## 2020-21 NOTABLES

- Stanford finished the regular season on Feb. 19 against No. 3 California, claiming a 153-141 dual meet victory in the Avery Aquatic Center.
- The win against California pushed Stanford to 7-0 on the season including 5-0 in Pac-12 dual meets. The victory marked the fifth dual meet win in a row against a top-25 program.
- This is the first season since 2017-18 that the Cardinal finished undefeated in the regular season.
- Grant Shoults earned a 15 second season-best mark in the 1000 free to take first place in the event with a time of 8:46.79.
- Luke Maurer and Preston Forst took second and third respectively in the 200 free. Both finished with season-best times in the event, with Maurer clocking a 1:33.39 and Forst taking a 1:33.63.
- Leon MacAlister kept the momentum for the Cardinal in the 100 backstroke, finishing first with a 46.07, another season-best swim. Ron Polonsky, Aaron Sequeira, and Shane Blinkman all finished with season-best marks in the event as well.
- The Cardinal finished two, three, four in the 100 breast, with Daniel Roy, Ethan Dang, and Jon Cook finishing in that order. Roy and Cook also took home season-best times which included an NCAA B standard time for the latter.
- Jonathan Affeld had an impressive day in butterfly events. The sophomore took home two event victories in the 200 fly and 100 fly. His time of 1:41.42 in the 200 is the fastest by any Stanford swimmer in the event this season, and the third-fastest all-time on The Farm. Affeld's victory in the 100 fly later in the meet came with a time of 45.34, a season-best and the fourth-fastest swim in Stanford history.
- In the short distance freestyle events, Andrei Minakov took second in the 50 free with a 19.27 while Rick Mihm finished fifth in the event with a 19.95, good for an NCAA B standard time. Luke Maurer and Mason Gonzalez each recorded a season-best time in the 100 free with Maurer clocking a 43.27 and Gonzalez taking a 43.82.
- Leon MacAlister nabbed second in the 200 back with a season-best time of 1:40.28. This mark also placed him seventh all-time in the Stanford record book, one spot above Cardinal great Jeff Rouse.
- Preston Forst earned the event win in the 500 free, clocking a 4:14.10, a season-best time by more than a second.
- In the 200 individual medley, Ron Polonsky shaved nearly three seconds off of his season record with a 1:42.32. Rick Mihm, Alex Liang, and Shane Blinkman also posted season-best marks, with all three of them earning NCAA B standard times.
- Heading into the final event, the 400 free relay, Stanford held a narrow three point lead. The team of Leon MacAlister, Luke Maurer, Jonathan Affeld, and Andrei Minakov combined for the meet winning event victory with a time of 2:49.59.
- In the diving pool, Conor Casey, Jack Ryan, and Hunter Hollenbeck finished in that order in both the 1-meter and 3-meter competitions. Ryan recorded a season-best 390.53 on the 1-meter.
- In the most recent CSCAA poll, Stanford moved up from no. 11 to no. 6.
- Andrei Minakov was named the Pac-12 swimmer of the week after a dominant performance at #8 USC.
- Stanford men's swimming and diving upset No. 8 USC, 182-118 on Saturday at the Uytensu Aquatic Center. The win improves the 11th-ranked Cardinal to 6-0 on the season, 4-0 in Pac-12 duals, and is the fourth straight win against a Top-25 opponent.
- Stanford took home 11 event titles on the day, including sweeping both relay events against the Trojans (4-2, 2-2 Pac-12)
- Andrei Minakov scored 23.5 points to lead the Cardinal, picking up victories in the 50 free (19.58) and 100 fly (46.40). He also swam on Stanford's two winning relay teams to victory, including a 17-hundredths of a second victory over the Trojans in the 200 medley relay to open the meet – 1:25.67 to 1:25.84.
- The 200 medley relay team was comprised of Minakov, Leon MacAlister and Ron Polonsky.
- Preston Forst picked up wins in the 200 free (1:35.44) and 500 free (4:20.47) and swam the opening leg of Stanford's victorious 400 free relay team to close out the dual. The sophomore was joined by Neel Roy, Luke Maurer and Minakov in the latter event.
- The Cardinal swept the 200 IM led by Polonsky's 1:46.01 coming out of the final break. He was followed by Rick Mihm (1:46.65) and Alex Liang (1:49.87). Polonsky also won the 200 back in 1:44.99 and finished third in the 100 breast in 53.98 to swim NCAA B standards in both events.
- Liang also won the 200 fly in 1:47.32.
- Grant Shoults won the 1000 free in 9:00.21 and was second in the 500 free (4:22.28). Shoults' time in the 1000 free was his fastest of the season. Daniel Roy (1:56.27) and Ethan Dang (1:58.08) went 1-2 in the 200 breast.
- In the diving pool, Jack Ryan finished second on the 3-meter with a score of 342.45. Both Ryan and Ethan Foster set season-best marks on the 1-meter with scores of 372.68 and 328.88, respectively. Stanford moved to 5-0 on the season and 3-0 in Pac-12 meets with two victories over no. 6 Arizona State and no. 20 Arizona.
- Leon MacAlister won Pac-12 swimmer of the week as he won three individual events and two relays during the two meets.
- Conor Casey took home Pac-12 diver of the week after winning three of four total events during the two duals.
- Ron Polonsky earned three NCAA B standard times, in the 100 back, 200 breast, and 200 individual medley.
- Earlier in January, Stanford kicked off 2022 with two wins. The Cardinal defeated Harvard and Pacific in the first home meet of the season.
- Stanford claimed 10 victories in the 16 total events, including multiple event wins from Andrei Minakov, Grant Shoults, and Ron Polonsky.
- Four Stanford divers competed at the Bruin Diving Invite in Los Angeles in mid-January.
- Conor Casey was the top Cardinal finisher on the 1-meter and took second place with a score of 739.95.
- On the 3-meter, Conor Casey earned a score of 795.30 and second place.
- Jack Ryan took third place with a score of 743 while Ethan Foster earned fourth with a score of 683.40. Hunter Hollenbeck took home fifth with a mark of 675.60.
- The Cardinal ended the fall season on a high note at the NC State/GAC Invite which included 42 NCAA A and B standard cuts, a Stanford record setting swim in the 100 free by Andrei Minakov, and multiple event wins.
- Daniel Roy and Ethan Dang led the way in the 100 and 200 breast for Stanford, reaching B standard times in both events. Roy recorded the second-fastest time in Stanford history behind his own time from last season.
- Leon MacAlister continued his hot start to the season, clocking a B standard time in the 50 free, 100 back, and 200 back.
- The Cardinal started the season ranked tenth in the Preseason CSCAA Poll.
- Stanford has two Olympians on the team this year, Andrei Minakov who competed for the Russian Olympic Committee and Ron Polonsky who swam for Israel in Tokyo.
- The 2021-22 season marks the third campaign under the direction of Dan Schemmel.
