### NEED TO KNOW

California men's basketball is set for a rare matchup with Bay Area rival Stanford at the Pac-12 Tournament when the No. 12 seed Golden Bears meet the No. 5 seed Cardinal in the first round Wednesday at 2:30 p.m. PT. All of this week's action takes place at T-Mobile Arena in Las Vegas, Nev., with Wednesday's game airing live on the Pac-12 Networks and KGO 810 AM.

The Bears and Cardinal have met just twice in the conference tournament, splitting those games 1-1. Cal is the series' most recent victor, taking a 77-70 win in 2012. Stanford won the inaugural meeting, 77-61, in 1990.

The Bay Area battle comes after a pair of exciting regular-season games between the two foes in which both games were decided by four points or fewer. Cal took the first victory of the season, 77-74, down at the Farm, but the Cardinal avoided a sweep with a 77-73 win in Berkeley.

Senior Marcus Lee led the Bears in the regular-season series with Stanford, averaging 17.0 points and 8.0 rebounds. Justice Sueing averaged 16.5 points and Don Coleman averaged 16.0. All three finished the regular season averaging double-figure scoring totals alongside Darius McNeill's 11.1 ppg.

### BY THE NUMBERS

**2012** Cal's last meeting with Stanford in the Pac-12 Tournament was a March 8, 2012 matchup. The No. 2-seed Bears defeated the No. 7-seed Cardinal 77-70.

**4** Both of Cal's meetings with Stanford in the regular season were decided by four points or fewer. The teams split the series, with the Bears taking a 77-74 victory at Stanford and the Cardinal taking a 77-73 victory at Cal.

**1** Darius McNeill is one three-pointer away from setting a Cal freshman record for three-pointers made. With 62 this season, he is currently tied with Brooklyn Nets standout Allen Crabbe's 2011 freshman record.

**77** Feeling lucky? In Cal and Stanford's previous two meetings in the conference tournament, the winner scored 77 points. In both of Cal and Stanford's meetings in the 2018 regular season, the winner scored 77 points.

**3** Cal has won its opening game at the Pac-12 Tournament each of the past three seasons. The Bears started both the 2015 and 2017 Tournaments in the first round, and earned a bye to open in the quarterfinals in 2016.

## BEAR NECESSITIES: CAL'S STORYLINES

## CAL IN THE PAC-12 TOURNAMENT

California owns a 16-20 all-time record in the Pac-12 Tournament, including two trips to the championship game in 2006 and 2010.

Cal won its opening-round games each of the last three seasons, defeating Washington State, 84-59, in 2015's first round and topping Oregon State, 76-68, in the quarterfinals in 2016. In 2017, Cal opened against Oregon State and pulled past the Beavers, 67-62. The Bears have never failed to reach the tournament quarterfinals, and own a 9-10 record in the Pac-12 Tournament quarterfinals.

## SCOUTING THE CARDINAL

## LAST TIME OUT

**California fought to the finish but fell to No. 19 Arizona, 66-54**

- Justice Sueing led the way for the Bears with 17 points, the lone Cal player in double figures.
- Darius McNeill hit two three-pointers to tie Allen

Crabbe with a Cal freshman record 62 three-pointers on the season.

- The Bears outshot Arizona 38.9 percent (21-54) to 38.8 percent (19-49). Cal's 19 field goals allowed to the Wildcats were the Bears' fewest allowed this season.
- Tied at 53-53 with 5:49 to play, Arizona used a 13-1 run in the last 5:38 to pull away from the Bears.
- Cal held Arizona's second-leading scorer, Allonzo Trier, to just 2 points. Entering the game, Trier was averaging 18.1 points in league action.

## KING OF THE BLOCK

With two blocks against Washington, Kingsley Okoroh reached a new career milestone, moving into the top 10 among the Pac-12's career leaders for blocked shots. Okoroh is in sole possession of 9th on the conference's all-time list with 196 career blocks. He also ranks 9th among the NCAA's active career leaders.

The 7-1 Okoroh has tied the Cal single-game record for blocked shots twice this season, recording 7 blocks against UC Riverside and against Portland State. He tied the number set by Michael Stewart (1994-97), which Stewart recorded thrice in his Golden Bear career. Okoroh is currently ranked third among Cal's career leaders. Stewart ranks second with 207 blocks, and David Kravish (2012-15) leads with 226 career blocked shots.

## STEAL CITY

With 214 steals this season, California will finish the year with its highest steal total in more than a decade. Cal is 87th in the country in steals per game (6.9) and 96th for total steals. The Bears have 200 takeaways for the first time since the 2002-03 season. Cal last finished a season averaging 6.0 or more steals per game in 2003-04 (6.2), capping off the year with 173 steals. Prior to the 15-season drought, which ended on March 1 when Cal logged nine steals against Arizona State to reach 208 total, the Bears had tallied 200 or more steals for 12 consecutive seasons, a span which included three head coaches – Lou Campanelli, Todd Bozeman and Ben Braun.

#### FEELS LIKE HOME

Adjusting to life in Berkeley has been a seamless adjustment for Anticevich because he views his new locale as similar to his hometown of Sydney, Australia.

He has attended numerous community service events in the Bay Area and in Lexington, including serving a pancake breakfast to seniors, spreading holiday cheer at the Children’s Hospital Oakland, organizing a blanket drive and visiting children affected by pediatric hospitalization.

#### OKOROH ON KAREEM ABDUL JABBAR AWARD WATCH LIST

Kingsley Okoroh is on the shortlist of the best collegiate centers in the nation. The Cal big man was named one of 20 players on the 2018 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award.

Okoroh enters his senior season following Pac-12 All-Defensive Honorable Mention laurels last year. He logged 74 blocks to become Cal’s single-season blocked shots leader. The Derby, England native started 24 contests in 2016-17 – appearing in all 34 games – en route to averaging a career-best in points (4.6) and rebounds (5.5). During his junior season, Okoroh also averaged 2.2 blocks per a game and recorded four or more blocks in six outings, while also setting single-game career-highs with five blocks against Wyoming and 13 rebounds against No. 4 UCLA.

The list will be narrowed down to 10 candidates by mid-February, with five finalists announced in March and the winner crowned in April.

#### BEARS SIGN TOP 25 CLASS

Head coach Wyking Jones first recruiting class is off to a strong start, signing a consensus Top 30 class, with three outlets listing Cal’s 2018 signees as a Top 25 group. Top 100 recruits Jacobi Gordon (Houston, Texas) and Matt Bradley (San Bernardino, Calif.) and three-star California standout Andre Kelly have signed with the program. 247Sports and Scout gave the Bears the 18th-best class in the country. ESPN ranks the class 22nd. More notes on the class:

- Matt Bradley – 97th in the ESPN 100, four-star shooting guard
- Jacobi Gordon – 89th in the ESPN 100, No. 22 small forward in the country
- Andre Kelly – Stockton Record’s reigning All-Area Player of the Year who averaged 24.1 points, 15.2 rpg, 2.7 assists and 1.9 blocks as a junior.

#### CAL TO OPEN NEXT SEASON IN CHINA

California men’s basketball will open the 2017-18 season against Yale in China in the fourth edition of the Pac-12 China Game presented by Alibaba Group. The flagship event of Pac-12 Global is designed to grow the global popularity of Pac-12 athletic programs and universities, fostering cultural exchange through sport, and creating unique educational experiences for Pac-12 student-athletes. In addition to the game, the trip will include educational and cultural experiences for student-athletes and university delegations. Specific date and location information will be announced at a later date.

#### HAMILTON NAMED TO NABC HONORS COURT

Senior guard Nick Hamilton was recognized for his exemplary work in the classroom this summer, earning NABC Honors Court laurels. The Honors Court recognizes student-athletes who excelled in academics during the 2016-17 season, carrying a 3.2 GPA or higher.

Hamilton boasts a 3.74 cumulative GPA as a double major in legal studies and media studies. The Inglewood, Calif. product saw action in 12 games during the Bears’ 2016-17 campaign after recovering from a knee injury during the 2015-16 season.

**NEW-LOOK BEARS**

California’s new look extends beyond the nine newcomers on the squad, as the Golden Bears launched a 10-year partnership with global footwear and apparel leader Under Armour on June 1, 2017. The launch included a rebranding of several key athletics marks. The Cal script logo – one of the most iconic and recognizable marks in collegiate athletics – remains a staple, while two classic California symbols in the walking Bear and the block C combine to replace the old growling Bear logo. The Bears will also benefit from exclusive use of the custom Sather Stripe design, which pays homage to campus designs, including the Campanile.

**NEWELLY-SURFACED**

As part of Cal’s transition to Under Armour, the Golden Bears received updated facilities paid for with a bonus from the apparel giant. Along with new signage and decor throughout Haas Pavilion, Pete Newell Court now displays the traditional Cal script logo at center court on the first-grade maple. The old maple wood surface was used for 17 seasons, reaching the end of its functional lifespan. The Sather Stripe makes an appearance on both baselines, as does the new font, again spelling out California and Golden Bears.

## HEAD COACH WYKING JONES

With more than 15 years of collegiate coaching experience, Wyking Jones was introduced as California's head coach on March 24, 2017.

Prior to his tenure as head coach, Jones served as an assistant coach at Cal for two seasons under Cuonzo Martin in 2015-16 and 2016-17.

Charged with coaching Cal's big men, Jones helped forward Ivan Rabb become a two-time All-Pac-12 performer and Jaylen Brown earn All-Pac-12 and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year honors in 2015-16. In addition, center Kingsley Okoroh set a school record with 74 blocks in 2016-17.

In his first season with the Golden Bears, Jones helped steer Cal to the program's first NCAA Tournament bid since 2013 and the program's highest tournament seeding, a No. 4 seed. Cal's defense earned top marks, leading the Pac-12 with just 67.3 points allowed per game and finishing in the top three for rebounding. The Bears went 23-11 and extended their home winning streak to 19 games, dating back to the 2014-2015 season.

The Bears continued their success in 2016-17 by pushing their home winning streak to a program-record 27 games and once again led the league in defense, limiting opponents to 63.4 ppg and 40.0 percent shooting. Cal finished the season with a 21-13 record and earned the top seed in the National Invitation Tournament.

Throughout his career, Jones has also been instrumental in the development of 11 current and former NBA players, including standout Golden Bear Jaylen Brown, plus Terry Rozier, Gorgui Dieng, Montrezl Harrell, Tony Snell, Russ Smith and Peyton Siva.

Jones, a native of Inglewood, Calif., returned to his home state with 12 years of experience as a coach at the collegiate level and was introduced as Martin's assistant on April 23, 2015. He joined the Golden Bears' staff after serving as an assistant coach at Louisville for four seasons. During his time on the Cardinals' coaching staff, UofL's combined record was 123-30. Louisville captured the 2013 NCAA Championship and reached two Final Fours over the past four seasons. The Cardinals completed the 2014-15 season with a 27-9 record, reaching the NCAA Tournament regional final.

Prior to Louisville, Jones served two seasons on the coaching staff at New Mexico where the Lobos won 52 games in two seasons, including a school-record 30-win campaign in 2010. New Mexico finished the 2010 season ranked eighth in the Associated Press national poll.

Jones served as an assistant coach for five seasons from 2002-06 at Pepperdine, where he was the Waves' recruiting coordinator. He got his start in coaching at his alma mater, Loyola Marymount, during the 1996-97 season.

As an assistant coach, Jones boasts one national championship, two Final Four runs, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, an Elite Eight and Sweet 16 run and 10 NBA Draft selections.

He was a standout at LMU from 1991-95 under head coach John Olive, where his 1,076 career points rank 24th all-time in the program's history. Jones also collected 493 career rebounds during his career with the Lions. He was a two-time All-West Coast Conference selection, highlighted by a 19.7 ppg average as a junior. He earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from Loyola Marymount in 1995.

Jones played professional basketball from 1995-2001 in Italy, France, Japan, Lebanon and South Korea. He also served on the staff at Nike Elite Youth Basketball for three years, where he was the Travel Team Manager for more than 45 programs.

Jones and his wife, Estrella, have a son, Jameel and a daughter, Zoe.
