USF at a Glance

- USF is riding a four-game winning streak, their second streak of at least four wins or more this season. USF opened the season with a seven game winning streak. Last season, the Dons had just one streak of at least four games, that came during their stretch in the CBI.
- The Dons 11-1 start is the 10th time in program history since WWII that USF has started 11-1 or better through the first 12 games. Eight of the previous nine teams advanced to the post season.
- USF's 11-1 start is the best since the 1999-00 season when that team went on a 12-game winning streak to finish non-conference play at 12-1.
- Saturday's game is the second matchup against a Pac-12 foe for the Dons this year, earlier this season they beat Cal in Berkeley. Under head coach Kyle Smith the Dons are 2-2 against Pac-12 foes.
- Sophomore guard Charles Minlend celebrated his 21st birthday on Wednesday with a bang - during the win over Northern Arizona he scored his 500th career point. USF has five current players with 500 or more points.
- The Dons remain strong in the NET rankings. USF is still in the top-25 sitting at 23rd as of Friday morning. The Dons are one of two WCC teams in the Top-25 with Gonzaga ranked 14th.
- For the second-straight week, USF is receiving votes in the weekly AP Poll. The Dons notched two votes this week. Prior to last week, the last time the Dons received votes was the 1999-00 season.
- USF is currently sixth in the nation in scoring margin at +20.9. After defeating Northern Arizona by 16, the Dons have nine wins by 15 or more this season.

Vs. STANFORD

Series

The series between USF and Stanford goes all the way back to 1913-14 before basketball was a recognized sport at USF. Saturday's contest will be the 68th meeting between the two school with Stanford holding a 46-21 advantage in the series. In the first meeting between the two schools, Stanford defeated the "Grey Fog" 22-20 on the Farm in 1913-14. At home, the Dons are 10-6. The last time Stanford visited the Hilltop was on Dec. 12, 1987 when Stanford came away with the 68-67.

About the The CARDINAL

Stanford enters Saturday's contest with a 6-4 overall record. The young Cardinal squad boasts a 11 of 15 players in their first or second year on the roster. Stanford is one of four teams that have started all freshmen or sophomores. The Cardinal were picked to finish ninth in the Pac-12 in the media poll. On the road this year, Stanford is 1-2 which includes losses at North Carolina and a 90-84 overtime loss at No. 2 Kansas. Leading the team in scoring is sophomore forward KZ Okpala who is averaging 16.8 points per game.

Last Time vs. STANFORD

On Dec. 17, 2017 the Dons and Cardinal reignited an annual rivalry that had only been played four times since 1995, when USF traveled to the Farm. The Cardinal came away with the 71-59 victory over the Dons. USF struggled to get into a shooting rhythm connecting on just 26 percent of its 3-point field goal attempts going 8-for-30. On the defensive side of the ball, USF had trouble containing First Team All-Pac-12 honoree Reid Travis who led all scorers with 29 points. Former Dons' Chase Foster and Souley Boum led the USF with 14 points apiece. The Dons went into the locker room trailing 38-21 and actually outscored the Cardinal in the second half. But the Cardinal, with their 36 points in the paint, maintained the lead and came away with the home victory.

What's a Don

"Don" is an acronym for **De Origen Noble**, which translates to "of noble origin" and is a Spanish title given only to a noble person of political, social or official distinction. The name references the early history of California and San Francisco, which was marked by the exploits of the adventuresome and swashbuckling Spanish Dons. All USF students and alumni are of noble origin who share in the long passion for learning in order to better understand the past, clarify the present and anticipate the future. Thus, we are proud to call ourselves the Dons. USF's mascot is named **Don Francisco**, in honor of **Don Francisco de Haro**, the first mayor of San Francisco.

This is Kyle Smith's third season as the head coach at USF and his ninth as a head coach. Following back-to-back 20 win campaigns, including two-straight trips to the post season, Smith signed a well earned contract extension that will keep him on the Hilltop well into the next decade.

In two years at the helm of the men's basketball program, Smith has exceeded even his own expectations. The Dons have gone 42-30 overall, including 19-17 in the West Coast Conference. His .583 winning percentage at the Hilltop is fifth-best in program history for a head coach through two seasons, topping Naismith Hall of Fame names such as Pete Newell (.509), Phil Wolpert (.400) and other legendary Dons' head coaches such as Pete Paletta (.509), Phil Vukicevich (.568), and Jim Brovelli (.410).

Smith's 42 wins after two seasons ranks fourth-most in USF history, behind Pete Berry (49 wins), Dan Belluomini (45 wins), and Bob Gaillard (43 wins). In posting back-to-back 20-win seasons, Smith becomes the first Dons head coach to accomplish that feat since the 1981-82 seasons. He has guided the Dons to consecutive postseason tournament appearances, the second culminating with the Dons' first postseason tournament championship appearance since USF took home the NCAA Championship in 1956.

Under Smith, the Dons have excelled in the classroom as well. They finished last fall with a team GPA of 3.36, including 12 players with GPAs of 3.0 or higher, and six who made the Dean's List. Nate Renfro turned in a 4.0 GPA for the Dons. Five current and past players have earned WCC All-Academic Honors in the last two seasons. The Dons have also been leaders in the community, annually partnering with E-Hoops, an inclusive basketball program that trains and develops kids through the game of basketball, including children with special needs.

ASSISTANTS

Kyle Smith is pleased to bring back the core of his assistants who have helped the Dons win 43 games in two seasons. Associate head coach Derrick Phelps begins his fifth season on Kyle Smith's staff. Phelps works closely with USF's backcourt. A member of the North Carolina 1993 National Championship team, Phelps also takes a lead role in scouting and international recruiting. Associate head coach Todd Golden, a former standout player at Saint Mary's College returned to Smith's staff when he came out west. Prior to USF, Golden spent two seasons at Auburn under head coach Bruce Pear. Golden serves as USF's recruiting and defensive coordinator. In his third season at USF and seventh season under Smith is assistant coach Kevin Hovde. The Richmond graduate serves as the Dons offensive coordinator. In his first year with the program is Director of Operations Jonathan Safir. Prior to joining the Dons, Safir was a member of Columbia's coaching staff serving in the same role since 2016.

The Dons will play their final home non-conference game on Saturday when Stanford comes to the Hilltop. It is the first time since 1987 Stanford has played the Dons at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center. Saturday's game is slated for a 2:00 p.m. tip and will be televised on Pac-12 Network with Barry Tompkins and Dan Belluomini calling the game live. Fans can also tune into the official home of USF Dons Basketball, 1550-AM The GAME, to hear pat Olson and Jim Brovelli with all the action courtside.

Last Time Out

The Dons improved to 11-1 with a 76-60 win over visiting Northern Arizona on Wednesday. The Dons led for 33 minutes but needed a trailed by six early in the first half. A 23-7 run by USF to close out the first half gave the Dons the cushion they would need for the win. USF never led by less than eight for the remainder of the game and led by as much as 21 with 2:19 to play. Charles Minlend celebrated his 21st birthday in style, leading the Dons with a game-high 18 points.

He Said It

Following the 76-60 win over Northern Arizona, head coach Kyle Smith was asked if the Dons could have played better.

"I know we're decent because we're getting questions about our performance when we win by 16," said head coach Kyle Smith. "That comes with the territory."

Minlend Scores His 500th

With 8:05 in the second half, sophomore Charles Minlend scored his 500th career point. He accomplished that feat in his 45th game. Minlend is one of five active Dons with at least 500 career points. He joins Jordan Ratinho (813), Frankie Ferrari (735), Matt McCarthy (716), and Nate Renfro (582).

Historical Perspective on the Dons 11-1 Start

The Dons 11-1 start is one of the best in program history. Since World War II the Dons have started 11-1 or better through 12 games 10 times. Of the previous nine times eight have gone to the post season, of those eight seven advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

In Wednesday night's win over Northern Arizona seven of the Dons first nine points were scored immediately following an NAU turnover. For the game, USF finished with 18 points off 15 Lumberjack turnovers. For the season, the Dons have scored 199 points off 158 turnovers. The Dons are averaging 16.5 ppg off their opponents turnovers. In the win over Maine, USF scored a season-high 26 points off 14 turnovers.

Dons Versus the Pac-12

On Saturday, USF will square off against regional conference rival the Pac-12 when Stanford comes to the Hilltop. Under head coach Kyle Smith, the Dons are 2-2 with wins over Cal Utah at the Diamondhead Classic in 2016-17. Last season the Dons went 0-2 against Pac-12 teams falling to Arizona State and Stanford on the road. All-time USF is 73-88 against the Pac-12.

When the Dons and Cardinal tip on Saturday it will be the second matchup between father/son. Tom Orlich is the assistant to Stanford head coach Jerod Haase. Tom is the father of Dons' senior guard Michael Orlich. The elder Orlich owns a 1-0 advantage in the father/son series with the Cardinal defeating the Dons last season at Maples Pavilion.

Cold Start From Beyond the Arc

The Dons opened the game very cold from 3-point range going 0-for-8 from beyond the arc before Frankie Ferrari hit the first triple at the 10:15 mark in the first half. The Dons finished the game 9-for-30 from 3-point range. The Dons are 103-for-301 from long range this season, averaging 8.5 3-point field goals per game.

Defeating the Lumberjacks

On Wednesday, the Dons improved to 2-0 against teams nicknamed the Lumberjacks. USF defeated Stephen F. Austin on Nov. 30 in Belfast. Northern Arizona and Stephen F. Austin are the only two Division I schools that use Lumberjacks as their mascot.

Bench Production

In the win over Northern Arizona the Dons' reserves finished with 25 points - outscoring NAU's bench 25-22. USF is 9-0 this season when the bench outscores their opponent. The Dons' bench has scored 311 points this season, averaging 25.9 points per game.

Held to Less Than 70

In the win over Cal State Fullerton, the Dons were held to less than 70 for the first time this season. Under head coach Kyle Smith the Dons are just 11-20 when USF scores less than 70.

Spreading Out The Minutes

In the Kyle Smith era, the Dons have routinely spread out the minutes and utilized their entire bench. This year is no different. USF has eight players on its roster that have played 12 or more minutes with an additional six playing three or more minutes. Only one player on the roster is averaging more than 30 minutes per game and that's senior guard Frankie Ferrari at 30.9 minutes per contest.

Home Sweet Home

The Dons will play their eighth of 18 home contests in Wednesday when they take on Northern Arizona. The Dons are 7-0 at home this season. Under head coach Kyle Smith USF is 35-10 in two and a half seasons. All-time USF is 607-254 at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center which opened officially on Dec. 4, 1958.

Dons Receiving Votes

For the second-straight week the Dons are receiving votes in the AP Poll. This week, the Dons are receiving two votes. Prior to last week's poll, the Dons last made an appearance in the "receiving votes" category in the 1999-00 season when USF rattled off 12-straight wins entering conference play 12-1.

Streaking Again

Following the Dons loss to No. 21 Buffalo, USF has responded with a four-game winning streak. Coming out of the loss, the Dons have wins over 19, 22, 14, and 16. It is their second winning streak of at least four games this season. Last year, the Dons only had one winning streak of four games and that came during the Dons run in the CBI.

Ferrari Named to Senior Class Award Watch List

Senior guard Frankie Ferrari was selected as one of 30 candidates nationwide for the Senior Class Award List. The list of 30 will be whittled down to 10 finalists in February. Ferrari is off to a fantastic start this season, averaging 11.3 ppg and 6.6 assists per game. His assist to turnover ratio is currently ninth-best in the nation.

Ratinho From 3

Junior guard Jordan Ratinho has made 33 3-point field goals this year, giving him 174 for his career. The 174 made 3-point field goals ranks fourth all-time at USF. Ahead of him is John Cox (1999-05) with 185 made threes. Ratinho set the USF single season record with 86 threes last year.

•The USF single-season holder made 85 last season - with 19 games remaining at his current pace he is set to tie his record.

Four in Double Figures

Through 11 the Dons have four players in double figures. Leading the team is Charles Minlend at 14.4, followed by Frankie Ferrari at 12.5, Jordan Ratinho at 12.3 and Matt McCarthy at 10.8.

•At his current pace - Ratinho will finish the year with 368 points giving him 1,046, making him the 37th player in USF history to eclipse 1,000 points.

•Minlend has scored 10 or more in 10 of 11 contests this year, for his career he has 492 points.

Kyle Smith Wins 50th at USF

Third year head coach Kyle Smith reached another coaching milestone last Wednesday against Cal. With the win over the Bears, Smith won his 50th game as the head coach at USF, he improves to 52-31 on the Hilltop. Earlier this year he won his 150th game in the win over Stephen F. Austin. For his career he is 153-113 in nine seasons as a head coach between six years at Columbia and three years at USF.

Dons Sixth In Scoring Margin

The Dons are currently sixth in the nation in scoring margin at +209. After dispatching Northern Arizona by 16, the Dons have nine wins by 15 or more.

Dons Inside the Arc

This season the Dons are shooting 48.9 percent from the field going 355-for-726. However, inside the arc the Dons are one of the nations leaders in 2-point field goal percentage. From inside three-point range, USF is shooting 59.4 percent which is tied for second best in the nation. A big reason for that is senior Matt McCarthy who is shooting 67.4 percent which ranks 12th in the nation, ahead of Duke's super frosh Zion Williamson.

One Of The Last Undefeated

Before the Dons fell to No. 21 Buffalo on in Belfast, USF was one of 16 remaining undefeated teams left in Division I. Of those 16 - three came from the WCC. As of Tuesday morning there are only 11 teams still undefeated.

Dons On The Glass

The Dons have been stellar on the glass this season. USF is eighth in the nation in rebound margin at +12.4. The lone contest in which the Dons were outrebounded came against No. 21 Buffalo who outrebounded the Dons 39-37. USF is ninth in the nation in defensive rebounds - averaging 31.33 per game and 13th in total rebounds per game at 42.78.



The NCAA Evaluation Tool, which will be known as the NET, relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin, net offensive and defensive efficiency, and the quality of wins and losses.

THE N.E.T

As of Friday, USF remains in the top-25 in the NET, they are currently ranked 23rd. USF is one of two WCC teams in the top-25 with Gonzaga ranked seventh. The NET replaced the RPI this season and will be one of the major factors for the NCAA Tournament selection committee.

The Dons currently rank 23rd in the nation in AdjD (adjusted defensive efficiency: points allowed per 100 possessions) with a ranking of 93.7 according to KenPom.com. Last season, the Dons finished 99th in AdjD with a rating of 101.1.]

More Kenpom numbers: The Dons rank 2nd in the nation in OR% which is the percentage of times the offense gets the rebound - the Dons are limiting opponents to a rebound 19.5 percent of the time - meaning that more than 80% of the time on a missed shot the Dons are getting the rebound and not letting their opponents get a second opportunity.

Haslametrics.com, another college basketball analytics site has the Dons ranked ninth in their list and says this about the Dons: "When you talk about the elite teams in college basketball this year, San Francisco most definitely is in the conversation. Carrying a record of 9-1, they are currently rated #9 overall (out of 353) in All-Play Percentage this season.

San Francisco is one of the most menacing defensive teams in the country. Ranked second in defensive efficiency, they will allow fewer than 81 points every 100 possessions vs. AO. San Francisco does an outstanding job shutting down the opposition from behind the arc. They rank second in the NCAA in defensive three-point percentage, allowing AO to make just 20.1% of their attempts from afar. For this reason, AO takes nowhere near as many threes as they typically would and, as a result, just 31.8% of AO's field goal attempts will be from downtown. San Francisco is also one of the very best in the land in overall defensive field goal percentage. The team ranks #21 nationally in field goal percentage allowed, as AO only makes good on about 38.0% of their total attempts from the floor."
