TEAM

- Stanford improved to 10-2 in home openers under David Shaw and 9-3 in season openers
- David Shaw improved to 94-45 overall in his career and now sits alone with the 10th-most wins by any coach in Pac-12 Conference history
- Stanford had 497 yards of total offense, its highest mark since a two-OT win at UCLA in 2020 (560)...and its most in a non-OT game since Nov. 16, 2019 against Washington State (510 yards)
- The last time Stanford won a game despite having 4+ turnovers was vs. Oregon State (11/10/2012)
- The last time Stanford won a game by 30+ points despite having 4+ turnovers was vs. San Jose State (9/14/2002)
- The last time Stanford held an opponent without a 100-yard passer, rusher or receiver was 8/31/2019 vs. Northwestern
- Stanford has won seven straight games when rushing for multiple touchdowns in a game ... the Cardinal has had at least three rushing touchdowns in three of its last four wins
- E.J. Smith's two rushing touchdowns marked the first time a Cardinal has had multiple rushing TDs in a game since Austin Jones had two at UCLA in 2020
- Michael Wilson's two receiving touchdowns marked the first time a Cardinal has had multiple receiving TDs in a game since Simi Fehoko had three at UCLA in 2020
- E.J. Smith became Stanford's first 100-yard rusher since Nathaniel Peat at USC in 2021
- RG Levi Rogers, DL Anthony Franklin and EDGE David Bailey each made their first career start on Saturday
- 16 players made their first career appearance for the Cardinal on Saturday: early enrollees EDGE David Bailey, TE Sam Roush and WR Mudia Reuben, in addition to QB Ashton Daniels, RB Caleb Robinson, ILB Ese Dobre, RB Arlen Harris, DL Jaxson Moi, EDGE Duke Reeder, DL Matthew Merritt, OL Jason Amsler, OL Logan Berzins, OL Will Gibson, WR David Kasemervisz, DL Zach Buckey and DL Zephron Lester

INDIVIDUAL

QB TANNER MCKEE

- Finished 22-of-27 for 308 yards and two touchdowns
- Second career 300-yard game

RB E.J. SMITH

- Finished with 118 yards on 11 rushes and added five receptions for 37 yards
- First career two-rushing TD game
- 87-yard touchdown run on first play from scrimmage was tied for the fifth-longest in program history
- First career 100-yard rushing game

WR MICHAEL WILSON

- Caught five passes for 82 yards and two touchdowns
- First career two-TD game
- First receiving TD since 11/20/20 at Cal

RB CASEY FILKINS

- First career rushing TD

S KENDALL WILLIAMSON

- First career interception

QB ARI PATU

- Second career passing touchdown

WR MUDIA REUBEN

- First two career catches and first career touchdown reception

ILB LEVANI DAMUNI

- Led team with 10 tackles
