## Oregon State (11-9, 3-5) at Stanford (11-11, 5-4)

February 1, 2018 • 8:00 p.m. PT • Maples Pavilion • Stanford, Calif.

**THE GAME:** Oregon State heads to the Bay Area this week, beginning with a stop on The Farm to play Stanford at 8 p.m. on Thursday at Maples Pavilion.

**QUICKLY:** In conference games, Oregon State leads the Pac-12 in scoring defense (66.1) and field goal percentage defense (.414) ... The Beavers are shooting 70.7 percent from the free throw line; it would be their best percentage since the 2004-05 team shot 72.4 percent ... Tres Tinkle is the only Pac-12 player to score in double figures in every game this season ... Tinkle is shooting 93.9 percent (31-for-33) from the free throw line in Pac-12 play; the Oregon State single-season conference record is 89.9 percent by Brent Barry (1994-95) ... Drew Eubanks is tied for fourth in the Pac-12 in blocked shots (1.8) and sixth in field goal percentage (.608) ... Stephen Thompson Jr. has scored in double figures and made at least five field goals in nine consecutive games ... Ethan Thompson shot 87.5 percent (14-for-16) from the free throw line the past three games ... Seth Berger has grabbed at least four rebounds in six consecutive games ... Gligorije Rakocovic averaged 5.0 points in 11.5 minutes the last two games.

**vs. STANFORD:** Oregon State and Stanford meet for the 144th time with the Beavers holding a 73-70 advantage. The Cardinal has a 40-29 edge on their home court, by going 21-2 at Maples Pavilion since 1993.

Oregon State won on The Farm two years ago, 62-50, on Feb. 11, 2016 to snap a 10-game conference road losing streak. Tres Tinkle scored a game-high 19 points and grabbed nine rebounds, while Gary Payton II added 14 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals.

The other Oregon State win at Maples Pavilion since 1993 came on Jan. 24, 2009 when the Beavers won, 77-62, behind 25 points from Calvin Haynes, 19 from Seth Tarver and 18 from Roeland Schaftenaar.

Stanford won both meetings last season. The first was a 62-46 victory on Jan. 19 at Gill Coliseum when Stephen Thompson Jr. scored a team-high 15 points. The second was a 79-66 win on Feb. 22 at Maples Pavilion when Drew Eubanks dropped 21 points and 14 rebounds, and Gligorije Rakocevic scored a career-high 16 points.

**CHASING 1,000:** Oregon State has three players who have a chance to join the 1,000-point club this season. It would be the third time in program history that a team had three 1,000-point scorers. Stephen Thompson Jr. reached the milestone against Oregon, while Drew Eubanks needs 49 points and Tres Tinkle needs 168.

**TEAM NOTES:** Here are some quick-hitters about the 2017-18 Oregon State men's basketball team:

- Oregon State leads the Pac-12 in scoring defense (68.6); it would be the first time leading the conference in that category since 2001-02 (66.5).
- The Beavers are shooting 70.7 percent from the free throw line; it would be their best percentage since the 2004-05 team shot 72.4 percent.
- In conference games, Oregon State leads the Pac-12 in scoring defense (66.1) and field goal percentage defense (.414).
- Oregon State is 8-0 overall, and 2-0 in the Pac-12, when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
- The Beavers are 2-0 in Pac-12 play when shooting a better percentage than their opponent; 1-5 when the opponent shoots a better percentage.
- Oregon State is 3-0 in Pac-12 play when limiting its opponent to less than 40 percent from the field; 0-5 when the opponent shoots better than 40 percent.
- In six of the nine losses, Oregon State had its biggest lead with less than 14 minutes left in the game -- 53-47 with 11:49 to play vs. Wyoming; 62-52 with 9:32 to play vs. St. John's; 49-42 with 10:26 to play vs. Long Beach State; 53-47 with 11:24 to play vs. Utah; 57-44 with 11:43 to play at Arizona State; 45-37 with 13:20 to play against USC.
- In four seasons under Wayne Tinkle, Oregon State is 40-12 when leading at halftime and 44-5 when leading with five minutes to play.
- A record seven Oregon State players were named to Pac-12 All-Academic teams last season.
- Nine Oregon State players have a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or better.

**TRES TINKLE:** Here are some quick hitters about Tres Tinkle, a redshirt sophomore forward from Missoula, Mont.:

- Is the only Pac-12 player to score in double figures in every game this season.
- Is the only Pac-12 player in the top 15 in the conference in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals.
- Is sixth in the Pac-12 in scoring (17.9), tied for ninth in rebounding (7.3), 12th in assists (3.5), tied for ninth in steals (1.4), third in free throw percentage (.874) and second in minutes played (35.9).
- Shooting 87.4 percent from the free throw line in all games; the Oregon State single-season record is 89.2 percent by Chris Stephens (2005-06).
- Shooting 93.9 percent (31-for-33) from the free throw line in Pac-12 play; the Oregon State single-season conference record is 89.9 percent by Brent Barry.
- Had streaks of 23 and 21 consecutive free throws made this season.
- Leads the team with four double-doubles; he had four double-doubles in 33 career games entering this season.
- Has scored 20-plus points seven times this season; he scored 20-plus points seven times in 33 career games entering this season.
- His career scoring average of 15.7 is the 10th best in Oregon State history.
- Selected to the Pac-12 All-Academic Second Team last season with a 3.44 cumulative GPA in university exploratory studies.

**DREW EUBANKS:** Here are some quick hitters about Drew Eubanks, a junior forward from Troutdale, Ore.:

- Has taken three shots and scored four points in each of the last two games; he averaged 8.4 shots and 13.2 points in the first 18 games.
- Averaging 14.9 points and shooting 67.0 percent from the field in wins; 9.1 points and 50.8 percent in losses.
- Is sixth in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage (.608); he finished fourth in that category as a sophomore (.587) and a freshman (.580).
- Is tied for fourth in the Pac-12 in blocked shots (1.8).
- Has dished out 12 assists in the last six games; he had six assists in the first 14 games.
- Is the only player on the roster who hasn't missed a game the past three seasons (84 total); has started 67 consecutive games.
- Is third on Oregon State's career blocked shots list with 143; next up is Scott Haskin with 172 (1989-93).
- Went 10-for-10 from the field against Loyola Marymount; joined Oregon State legends Steve Johnson (twice), Charlie Sitton (twice) and A.C. Green to be perfect in a game with a minimum 10 attempts.
- Selected Pac-12 All-Academic Honorable Mention last season with a 3.07 cumulative GPA in university exploratory studies.

**STEPHEN THOMPSON JR.:** Here are some quick hitters about Stephen Thompson Jr., a junior guard from Los Angeles, Calif.:

- Has scored in double figures and made at least five field goals in nine consecutive games.
- Is tied for fourth in the Pac-12 in steals (1.6) and third in minutes played (35.3).
- Shooting 42.9 percent (33-for-77) from beyond the arc the last 13 games; shot 19.4 percent (7-for-36) from deep the first seven games.
- Averaging 5.4 points in the first half this season (third on the team); 10.9 in the second half (first on the team).
- Is tied for 29th on Oregon State's career scoring list with 1,089 points; next up is Vince Fritz with 1,121.
- Is tied for eighth on Oregon State's career 3-pointers made list with 145; next up are Josh Steinthal (1999-01) and Charles McKinney (1990-93) with 160.
- Has scored the game-winning points in the final seconds three times in his career (free throws vs. Utah with one-tenth of a second to play; 3-pointer at the buzzer vs. Washington; layup vs. Utah with 10.3 seconds to play).
- Selected to the Pac-12 All-Academic First Team last season with a 3.49 cumulative GPA in digital communication arts.

**ETHAN THOMPSON:** Here are some quick hitters about Ethan Thompson, a freshman guard from Los Angeles, Calif.:

- Has started all 20 games.
- Is second on the team in free throw percentage (.709) and blocked shots (10), and third on the team in rebounds (81), assists (62) and steals (14).
- Is tied for 13th in the Pac-12 in assist/turnover ratio (1.5).
- Shot 87.5 percent (14-for-16) from the free throw line the past three games; was 67.1 percent (47-for-70) from the stripe in the first 17 games.
- Scored 20 points in the season opener; it's the second-most points by an Oregon State freshman in their college debut (Steve Johnson, 22, Nov. 26, 1976).

**SETH BERGER:** Here are some quick hitters about Seth Berger, a senior forward from Seattle, Wash.:

- Has started the last 15 games.
- Leads the team with an assist/turnover ratio of 2.17 in conference play (13/6).
- Averaging 17.4 minutes and shooting 52.7 percent from the field as a starter; averaged 6.0 minutes and shot 33.3 percent from the field as a reserve.
- Averaged 6.9 points, 4.7 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 0.9 steals in the last seven games, while shooting 59.4 percent from the field, 37.5 percent from beyond the arc and 63.6 percent from the free throw line.
- Is 3-for-8 from beyond the arc in the last six games; started the season 0-for-5 from deep.

- Has played 29 minutes the last four games and hasn't committed a turnover.

- Scored first career points on a layup in the second half against Colorado.
- Had first career steal against Arkansas-Pine Bluff.
- Won the slam dunk contest during the team's open practice on Oct. 14.
- Joined the team as a walk-on after averaging 22.8 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.3 steals as a senior at O'Dea High School in Seattle, Wash.

# WAYNE TINKLE

**Head Coach**  
**4th Year**  
**Montana, 2005**

If past success is the surest indicator of future success, Oregon State will return to prominence in the Pac-12 Conference under Wayne Tinkle.

The veteran head coach has upgraded and retooled his roster for his fourth season at the helm in Corvallis. Those actions position the Beavers to significantly improve upon a challenging 2016-17 season.

The loss of seven starters/key reserves from an NCAA-qualifying 2016 squad, and an unprecedented spate of injuries, led to a 5-27 record in Tinkle's third season at

OSU. It was just the second losing record in Tinkle's 11 years as a head coach.

The Beavers used their anticipated regular lineup in only one game. Starters Tres Tinkle (26) and Stephen Thompson Jr. (6) and top reserve Cheikh N'diaye (23) combined to miss 55 games because of injury; three-year letterman Malcolm Duvivier, another projected starter, sat out the entire season.

As a result, the Beavers were one of the youngest teams in Division I basketball. They often started three sophomores and two freshmen, inexperience reflected by the uncharacteristic won-loss record.

Center Drew Eubanks earned honorable-mention all-Pac-12 honors, becoming the first OSU sophomore to earn all-conference recognition since Jared Cunningham made the second team in 2011.

Off the court, the Beavers thrived academically. A record seven players (Daine Muller, Gli-gorije Rakocevic, Stephen Thompson Jr., Tres Tinkle, Matt Dahlen, Drew Eubanks, Tanner Sanders) earned Pac-12 all-academic honors.

The seven selections were the most of any Pac-12 school. OSU's previous high for any season was two, in 2000, 2005, 2006, 2011, 2012 and 2014.

And 2017's temporary downturn cannot overshadow the accomplishments of Tinkle's first two seasons at OSU.

In Year 1, he guided a team picked to finish last in the Pacific-12 Conference after losing its top five scorers from the previous season to a 17-14 overall record, the most home wins (15) in school history, and victories over Pac-12 champion Arizona and NCAA Sweet-16 finisher UCLA.

In Year 2, he surpassed those milestones and capped another season of notable accomplishments when the Beavers garnered their first berth in the NCAA Tournament in 26 seasons.

The Beavers went 19-12 in the regular season, the most wins in a season since 1990. Tinkle thus became just the second coach in the program's long and storied history to win at least 17 games in his first two seasons. Bob Hager did so in 1923 (19-7) and 1924 (20-5).

OSU finished in a three-way tie for sixth place with a 9-9 Pac-12 record, its best conference record since 1993. The Beavers won 17 games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1989 (22-8) and 1990 (22-7)

Tinkle has two wins over top-25 opposition. The Beavers defeated No. 7 Arizona, 58-56, in 2015 and topped No. 21 USC, 85-70, in 2016. It was the first time they've defeated Top 25 teams in back-to-back seasons since 2005-2006.

In 2016 OSU also defeated Oregon, California and Utah, teams that all were ranked in the Top 25 at one point, and Metro Atlantic Athletic Association champion/NCAA qualifier Iona.

The 51-year-old Tinkle, who came to OSU on May 19, 2014, after eight successful seasons at the University of Montana, became the fourth OSU coach since 1928 to record a winning record in his first season in 2015. He joined Beaver legends Slats Gill, Paul Valenti and Jim Anderson in that exclusive fraternity.

Tinkle's debut season was also replete with accomplishments and highlight moments. The Beavers:

- Set a school record for their best start at Gill Coliseum (14-0) and the most home wins in a single season (15).
- Posted an 8-10 Pac-12 record, their best conference mark since the 1992-93 team finished 9-9.
- Defeated No. 7 Arizona for their first win over a top-10 team in 15 years.
- Defeated Arizona, UCLA and Washington in the same season for the first time since 1990.
- Also downed DePaul of the Big East and Mississippi State of the SEC.

Tinkle stressed defense from his first day on the job and the Beavers responded. They led

the Pac-12 in steals, 3-point field goal percentage defense and turnover margin. They also set school records for scoring defense, field-goal percentage defense and 3-point field goal percentage defense.

Tinkle steadfastly preached the value of teamwork but the Beavers have enjoyed their share of individual accomplishments as well in his first two seasons.

In 2016, senior guard Gary Payton II earned Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year honors for the second year in a row. He was sixth in the nation in steals (2.41) and broke his father's (former OSU All-American Gary Payton) school record of at least one steal in 38 consecutive games.

Payton II also earned first-team all-Pac-12 and Pac-12 all-defensive honors for the second season in a row. Also, forward Tres Tinkle, Wayne Tinkle's son, earned honorable-mention on the All-Freshman team.

In 2015, Payton II was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year and earned All-Pac-12 First Team and Pac-12 All-Defensive Team honors after finishing second in the nation in steals. The junior transfer had a steal in all 31 games, the second-longest streak in school history. His 95 steals were the second most in Oregon State single-season history and tied for the third most in a season in Pac-12 history.

Tinkle inherited a senior-less program depleted by the graduation or transfer of six players who combined for 128 starts. That manpower shortage was further exacerbated in the offseason when Chi Baker, a touted incoming recruit from Florida who was expected to see significant playing time, was stricken with a heart ailment that sidelined him for the season.

Baker's illness left the Beavers with just eight scholarship players. However, Tinkle cleared that hurdle by holding a campus-wide open tryout just before the start of practice.

Five of the 22 participants were added to the official roster, joining two walk-ons from the previous season, and all played a major part in the team's success, as role players or by pushing the starters in practice. Tinkle subsequently rewarded them for their dedication and commitment by starting five walk-ons, all from the state of Oregon, against rival Oregon in the team's final regular-season home game.

The success of Tinkle's first season at OSU was noted nationally as he was named a semifinalist for the Naismith National Coach of the Year.

Tinkle was named the 21st head coach in OSU history on May 19, 2014, after leading Montana to three NCAA Tournament appearances and seven winning records in eight seasons. His Grizzlies captured Big Sky Conference regular-season titles in 2010, 2012 and 2013, and Big Sky Conference Tournament championships in 2012 and 2013.

He led Montana to four consecutive postseason trips from 2010-13, including the NCAA Tournament in 2010, 2012 and 2013. His 97 conference wins are the most by any Montana coach and his 158 overall victories are the second-most in school history.

He was named the Big Sky Coach of the Year after the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, and the NABC Division I All-District 6 Coach of the Year in 2012. He is the only coach in Montana history with three NCAA-Tournament berths and two Big Sky Coach of the Year awards.

Tinkle directed Montana to 25-7 seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 when the Grizzlies won the second-most games in school history in successive seasons. They won 25 consecutive Big Sky games in that span and set a conference record with 19 league wins in 2012-13.

Montana had winning records in seven of Tinkle's eight years as head coach and won 20 or more games in four consecutive seasons (2010-13). He also went to the NCAA tournament three times during his five years as an assistant coach under Don Holst, Pat Kennedy and Larry Krystkowiak, presently the head coach at the University of Utah.

The son of a college administrator, Tinkle was born on Jan. 26, 1966 in Milwaukee, Wis., as the youngest of 11 children (seven girls and four boys). He graduated from Ferris High School in Spokane, Wash., in 1984, and then enrolled at Montana, where he had a standout career from 1986-89.

Tinkle was a standout forward for the Grizzlies from 1986-89 and a three-time All-Big Sky pick his sophomore, junior and senior seasons. He ranks fourth all-time at Montana in rebounds (836), and sixth in points (1,500). He earned the team's Carl Dragstedt Award (MVP) in 1988 and 1989; led the team in rebounding in 1987, 1988 and 1989, and led the team in scoring in 1988 and 1989.

He then played professionally for 12 years with stints in the CBA and in Sweden, Spain, Italy and Greece before retiring to become a coach.

Tinkle earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Montana in health and human performance in 2005.

Tinkle is married to the former Lisa McLeod, who was a standout basketball player at Montana and was inducted into the Grizzly Sports Hall of Fame in 2011. They have two daughters, Joslyn and Elle, and one son, Tres.

Joslyn played in three basketball Final Fours during her four-year career at Stanford. Elle played basketball at Gonzaga and helped lead the Bulldogs to the Sweet 16 in 2015.

A two-time Gatorade Montana Player of the Year at Missoula's Hellgate High School, Tres joined the program for the 2015-16 season.

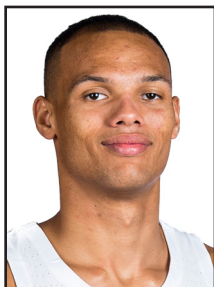

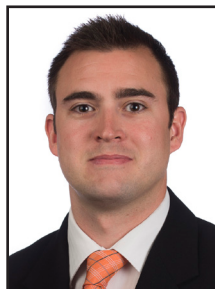
