- In the last meeting at Sunken Diamond, No. 3 UCLA won two of three in 2015.
- Prior to last season, Stanford won six of the previous seven series between these teams.
- The Cardinal has won two straight series against the Bruins in Los Angeles. The last time
- UCLA won a series over the Cardinal in LA was in 2010 when the Bruins were ranked No. 2.

Current Cardinal against UCLA

• Kris Bubic threw two scoreless innings in a relief appearance at UCLA last season.

In three career appearances against the Bruins, Chris Castellanos is 1-1 with a 4.76 ERA in 11.1 innings (two starts). Two years ago at Sunken, UCLA scored four in 2.1 innings, but last season Castellanos allowed just one earned in 7.0 innings at Jackie Robinson Field.
Beau Branton is a .429 lifetime hitter (6-of-14) against UCLA

- Deau Dranton is a .429 thethre initier (6-01-14) against OCLA
- Mikey Diekroeger was 4-for-12 with three doubles and three runs vs. UCLA in 2016.

• Senior Alex Dunlap is a career .346 (9-of-26) hitter against the Bruins, including 5-for-10 with three runs, a double, home run and two RBI last season.

• Brett Hanewich has a 1.54 ERA in 2 starts vs. UCLA, including a complete-game win in 2015.

- Andrew Summerville owns a 1.50 ERA in 6 innings vs. UCLA (5.0 innings, 1 ER in start last yr).
- In four relief appearances, Tyler Thorne has yet to allow a Bruins run in 6.1 innings.
- Matt Winaker was 4-for-12 with two doubles, two RBI and two walks in this series last year.

LAST WEEKEND

Stanford took two of three in its first Pac-12 road series (at USC).

▶ In Game 1 against the Trojans, Matt Winaker became the first Cardinal since 2010 to lead off the game with a home run and the first with two homers in a game since 2014, but it the Cardinal fell 7-5 and dropped to 0-3 in Pac-12 openers this year.

In Game 2, Colton Hock threw 5.0 scoreless innings in relief and the Cardinal scored five in the 10th to win, 8-3.

In the finale, freshman Daniel Bakst hit a two-out, three-run, bases-clearing double to give the Cardinal a 4-2 lead in the seventh inning. The Cardinal hung on to win 6-3.

On Tuesday, Stanford scored five runs in the second and used five hurlers to win at SJSU.

UP NEXT `

Another mid-week matchup with Cal on Pac-12 Network. The Cardinal host the Bears at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday.

Stanford then takes to the road for the next four. For the first time since a flight to Houston for the series at Rice, March 9-12, the Cardinal hits the skies. Stanford flies to Oregon to take on the Ducks, April 21-23, before returning back to the Bay Area to play Santa Clara.

Moving Up 💷

▶ Junior reliever Colton Hock set a career high with his seventh save of the season on March 28 vs. Long Beach State. He has 16 for his career which ranks fourth alltime at Stanford, tied with Jeff Bruksch (2000-01) and A.J. Vanegas (2011-14). Steve Chitren holds the school record with 26 saves. Chitren recorded the final out for both of Stanford's national titles.

Stanford Standouts

Junior Matt Winaker is leading the conference with an .821 slugging percentage and nine walks in Pac-12 play this year and is second with a .550 on-base percentage.
 Duke Kinamon is the first Cardinal with nine steals in the season since Justin Ringo in 2009, and is seeking to become the first with double-digit thefts since Zach Jones (2010).

Stanford Streaks 📈

Freshman catcher Maverick Handley has Stanford's longest active hit streak at five games and has a hit in all six career starts.

Freshman Daniel Bakst's 11-game hitting streak (March 12-April 6) was the longest of the year for Stanford. He has a hit in 13 of the last 14 games and in games where he has at least three at-bats he has a hit in 18 of 19 games.

Junior Matt Winaker has played in 95 straight games. The last time he did not enter Coach Marquess' lineup was April 28, 2015 vs. SJSU).

Junior Quinn Brodey has started 91 consecutive games for the Cardinal — last time he was not in starting lineup was May 5, 2015 vs. Santa Clara.

Stanford had a 12-game home win streak between 2016-17—longest since a 16-game streak in 2004—snapped by Texas on March 2. Stanford won next three games of series.

Back-2 -Back

▶ Junior Quinn Brodey earned back-to-back Pac-12 Baseball Player of the Week honors on March 7 and March 14. Brodey was the first player to win the award in back-to-back weeks since Washington State's Brian Wolfe in 2014, and the first Stanford player to do so since Jon Schaeffer in 1997.

Shortly after the 2016 season, head coach Mark Marquess announced that 2017 would be his final season.

- » Became fourth Division I head coach (fifth ever) to win 1,600 games.
- » Will coach in 2,500th game at Cal on Sunday, May 14 on Pac-12 Network.
- » Most wins in Pac-12 history, fourth-most wins in Division I history.
- » Two national championships (1987, 1988) and 29 NCAA Tournament berths and 14 CWS.
- » Stanford has finished .500 or better in 38 of his first 40 seasons.
- » Nine-time conference Coach of the Year, three-time national Coach of the Year.
- » 38 winning seasons in first 40 years, including six 50-win campaigns.


