THE GAME: The season marches on for No. 2 Stanford in its first home game of 2022 as the Cardinal welcomes Oregon to Maples Pavilion on Friday, Jan. 7 at 7 p.m. Ann Schatz and Mary Murphy have the call on Pac-12 Network and Tim Swartz will handle the radio broadcast on GoStanford.com and Varsity Network.

THE RUNDOWN: Tara VanDerveer is the winningest coach in women's basketball history with 1,134 career victories ... Cameron Brink became the fifth player in program history with a 20+ point and 20+ rebound game vs. Indiana ... Haley Jones notched the program's first triple-double in nearly two decades vs. Portland ... Brink set the Stanford single-season blocks record with 88 as a freshman, the most of any rookie in the nation ... Stanford has held 44 of its last 45 opponents to 41.8 percent shooting or worse ... Stanford won its 24th Pac-12 regular season championship and 14th tournament championship last year ... Stanford held each of its opponents to 77 points or less in one season for the first time since 2012-13 last year ... Stanford set an NCAA Tournament record with 59 3-pointers last year ... Francesca Belibi was the first woman to dunk in a college game since Britney Griner in 2013 ... Lexie Hull recently became the 42nd player in program history to eclipse 1,000 career points ... Jones' 12 made free throws at Tennessee were the most at Stanford on the road since 2015 ... The Cardinal was ranked in the top-three in the preseason for the third straight year ... Stanford's 13 true road victories last season were its most since 2012-13.

WHAT TO EXPECT »

- Five of Stanford's 12 opponents have had their worst shooting game this season when playing the Cardinal.
- Stanford has won 16 straight games vs. Pac-12 opponents, including postseason play.
- No team has scored over 55 points in Stanford's last eight games vs. Pac-12 opponents.

CATCHING YOU UP »

- Stanford enters the season as the defending national champion after a dramatic run to the 2021 title. The Cardinal defeated South Carolina in the Final Four and Arizona in the championship game each by a single point, the first time in NCAA Women's Basketball history to win two straight games by one to claim the national title.
- Just how deep is Stanford? 14 different players scored at least one point in its season-opening victory over Morgan State. This marks the most players to score in one game in program history, only the fourth team to do so in the Pac-12 since 2001.
- Stanford is one behind South Carolina for the nation's lead with two top-five wins so far this season.
- The Cardinal is ranked No. 4 in the NET rankings with a 6-3 record against top-100 NET opponents.
- The Cardinal spent a bulk of last season on the road, 63 days in fact, following the emergency directive issued by the Santa Clara County Public Health Department from Nov. 29-Jan. 31 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Cardinal won its 22nd straight conference openers last Sunday, with its last loss coming at Arizona State on Jan. 6, 2000.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS... AGAIN »

- For the third straight season, Stanford entered the year in the top three, ranked No. 3 in the pre-season. The Cardinal currently checks in at No. 2.
- The Cardinal tied a program record last year, spending six straight weeks at the No. 1 spot from early December to mid-January.
- Stanford has been ranked in the top-10 in 52 straight AP polls, the second-longest active streak in the country.
- The Cardinal is second in total appearances in the AP poll with 595 behind Tennessee (759). Its 454 appearances in the top 10 are third, trailing Tennessee (622) and Connecticut (517) and its 269 appearances in the top five are fourth behind Connecticut (470), Tennessee (464) and Louisiana Tech (278).
- The Cardinal had been ranked in 312 consecutive polls, the third-longest streak all-time, until it fell out on Dec. 25, 2017. Stanford has appeared in each of the past 73 AP polls, the sixth-longest active streak in the country.

BACK FOR MORE »

- In her first season as a starter, Anna Wilson was key for the Cardinal in shutting down top performers from opposing teams, earning Pac-12 Co-Defensive Player of the Year accolades.
- Wilson featured career bests in every statistical category including points (153), rebounds (123), assists (68), steals (49), minutes (779) and 3-pointers (28). She scored in double figures in back-to-back games for the first time in her career during last season's postseason run with 11 points in the NCAA Tournament second round and 13 in the Sweet 16.
- Wilson wasn't the only Cardinal to take advantage of extra eligibility, as Alyssa Jerome returns for a

fifth year, maintaining her status as one of the team's top leaders.

- Jerome's standout performance at Oregon State last season was her highlight on the court, exploding for a career-high 14 points on 5-of-6 shooting in 18 minutes.
- Both Wilson and Jerome are poised to sit atop Stanford's record books for most career games played.

STACKED SCHEDULE »

- Stanford is not shying away from having the target on its back, set to play 16 games vs. teams that advanced to the 2021 NCAA Tournament.
- Stanford also has 12 games scheduled against teams ranked in the preseason top-25, including six of its 11 non-conference matchups.
- The Cardinal was 10-1 against ranked competition last year and entered the year with seven straight victories against teams in the top-25. It is currently 3-3 vs. ranked foes this year.
- Stanford and South Carolina lead the nation with six games played vs. ranked opponents so far this season.

RETURN OF THE CHAMPS »

- Already known for its depth of talent, Stanford not only retained the majority of its production from last season, it added five new players, making the largest team in program history.
- All but one player returned from last year's championship season, including 82 percent of the team's scoring, 95 percent of its rebounding, 81 percent of its assists, 72 percent of its made 3-pointers, 84 percent of its steals and 99 percent of its blocks.
- Three players were named Preseason All-Pac-12 for the conference favorite Cardinal - Cameron Brink, Lexie Hull and Haley Jones.
- Jones leads the way as one of the country's most versatile players and saved her best performances for the big stage, leading the Cardinal to the national championship with 24 points, including the game-winning shot after an offensive rebound vs. South Carolina, and 17 vs. Arizona.
- Jones shot 14-of-15 (.933) from the floor last year against Washington, the second-best shooting percentage in a single game for a Stanford player and best since 1981. She was the only player in the Pac-12 to lead her team in points, rebounds and assists for the majority of the season.
- Nine different players have scored at least 10 points in a single game so far this season.

HALEY'S BIG SUMMER »

- Riding high after being named the Final Four's Most Outstanding Player, Haley Jones had an eventful summer that included a parade around her hometown of Santa Cruz, California for "Haley Jones Day", earning a key to the city of Santa Cruz, throwing out the first pitch at a San Francisco Giants game, and winning a gold medal for Team USA at the 2021 AmeriCup in Puerto Rico.
- She averaged 5.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.7 assists in six games for Team USA, playing alongside the country's other top returning college players.

A LOOK BACK »

- In a season full of unprecedented challenges and scheduling mayhem, Stanford finished with a conference-record 19 wins. The Cardinal finished with at least 14 wins in the regular season of Pac-12 play for the 31st time in the 35-year existence of the conference.
- The Cardinal won its first regular season Pac-12 title since 2014.
- Tara VanDerveer became the winningest coach in women's college basketball history, passing Pat Summitt on Dec. 15, 2020 at Pacific.
- Stanford won at least 20 games for the 20th straight season, the third longest active streak in the nation. No team beat more top-11 teams than Stanford.
- Stanford has not finished outside the top-three in the league standings since 1987, the first year of the conference.
- Stanford was 29-1 last season when holding a lead at halftime, 31-0 when holding its opponent under 70 points and 24-1 when scoring over 70 itself. The Cardinal was 18-0 when committing less turnovers.
- 10 of Stanford's 21 total opponents were held to their lowest shooting percentages of the season when facing the Cardinal.
- Stanford won 21 games by 20+ points for the first time since 2010-11 (22).
- Stanford is now 5-2 in games decided by one point in the NCAA Tournament.
- Stanford didn't lose a game in the regular season by more than five points for the first time since 2004-05. It was the only team in the conference to beat every other Pac-12 team at least once. The Cardinal has not lost a game by more than five points since the end of the 2019-20 season.

WHO'S NEW? »

- The Cardinal welcomed the nation's sixth-ranked recruiting class, featuring No. 11 Brooke Demetre, No. 19 Kiki Iriafen, No. 78 Jzaniya Harriel, and the program's first player from Europe, Elena Bosgana, from Greece.
- Both Demetre and Iriafen were named McDonald's and Jordan Brand Classic All-Americans, pushing

- Of Stanford's 27 McDonald's All-Americans all-time, eight are currently on the roster.
- In addition to the freshman class, Stanford added its first ever graduate transfer in Jordan Hamilton, who played the last four seasons at Northwestern.
- There, Hamilton helped lead the Wildcats to its first Big Ten title in 30 years as a junior. She finished her time in Evanston with 833 career points, while averaging 3.3 assists per game in 110 appearances.
- Many fans may recognize another new face on the bench, as former All-American and 2011 Pac-10 Player of the Year Jeanette Pohlen has rejoined the program as a coaching intern this season.

TARA AT THE TOP »

- A five-time national coach of the year (1988, 1989, 1990, 2011, 2021) and 16-time Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Tara VanDerveer, who prior to coming to Stanford served as head coach for a combined seven seasons at Idaho (1978-80) and Ohio State (1980-85), has accumulated a 1,134-258 (.815) record as a collegiate head coach and a 982-207 (.827) record at Stanford.
- VanDerveer has more wins to her name than 344 of the NCAA's 351 Division I programs and surpassed Pat Summitt (1,098) as the winningest coach in women's college basketball history last year.
- VanDerveer owns the fifth-highest winning percentage (.815) among Division I women's basketball coaches all-time and her 36 20-win seasons are tied with Summitt (36), behind C. Vivian Stringer (37).
- She has accounted for 982 of Stanford's 1,158 total victories since its first varsity season in 1975.
- In Dec. 2018 the Women's Sports Foundation announced the creation of The Tara VanDerveer Fund for the Advancement of Women in Coaching and is now in its third class of grant recipients.
- A total of \$200,000 was awarded to 10 universities and colleges to support a female coach on the rise, assisting with living expenses, professional development and mentorship. The institutions will use funding to support coaching fellows across a myriad of women's sports including field hockey, wrestling, basketball and volleyball, as well as softball and strength and conditioning.
- The WSF created the VanDerveer Fund to directly address the alarming decline of women in coaching. In the 1970-71 academic year, 90% of all head coaches for women's college teams were women. By 2017, 45 years after the passage of Title IX, women's share of these positions in women's NCAA sports had dropped to 40%.

- Stanford has four players on preseason watch lists for positional awards announced by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame: Lexie Hull » Ann Meyers Drysdale Award (shooting guard); Haley Jones » Cheryl Miller Award (small forward); Francesca Belibi » Lisa Leslie Award (center); Cameron Brink » Katrina McClain Award (power forward).
- Cameron Brink, Lexie Hull and Haley Jones were also named to the watch list for the Naismith Trophy, while Brink and Jones picked up spots on the Wooden Award Midseason Top-25 Wade Trophy Watch List, all awarded to the nation's player of the year.

BAHAMAS BREAKOUT »

- Brink was named the Pac-12 Player of the Week following the sophomore's stellar performances in the Bahamas. She averaged 17.3 points, 12.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 3.3 blocks in three games.
- She became the first player in the nation since at least 1999-00 with a stat line of 20+ points, 20+ rebounds, 5 assists and 5 blocks against a ranked team, doing so vs. No. 4 Indiana.

- Stanford surpassed the century mark in 2020-21 for the most times in one season since 2010-11.
- Stanford set a program record, making 166 3-pointers in conference play last season.
- The Cardinal is 30-2 when Hannah Jump makes just one 3-pointer through last season and this one.
- Stanford is 27-3 when Cameron Brink has at least two blocked shots in a game. The Cardinal is also 27-3 when Haley Jones has at least three assists, including 16-0 last season.
- The Cardinal hasn't lost a game when scoring at least 80 points since an 81-80 loss at California on Jan. 31, 2019, winning 26 such games in a row.
- Stanford is 15-0 when Haley Jones collects double-digit rebounds.
- Jones became the ninth player this century with 15 points, 15 rebounds and 5 assists in an AP Top-10 matchup with 18 points, 19 rebounds and 6 assists at No. 7 Tennessee. Three of those nine performances are from the Cardinal.
- Jones is now one of four players in the country this season to have a game with 24 points, 16 rebounds and three assists, doing so at Washington State, but the only one to do it while shooting 70.0 percent from the floor, and the only one to do it on the road.

- Cameron Brink is 25th nationally, averaging 2.2 blocks per game. Her 56.0 shooting percentage is 35th in the nation. Hannah Jump leads the league and is 35th nationally in made 3-pointers (32).
