### TEAM

- Tonight's game marked Stanford's third straight game against a ranked opponent, the first such stretch in the regular season since ending the 2012 campaign with three straight.
- Arizona State now leads the all-time series, 18-15
- Tight end Bradley Archer made his first career start
- Stanford is now 11-3 in Friday games under David Shaw
- Benjamin Yurosek (118) and Elijah Higgins (110) are the first Stanford duo since Nov. 16, 2019 (Michael Wilson, Connor Wedington) to have 100 yards receiving in the same game
- After its touchdown with 10:24 left in the second quarter, the Stanford defense did not allow a point over the final 40:24 of the game; Arizona State's final touchdown came on a pick-six

### INDIVIDUAL

#### **QB TANNER MCKEE**

- Finished 27-of-45 for 356 yards (all career highs)
- Threw a touchdown to Elijah Higgins
- Threw three interceptions, his first snapping a streak of 161 straight to begin the season without an interception...he had 168 straight attempts without an interception to start his career

#### **TE BENJAMIN YUROSEK**

- Career highs in catches (6) and yards (118)
- First Stanford tight end since Colby Parkinson with a 100-yard receiving game (Nov. 10, 2018 vs. Oregon State)

#### **WR ELIJAH HIGGINS**

- Career highs in catches (7) and yards (110)
- Caught a touchdown pass for the third straight game and fourth time in five games

#### **OLB GABE REID**

- Totaled a career-best 10 tackles and had 2.5 tackles for loss

#### **P RYAN SANBORN**

- Handled all three phases of the kicking game (Joshua Karty out for game; Emmet Kenney injured on first PAT)
- Punted four times with three inside the 20 and did not allow a return
- Made a 32-yard field goal and is now 8-for-10 in his career
- Also had three kickoffs with three touchbacks
