**STANFORD, Calif.** - Stanford will embark on a busy week with four games in five days and a long-distance bus ride to begin Pac-12 play.

The Cardinal (11-10) plays host to Dartmouth (6-8) on Tuesday at 2 p.m. (PT) before taking a spring-break bus-ride to No. 7/9 Oregon (21-4) to open conference play. Stanford will be the first team to take on the Ducks in its newly renovated Jane Sanders Stadium. Live statistics will be available for all four games and a live stream will be available for the Oregon games.

The Cardinal returns to action after having this past weekend off to avoid any conflicts with finals week. Stanford concluded regular-season tournament play playing host to the rain-shortened Louisville Slugger Classic. The Cardinal dropped decisions against Cal Poly and Tulsa on Saturday, March 12.

Stanford had trouble getting going offensively at the tournament but was led by Kylie Sorenson who went 3-for-5 over two games with a two-run home run and a double.

### THE DARTMOUTH SERIES

• Tuesday will be the first meeting in program history against Dartmouth.

• Stanford head coach Rachel Hanson coached at Dartmouth for four seasons and led the Big Green to its first Ivy League title in 2014 with 18 conference wins - the most in program history.

### THE OREGON SERIES

• Stanford is 33-33 (.500) all-time against Oregon and went 0-3 against the Ducks in last year's series. The Cardinal hung tight with the Ducks through each game. Oregon outscored Stanford 23-15 over the three games, a run differential of eight - the second-lowest of any Pac-12 series the Ducks completed last season. Oregon entered the series outscoring opponents in three-game sets by an average of 16.2 runs.

• Stanford's 15 runs produced against Oregon was the second-most of any Pac-12 team against the Ducks last season. Only Washington scored more against Oregon, registering 16 during its three-game set.

### SORENSEN STARTS STRONG

• Kylie Sorenson has had a quality start to the season and is hitting .357 with 22 RBIs, six home runs, three doubles, 19 runs, 13 walks and a .657 slugging percentage.

• Sorenson was the one bright spot offensively in its two games at the Stanford Louisville Slugger Classic, registering three of the Cardinal's four hits and generating all of the scoring with a two-run homer.

### PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

• Kayla Bonstrom (international relations), a 2015 NFCA All-America Second Team selection, picked up where she left off last season and is hitting .348 with 15 RBIs, seven doubles, two home runs, a triple, 18 runs, six walks and a .565 slugging percentage.

• Bonstrom was named to the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top-50 Watch List earlier this season. She was also selected as a Senior CLASS Award Top-30 finalist.

• Bonstrom was a force at the plate and led Stanford in every major offensive category throughout the 2015 season. She was named a NFCA Second Team All-American, NFCA All-West Region First Team at first base, All-Pac-12 First Team and a Pac-12 All-Defensive Team honorable mention.

• Bonstrom had at least one hit in 40-of-54 games (74 percent) and registered a hit in 23 of her final 34 contests, accumulating 42 hits during that span.

• Bonstrom set the Stanford single-season slugging percentage record at .806 – becoming the first Cardinal player to break the .800 mark. She finished in the top-11 in multiple single-season categories in Stanford history including: batting average (5th, .439), home runs (T-5th, 13), RBI (T-7th, 54), doubles (11th, 16) and fielding percentage (T-2nd, .997). She was solid defensively, committing just one error in 381 chances.

• Bonstrom finished the 2015 regular season ranked 41st in the nation in batting average (.439), 24th in on-base percentage (.549) and 39th in slugging percentage (.806). She finished in the top-10 among Pac-12 players in multiple categories, including: on-base percentage (4th, .549), batting average (5th, .439), slugging percentage (5th, .806), doubles (T-5th, 16), hits (T-6th, 68), total bases (T-7th, 125), RBI (10th, 54) and putouts (2nd, 365).

• Bonstrom excelled in the classroom as well and was a 2015 Capital One Academic Second Team All-American and All-District Softball Team District 8 selection. She was selected to the Center for International Security and Cooperation (CISAC) Interscholar Honors Program in International Security Studies to develop a senior thesis with the federal government related to national security. She's interested in working in national security upon graduation.

### MOLINA SWINGS A BIG BAT

• Victoria Molina homered in three-of-five tournaments this season. Of her 12 hits this season, four have been home runs.

• Molina led Stanford offensively at the Nike Invitational, going 5-for-13 (.385) with five RBIs, a home run, a double, a run and a .692 slugging percentage. She hit a three-run home run in the bottom of the sixth inning against St. Mary's (Feb. 21) to erase a 4-1 deficit and help send the game to extra innings.

• As a freshman, Molina hit a two-run walk-off home run in the bottom of the ninth inning against No. 24/23 Arizona State to propel Stanford to a dramatic 4-2 victory. Three of her four hits last season were home runs.

### STABILITY BEHIND THE PLATE

• Four-year starting catcher Jessica Plaza has had a strong start to her senior campaign. She is fourth on the team with a .315 batting average, producing eight RBIs, six doubles, 13 runs and 11 walks.

• Defensively, Plaza calls her own games and has done well to help guide a young pitching staff. She earned Pac-12 All-Defense recognition a year ago after registering a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage for the second consecutive season. Plaza is one of two Stanford players all-time to record a perfect fielding percentage.

### FROST PROVIDES BIG BLASTS

• Freshman Lauren Frost has found her groove at the plate and provided power at the plate in the final three games in Hawaii. Frost came off the bench with Stanford holding a one-run lead against Coastal Carolina and hit a pinch-hit two-out grand slam to help the Cardinal secure the victory.

• Frost hit a two-run home run in the following game against Hawai'i and then a three-run shot in the weekend finale against Coastal Carolina.

### IN THE CIRCLE

- Sophomore Haley Snyder and freshman Carolyn Lee are the focal points in the circle. Snyder made 29 appearances (15 starts) during her freshman year, picking up 38 strikeouts in 112.2 innings before she was sidelined by an injury.
- Lee was a 2015 Cal-Hi Sports All-State third team selection from nearby Dougherty Valley High School and is expected to play a major role beginning early in the season. Sophomore Kaitlyn Lagattuta will likely see some innings in the circle as relief.

### NOLL PROVIDES POWER

- Junior centerfielder Bessie Noll had a hot start to the season, and hit .400 (4-for-10) with two home runs, four RBIs, five runs, a double and a 1.100 slugging percentage through the first three games of the Malihini Aloha Tournament. She was hit by a pitch in her first at-bat of the fourth game of the tournament and was injured. She is out for the foreseeable future.
- Prior to her injury, Noll led Stanford in batting average (.404), home runs (6), doubles (7), runs (18), walks (13), slugging percentage (.885) and on-base percentage (.536).
- Noll grew up playing baseball in Tokyo, Japan, and only played softball during the summer of her high school years.

### PETTIT SPENDS TIME WITH U-19 U.S. NATIONAL TEAM

- Pettit was one of 22 athletes to receive an invitation to try out for the 2015 USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) National Team. She was named an alternate to the team at the conclusion of the camp and spent time with the team this past summer.

### 2015 IN REVIEW

- Stanford battled through injuries and adversity during the 2015 season but produced a number of highlight moments en route to a 17-37 record and 2-22 mark in the Pac-12. The Cardinal defeated five NCAA Tournament teams, recorded single-season top 10 numbers in multiple offensive categories and saw one of the best single-season individual performances in program history by Kayla Bonstrom.
- Stanford picked up victories against NCAA Tournament teams No. 3/4 Alabama, No. 24/23 Arizona State, RV/25 Texas, Utah and Weber State.
- The Cardinal was strong offensively, finishing the season in the top-10 in program history in walks (T-6th, 198), home runs (8th, 39), triples (8th, 11), slugging percentage (9th, .422) and RBI (10th, 259).

### ALL-PAC-12 CONFERENCE

- Kayla Bonstrom earned 2015 All-Pac-12 First Team honors, while Erin Ashby, Kylie Sorenson and Tylyn Wells received honorable mention recognition.
