## **CARDINAL HEADS TO THE BEACH**

Stanford plays its only nonconference true road game of the season Sunday, as the Cardinal travels to Long Beach, California, to face Long Beach State at the Walter Pyramid at 2 p.m. PT. Sunday marks Stanford's first visit to the 49ers' campus since Dec. 2, 2000.

## HOW TO FOLLOW

Sunday's game will not be televised. It is the Cardinal's first non-televised game since Feb. 16, 2012. The Stanford Cardinal Sports Network will have live audio coverage of the game as former Stanford men's basketball guard John Platz has the call courtside in Walter Pyramid. Fans can access the broadcast on GoStanford.com or on a mobile device via the TuneIn app.

## AGAINST LONG BEACH STATE

Stanford and Long Beach State have squared off three times previously, with the Cardinal winning all three matchups. In the lone previous meeting at the Walter Pyramid, No. 4 Stanford earned an 86-63 victory over LBSU on Dec. 2, 2000. The Cardinal owns home wins against the 49ers on Dec. 15, 2001 (94-77) and March 17, 1988 (80-77) in the postseason NIT.

## AGAINST THE BIG WEST CONFERENCE

Stanford is 57-9 all-time against teams currently in the Big West Conference. Sunday marks Stanford's first road game against a Big West Conference opponent since playing at UC Davis on Nov. 18, 2011. The Cardinal defeated the Aggies, 70-49, in that contest. Stanford is 10-6 all-time in true road games against current Big West Conference schools.

## **POST PRESENCE**

Stanford's starting post players, Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey, have combined to average 32.1 points and 16.3 rebounds per game. Travis is fourth in the Pac-12 in scoring at 21.2 ppg and 12th in rebounding at 7.4 rpg entering Friday's games. The junior has posted seven 20-point games in nine contests this season. Humphrey is nearly averaging a double-double with 10.9 ppg and 8.9 rpg. His rebounding average is third-best in the Pac-12 entering Friday's action.

## YOUTH MOVEMENT

Stanford's roster has played 577 combined games. The Cardinal entered the season with the fifth-most veteran roster (games played) in the nation. While fourth-year players Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey anchor the post, injuries have limited several veteran perimeter players. This has given one of the nation's top recruiting classes a chance to play important minutes as freshmen this season. Stanford has started three freshmen - Daejon Davis, Oscar da Silva and Isaac White - together in six games this season. All three average more than 27 minutes per game. Davis leads the Cardinal in assists (4.5 apg), White ranks fourth on the team in scoring (10.3 ppg) and da Silva ranks third on the roster in rebounding (5.7 rpg).

Prior to this season, Stanford last started three freshmen on January 27, 1983 (at Washington) with Keith Ramee, Andy Fischer and Earl Koberlein earned the starting nod in that contest.

Junior preseason All-American Reid Travis is living up to his preseason accolades. The forward, who entered the year as the Pac-12's leading returning scorer and rebounder, ranks fifth nationally in total points with 191, 14 points behind NCAA leader Matt Scott of Niagara and 10 points back of Duke's Marvin Bagley III as of Friday. He leads the Pac-12 and ranks in the top six nationally in total points, total field goals, free throws made and free throws attempted as of Friday.

#### LAST TIME OUT

Freshman Daejon Davis scored 17 points to help spark Stanford to a 70-54 win over Montana Wednesday night at Maples Pavilion. Reid Travis scored 20 points and Michael Humphrey added 12 points and 12 rebounds for the Cardinal. Montana led 50-44 with just under 10 minutes left, but was outscored 26-4 the rest of the way, including 14-0 to finish the game. They missed their final nine shots and were 17 of their last 19.

#### DAVIS TAKING CONTROL OF THE POINT

Freshman Daejon Davis has started all eight career games he has played in. After averaging 3.0 ppg in his first two career games, he is averaging 11.5 points in his last six contests. The freshman posted a career-best 17-point performance last time out against Montana on Wednesday.

#### **CARDINAL OFFENSE IMPROVED FROM LAST SEASON**

Stanford, which returned 78.4 percent of its scoring from last season, is averaging 75.4 points per game this season. The average is up nearly 7.0 ppg from its 69.1 scoring average last season. The Cardinal has topped the 70-point mark in a game eight times in nine games. Last season, it had only reached the 70-point mark three times in its first nine games.

#### PAGON EARNING IMPORTANT MINUTES

Sophomore guard Blake Pagon, a walk-on, has earned valuable minutes for the Cardinal recently. After playing 10 minutes over five games last season, Pagon has totaled 58 minutes playing in seven of the first nine games this year. He is coming off a career-long 19-minute game vs. Montana Wednesday. He had a career-best four rebounds and two assists vs. the Grizzlies. Pagon, who has two career points on a pair of free throws last season, is in search of his first career field goal. He has one field goal attempt this season.

Pagon, one of five sons for parents Garrett and Amanda, is following in his parents' footsteps. Both also studied at Stanford. His mother, Amanda, was a standout runner and swimmer at Stanford. She was a member of three Pac-10 cross country championship teams in 1993, 1994 and 1996. She was a member of Stanford's first NCAA champion women's cross country team in 1996.

## **HUMPHREY CONTROLLING THE GLASS**

Michael Humphrey, who was among the Pac-12 leaders in rebounding last season, ranks third in the Pac-12 in rebounding this season with an average of 8.9 rpg. He posted a career-high 18 rebounds against Pacific on Nov. 12. The senior, who is averaging 10.9 ppg, has three double-doubles this year.

## **CARTWRIGHT WITH CAREER-BEST NUMBERS**

After averaging 4.1 ppg over the first two seasons (67 games) of his career, junior Robert Cartwright is averaging 10.2 ppg in nine games this season. He had a season-high 19 points against Portland State two games ago. He ranks eighth in the Pac-12 in assist/turnover ratio (2.5). Cartwright earned his first start of the season last time out against Montana, finishing with 11 points and five assists.

## THE FOURTH-YEAR CLASS

The four members of Stanford's fourth-year class - Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens Michael Humphrey and Robert Cartwright - accounted for 62.6 percent of the team's scoring and 55.4 percent of the team's rebounding last season. Pickens and Humphrey are true seniors, while Travis and Cartwright have each had their medical hardship waivers granted and are redshirt juniors with another year of eligibility remaining after this season. Cartwright missed the entire 2015-16 season with a compound fracture of his right forearm sustained in preseason practice on Nov. 2, 2015. Travis was forced to miss the final 22 games of the 2015-16 season with a right leg injury. Pickens has missed the last seven games with a left foot injury.

## PETER SAUER CAPTAINSHIP

Head coach Jerod Haase announced the establishment of the Peter Sauer Captainship in September, naming Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens and Michael Humphrey captains. The three will wear patches on their uniforms honoring the legacy of the late Peter Sauer, a team captain and leader of Stanford's 1998 Final Four team. Stanford will celebrate the 20-year anniversary of the 1998 Final Four team during the regular-season home finale against Washington State on Feb. 24, 2018.

## **TOP-TIER RECRUITING CLASS**

After signing a consensus top-25 national recruiting class last season, the Cardinal once again inked one of the nation's top classes for 2018. On Nov. 8, Stanford announced the signing of 6-5 guard Cormac Ryan from New York, New York, and 7-0 forward Keenan Fitzmorris of Overland Park, Kansas, Fitzmorris is the younger brother of Stanford women's volleyball All-American Audriana Fitzmorris.

## **FIFTH IN PAC-12 PRESEASON POLL**

Stanford was selected fifth in the Pac-12 Conference media preseason poll. The Cardinal totaled 182 points to place fifth in a vote of the media members that regularly cover the conference.

## FACING THE NATION'S BEST

Stanford recently completed a stretch of eight games in 17 days. The stretch included games against No. 7 Florida, No. 9 North Carolina and Ohio State in a seven-day span. The games against the Tar Heels and Gators marked the first time in nearly 19 years Stanford faced back-to-back top-10 opponents in the Associated Press poll. On Nov. 27, 1998, Stanford played No. 9 North Carolina in the preseason NIT in Madison Square Garden. The Cardinal's next game was against No. 2 Maryland on Dec. 6, 1998 in the BB&T Classic in Washington, D.C. Stanford, ranked fifth in the Associated Press poll themselves, dropped a 57-49 decision to the Tar Heels and a 62-60 decision to the Terrapins.

## FLOOR BURNS STAT COMES TO THE FARM

During his standout collegiate career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court, diving for loose balls and taking charges, whatever he could do to help his team win. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" stat was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 in the 1996-97 season. For the second season, Stanford is tracking floor burns as an official stat throughout the year.

#### The Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball Jerod Haase

Overall: 98-75 (Sixth Season) Stanford: 18-22 (Second Season)

After being introduced as the Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball by Jaquish & Kenninger Director of Athletics Bernard Muir on March 25, 2016, Jerod Haase developed a strong relationship with his program and instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude among his student-athletes.

In his first year at the helm of the Cardinal program, Stanford posted 14 wins against one of the toughest schedules in the nation. Redshirt sophomore Reid Travis earned First Team All-Pac-12 and NABC All-District honors, developing into one of the top players in the conference on both ends of the court. His program finished in the top-10 percent among men's basketball programs nationally in the classroom as well.

Haase and his staff signed a top-tier recruiting class that is rated as high as No. 10 nationally in the 2017 rankings, welcoming the four-member class to The Farm for the 2017-18 season.

Haase arrived on The Farm prior to the 2016-17 season after completing his fourth season as the head coach at UAB, where he led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament appearance in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Tabbed the 2016 Gene Bartow Conference USA Coach of the Year, Haase led the Blazers to a 26-5 overall record and a 16-2 conference mark while capturing their first regular-season title since 2011. Along the way, UAB established school records for overall victories (26), conference wins (16), road wins (10) and consecutive victories (14). Also named the 2016 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Coach, Haase directed the Blazers to an NIT berth for the 12th time in school history. UAB also finished 16-0 at home in his final season at the helf of the Blazers, extending the nation's fifth-longest home winning streak to 25, while ranking among the nation's best in field goal percentage (.478 – 24th), assists per game (18.4 – 4th) and blocks per game (4th – 6.1).

Under Haase's guidance, UAB returned to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, shocking No. 3 seed Iowa State, 60-59, in the second round for the Blazers' first NCAA victory since 2005. UAB reached the Big Dance after claiming the program's first Conference USA Tournament title despite being seeded No. 4. The triumph marked UAB's first league tournament title since 1987, when the

Blazers won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. More impressively, Haase successfully developed a roster comprised of 10 underclassmen – all players recruited by Haase and his staff – and finished 20-16 overall while guiding the third-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

The Blazers made impressive strides under Haase's leadership during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing 18-13 overall while notching three victories against teams that qualified for the NCAA Tournament. Of UAB's 18 victories, perhaps none were more impressive than the Blazers' 63-59 home win against No. 16 North Carolina. UAB was ranked in the top five nationally in rebounding throughout the season and finished the year ranked second in the country at 44.5 boards per game.

During Haase's first year with the Blazers in 2012-13, UAB won six of its final nine regular-season Conference USA games and collected a victory in the conference tournament.

Prior to arriving at UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. A 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration, Haase got his start as Kansas' Director of Operations from 1999-2003. During that time, the Jayhawks reached the 2002 Final Four and the national championship game in 2003.

When Williams was named head coach at North Carolina prior to the 2003-04 season, he brought Haase with him as an assistant coach and director of operations, a title Haase held from 2003-09. Haase then served exclusively as an assistant coach during his final three seasons with the Tar Heels.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, Haase attended California in 1992-93 before transferring to Kansas. He helped lead the Jayhawks to three consecutive conference titles and finished his career ranked in the school's top 10 in assists, three-point field goals and steals. Haase started 99 of 101 games at Kansas and scored 1,264 points, averaging 12.5 per game and reaching double figures 74 times. While at Kansas, Haase was a candidate for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.

As a senior in 1996-97, Haase started alongside Jacque Vaughn, Scot Pollard, Paul Pierce and Raef LaFrentz as Kansas finished with a 34-2 record while averaging 12.0 points per game despite playing with a broken wrist. As a sophomore in 1994-95, Haase averaged 15.0 points and was named the Big Eight Conference Newcomer of the Year and also tabbed a second-team all-conference selection.

Haase was a first-team GTE Academic All-American as a senior, a second-team Academic All-American as a junior and a three-time academic all-conference pick. The Jayhawks' Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 1997, Haase later earned a master's degree in business at Kansas in 2000.

Haase started 23 games in 1992-93 as a freshman at California, teaming with Jason Kidd in the backcourt.

In 2017, Haase joined the National Advisory Board of the Positive Coaching Alliance, the organization that uses the power of positive reinforcement to pursue winning and the more important goal of teaching life lessons through sports.

Haase, 42, and his wife, the former Mindy Meidinger, have three children: Gavin (11), Garrett (7) and Gabrielle (4).
