Teams will be ranked by their highest score from Jan. 9-16 ... From Jan. 23-Feb. 13, teams will be ranked by their total season average ... Starting Feb. 20, teams and gymnasts will be ranked by Regional Qualifying Score (RQS) ... A Regional Qualifying Score is based on a team's top six regular-season scores, with three scores coming from away meets ... To obtain the regional qualifying score, the team's or gymnast's highest score is dropped and the remaining five scores are averaged.

For Immediate Release: Wednesday, February 1, 2006 Nationally-Ranked Stanford Women's Gymnastics Team Travels to California

**Stanford, Ca** - The nationally-ranked Stanford women's gymnastics team (6-2 overall, 0-1 Pac-10) continues competition in the Pacific-10 Conference with a trip to Berkeley on Friday (February 3) against the California Golden Bears (2-6 overall, 0-2 Pac-10). The meet begins at 7:30 p.m. at Haas Pavilion.

For Stanford head coach **Kristen Smyth**, she will be returning to her alma mater. **Smyth**, a 1993 graduate of California, is one of the top gymnasts in both Pac-10 and University of California history. **Smyth** was named the Golden Bears' Gymnast of the Decade, and was a nominee for Pacific-10 Conference Gymnast of the Decade honors. **Smyth** was both a three-time All-American and a three-time Academic All-American, and led the Golden Bears to their first-ever NCAA championship berth in 1992.

Stanford has dominated the series against California. The Cardinal has won ten straight meets against the Golden Bears dating back to the 1996 season.

Stanford's next home meet is February 17 against tenthranked Arizona at Burnham Pavilion (Burnham Pavilion, 7:30 p.m.).

Stanford is averaging 194.475 points in three meets this year ... The Cardinal attained its season-best mark of 194.950 in the season opener at the Cancun Classic (1/6/06) ... That point total is fourth-best in the Pac-10 and 13th-best in the nation.

# Kelly Fee, Freshman, St. Charles, Il

Has emerged as one of Stanford's top gymnasts this year ... Has competed in the All-Around in two of the three meets this year, with a season-best mark of 38.725 ... Is seventh in the Pac-10 on Beam (9.750).

# Natalie Foley, Senior, Englewood, Co

Has competed in the All-Around in all three meets this year with a season-best total of 39.150 against UC Davis, San Jose State and Sacramento State (1/15/06) ... Ranks in the Top 10 in two events in the Pac-10 ... Her score of 9.833 in Floor Exercise is third-best in the conference behind teammates Tabitha Yim (9.892) and Nicole Ourada (9.850) ... She is tenth in the Pac-10 on Bars (9.783).

Stanford is ranked high nationally in several events ... Stanford is sixth in the nation on Vault with an average score of 49.008 ... The national leader is Georgia (49.219) ... Stanford is eleventh in the nation on Beam (48.417) ... Arizona State leads the nation with an average score of 48.908 ... On Bars, Stanford is 12th with an average score of 48.692 ... Michigan is the national leader (49.117) ... In Floor Exercise, the Cardinal is 19th (48.358) ... Georgia leads the nation (49.262) ... Sophomore Tabitha Yim continues to lead the nation in the All-Around (39.600) ... Freshman Nicole Ourada is 19th (38.992) ... Yim is fourth nationally in Floor Exercise (9.892) ... **Ourada** is 14th (9.850) ... On Bars, **Yim** is sixth nationally (9.900) while sophomore **Liz Tricase** is eighth (9.892) ... On Beam, **Yim** occupies the eighth position nationally (9.825), and eleventh (9.858) on Vault.

No doubt, the Pacific-10 Conference is loaded with outstanding women's gymnastics programs ... Five of the seven conference schools (Stanford, Arizona, Arizona State, Oregon State, UCLA) are ranked in the national Top 25 ... No other conference in the nation can make that claim ... Arizona and UCLA are ranked tenth, followed by Arizona State (12th), Stanford (13th) and Oregon State (19th) ... Sophomore **Tabitha Yim** is first in the Pac-10 in the All-Around (39.600), Floor Exercise (9.892), Bars (9.900), and second on Beam (9.825) and Vault (9.858) ... Stanford is 1-2-3 in the Pac-10 in Floor Exercise with **Tabitha Yim** (9.892), Nicole Ourada (9.850) and Natalie Foley (9.833) leading the way.

# **Recruits Report**

The Stanford Women's Gymnastics Program has signed three outstanding high school seniors to national letters of intent ... All three gymnasts will enter Stanford University in the Fall of 2006 ... The three gymnasts are Allyse Ishino (Foothill HS, Santa Ana, Ca), Carly Janiga (Saguaro HS, Paradise Valley, Ca) and Blair Ryland (Woodbridge HS, Woodbridge, Va) ... Ishino is an International Elite gymnast who was fifth in the All-Around at the 2004 U.S. Olympic Trials and was an alternate on the 2004 silver medal winning U.S. Olympic team ... Janiga finished in the Top 9 in the All-Around, Vault, Beam and Floor Exercise at the 2004 U.S. Olympic Team Trials ... Janiga was one of only ten athletes invited to the 2004 Olympic Team selection camp and almost earned a spot representing the United States ... Ryland is an International Elite gymnast, who placed first on Beam at the National Training Camp in June, and qualified to the U.S. Classic.

#### Cancun Classic (1/6/06)

The Cardinal opened the 2006 season on Jan. 6 with an impressive effort at the Cancun Classic in Mexico ... Stanford tallied a team score of 194.950, just behind the winning effort of top-ranked and defending NCAA champion Georgia ... Victories by **Glyn Sweets** in the Vault (9.925), **Liz Tricase** on Bars (9.875) and **Natalie Foley** on Beam (9.775) helped the Cardinal in the five team meet ... Denver finished third with 193.850 points followed by Oklahoma with 193.325, and Arizona with 192.925 ... Three Cardinal athletes competed in the All-Around ... Senior **Natalie Foley**, an eight-time All-American, finished third (39.025) while freshmen **Nicole Ourada** placed fifth (39.025) and **Kelly Fee** placed sixth (38.725).

# Sacramento State, San Jose State, UC Davis (1/15/06)

In its home opener, Stanford looked impressive in a four-way meet with Sacramento State, UC Davis and San Jose State ... The Cardinal chalked up 194.350 points to easily outdistance runnerup Sacramento State (191.525), San Jose State (190.575) and UC Davis (186.875) ... The Cardinal captured first, second and third place in each of the four events (Bars, Beam, Floor Exercise, Vault) in addition to placing 1-2-3 in the All-Around ... **Tabitha Yim**, competing in only her third collegiate All-Around, tallied a career-best 39.600 to finish first ... **Yim** gained first place honors in the All-Around thanks to victories on Floor Exercise (9.925, tied her career-best), Vault (9.900, career-best), and Beam (9.875) ... **Liz Tricase** tied her career-best on Bars with an impressive effort of 9.950.

#### **Oregon State (1/27/06)**

Despite an upset loss to Oregon State (195.150 - 194.125), several Cardinal athletes performed with high marks ... Liz Tricase won the Bars competition with a score of 9.850 ... Sophomore Tabitha Yim, who is the national leader in the All-Around (39.600), competed in three events (Vault, Beam, Floor) and collected wins on Floor (9.850) and Vault (9.900).
