UCLA has won six of its last eight meetings against Stanford, going 2-1 against the Cardinal last season.

UP NEXT FOR UCLA

The Bruins will open their Pac-12 schedule against Stanford on Thursday. Last season, both schools split a pair of regular-season games before the Bruins secured an 88-77 win in the Pac-12 Tournament quarterfinals. UCLA won the game in Pauley Pavilion (89-73) after Stanford secured an 107-99 win in double overtime at Maples Pavilion. UCLA has compiled an all-time mark of 145-94 against Stanford. UCLA has won 10 of the last 14 meetings over the previous seven seasons.

COACHING CHANGE

Murry Bartow will serve as UCLA's interim head coach, after Steve Alford was relieved of his head coaching duties on Dec. 31, 2018. Bartow, the son of former UCLA head coach Gene Bartow, arrived at UCLA in April 2018. He served as interim head coach at the University of South Florida in 2016-17 after having been a collegiate head coach for 18 seasons – 12 years at East Tennessee State (2003-04 through 2014-15) and six seasons at UAB (1996-97 through 2001-02).

SCORING IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Sophomore guard Kris Wilkes has scored in double figures in all 13 games this season. The 6-foot-8 guard from Indianapolis, Ind., has scored at least 20 points in four games. He tallied 21 points in a loss at Cincinnati (Dec. 19), registered 20 points in the team's loss to Belmont (Dec. 15) and had 22 points in a game against North Carolina in Las Vegas (Nov. 23). He scored a career-high 27 points and grabbed 10 rebounds in a season-opening win against Purdue Fort Wayne (Nov. 6).

AMONG PAC-12 PLAYERS: Through Dec. 31, Wilkes ranked No. 4 in the Pac-12 in scoring (17.5 ppg). Washington State's Robert Franks has averaged a league-leading 22.1 points per game (11 contests). Wilkes is one of seven players in the Pac-12 Conference with at least four games of 20 or more points.

LEAGUE LEADER

Sophomore Jaylen Hands enters the weekend as the Pac-12's leader in total assists (91) and assists per game (7.0). The 6-foot-3 guard from San Diego has averaged 11.5 points, 3.7 rebounds and 7.0 assists through the team's first 13 games. Hands also ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in assist-turnover ratio (2.3-to-1). Hands has tallied at least nine assists in six of UCLA's last eight games. He had at least 10 assists in three consecutive games (versus Hawai'i, Notre Dame and Belmont).

RARE FEAT: Hands became the first Pac-12 player to record at least 10 assists in three straight games since USC's Brandon Granville in March 2000. Granville also accomplished that feat in January 2000 and November 1999.

LOOKING AHEAD

The Bruins will conclude their homestand against California on Saturday, Jan. 5, in Pauley Pavilion presented by Wescom. This marks the second consecutive year in which UCLA will open its league schedule at home. Last season, the Bruins swept a pair of home games against Washington State (96-82) and Washington (74-53) prior to New Year's Day. In fact, this will be the first season since 2015-16 in which the Bruins will have opened their Pac-12 schedule after Dec. 31.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

Through Sunday, Dec. 30, UCLA ranked No. 2 in the Pac-12 in rebounding offense (42.3 rpg) and was No. 4 in the league in rebounding margin (+5.2). In addition, the Bruins ranked No. 13 in the nation (through Dec. 30) in total rebounds per game (42.2). Freshman Moses Brown (11.5 ppg, 8.8 rpg) ranks fourth in the league in rebounds per game, while redshirt freshman Jalen Hill (2.9 ppg, 6.2 rpg) ranks No. 13 in that category. Brown, a 7-foot-1 center from Queens, N.Y., is currently tied for second in field goal percentage (66.7%) and ranks second in the league in blocks per game (2.5 bpg).

FIRST TIME SINCE: Moses Brown's 23-point, 14-rebound and eight-block effort against Saint Francis (Nov. 16) marked the first time any UCLA player had at least 20 points and five blocks in a game since Jan. 22, 2000 (Jerome Moiso).

MULTIPLE DOUBLE-DOUBLES: UCLA has seen three players register double-doubles of the point-rebound variety this season (Moses Brown, Kris Wilkes and Cody Riley). In addition, Jalen Hill has recorded a team-high 20 rebounds (versus Presbyterian on Nov. 19). Brown has totaled a team-leading four double-doubles for UCLA.

STANDING TALL

UCLA's 17-person roster includes eight players who measure at least 6-foot-8. Freshman Moses Brown (7-foot-1, 245 pounds) is the Bruins' tallest player since the late Mike Lanier (7-foot-7, 310 pounds) competed as a reserve center for UCLA in 1991-92 and 1992-93. UCLA redshirt junior Alex Olesinski and redshirt freshman Jalen Hill both stand at 6-feet-10, while freshmen Shareef O'Neal and Kenneth Nwuba, sophomore Chris Smith and redshirt freshman Cody Riley all stand at 6-foot-9. Sophomore guard Kris Wilkes rounds out the eight-person group at 6-foot-8.

Media Availability

Weekly media availability typically takes place Tuesday afternoons, prior to practice (in either the Mo Ostin Basketball Center or Pauley Pavilion). Players are available to the media after Steve Alford speaks. Members of the media are welcome to observe and record the first 15 minutes of practice those days. Media availability is not open to the public.

Credentials

Admission to the press seating and media room is by credential only. All credential requests should be made through UCLA's credential website at least two days prior to the game. Website address and instructions can be obtained by emailing Alex Timiraos (atimiraos@athletics.ucla.edu). Members of the media covering UCLA should request credentials for road games through Timiraos (via email, or phone at 310-206-0524).

Credential Pickup

Credentials are available during the week at the Athletic Communications Office. Credentials not claimed prior to game day will be available at Pauley Pavilion's "Will Call" window (Northwest corner of the arena). The media will call window and entrance opens two hours prior to tip-off.

Media Seating

A press pass enables entrance at Pauley Pavilion's Northwest media gate (across from the intramural field). Press seating is located in the upper level (Section 215) of the arena's south side (opposite team benches). Pauley Pavilion's media workroom is located in the Southeast corner of the building on the event level, adjacent to the Southeast elevator.

Postgame Procedure

Steve Alford and selected players will be available to the media in Pauley Pavilion's media room following a 10-minute cooling off period after each game. UCLA's locker room is closed to the media. To access the media room during or after the game, follow the stairwell down to the court and proceed to the southeast corner (elevator access available at the arena's southeast corner). The visiting team's head coach will be available following a 10-minute cooling off period outside the visiting locker room (northwest corner, event level).

NEWS AND NOTES

- Kris Wilkes has scored in double figures in all 13 games for UCLA this season. He leads all current UCLA players in most career points (679), career field goals made (243), career three-pointers made (84) and career free throws made (109).
- Kris Wilkes' game-winning shot against Notre Dame (Dec. 8) was UCLA's first near-buzzer-beater to win a game since Jan. 7, 2016, when Bryce Alford made a 3-pointer to put UCLA ahead of No. 7 Arizona, 87-84, with 1.8 seconds remaining.
- In Dec. 2018, Jaylen Hands became the first UCLA player with multiple games of at least 10 assists in the same season since Lonzo Ball finished his freshman year (2016-17) with seven games of at least 10 assists.
- Prince Ali is the oldest player on UCLA's roster (currently a redshirt junior) and has played in 75 career games, the highest career total of any current Bruin. Ali leads all current UCLA players in career minutes played (1,418).
- Prince Ali made a career-high five three-pointers (on six attempts), totaling a career-high 23 points, in the team's victory over Hawai'i (Nov. 28). Ali was a perfect 4-for-4 from three-point range before the 16:00 mark in the first half that night.
- Moses Brown became UCLA's first player with at least 19 points and 17 rebounds in his collegiate debut since Kareem Abdul-Jabbar (then Lew Alcindor) tallied a then-school-record 56 points and grabbed 21 rebounds on Dec. 3, 1966.
- Moses Brown had eight blocks in the team's win against Saint Francis U (Nov. 16). Since the school began to officially record blocks in 1978-79, only three other players at UCLA have recorded at least eight blocks in one game.
- Jalen Hill tallied a season-best 20 rebounds in the team's victory over Presbyterian (Nov. 19). That marked the highest single-game rebound total by a Bruin since Kevin Love had 21 rebounds at Oregon State on Jan. 26, 2008.
- UCLA has made a season-high 10 three-pointers in two games – against North Carolina in Las Vegas (Nov. 23) and at home against Hawai'i (Nov. 28). The Bruins shot a season-best 50.0 percent in the win over Hawai'i (10-for-20).
- Presbyterian attempted 45 three-pointers in UCLA's 80-65 victory (Nov. 19). That marked the highest total ever attempted against UCLA since the NCAA adopted the three-point line (prior to 1986-87). Presbyterian made 13 of 45 attempts.

PAC-12 PLAY

UCLA went 11-7 in Pac-12 play last season, one year after having gone 15-3 in league action. Over the past five seasons (2013-14 through 2017-18), UCLA has compiled a Pac-12 record of 55-35. The Bruins have recorded double-digit victories in conference action in 12 of the last 14 years, with 15 wins in 2016-17, 16 wins in 2007-08 and 15 victories in 2006-07. The Bruins last won the Pac-12's regular-season title in 2013, going 13-5 in league games that year.

UPCOMING – UCLA vs. CALIFORNIA

Last season, UCLA went 2-0 against California. The Bruins won the game at Haas Pavilion (Berkeley, Calif.) by a 107-84 margin. Three weeks later, UCLA downed the Golden Bears 70-57 in Pauley Pavilion. UCLA has won its last three meetings against California and leads the all-time series versus the Golden Bears, 139-103. In fact, the Bruins have gone 6-3 versus California over the previous four seasons. UCLA has won its last five home games against California.

BRUINS AT HOME

UCLA went 14-2 at home last season and has won 37 of 42 games in Pauley Pavilion presented by Wescom since the start of the 2016-17 campaign. During UCLA's 2016-17 season, the Bruins went 16-1 at home. Last year, the team's only home losses came against No. 25 Cincinnati (12/16/17) and Colorado (1/13/18). Since UCLA renovated Pauley Pavilion prior to the 2012-13 season, the Bruins have tallied an overall home record of 94-17 (posting an 84.7 winning percentage).

THE ROAD AHEAD

Following this week's two games in Pauley Pavilion presented by Wescom (vs. Stanford, vs. California), the Bruins will hit the road next week to play at Oregon (Jan. 10) and at Oregon State (Jan. 13). Last season, UCLA split a pair of regular-season games against Oregon, with each team winning the game at its home venue. UCLA also went 1-1 in its two regular-season matchups with Oregon State, dropping the game in Corvallis before securing a victory at home in mid-February.

STREAKING

UCLA has made at least one 3-pointer played in its last 635 games. That 3-point streak began after the Bruins went 0-for-14 from 3-point territory in a 78-63 loss at No. 2-ranked Stanford on Feb. 3, 2000 (Maples Pavilion). UCLA has made at least three 3-pointers in 182 of 187 games since the start of the 2013-14 season. The Bruins made a school single-game-record 19 three-pointers (on 31 attempts) at Colorado on Jan. 12, 2017 (UCLA won that game, 104-89).

MAKING AN IMPACT

Redshirt freshman Cody Riley has averaged 8.6 points and 5.5 rebounds per game, having played in each of UCLA's last 10 contests. After missing the first three games of the season (jaw injury), Riley has shot 47.8 percent from the field and has connected on 3 of 6 attempts from 3-point range. The 6-foot-9 forward who starred at nearby Sierra Canyon High School (Chatsworth, Calif.), registered his first collegiate double-double at Cincinnati (11 points, 10 rebounds).

THE BRUINS WHEN ...

Since the start of the 2013-14 season, UCLA has gone 101-12 when leading at halftime (spanning 187 games). During that same span, the Bruins have gone 20-46 when trailing at halftime and 3-5 when tied at the break. UCLA's largest halftime deficit overcome during that stretch has been nine points (twice) – the Bruins trailed Oregon State, 38-29, on March 2, 2014 and trailed Oregon, 48-39, on Feb. 9, 2017. When the Bruins have built a 10-point lead (or larger) at any point in the game, UCLA has gone 111-14. Conversely, when trailing by 10 or more points in a game, UCLA has gone 10-50.

DEFICITS, COMEBACKS & MORE

UCLA'S LARGEST COMEBACK (in 2017-18): The Bruins overcame a 14-point deficit with 17:11 to play in the second half in the team's 74-53 victory against Washington (Dec. 31). Trailing by a 43-29 margin, the Bruins used a 45-10 scoring run over the game's final 17:11 to earn the victory. In fact, Washington led the Bruins, 52-48, with just over eight minutes to go. Over the last seven minutes, UCLA outscored Washington by a 26-1 margin to coast to a 21-point victory. Earlier in the season, UCLA had overcome a 12-point deficit in the 72-70 win against Wisconsin (Nov. 21). Wisconsin built a 38-26 cushion with 1:51 to play in the first half before UCLA closed the gap to just seven points by halftime (38-31).

OPPONENT, LARGEST COMEBACK (in 2017-18): UCLA surged ahead by 15 points in the second half at Michigan (Dec. 9), leading 46-31 with 14:48 to play after a three-pointer by Aaron Holiday. The 15-point cushion fell to two (60-58) at the 4:06 mark. Michigan trailed, 64-61, with less than 30 seconds to play but tied the contest, 65-65, in the final 10 seconds. The Wolverines outscored UCLA, 13-4, in the overtime session to win, 78-69. That marked UCLA's largest blown lead since Nov. 25, 2012, when Cal Poly overcame an 18-point deficit in the game's final 12:21 to defeat UCLA, 70-68, in Pauley Pavilion.

COMEBACKS IN 2016-17

The Bruins' largest comeback victory during the 2016-17 campaign took place in a game against No. 5 Oregon in Pauley Pavilion (2/9/2017). UCLA trailed by 19 points (37-18) with 6:37 to play in the first half and by a 13-point margin (64-51) with 13:40 left in regulation. Midway through the second half, the Bruins used an 18-3 scoring run to overcome the deficit and secure an 82-79 victory. In an 83-82 win at Utah (1/12/2017), UCLA trailed the Utes, 51-42, with 16:13 left in the second half. UCLA's largest deficit at any point during the 2016-17 season was 19 points versus No. 5 Oregon (2/9/2017).

UCLA'S TRIPLE-DOUBLE NOTES

The Bruins have four triple-doubles in their record book, including three since the assist became an official NCAA stat prior to the 1983-84 season. Most recently, Kyle Anderson had a triple-double as a sophomore in Nov. 2013.

- Freshman Moses Brown finished with 23 points, 14 rebounds and eight blocks in the Bruins' 95-58 victory against Saint Francis U, earlier this season (Nov. 16, 2018). Brown became UCLA's first player since Jerome Moiso (Jan. 22, 2000, versus Arizona State) to have recorded at least 20 points and five blocks in a game. The Bruins have not had any player with a triple-double of the point-rebound-block variety since Jelani McCoy on Dec. 9, 1995 (stats located above).

- Earlier this season, Jaylen Hands finished with 12 points, eight rebounds and seven assists in UCLA's 74-72 loss to Belmont (Dec. 15). Last year, Aaron Holiday came close to achieving a triple-double with 23 points, nine assists and six rebounds in an 82-79 victory at home against USC (Feb. 3, 2018). Holiday also approached triple-double territory in a win over Stanford (March 8, 2018), recording a career-high-tying 34 points, eight assists and seven rebounds.

- In 2016-17, then-freshmen Lonzo Ball and TJ Leaf each came close to recording triple-doubles. Now playing for the Los Angeles Lakers, Ball was two rebounds shy of a triple-double in his UCLA debut on Nov. 11, 2016 (19 pts, 11 assists, 8 rbs versus Pacific). Ball and TJ Leaf each finished just short of triple-doubles in UCLA's 102-62 win over UC Santa Barbara (12/14/16) – Leaf had 25 points, 10 rebounds, and eight assists, while Ball had 13 points, 10 rebounds and seven assists.

UCLA IN OVERTIME

The Bruins played five games into overtime last season (2017-18), with one of those contests pushing into two overtime periods. UCLA went 2-3 in those games, logging wins at home against Central Arkansas (106-101) in its first regular-season home game and versus Oregon (86-78) in the team's final home contest. The game against Arizona in the Pac-12 Tournament semifinals was UCLA's first overtime game in the conference tournament since March 8, 2007.

HEADED TO DOUBLE OVERTIME

Two of UCLA's last three double OT games have come against the Stanford Cardinal. Last season, the Bruins absorbed a 107-99 loss at Stanford. UCLA's last win in double overtime came against Stanford in Pauley Pavilion (Jan. 8, 2015). In that game, freshman Kevon Looney totaled 27 points and 19 rebounds to help the Bruins overcome a 14-point deficit with just over nine minutes to play in the second half.

Other recent games against No. 1 teams took place against Kentucky in Chicago (Dec. 20, 2014), at home versus Arizona (Jan. 9, 2014) and in the Sweet 16 against Florida (March 27, 2014). UCLA has gone 12-22 all-time against the Associated Press' No. 1-ranked team.

Since the start of the 1999-2000 season, UCLA has gone 6-8 against the nation's No. 1-ranked team. Steve Alford's UCLA teams have posted a 2-3 record the previous four seasons against the nation's No. 1-ranked team (as ranked in that week's AP poll).

- Last season's game against Kentucky marked UCLA's fifth meeting with the Wildcats in four seasons. The Bruins have gone 3-2 against Kentucky in those five games (spanning four seasons). Two years ago, UCLA won at Rupp Arena (97-92 on Dec. 3, 2016) before the Wildcats knocked off the Bruins, 86-75, in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament (on March 24, 2017, at FedEx Forum in Memphis, Tenn.). UCLA's win against Kentucky last December took place in New Orleans, La.

2017-18, AT A GLANCE

The Bruins went 21-12 last season, posting an 11-7 record in Pac-12 play (tied, third place). UCLA entered the Pac-12 Tournament as the No. 4 seed, securing one of four first round byes. After defeating Stanford in a quarterfinal contest (88-77), the Bruins lost to top-seed Arizona in overtime (78-67). UCLA's season ended four days later with a loss to St. Bonaventure in the "First Four" of the NCAA Tournament in Dayton, Ohio.

Aaron Holiday led the Pac-12 in scoring last season, averaging 20.3 points per game. He was selected No. 23 in the first round of the 2018 NBA Draft by the Indiana Pacers. With Holiday's selection to that organization, the Pacers currently have four UCLA products on their roster (including Darren Collison, TJ Leaf and Ike Anigbogu).

Thomas Welsh was selected in the second round of the 2018 NBA Draft by the Denver Nuggets (as the No. 58 overall pick). Welsh concluded his UCLA career ranking No. 3 on the school's all-time rebounding list and blocked shots list (1035 rebounds, 143 blocks).

Kareem Abdul-Jabbar (known as Lew Alcindor while in college) earned MVP honors six times (1971, 1972, 1974, 1976, 1977 and 1980) and Bill Walton was named the league's MVP in 1978 ... in the summer of 2017, UCLA became the first school in the nation to have produced three players who have won the NBA's Most Valuable Player Award.

FROM WESTWOOD TO THE NBA

• Russell Westbrook was named MVP of the NBA All-Star Game in 2015 and 2016 ... last season, Westbrook was selected to compete in the NBA's All-Star Game for the seventh time ... in 2017, Westbrook scored 41 points in the contest ... Kevin Love, who was teammates with Westbrook at UCLA in 2007-08, was chosen last season for the fifth time in his career.

• UCLA's former guards stole the show at both NBA All-Star Weekends in 2015 (New York) and 2016 (Toronto) ... during of those two All-Star Weekends, Zach LaVine won the annual Slam Dunk Contest one night before Westbrook captured NBA All-Star Game Most Valuable Player (MVP) accolades.

• UCLA has seen 13 players advance to the NBA over the past five years. Seven of those Bruins were first-round NBA draft picks (Zach LaVine, Jordan Adams, Kyle Anderson, Kevon Looney, Lonzo Ball, T.J. Leaf and Aaron Holiday). Norman Powell, Jonah Bolden, Ike Anigbogu and Thomas Welsh were selected in the NBA Draft's second round, while Travis Wear and David Wear joined NBA teams as undrafted free agents.

PRESEASON PROJECTIONS

UCLA was selected second in the preseason Pac-12 media poll, announced at Pac-12 media day in San Francisco (Oct. 11). Oregon was picked to finish first in the preseason poll, earning 16 of 23 first-place votes. The Bruins secured six of the first-place votes.

PREDICTIONS: Members of the media have correctly picked the regular-season winner of the conference 16 times in 26 tries, while the winner has been accurately chosen in 18 of the 29 all-time preseason votes. UCLA was selected third in last season's preseason poll and finished in a tie for third place in the standings with an 11-7 conference record.

LAST TIME: UCLA last won the Pac-12's regular-season crown in 2012-13. Other previous regular-season titles for UCLA took place in 2005-06, 2006-07 and 2007-08. The Bruins finished second in the league in 2013-14 and third in 2016-17. UCLA most recently won the Pac-12 Tournament Championship in 2014 (in Las Vegas, Nev.).

MO OSTIN BASKETBALL CENTER

UCLA officially opened the Mo Ostin Basketball Center with a grand opening ceremony on Oct. 26, 2017. The state-of-the-art facility not only has provided the men's and women's basketball teams with vital resources, but has also freed up facility access for other programs and student-athletes. With approximately 35,000 gross square feet of space, the facility stands near Pauley Pavilion's southwest corner, along the south end of the Los Angeles Tennis Center.

The Mo Ostin Basketball Center was designed by award-winning architectural design firm Kevin Daly Architects, in partnership with globally acclaimed high-performance design firm AECOM. The practice facility features two separate courts – Russell Westbrook Court for the men's team and Ann Meyers Drysdale Court for the women's team. The building also houses the Kevin Love Athletic Performance Center, which is raised over the main entrance, has its own skylights and includes separate offices for the athletic performance staffs of the men's and women's basketball teams.

UCLA's facility also features separate conference rooms for the men's and women's basketball teams that each overlook their respective courts. The Mo Ostin Basketball Center includes locker rooms for the student-athletes, a film room, an equipment room, a training room, a nutrition center, an alumni locker room and locker rooms for the coaching staffs. Portions of the facility's hallways include "By the Numbers" displays and an Under Armour uniform presentation. Adjacent to both courts is a "Champions Plaza" patio with a wall that honors student-athletes from past men's and women's teams.

The Bruins' state-of-the-art facility is named after legendary music industry executive and philanthropist Morris "Mo" Ostin, who generously committed \$10 million to the project. Ostin, who holds a B.A. in Economics from UCLA, serves as Chairman Emeritus of Warner Bros. His influence is reflected throughout the building, from a state-of-the-art sound system, acoustics and videoboard to the design of the donor display in the lobby, which was modeled after a sheet of music.

UCLA BASKETBALL ON THE AIR

For the 11th straight season, UCLA men's basketball games will be produced by the UCLA Sports Network from IMG College, with AM 570 Fox Sports LA in Los Angeles serving as the flagship station for the network.

The 2018-19 campaign will mark the 22nd year of UCLA's partnership with AM 570 Fox Sports LA owner iHeartMedia (formerly Clear Channel Communications). All UCLA men's basketball games will be broadcast on KLAC (AM 570) or one of its sister iHeartMedia stations. UCLA and IMG College have agreed to terms on an agreement to simulcast a significant number of UCLA men's basketball games on 97.3 THE FAN in San Diego, home to a large population of UCLA alumni and fans. The primary sister station in the greater Los Angeles area is AM 1150 (KEIB).

All 31 regular-season games are scheduled to be televised live in 2018-19. The Bruins will have at least 10 games broadcast by the ESPN family of networks. Six games will be televised by FOX Sports, and 14 will be carried by Pac-12 Networks. CBS will televise games against Ohio State (Dec. 22) and USC (Jan. 19).

Josh Lewin enters his third year serving as the play-by-play voice for UCLA men's basketball and football. In addition to calling UCLA games, Lewin recently completed his seventh season handling play-by-play duties for the New York Mets. He served as the voice of the San Diego Chargers for 12 seasons (2005-06 through 2016-17). Lewin has over two decades of experience calling NFL, MLB, NHL and NCAA football and basketball contests.

Tracy Murray begins his 10th season as a radio analyst. Murray, who played at UCLA (1990-92) before enjoying a 12-year NBA career, spent the 2015-16 season as a shooting coach for the Los Angeles Lakers. Previously, he served as a radio analyst with UCLA from 2008-15. Murray ranks 10th on UCLA's all-time scoring list with 1,792 career points in 98 games.

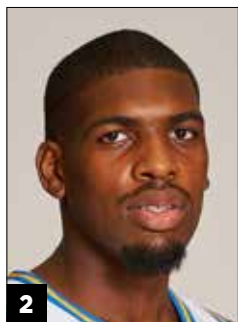

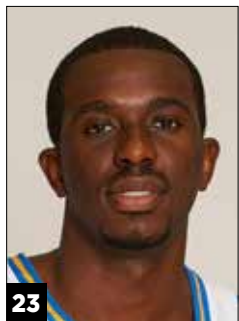

UCLA SIGNS THREE HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUTS DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

Bruins' incoming class for next season includes Jaime Jaquez, Jake Kyman and Grant Sherfield

The UCLA men's basketball program received signed National Letters of Intent from high school seniors Jaime Jaquez, Jake Kyman and Grant Sherfield on the first day of the early signing period, as announced on Nov. 14, 2018.

Jaquez, Kyman and Sherfield will enroll at UCLA in 2019 and begin their freshman seasons in Westwood during the 2019-20 academic year. All three student-athletes are currently high school seniors – Jaquez at Camarillo High School (Camarillo, Calif.), Kyman at Santa Margarita Catholic High School (Rancho Santa Margarita, Calif.) and Sherfield at Sunrise Christian Academy (Bel Aire, Kansas).

Jaquez averaged 31.0 points, 12.8 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game last season at Camarillo High School. The 6-foot-7, 215-pound guard has been ranked as high as No. 71, nationally, in his high school class by ESPN.com. Jaquez established Camarillo High School's single-season scoring record (838 points), recording the fourth-highest single-season point total in Ventura County history.

Last December, Jaquez registered a career-best 50 points against Prestonwood Christian (Plano, Texas) at the Tarkanian Classic in Las Vegas. He also registered a season-high 25 rebounds in a game that month against Leuzinger High School.

Kyman averaged 17.1 points, 6.5 rebounds and 2.9 assists per game last year at Santa Margarita Catholic High School. The 6-foot-7, 185-pound guard shot 50.1 percent from the field and 44.7 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Kyman totaled a season-high 32 points in a game against St. John Bosco (Jan. 12, 2018), sinking a season-high six three-pointers on eight attempts.

A first-team Orange County Register all-county selection as a junior, Kyman was named to the CIF Southern Section All-Open Division Team. His parents both excelled as collegiate athletes. Kyman's mother, Michelle, played volleyball for UCLA. His father, Coley, was a football and volleyball standout at Cal State Northridge.

Sherfield, currently a senior at Sunrise Christian Academy (Bel Aire, Kansas), starred the past two years at North Crowley High School in Fort Worth, Texas. The 6-foot-3, 185-pound guard from Fort Worth, Texas, averaged 24.1 points, 4.2 assists and 3.6 rebounds per game, leading North Crowley to a 31-6 record.

Last season, Sherfield guided North Crowley to a berth in the Texas state playoffs, advancing to the semifinals of the 6A Region 1 Tournament. He totaled 27 points, including 17 in the first half, in North Crowley's season-ending loss to Allen High School in the 6A Region semifinals.

In addition, Sherfield was one of three players on his high school team to secure District 4-6A All-Academic Team honors. He was named the high school district's co-MVP and the Offensive Player of the Year. Sherfield was recognized as a second-team all-state selection as a junior in USA Today's state-by-state honors.
