DEMARINI INVITATIONAL SET FOR THIS WEEKEND

Stanford will host the DeMarini Invitational this weekend

QUICK HITS

» **STANFORD** had an eight-game win streak snapped on Sunday ... has won 10 of its last 12 ... entered the week receiving votes in the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball polls ... has won seven games in its final at bat, including five walk-off wins (three walk-off home runs) ... ranks first in the Pac-12 in stolen bases (38-for-39) and third in ERA (1.41) ... is 10th in the nation in ERA and owns six shutouts – fourth-most in the nation ... ranks tied for fourth in the nation in steals, led by Taylor Gindlesperger with 11 ... opened the year with 32 consecutive successful stolen base attempts ... has drawn 51 walks to rank fourth in the Pac-12 ... has collected 26 two-out RBIs while limiting opponents to 13 ... made its first NCAA regional appearance since 2013 (17th overall) last season ... recorded two wins over a top-seven opponent last year, defeating then-No. 7 LSU on the road on February 21 and knocking off No. 2 UCLA at home on May 3 ... 33 wins last year were the most in a season since 2013 (39-21) ... eight Pac-12 wins were more than the previous four years combined (7).

» **JESSICA ALLISTER** is in her third season at her alma mater ... was 2019 Pac-12 Coach of the Year.

» **TATUM BOYD** contributed a walk-off, two-RBI single vs. UNM on Feb. 7 ... went 2-0 and did not allow a run over 13.2 IP at the GCU Kickoff Tournament ... owns the second-best ERA in the Pac-12 (0.69).

» **TEAGHAN COWLES** has reached safely in 12 straight games ... has amassed seven multi-hit games ... hit a walk-off, two-run home run vs. Drake on February 16, handing Stanford a 9-0 run-rule victory in the sixth inning ... led the team and was 12th in the Pac-12 in average (.374) last season ... collected a team-best 20 multi-hit games ... hit safely in 40 of 53 games a year ago, including 34 of the last 43 overall ... finished second in the Pac-12 in triples (5) last year ... hit .343 in Pac-12 play.

» **MONTANA DIXON** reached in 46 of 53 games last year, including 41 of the last 44 overall, and 17 straight from March 9 - April 14 ... hit by 11 pitches last year to rank second in the Pac-12.

» **TAYLOR GINDLESPERGER** has already surpassed her hits (13), runs scored (13) and RBIs (10) totals from last year ... connected for a walk-off, two-run home run in the bottom of the 10th to seal a 3-1 victory and a split of two games with Seattle U on February 13 ... two career home runs are a grand slam at Santa Clara on April 9, 2019 and the walk-off home run ... enters the weekend hitting .377 with 20 hits – fifth in the conference ... leads the team with 11 stolen bases and four multi-RBI contests ... has collected six multi-hit games.

» **HANNAH HOWELL** leads the team in batting average at .419 ... has reached safely in eight straight games ... reached safely in 33 of her 45 games played a year ago ... collected 10 multi-hit games ... hit a team-best .344 in Pac-12 play.

» **KRISTINA INOUE** has amassed six multi-hit games ... was team leader in RBI (31) and amassed eight multi-RBI games last year ... finished second on team with 13 multi-hit games.

» **KAITLYN LIM** had a six-game hit streak snapped in the opener vs. Nevada, but has reached in all but one game this year ... has a hit in all but two games played with an at bat ... hit her first career home run vs. Hofstra on February 15 to guide the Cardinal to a 1-0 victory ... drove in four runs, including a three-run triple, vs. Drake on February 16.

» **KIANA PANCINO** was 7-0 with eight saves and a 2.49 ERA over 29 appearances (one start) last year ... led the Pac-12 and was fourth in the nation in saves (8).

» **EMILY SCHULTZ** hit safely in 10 straight games from February 8-22 after going hitless in her first four contests ... has hit safely in 11 of her last 12 overall ... ranked third on the team in average (.304) and was second in SLG (.569) and OB% (.419) a year ago ... launched a two-run homer to provide all the run support Stanford would need in a 2-1 win over #2 UCLA on May 3 ... saw 17 of her 31 hits go for extra bases (10 2B, four 3B, three HR) last year ... amassed nine multi-hit games and six multi-RBI games a year ago.

» **SYDNEY STEELE** hit a walk-off grand slam in the bottom of the ninth inning to hand Stanford a 7-3 victory over Fresno State on February 18 ... contributed a second walk-off hit on February 22 vs. Nevada - shooting a single into left field to hand Stanford a 2-1 victory in the bottom of the seventh.

» **ALANA VAWTER** tossed a one-hit, complete-game shutout vs. Drake on February 16 ... faced one over the minimum in that game vs. the Bulldogs ... shutout was her second of the week as she struck out a career-best eight in a 3-0 win over Hofstra on February 14.

» **EMILY YOUNG** reached in 11 straight games from March 27 - April 14 last season ... connected for a two-out inside-the-park grand slam in the bottom of the third against Seattle University on February 9 ... ranked second in the Pac-12 in triples (5) ... was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Week on March 5.

THIS WEEKEND

Stanford will conclude a 15-game homestand this weekend when it hosts the DeMarini Invitational. The Cardinal will welcome Pacific, Rhode Island and Saint Francis to The Farm for a total of 10 games. Stanford will play its first game of the tournament on Friday vs. Pacific at 4 p.m. Live stats and a live stream will be available all weekend at GoStanford.com.

A LOOK BACK

Stanford won a three-game series against Nevada last weekend, earning a sweep of a Saturday doubleheader before dropping the finale to the Wolf Pack. The Cardinal blanked Nevada, 7-0, in game one on Saturday before Sydney Steele contributed her second walk-off hit of the season to hand Stanford a 2-1 victory in game two. Stanford held a 3-1 lead headed into the fifth inning on Sunday, but the Wolf Pack scored four in the fifth and three more in the seventh to eventually claim an 8-3 victory.

CARDINAL VS. THE OPPOSITION

The Cardinal is 31-12 against Pacific, including a 6-1 victory in the most recent meeting on February 14, 2019. Stanford has never faced Rhode Island or Saint Francis.

READY TO RUN

Stanford is 38-for-39 in stolen base attempts this year, led by 11 from sophomore Taylor Gindlesperger ... the Cardinal, which opened the season with 32 consecutive successful steals, ranks tied for fourth nationally in the category and leads the Pac-12 ... nine different players have swiped at least one bag this year, including five with three or more stolen bases ... senior Teaghan Cowles has swiped eight, while senior Hannah Howell owns five. Sophomore Emily Young and freshman Kaitlyn Lim each have four steals ... the Cardinal stole seven bags vs. Hofstra on February 14 - the most since swiping seven vs. Oregon State on April 16, 2011 ... Stanford has been held without a steal just three times this year, and has swiped at least two in all but four games this season.

TOSSING ZEROS

The Cardinal has amassed six shutouts over the first 16 games played this year - fourth-most in the nation ... Stanford won the season opener over Grand Canyon, 3-0, in eight innings before blanking the Lopes once more on February 7 ... a pair of shutouts over Hofstra got the Card started at the Stanford Invitational before a 9-0 victory over Drake capped play at the same tournament ... Stanford most recently blanked Nevada, 7-0, on February 22 to open a three-game series with the Wolf Pack ... thanks to the scoreless innings of work, Stanford enters the week ranked third in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in ERA (1.41).

LOADED FOR US? GREAT. LOADED FOR THEM? NO PROBLEM.

Stanford is hitting .625 (10-for-16) and has drawn four walks with the bases loaded this year - compiling 23 RBIs along the way. On the other side, opponents are just 2-for-14 (.143) with one walk while hitting with the bags loaded. Stanford has also compiled three extra-base hits in the situation (one double, one triple, one grand slam).

CARD PICKED SIXTH IN PRESEASON POLL

Stanford was chosen by the conference coaches to finish sixth in the stacked Pac-12 Conference this season. Washington, one of three league teams in the 2019 Women's College World Series, garnered 69 points and six first-place votes to sit atop the poll. UCLA, the reigning NCAA National Champion, was selected to finish a close second with 65 points and two first-place votes. Arizona received the last remaining first place vote and was picked to finish third with 61 points. Arizona State was selected fourth with 49 points, followed by fifth place Oregon with 40 points. The Cardinal tallied 38 points to rank sixth, Oregon State placed seventh with 34 points and California and Utah rounded out the poll, tying for eighth place, with 20 points each.

A STACKED PAC

Pac-12 teams occupied three of the top five spots in the USA Today/NFCA Preseason Coaches Poll with No. 1 Washington, No. 4 UCLA and No. 5 Arizona. Arizona State made the top-25 at No. 22 with Oregon and Stanford receiving votes. All three Pac-12 Women's College World Series participants from 2019 were ranked in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Preseason Poll with No. 2 Washington, No. 4 UCLA and No. 5 Arizona, while Arizona State checked in at No. 22 and Oregon at No. 24 to give the Pac-12 five teams in the top-25. The Cardinal also received votes in the poll to open the season. The Pac-12 has dominated collegiate softball as 24 of a possible 38 national titles have been claimed by Conference programs.

ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS

In addition to Jessica Allister's Coach of the Year selection, Stanford placed four players on the All-Conference teams, and two on the All-Freshman squad, last season. Teaghan Cowles and Kristina Inouye highlighted the list of All-Conference selections for Stanford, with each earning a spot on the second team. The two second-team selections were the most for the Card since Kylie Sorenson and Leah White earned second-team honors in 2014. Stanford placed two more players on the third team, as then-senior Carolyn Lee and Emily Young were lauded. Young also earned a spot on the All-Freshman team, joined by Emily Schultz. Those selections marked the first All-Freshman team picks since Lee earned a spot in 2016. The last time Stanford had at least two All-Freshman honorees was 2014, as Sorenson, Madi Schreyer and Bessie Noll were each selected.

WINS FOR THE AGES

Stanford picked up a few historic wins in 2019, collecting its first win over Cal on March 23 since earning a 14-13 win on March 14, 2014. The comeback victory on March 24 also secured the Card's first Pac-12 series win since sweeping the Bears from May 3-5, 2013. Stanford's 8-6 victory over Oregon on March 29 pushed the Card to its first 3-0 start to Pac-12 play in program history. That win was also the first for the Cardinal over Oregon since April 6, 2012 - snapping a string of 19 consecutive losses to the Ducks. Stanford finished the series with a 7-6 win over the Ducks to secure its first series win over Oregon since sweeping the Ducks from May 13-15, 2010. Stanford then posted a win over No. 2 UCLA on May 3 - the first victory over a top-two opponent since beating No. 2 UCLA, 12-9, on May 2, 2014. Finally, after reaching its first NCAA Tournament since 2013, the Cardinal collected its first postseason win since May 18, 2013 on May 18 of last season - defeating Boston University 13-2.

QUITE THE LEADER

Teaghan Cowles, a two-time National Fastpitch Coaches Association Division I All-Region selection, emerged as one of the top leadoff options in the nation, hitting first in each of the 53 games last year. Cowles hit a team-best .374 overall, including .372 (42x113) with the bases empty. Furthermore, she reached at a .481 clip (39x81) and hit .356 (26x73) when leading off an inning. In true leadoff at bats to start a game, Cowles hit .333 (16x48) with two home runs and a triple.

CARDINAL HONORS

MAKE IT A TRIPLE

Teaghan Cowles had six triples in 2018, tying for second all-time for a single season in Stanford program history. It was the most in a year since Cassandra Roulund also had six in 2013. Cowles did not triple over the first three weekends of last season, but recorded a pair in five games played at the Stanford Invitational to eventually finish with five for a share of the team lead in 2019 with Emily Young. Already with three this season, Cowles has racked up 18 triples in her career on The Farm - tied for the program record with Ashley Hansen (2009-2012). It seems the triple was contagious in 2019, as Stanford managed a program-record 25 to lead the Pac-12 and place second in the NCAA in triples per game.

THE 2019 SEASON

Stanford went 33-20 overall in 2019, including an 8-13 mark in the Pac-12 Conference, to reach its first NCAA Tournament since 2013. The Cardinal's 33 wins, two of which came over top-10 opponents, were the most in a season since 2013, and the winning record was the first for the Card since 2014. In addition, Stanford's eight Pac-12 wins were more than the previous four years combined (7), and the Cardinal registered a national ranking (#22 according to Softball America) on March 5 for the first time since April 1, 2014. A 12-game win streak, starting with a victory over No. 7 LSU on February 21, provided another highlight for the year, and marked the longest such streak since the 2014 squad began the season 13-0. Statistically speaking, 2019 saw the Cardinal register the most triples in program history, as Stanford managed 25 to lead the Conference and rank second in the nation.

THREE SELECTED FOR ACE PROGRAM

Emily Klingaman and Emily Schultz joined Hannah Howell as three of 20 Stanford student-athletes selected to participate in the Rubenstein-Bing Student-Athlete Civic Engagement (ACE) Program last summer. Klingaman and Schultz traveled to Peru from July 20 - August 10, while Howell kicked-off the program from June 15 - July 6 in South Africa. The program provides one-time funding for accepted Stanford and Duke student-athletes to participate in three-week, immersive summer service experiences with international community partners. ACE is a joint collaboration between the Stanford and Duke athletic departments, as well as Haas Center for Public Service at Stanford and DukeEngage at Duke. The program is made possible by the generous supports of David Rubenstein and Peter and Helen Bing. Student-athletes from both institutions will have the chance to volunteer together in one of four international group programs (South Africa, Vietnam, China and Peru) with diverse service themes including coaching, education, environmental sustainability and conservation, and more. Teaghan Cowles (South Africa, 2017) and Kristina Inouye (India, 2017) are also past participants of the program.

ALLISTER RETURNS TO THE FARM

Jessica Allister became the Cardinal's fourth head coach in program history on July 18, 2017. Allister arrived on The Farm after serving as the head coach at Minnesota for seven seasons, compiling a 290-107 (.730) overall record. Allister led the Gophers to unprecedented heights in 2017, registering a program-best 56-5 record and earning the first No. 1 national ranking in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches poll in program history. Allister registered her 300th career win against Santa Clara on Feb. 25, 2018. Currently in her 10th season as a head coach (seven at Minnesota), Allister has amassed a 360-161 (.691) overall record, including going 70-54 at the helm of Stanford's program. A second-team All-American in 2004 and three-time all-conference selection, Allister helped guide the Cardinal to four NCAA Women's College World Series appearances in 2001 and 2004. A four-year starting catcher, Allister holds the school record for most games played (266) and graduated among the top-10 in numerous career categories.
