SETTING THE SCENE

Stanford continues its three-game homestand on Thursday, Jan. 18 with a visit from Washington State. The contest will tip off at 8 p.m. on Pac-12 Network.

THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford is off to a 9-7 start (4-2 Pac-12) with conference wins over then-No. 4 Arizona, Utah, UCLA and Oregon State. Five players are averaging in double-figure scoring: Maxime Raynaud, Kanaan Carlyle, Spencer Jones, Brandon Angel, and Michael Jones.
- Raynaud leads the Cardinal with 13.9 points and a team-leading 9.8 rebounds per game, while Carlyle is close behind at 13.8 points per night. Raynaud ranks 16th in the Pac-12 in scoring and second in rebounds.
- The Cardinal welcomed a graduate transfer for the second year in a row, with former Providence starting point guard Jared Bynum joining the program for his additional season. Bynum ranks 10th in the nation and first in the Pac-12 in assists per game (6.5).
- Michael Jones and Angel both rank in the top-12 nationally in effective field goal percentage, with Stanford the only team with multiple players in the top-25, not just the top-12.
- Stanford once again welcomed a top-20 recruiting class, led by five-star signee and McDonald's All-American Andrej Stojakovic and top-50 rated Kanaan Carlyle. Stojakovic is averaging 9.0 points over his first 15 games, including four performances of at least 16 points, while Carlyle has scored at least 11 points in five of his seven appearances this season, including 28 points against Arizona on Dec. 31.

CARLYLE EMERGES

Kanaan Carlyle is off to a tremendous start over his first eight games, ranking second on the team in scoring (13.8 ppg) and ranking 11th in the Pac-12 in scoring (16.2 ppg) and eighth in 3-point shooting (50%) during conference play. Against Pac-12 opponents, Carlyle ranks second among freshmen in scoring, just 0.6 points per game behind Oregon's Jackson Shelstad. The Atlanta native has two 20-point outings in conference play, with 28 against Arizona and 22 over Oregon State. He is also posting 3.2 assists per game in the Pac-12, which leads all true freshmen.

SEASON OF GIVING

Stanford is sharing the ball at an elite level, averaging 18.3 assists per night - the program's best average since posting a school record 18.3 per game in 1988-89. Jared Bynum ranks 10th nationally with 6.5 assists per game, while six rotation players are north of 2.0 per night. The Cardinal offense has benefitted as a result, scoring 78.9 points per game - which is on pace for the sixth-best average in program history. Only four Stanford teams have averaged more than 80 points per game in program history, the last in 2001-02. Stanford ranks 15th nationally in assists per game.

3-POINT SHOOTING

Stanford returns one of the leading 3-point shooting teams in the country, with seven players entering the campaign with at least one season of 39 percent or better shooting from beyond the arc. The Cardinal paced the Pac-12 in 3-point proclivity in conference play a year ago (37.9%), while the team led the country after Jan. 19 last season with a 42.6 percent clip from deep.

Stanford is shooting 38.6 percent from three over the first 16 games, second-best in the Pac-12. The Cardinal is led by four players shooting over 40 percent: Brandon Angel (52.9%), Kanaan Carlyle (43.2%), Michael Jones (42.9%) and Spencer Jones (40.0%). Michael Jones leads the team with 30 made triples, while Angel ranks second in the Pac-12 with his percentage overall and first in Pac-12 play (66.7%).

Stanford ranks first in the Pac-12 with 9.4 made triples per game, increasing its output at home (10.4 per game, 42.0% as a team). The Cardinal hit a program-record 16 triples (on 25 attempts, 64%) in its 100-82 win over No. 4 Arizona on Dec. 31, led by six makes from Carlyle and five from Spencer Jones. Stanford has at least 10 threes this season on eight occasions, including six of the last nine games. The Cardinal ranks 18th nationally in 3-point percentage and second since Christmas Day.

Stanford leads the Pac-12 in conference games with 10.5 made triples per night, doing so on a league-best 46.0% shooting.

MR. EFFICIENCY

Brandon Angel continues to be one of the most versatile and efficient players in the country. He is averaging 13.3 points per game on shooting splits of 61.6/52.9/85.7, and he is the only player nationally meeting all four benchmarks. The San Diego native is fifth nationally in true shooting percentage (72.3%) and eighth in effective field goal percentage (69.6%).

He ended the 2022-23 season in similar fashion, posting 14.1 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists per game from Feb. 1 through the end of the season while shooting 64.5 percent from the field and 69.0 percent from 3-point range - making him the only player nationally to hit those benchmarks over that time frame. Angel is a star in the classroom as well, earning CSC Academic All-America status in 2022-23 and completing an honors thesis as a senior in 2023-24.

POTENTIAL HISTORY FOR SPENCER JONES

Spencer Jones became the program's 50th member of the Stanford 1,000-point club a year ago, and he has moved into 17th on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,440 points. Next up are Oscar da Silva '21 (15th, 1,446) and Dwight Powell (14th, 1,465) to move into the top-15.

Establishing himself as one of the best 3-point shooters in program history, the sniper has 281 career threes, which ranks second all-time in program history and 11th in Pac-12 history. He is 24 away from passing Chasson Randle '15 for the top spot and 65 away from beating former Oregon guard Tajuan Porter for the all-time Pac-12 record. Jones is one away from matching former Oregon guard Orlando Williams (282) for 10th, while Payton Pritchard (Oregon) is ninth at 288 3-pointers.

Jones also ranks 11th all-time at Stanford in blocks with 100, one away from tying Brook Lopez for 10th, and ninth in steals with 129. He would be the first player in program history to make the top-10 on both lists.

CARD DOWNS TOP-5 ARIZONA, AGAIN

Stanford knocked off a top-five Arizona team for the second season in a row, winning 100-82 over the No. 4 Wildcats on New Year's Eve. Stanford has scored a top five AP victory in each of the past three seasons, having also downed No. 5 USC in 2021-22. The Cardinal joins Arizona as the only two programs in the country with a top five win in each of the last three seasons. The win was the third for Stanford over Arizona in their last four meetings in the Bay Area.

The Cardinal has eight ranked wins since the calendar turned to 2020, including five wins at Maples Pavilion. The 100 Stanford points were its most in program history over an AP ranked foe, and the most against Arizona in program history.

NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kanaan Carlyle introduced himself to the college basketball world with a career-high 28 points to lead Stanford to victory over Arizona on Dec. 31. The 28 points was the most for a Stanford freshman since Chasson Randle scored 30 against Arizona State at the 2012 Pac-12 Tournament, and his 28 points off the bench are the most for Stanford since Aaron Bright had 29 points in 2012 against Illinois State. Carlyle was honored as the Associated Press National Player of the Week, Dick Vitale's Diaper Dandy of the Week and the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week. The guard from Atlanta is averaging 13.8 points per game.

ROAD DOGS

Stanford opened its first road trip of 2024 with a gritty victory in a defensive battle, dispatching UCLA on Jan. 3, 59-53. Eight days later, Stanford capped its three-game stretch away from home with an 88-84 win (OT) at Oregon State. The Cardinal defense held the Bruins to a then-season low in scoring and its fewest against Stanford at Pauley Pavilion since March 3, 1973, and Stanford forced UCLA and Oregon State into 16 and 17 turnovers, respectively. Only Stanford, Arizona State and Oregon have two conference road wins through Jan. 11.

RAYNAUD DOUBT ABOUT IT

Maxime Raynaud has tallied two games this season of at least 15 points and 15 rebounds, and is the only player in the Pac-12 to accomplish the feat twice this season and one of three in major conferences, joining Kansas' Hunter Dickinson and Maryland's Julian Reese. Against CSUN in the opener, Raynaud was the first Stanford player with at least 20 points, 15 rebounds and three blocks in a game since Curtis Borchardt on Feb. 7, 2002 (vs. Oregon). He co-leads the Pac-12 with three double-doubles in conference play, achieving the mark against Utah, Oregon State and Arizona State.

The seven-footer returned to campus this summer with a gold medal around his neck, earning top honors with France at the FIBA U20 European Championship. Raynaud led France in scoring (14.0) and rebounding (5.0) while shooting 66.7 percent from the field and 87.5 percent (7-for-8) from 3-point range. The Paris native capped the event with a 26-point showing in the championship game against Israel.

STOJAKOVIC STANDS OUT

Andrej Stojakovic earned his first weekly honor from the Pac-12 on Dec. 18 as he was named the league's Freshman of the Week. In his fifth start of the campaign, the Carmichael, California native poured in 17 points on 7-for-11 shooting with a trio of makes from 3-point range. The honor was Stanford's 11th Freshman of the Week since award's inception in 2019-20, trailing only USC's 13 (now 14-12). He joins Tyrell Terry (2), Ziaire Williams (1), Michael O'Connell (1) and Harrison Ingram (6) as past Cardinal recipients, and Kanaan Carlyle (1) in 2024. Stanford is the only Pac-12 school with multiple unique winners this season.

A SECOND GRAD TRANSFER

Joining Stanford following a successful career at Providence, Jared Bynum was welcomed to the team as the second graduate transfer in program history, along with new teammate Michael Jones (Davidson) from 2022. Bynum was a decorated point guard at Providence, where he was an All-Big East second team honoree in 2022, as well as the Big East Sixth Man of the Year. He arrived with career averages of 10.3 points, 2.9 rebounds, 4.2 assists and 1.1 steals per game, leading Providence to two NCAA Tournaments.

Both graduate transfers have started the season on a strong note, with Jones scoring 11.8 points per game, while ranking seventh nationally in 2-point percentage (75.6%), and Bynum pitching in 8.3 points and 6.5 assists per night, which ranks 10th in the country and is first in the Pac-12. Bynum is the first Stanford player with three games with double-digit assists in the same season since Arthur Lee in 1997-98, while Brevin Knight previously tallied six in the 1996-97 campaign.

BEST OF BOTH WORLDS

Stanford's success extends beyond the court and into the classroom, where the Cardinal captured a series of major academic awards a year ago. Brandon Angel and Michael Jones joined a select group of men's basketball alumni before them with selections to the College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-America third team. It was the first year in program history with multiple selections, with Angel and Jones becoming the 13th and 14th Stanford players to be awarded the accolade. James Keefe was Stanford's third straight Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, making the Cardinal the first basketball program in conference history – men or women – to earn the award in three consecutive seasons. There have been 12 teams of any sport to win three straight times, with eight of those being Stanford programs, and the program would be the fifth to win four straight, joining only Stanford programs (M Rowing, W Soccer, W Swimming, W Volleyball, 1x each).

NOT A 4 YEAR DECISION, BUT A 40-YEAR DECISION

Stanford has continued its run of elite recruiting under head coach Jerod Haase, bringing in five-star, consensus-top-25 recruit Andrej Stojakovic and top-50 signee Kanaan Carlyle. Stanford's last classes with multiple top-50 signings were in 2017, when the Cardinal inked KZ Okpala, Oscar da Silva and Daejon Davis, and in 2006, when Brook and Robin Lopez ventured to The Farm. A high school All-American from multiple outlets, Stojakovic was the third Stanford player in four years to participate in the McDonald's All-American game. Carlyle was part of the gold medal-winning United States team at the 2022 FIBA U18 Americas Championship.

Additionally, Stanford inked ESPN four-star point guard Elijah Crawford on Nov. 8, 2023, in the class of 2024.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season (4.6 per game). Stanford's individual totals from this season (130 combined, 8.1 per game) are as follows:

JEROD HAASE

Anne and Tony Director of Men's Basketball Eighth Season at Stanford

In his first seven seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 112 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time since 2015. The 2020 team was set to be postseason bound before the cancellation of the NCAA Tournament.

The Cardinal won 14 games in 2022-23 and closed the season as one of the top offensive programs in the country. Stanford downed a top-five opponent for the second consecutive year and ended the season with a top-25 offense nationally. James Keefe was Stanford's third straight Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, while Brandon Angel and Michael Jones were named CSC Academic All-Americans. Spencer Jones was an All-Pac-12 forward for the second season in a row.

The streak of elite recruiting continued for Haase and his program, with Stanford signing Andrej Stojakovic, the team's third McDonald's All-American in four years, and Kanaan Carlyle, a top-40 signee. The top-tier class is Stanford's first with two top-40 recruits since 2006 (Brook & Robin Lopez).

Stanford added 16 wins in 2021-22, including the program's first win over an AP top-five opponent since 2007 and its first over a top-25 team on the road since 2014. Harrison Ingram was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year – Stanford's first since 2000 – while Spencer Jones blossomed into an All-Pac-12 conference forward. Sam Beskind was named Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, becoming the program's third honoree in the last five seasons.

The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country as one of two players to average 18 points, six rebounds and two assists per game while shooting over 55 percent from the floor. He was also named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year. The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20 and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04 and was led by junior Oscar da Silva (15.7 ppg, 6.4 rpg) and Tyrell Terry (14.6 ppg, 4.5 rpg, 3.2 apg), who emerged as one of the nation's top freshmen. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign. Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Several players have flourished under Haase's tutelage. KZ Okpala became Stanford's latest NBA Draft pick in 2019. Along with Okpala's first team all-conference selection and Josh Sharma's All-Pac-12 nod, Reid Travis was a two-time First Team All-Pac-12 selection in 2018 and a two-time NABC All-District pick. Dorian Pickens was named an all-conference player for his performance on the court and the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year for his efforts in the classroom in 2018. Daejon Davis was named to the five-member Pac-12 All-Freshman Team in 2018.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Tabbed the 2016 Gene Bartow Conference USA Coach of the Year, Haase led the Blazers to a 26-5 overall record and a 16-2 conference mark while capturing their first regular-season title since 2011. Along the way, UAB established school records for overall victories (26), conference wins (16), road wins (10) and consecutive victories (14). Also named the 2016 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Coach, Haase directed the Blazers to an NIT berth for the 12th time in school history. UAB also finished 16-0 at home in Haase's final season, extending the nation's fifth-longest home winning streak to 25, while ranking among the nation's best in field goal percentage (.478 – 24th), assists per game (18.4 – 4th) and blocks per game (4th – 6.1).

Under Haase's guidance, UAB returned to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, shocking No. 3 seed Iowa State 60-59 in the second round for the Blazers' first NCAA victory since 2005. UAB reached the Big Dance after claiming the program's first Conference USA Tournament title despite being seeded No. 4. The triumph marked UAB's first league tournament title since 1987, when the Blazers won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. More impressively, Haase successfully developed a roster comprised of 10 underclassmen – all players recruited by Haase and his staff – and finished 20-16 overall while guiding the third-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

The Blazers made impressive strides under Haase's leadership during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing 18-13 overall while notching three victories against teams that qualified for the NCAA Tournament. Of UAB's 18 victories, perhaps none were more impressive than the Blazers' 63-59 home win against No. 16 North Carolina. UAB was ranked in the top five nationally in rebounding throughout the season and finished the year ranked second in the country at 44.5 boards per game. During Haase's first year with the Blazers in 2012-13, UAB won six of its final nine regular-season Conference USA games and collected a victory in the conference tournament.

Prior to UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. A 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration, Haase got his start as Kansas' Director of Operations from 1999-2003. During that time, the Jayhawks reached the 2002 Final Four and the national championship game in 2003. When Williams was named head coach at North Carolina prior to the 2003-04 season, he brought Haase with him as an assistant coach and director of operations, a title Haase held from 2003-09. Haase then served exclusively as an assistant coach during his final three seasons with the Tar Heels.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, Calif., Haase attended California in 1992-93, starting 23 games as a freshman and playing alongside Jason Kidd in the backcourt. Haase then transferred to Kansas, where he helped lead the Jayhawks to three consecutive conference titles and finished his career ranked in the school's top 10 in assists, three-point field goals and steals. Haase started 99 of 101 games at Kansas and scored 1,264 points, averaging 12.5 per game and reaching double figures 74 times. While at Kansas, Haase was a candidate for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.

As a senior in 1996-97, Haase started alongside Jacqué Vaughn, Scot Pollard, Paul Pierce and Raef LaFrentz as Kansas finished with a 34-2 record while averaging 12.0 points per game despite playing with a broken wrist. As a sophomore in 1994-95, Haase averaged 15.0 points and was named the Big Eight Conference Newcomer of the Year and also tabbed a second-team all-conference selection. Haase was a first-team GTE Academic All-American as a senior, a second-team Academic All-American as a junior and a three-time academic all-conference pick. The Jayhawks' Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 1997, Haase later earned a master's degree in business at Kansas in 2000.

Haase and his wife, the former Mindy Meidinger, have three children: Gavin (17), Garrett (14) and Gabrielle (11).
