

SETTING THE SCENE

2023 opens with a rivalry, as the Cardinal travels to Berkeley for the first meeting this season with California. The action gets underway on Friday, Jan. 6 at 6 p.m. on ESPNU.

THE OPENING TIP

The Cardinal is 5-9 (0-4 Pac-12) to open the campaign, including home wins over Pacific (88-78), Cal Poly (80-43) and Green Bay (85-40) and neutral site wins over Florida State (70-60) and Loyola Chicago (75-62).
Through 14 games, Spencer Jones leads the team with 12.3 points per game, and joined Stanford's 1,000-point club on Dec. 29 with a 25-point outing against Colorado. Jones paces the program in Pac-12 play with 18.0 points per game, which ranks fifth in the league. He also ranks second in made free throws, third in made threes and third with 2.8 offensive rebounds per game.

• Harrison Ingram, who was Stanford's first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year since Casey Jacobsen in 2000, withdrew his name from the 2022 NBA Draft to return to The Farm for his sophomore campaign. He is averaging 9.1 points, 4.6 rebounds and a team-best 3.0 assists per game.

• The Cardinal returns eight of its top nine rotation players from a year ago, ranking sixth nationally in minutes continuity, per KenPom, while also bringing in the program's first transfer in 12 years and the first graduate transfer in program history in Michael Jones (Davidson). Jones had a game to remember in the season opener, with his 31 points the most by a Stanford player in his team debut on record. The 31 points remain tied for the best single-game mark by a Pac-12 player this season.

• Stanford split last season's meetings with California, and is 13-11 over the last 24 meetings in Berkeley. The Cardinal has won three of the last four matchups in the Bay Area since the 2020-21 campaign.

HAASE PAVILION

Stanford is looking for its fourth win in the last six tries at Cal's Haas Pavilion, and its ninth win over its rival in the Jerod Haase era. The Cardinal gave up just 51.5 points to Cal last season, which was the team's best defensive mark against any Pac-12 program. The Cardinal has won six of the last nine regular season contests with the Golden Bears. Spencer Jones and Harrison Ingram lead all returners with 9.5 and 9.0 points per game, respectively, against Cal last season. Head coach Jerod Haase played his first season at Cal, alongside Jason Kidd in the Bears' backcourt, before finishing his college career at Kansas.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH **DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL** JEROD HAASE

In his first six seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Car-dinal has won 98 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time since 2015. The 2020 team was set to be postseason bound before the cancellation of the NCAA Tournament.

Stanford won 16 games in 2021-22, including the program's first win over an AP top-five opponent since 2007 and its first over a top-25 team on the road since 2014. Harrison Ingram was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year – Stanford's first since 2000 - while Spencer Jones blossomed into an All-Pac-12 conference forward. Sam Beskind was named Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, becoming the program's third honoree in the last five seasons.

The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country as one of two players to average 18 points, six rebounds and two assists per game while shooting over 55 percent from the floor. He was also named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year.

The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram, Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign.

Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT. appearance in the NIT.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total everv vear.

THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters the matchup with the Utes at No. 108 in the NET Rankings (Jan. 2), with a NET SOS of 39 and an average opponent NET rank of 17. The matchup is currently a quadrant four contest, as Cal slots in at No. 297. 18 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are currently slated to be in quadrant one or two, and 9 of the remaining 17. The Cardinal is one of six teams to havbe paved nine O1 or O2 contests. joining North Carolina, Butler, Nebraska, Seton Hall and Mississippi Valley State.

A BALANCING ACT

Stanford has had balanced scoring through 14 games, as 11 different players have had at least one game in double-figure scoring, which leads all power conference teams. Five different players have had a 20-point game this season, a total which is matched in the Pac-12 only by Arizona.

50TH TO REACH 1,000

A high-scoring weekend against Colorado and Utah helped Spencer Jones cross the 1,000 point threshold. Jones scored a season-high 25 points against Colorado, his eighth-career 20-point outing, and added 16 against Utah. The senior became the program's 50th member of the 1,000-point club, and has moved into 47th on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,028 points.

FORCING TURNOVERS

The Cardinal defense has escalated its pressure over the past nine games, forcing at least 15 turnovers six times and a season-best 27 against Green Bay, which were the most for Stanford under head coach Jerod Haase, and the most for the Cardinal since causing 27 against UC Davis on Nov. 28, 2006. The Cardinal is averaging 7.9 steals per game over the last nine outings, led by at least one per game from four players: Spencer Jones, Michael Jones, Brandon Angel and James Keefe. The Cardinal has forced all four Pac-12 opponents into at least 16 turnovers, and boasts the league's third-best turnover margin at plus-3.3.

SANTA CRUZ SUCCESS

The Cardinal continued its run of success at Kaiser Permanente Arena, beating Loyola Chicago in Santa Cruz on Dec. 22 by 13 points. Stanford went 5-0 in the arena during the COVID-affected 2020-21 slate, including wins over Arizona, UCLA, Washington, Washington State and Cal State Bakersfield.

Harrison Ingram scored 15 points to lead the win over the Ramblers, while James Keefe added 14 points, eight rebounds and three steals. Michael Jones had 12 points and Michael O'Connell had a season-high 10 in the win, as the team shot 50 percent from the field with 11 different players on the scoresheet.

AROUND THE LEAGUE

Entering the third week of Pac-12 competition, Stanford ranks first in the league in made threes per game (7.5), second in the league in steals (9.0 per game) and third in turnover margin (+3.3). Spencer Jones ranks fifth in scoring at 18.0 points per game, and third in offensive rebounds (2.8), while also ranking second in made free throws and third in made threes. Stanford has six players averaging at least 1.0 steal per game in conference play.

In all games this season league-wide, Brandon Angel is the Pac-12's leading free throw shooter at 92.9 percent, while Ryan Agarwal paces the league in 3-point percentage at 52.0 percent. Michael Jones' 31 points on opening night remains tied for the best-single game scoring output this season.

FIVE-STAR CLASS OF 2023

Adding a pair of highly-touted student-athletes to the program in the class of 2023, Stanford signed Kanaan Carlyle (Atlanta, Ga.) and Andrej Stojakovic (Carmichael, Calif.) to national letters of intent. Carlyle is rated a five-star prospect by Rivals and the 247 composite, ranking as high as the 19th-rated recruit in the country from Rivals. Stojakovic is also a five-star signee via the 247 composite rankings and is ranked No. 17 overall nationally by 247 Sports. Both prospects are rated in ESPN's top-30 overall, with Stanford one of just four schools nationally with multiple top-30 signees, joining Kentucky, Duke and Oregon. Stanford has multiple top-25 signees in the same class for the first time since 2006, when Brook and Robin Lopez committed to play on the Farm.

JONESING FOR JONES

Spencer Jones garnered his first All-Pac-12 awards with honorable mention selections to the all-conference and all-defense teams last season. The swingman was the team's leading scorer at 12.0 points per game, while averaging 4.5 rebounds per night. He was one of six players league-wide last season to earn all-conference and all-defense honors. Establishing himself as one of the best 3-point shooters in program history, the sniper has 210 career threes, which ranks sixth all-time in program history. He is now eight triples away from matching Anthony Brown '15 for fifth place and 12 away from fourth, currently held by Casey Jacobsen '02. Jones is averaging 12.3 points, 4.2 rebounds, and 1.3 blocks per game through 13 appearances, the last of which ranks eighth in the Pac-12 and first among perimeter players.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATION

Stanford was picked fifth in the Pac-12's preseason poll, earning one first place vote while slotting in behind UCLA, Arizona, Oregon and USC. Spencer Jones and Harrison Ingram were each on the Pac-12 preseason first team, with Stanford joining only UCLA and USC with multiple players on the first team. Ingram also earned a selection to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year watch list for the second consecutive season, as well as nods to the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award watch lists.

IN THE PROS

Stanford boasts five NBA alumni entering the 2022-23 season: Ziaire Williams (Memphis Grizzlies), Brook Lopez (Milwaukee Bucks), Robin Lopez (Cleveland Cavaliers), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks) and KZ Okpala (Sacramento Kings), while a plethora of alumni are plying their trade in leagues around the world. Additionally, Chasson Randle spent the preseason with the Denver Nuggets and Landry Fields was promoted to general manager of the Atlanta Hawks in the offseason.

Brook Lopez is an early candidate for NBA Defensive Player of the Year honors as the league leader in blocks with 2.6 per game, to go along with 14.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, through games on Jan. 2, while shooting a slash line of 50/38/80. Dwight Powell is coming off a season-high 19 points on Dec. 29 against Houston, going 8-for-8 from the field. Powell is shooting 72.3% from the field this season.

RANKINGS REPORT

Stanford is 0-3 this season against ranked foes, falling to then-No. 17 San Diego State, -No. 21 UCLA and -No. 7 Texas. The Cardinal boasts six wins over ranked opponents since the calendar turned to 2020, and two last season, including the program's first over a top-five opponent since 2007 (UCLA) and its first over a top-25 team on the road since 2014 (Texas). Both wins came in Stanford's season sweep of USC.

FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR RETURNS TO STANFORD

One of the most dynamic and versatile players in the country, Harrison Ingram was Stanford's first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year since 2000, and also garnered All-Pac-12 honorable mention status a year ago. He was Stanford's first Freshman of the Year since Casey Jacobsen, and just the fifth all-time, joining Brevin Knight (1994), Johnny Rogers (1982) and John Revelli (1981). He joins only Jacobsen in program history with all-conference and all-freshman recognition in the same year. Ingram is the only rising sophomore in the country to have averaged 10 points, six rebounds and three assists per game last season, as he was joined by only Paolo Banchero, the top pick in the 2022 NBA Draft, in meeting those benchmarks as true freshmen. The only first-year player in the league last year to average double-figure scoring, he won six Pac-12 Freshman of the Week awards, which is the second-most in conference history, behind only USC's Evan Mobley (2020-21), who won the honor seven times.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season (4.6 per game). Stanford's individual totals (135 combined, 9.6 per game) are as follows:






