TEAM

- Today marked David Shaw's 96th career win, one shy of Pete Carroll for eighth-most in conference history
- Today marked Shaw's 65th career Pac-12 win, tied with Howard Jones (USC) for fifth-most in conference history
- The Cardinal improved to 16-18 overall against Arizona State, including 10-6 at Stanford Stadium. David Shaw is now 5-2 against the Sun Devils
- Saturday marked the first game since USC in week two that the Cardinal has started the OL combination of Rouse-Hornibrook-Nugent-Rogers-Hinton
- Coming into Saturday, ASU had converted 16-of-25 third downs over the last two games, but the Cardinal defense held them to just 4-of-13 on the day... the Stanford defense has held opponents to 11-of-38 on third downs over the past three games
- Today marked Stanford's first win without a touchdown since at least 1996 (according to STATS) and is believed to be the first game Stanford has won with three or more field goals and no touchdowns since a 9-7 win over UCLA in 1970 (Oct. 24)
- Just 10th win of Shaw era when trailing at halftime (10-37) and 13th win (13-36) when trailing after the third quarter
- Just ninth win of Shaw era when scoring 19 or fewer (9-25), two of them coming in last two weeks
- Stanford 3-0 this season when allowing 19 or fewer and 58-6 in Shaw era
- 3-0 this season, and 67-8 in Shaw era, when outgaining opponent
- The Cardinal has now had fewer penalties than its opponent in all seven games this season

INDIVIDUAL

K JOSHUA KARTY

- Career-high five field goals tied school record (John Hopkins at Cal, 1990; Nate Whitaker at Notre Dame, 2010)
- Has accounted for 25 of Stanford's 31 points the last two games (both wins)
- The five field goals made was tied for the most in the country this season (three times) and the five attempts was the most in the Pac-12 on the year
- 12-for-12 on the season for FGs and 18-of-18 on PATs
- His makes on Saturday were from: 44, 36, 44, 36, 47 yards

QB TANNER MCKEE

- Career high 33-of-57 for 320 yards
- Third career 300-yard passing game (second this season)
- 57 passing attempts was fifth-most in school history, and most since T.C. Ostrander's 59 vs. UCLA in 2007
- 33 completions was tied for eighth-most in school history and the most since Davis Mills' 33 at Washington State in 2019
- Now has 4,249 career passing yards, surpassing Mike Boryla (1970-73) for 14th-most on Stanford's career list

TE BENJAMIN YUROSEK

- Career-best 10 catches for 78 yards
- The 10 catches was the second-most by a tight end in the David Shaw era (Zach Ertz, at Oregon, 2012 had 11)
- The 10 receptions was also the most by a Cardinal on the season, besting Michael Wilson's nine from Notre Dame ... only eight Cardinal have had more than 10 catches in a game during the David Shaw era

WR JOHN HUMPHREYS

- Career-high eight receptions and 90 yards
- Previous career-best was four catches and receiving yards was 88, both vs. Colgate in the season opener

EDGE LANCE KENELEY

• Career-high 10 tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss

EDGE ERNEST COOPER

- First career appearance
- Made five tackles with 2.5 tackles for loss and one sack

ILB LEVANI DAMUNI

- Second career interception
- Totaled eight tackles with one for loss
