Stanford Postgame Notes Saturday, September 13, 2008 at TCU

- Sophomore **Doug Baldwin** scored his first career touchdown on a 38-yard reverse in the second quarter. The score came on just his sixth career rushing attempt.
- Stanford recorded its first blocked kick for a touchdown since Jon Alston did so on Oct. 1, 2005 vs. Oregon. Mark Mueller collected his first career block today by knocking down a second-quarter punt from TCU's Anson Kelton, while Richard Sherman picked up the loose ball and returned it 21 yards for a game-tying touchdown.
- Stanford now has two blocked kicks this season (both punts), after recording three blocks in 2007.
- In his first game of the 2008 season, junior linebacker **Nick Macaluso** started at middle linebacker and set his career highs for both tackles (nine, including six solo stops) and tackles-for-loss (2.0).
- Sophomore safety **Sean Wiser** made his impact felt during his collegiate debut, matching linebacker **Pat Maynor** for team-high honors with 11 tackles (seven solo efforts).
- Junior running back **Toby Gerhart** set his career standard with 42 receiving yards, compiled on a season-best three catches.
- Senior **Tom McAndrew** logged the first return yards of his career, taking a short TCU kickoff in the third quarter and rumbling 26 yards to the Horned Frogs' 44-yard line. McAndrew also added four solo tackles.
- Sophomore punter **David Green** twice pinned TCU within its own 10-yard line in the third quarter, and now has four punts inside the opponent's 20 this season. Stanford has a net punt average of 37.8 through three games.
