

SERIES **HISTORY**

Overall vs. Kansas: 18-3 (.833) • First meeting in 2004

- All 21 games of the series have been played at Sunken Diamond.
- Stanford has won five straight in the series after a sweep last season when the Cardinal won 2-0, 10-4 and 6-2 in its first series after Finals (March 18-20).
- These two teams have now met in each of the last three seasons.
- Prior to that, Kansas and Stanford met for four straight years (2004-07). Stanford swept the series in 2004, 2005 and 2007. Kansas earned its only series win with two victories in 2006.

Current Cardinal Against the Jayhawks

- Starter Chris Castellanos is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA in two appearances (6.2 inn) vs. Kansas.
- Alex Dunlap hits .368 (7-of-19) against KU with two doubles and three RBI.
- Colton Hock threw 2.2 scoreless innings in two games against Kansas last year, which included five strikeouts and just one hit.
- Nico Hoerner was 5-of-10 with 3 runs, 2B, 3B and 3 RBI against KU last year.
- Andrew Summerville earned a win in relief over the Jayhawks last year with just one run and three hits allowed, and four strikeouts in 5.1 innings.
- Tyler Thorne has a save, 0.00 ERA, 2 SO's, 0 BB, 1 H in 3.1 innings (2 app) against Kansas.
- · Last year, Brandon Wulff registered his first career home run against the Jayhawks, while Duke Kinamon notched his first career hit.

LAST WEEKEND

- On Opening Day, sophomore Kris Bubic was perfect through four, held a no-hitter into the sixth and struck out a career-high 10 batters, but No. 8 Fullerton tallied the game's only run.
- On Saturday, Fullerton (2-0) opened up a 6-0 lead after five innings and kept the Cardinal hitless until the sixth. Stanford had five freshmen (three pitchers) make their college debuts and fell 8-1.
- In the finale, Fullerton again scored the first six. But Stanford chipped away and it was 6-4 heading to the ninth. With two strikes and two outs, Quinn Brodey hit a game-tying double. Matt Winaker had the game-winning RBI with a double in the 11th inning for a 7-6 victory.

- Stanford plays eight games in 10 days all at Sunken Diamond.
- The Cardinal plays its first 16 games in 23 days before spring break and conference play.
- Stanford is next on the road when it makes its longest road trip of the season to Houston, Texas to take on Rice. This will mark the fifth straight season Stanford has traveled to Texas.

CARDINAL **NOTES**

We're No. 1 🤞

- Stanford finished the 2016 season ranked No. 1 in the nation in fielding percentage (.983). It also set a school record, which eclipsed the previous mark set in 2005 (.977).
- The Cardinal's 35 errors last season were the fewest in the country (295 teams), and also a program record. The previous Stanford standard for fewest errors in a season was 49. set in 2009.
- The 2016 Stanford pitching staff finished atop the Pac-12 in ERA (3.17), fewest hits allowed (412), fewest runs allowed (201), and fewest home runs (18) allowed.

Stanford Stats III

- The Cardinal, which finished 31-23 in 2016, has posted a .500 season or better in 38 of the first 40 seasons under head coach Mark Marquess. Coach Marquess is 14 wins from becoming the fourth coach in Division I history with 1,600 career wins (fifth person ever).
- Stanford held its opponent to two or fewer runs 23 times last year and went 22-1 in those contests. Stanford is 0-1 this season in that scenario—a 1-0 defeat on Opening Day.
- The Cardinal is 23-4 when out-hitting its opponent since 2016.


- Senior Jack Klein has played in all but four games over the last three seasons.
- Junior Matt Winaker has played in 71 straight games. The last time he did not enter Coach Marquess' lineup was April 28, 2015 vs. SJSU).
- Winaker has gone 68 straight games without an error (last was May 3, 2015 at Oregon). Since then, he's been perfect on all 598 chances. For his career, Winaker has made just two errors in 107 games and 942 chances.
- ☑ Junior Quinn Brodey has started 67 consecutive games for the Cardinal last time he was not in starting lineup was May 5, 2015 vs. Santa Clara.
- 🔽 Junior outfielder Quinn Brodey's 14-game hit streak at the end of last season (ended in final series of the year against Oregon) was the longest of the year for the Cardinaland the longest for a Stanford player since current Cincinnati Reds prospect Alex Blandino hit safely in 24 straight in 2014.

- Will Matthiessen appeared as a defensive replacement at first base on Saturday, and then retired all six batters he faced in his college pitching debut on Sunday.
- Reliever Jack Little struck out the side in his inning of work last week.
- Andrew Daschbach is 2-for-2 with a double and RBI after his first two career at-bats he was a pinch-hitter in both instances.
- Relievers Zach Grech (1.0 inn) and Erik Miller (3.2 inn) also made their first appearances as Cardinal against Fullerton.

- Stanford plays 29 of its 54 games at Sunken Diamond.
- Stanford opened with four straight road contests for the first time since starting with seven straight away from The Farm in 2001 (finished as national runner-up).
- The Cardinal play its first 16 games in just 23 days.
- 11-day break from March 12-23 for finals.
- Longest road stint this year is four games (five times).
- Longest home stand is eight games on two occasions—that includes a 25-day stretch from March 12-April 6 after Finals where Stanford doesn't leave The Farm.
- Stanford has 20 games against NCAA Tournament teams from last season.

Announcing Staff Changes

- ▶ Brock Ungricht was hired as a scout for the St. Louis Cardinals. Former volunteer assistant Jon Karcich was hired in his place as a full-time assistant coach and Nicholas Enriquez has assumed Karcich's duties as a volunteer assistant for the Cardinal.
- ► Karcich, a former standout at Santa Clara, was a volunteer on Coach Marquess' staff for the last two years.
- Enriquez comes to The Farm after four seasons as an assistant at San Jose State and eight years at Dartmouth.

Preseason Prognostications 🕙

- Pac-12 coaches picked Stanford baseball to finish second in the conference in 2016.
- ▶ Oregon State was selected as the Pac-12 favorite. The Beavers earned 97 points and eight first-place votes, while Stanford garnered two first-place votes and 89 points.
- Last season, Stanford was picked seventh and finished sixth at 15-15 in conference play.
- Stanford was also among the Top 25 in all five preseason national polls.


