SETTING THE SCENE

For the first time since the calendar turned to 2023, Stanford men's basketball returns to Maples Pavilion. The four-game homestand begins Jan. 19 against Oregon State at 8 p.m. on Pac-12 Network.

THE OPENING TIP

- The Cardinal is 5-2 (0-7 Pac-12) to open the campaign, including home wins over Pacific (88-78), Cal Poly (80-43) and Green Bay (85-40) and neutral site wins over Florida State (70-60) and Loyola Chicago (75-62).
- Through 17 games, Spencer Jones leads the team with 12.4 points per game, and joined Stanford's 1,000-point club on Dec. 29 with a 25-point outing against Colorado. Jones paces the program in Pac-12 play with 15.9 points per game, which ranks sixth in the league. He also ranks sixth in made triples and free throw percentage and fourth in offensive rebounds.
- Harrison Ingram, who was Stanford's first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year since Casey Jacobsen in 2000, withdrew his name from the 2022 NBA Draft to return to The Farm for his sophomore campaign. He is the first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year to return since Jahii Carson (Arizona State) in 2013-14.
- The Cardinal returns eight of its top nine rotation players from a year ago, ranking sixth nationally in minutes continuity, per KenPom, while also bringing in the program's first transfer in 12 years and the first graduate transfer in program history in Michael Jones (Davidson). Jones had a game to remember in the season opener, with his 31 points the most by a Stanford player in his team debut on record. The 31 points remain tied for the best single-game mark by a Pac-12 player this season.
- Stanford has won eight of the last 12 meetings with the Beavers, but have split the last six at Maples Pavilion. The teams only met once last season, an 11-point Stanford win in Corvallis.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES

Stanford is led in the scoring column by Spencer Jones and Michael Jones, with the former ranking sixth in Pac-12 play at 15.9 points per game. Michael Jones averages 8.4 points and 2.4 assists per game in conference action, and 9.6 points overall on the season. Spencer Jones paces the team in steals and blocks, both in conference play and overall, while both Jones contribute heavily to Stanford's 7.6 threes per game in Pac-12 play, which ranks second overall. The team is also third in offensive rebounds per game (12.3) and defensive rebound percentage (71.2) and fourth in steals (7.1) per night.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In his first six seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 98 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time since 2015. The 2020 team was set to be postseason bound before the cancellation of the NCAA Tournament.

Stanford won 16 games in 2021-22, including the program's first win over an AP top-five opponent since 2007 and its first over a top-25 team on the road since 2014. Harrison Ingram was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year – Stanford's first since 2000 – while Spencer Jones blossomed into an All-Pac-12 conference forward. Sam Beskind was named Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, becoming the program's third honoree in the last five seasons.

The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country as one of two players to average 18 points, six rebounds and two assists per game while shooting over 55 percent from the floor. He was also named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year.

The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (,469) since 2003-04. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign.

Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters the matchup with the Beavers at No. 150 in the NET Rankings (Jan. 17), with a NET SOS of 37 and an average opponent NET rank of 43. The matchup is currently a quadrant four contest, as Oregon State slots in at No. 229. 19 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are currently slated to be in quadrant one or two, and nine of the remaining 14. Stanford has six remaining Q1 opportunities.

BEAVER BATTLES

The Cardinal is 6-3 in head-to-head battles against Wayne Tinkle's Beavers, including a 2-1 mark since the start of last season. Stanford won at Oregon State last year in the only matchup between the two teams, led by 16 points and a career-best nine assists from Harrison Ingram, 15 points from Spencer Jones and 10 from Maxime Raynaud. The Cardinal has scored 75 or more points in each of its last five wins in the series and is 16-5 over the last 21 meetings at Maples.

A BALANCING ACT

Stanford has had balanced scoring through 17 games, as 11 different players have had at least one game in double-figure scoring, which ranks second among all power conference teams (Ole Miss, 12). Five players have had a 20-point game this season, a total which is matched in the Pac-12 only by Arizona.

50TH TO REACH 1,000

A high-scoring weekend against Colorado and Utah helped Spencer Jones cross the 1,000-point threshold. Jones scored a season-high 25 points against Colorado, his eighth-career 20-point outing, and added 16 against Utah. The senior became the program's 50th member of the 1,000-point club and has moved into 39th on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,067 points. He passed Josh Childress '04 and Daejon Davis '21 against Washington State, and is 14 away from Jarron Collins '01, currently 38th.

FIVE-STAR CLASS OF 2023

Adding a pair of highly-touted student-athletes to the program in the class of 2023, Stanford signed Kanaan Carlyle (Atlanta, Ga.) and Andrej Stojakovic (Carmichael, Calif.) to national letters of intent. Carlyle is rated a five-star prospect by Rivals and the 247 composite, ranking as high as the 19th-rated recruit in the country from Rivals. Stojakovic is also a five-star signee via the 247 composite rankings and is ranked No. 17 overall nationally by 247 Sports. Both prospects are rated in ESPN's top-30 overall, with Stanford one of just four schools nationally with multiple top-30 signees, joining Kentucky, Duke and Oregon. Stanford has multiple top-25 signees in the same class for the first time since 2006, when Brook and Robin Lopez committed to play on the Farm.

THREE BALL, AGARWAL

Ryan Agarwal has had a great start to his career from beyond the arc, ranking second in the Pac-12 in 3-point percentage at 47.1% and seventh in Pac-12 games at 45.5%. Agarwal has connected on multiple treys against three Pac-12 opponents, UCLA, Colorado and Washington, and two non-league foes, Cal Poly and Green Bay. Agarwal is on pace for a top-three single-season mark by a freshman in 3-point percentage in program history (min. 25 FGA).

Agarwal ranks fifth nationally among true freshmen in 3-point percentage (min. 1 3PM per game), and second among all power conference freshmen, trailing only Kansas' Gradey Dick (48.0%).

IN THE PROS

Stanford boasts five NBA alumni entering the 2022-23 season: Ziaire Williams (Memphis Grizzlies), Brook Lopez (Milwaukee Bucks), Robin Lopez (Cleveland Cavaliers), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks) and KZ Okpala (Sacramento Kings), while a plethora of alumni are plying their trade in leagues around the world. Additionally, Chasson Randle spent the preseason with the Denver Nuggets and Landry Fields was promoted to general manager of the Atlanta Hawks in the offseason. The Cardinal has had an NBA Draft selection in three of the past four seasons, one of 17 teams nationally to have done so.

Brook Lopez is an early candidate for NBA Defensive Player of the Year honors as the league leader in blocks with 106, and second at 2.5 per game, to go along with 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game, through games on Jan. 16, while shooting a slash line of 50/40/78. Dwight Powell is coming off a seasonhigh 19 points on Dec. 29 against Houston, going 8-for-8 from the field. Powell is shooting 73.2% from the field this season. Williams has started to emerge over his last six games, averaging 10.2 points per game.

FORCING TURNOVERS

The Cardinal defense has escalated its pressure over the past 12 games, forcing at least 15 turnovers six times and a season-best 27 against Green Bay, which were the most for Stanford under head coach Jerod Haase, and the most for the Cardinal since causing 27 against UC Davis on Nov. 28, 2006. The Cardinal is averaging 7.1 steals per game in Pac-12 play, which ranks third in the league, led by at least one per game from three players: Spencer Jones, Michael O'Connell and Brandon Angel. The Cardinal has forced four Pac-12 opponents into at least 16 turnovers, with the opponents averaging 13.2 per game in conference play, and boasts the league's third-best turnover margin.

SANTA CRUZ SUCCESS

The Cardinal continued its run of success at Kaiser Permanente Arena, beating Loyola Chicago in Santa Cruz on Dec. 22 by 13 points. Stanford went 5-0 in the arena during the COVID-affected 2020-21 slate, including wins over Arizona, UCLA, Washington, Washington State and Cal State Bakersfield. Harrison Ingram scored 15 points to lead the win over the Ramblers, while James Keefe added 14 points, eight rebounds and three steals. Michael Jones had 12 points and Michael O'Connell had a season-high 10 in the win, as the team shot 50 percent from the field with 11 different players on the scoresheet.

JONESING FOR JONES

Spencer Jones garnered his first All-Pac-12 awards with honorable mention selections to the all-conference and all-defense teams last season. The swingman was the team's leading scorer at 12.0 points per game, while averaging 4.5 rebounds per night. He was one of six players league-wide last season to earn all-conference and all-defense honors. Establishing himself as one of the best 3-point shooters in program history, the sniper has 216 career threes, which ranks sixth all-time in program history. He is now two triples away from matching Anthony Brown '15 for fifth place and six away from fourth, currently held by Casey Jacobsen '02.

Jones is averaging 12.4 points, 4.6 rebounds and 1.3 blocks per game through 16 appearances, the last of which ranks ninth in the Pac-12 and second among perimeter players (Keion Brooks, UW). Jones is tied with Lawrence Hill '09 for 15th on the program's all-time blocks list with 83.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATION

Stanford was picked fifth in the Pac-12's preseason poll, earning one first place vote while slotting in behind UCLA, Arizona, Oregon and USC. Spencer Jones and Harrison Ingram were each on the Pac-12 preseason first team, with Stanford joining only UCLA and USC with multiple players on the first team. Ingram also earned a selection to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year watch list for the second consecutive season, as well as nods to the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award watch lists.

FROM THE BACKCOURT TO HEAD COACH

Head coach Jerod Haase played with a pair of star guards in his collegiate career at California and Kansas, occupying a starting spot in the backcourt alongside Dallas Mavericks head coach Jason Kidd at Cal and Brooklyn Nets head coach Jacque Vaughn at Kansas.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season (4.6 per game). Stanford's individual totals (163 combined, 9.6 per game) are as follows:
