie Villanueva.

Monson grew up around basketball as his father, Don, was a well-respected collegiate coach. Don was the head coach at Idaho and Oregon and was an assistant coach under Jud Heathcote at Michigan State (1976-78) for two years.

Monson and his wife Darci have four children, a son, MicGuire, a daughter, Mollie, a son, Maddox and a daughter, McKenna.
