The Mark Campbell Invitational

- Stanford is kicking off the 2023 season at the Mark Campbell Invitational in Irvine, California, taking on two ranked teams and two who received votes in preseason polls.
- The Cardinal has a total record of 28-2 record against the opponents of the Invitational. Stanford holds a 4-0 record over Loyola Marymount, having last faced in 2021 and winning 2-0. Against Oklahoma, Stanford has a 3-0 record, but has not faced the Sooners since 2012. Stanford has the longest history with San Jose State, leading the series 21-2, with the last show down occurring last season where the Cardinal won 2-1.
- This will be the first meeting Stanford will have with both Duke and Liberty.

Preseason Honors

- Ahead of the start of the season, the Cardinal have picked up numerous awards and preseason rankings.
- Stanford has been ranked in every major preseason poll, with D1Softball ranking the Cardinal the highest at 11. The NFCA maintained the Card's 18 ranking from the end of the 2022 season and USA Softball put Stanford at 14th.
- Alana Vawter picked up multiple preseason recognitions, including USA Softball's Player of the Year Watchlist. She was also selected to D1Softball's Top 100 players to watch, coming in at 24, and 9th on their pitcher list. Vawter was also named to the Preseason All-Pac-12 team.
- The Cardinal was tabbed to finish second in the Pac-12, as voted on in the conference's preseason coaches poll. This is the highest ranking the team has received with Coach Allister at the helm.

A Super Season

- Stanford ended it's 2022 season with 39 wins, it's most since 2013. Additionally, the Cardinal made it's first Super Regional's appearance since 2011.
- The Cardinal held sixth-seeded Alabama in the Tuscaloosa Regional, preventing the Crimson Tide from advancing to the Supers for the first time in program history.
- In Pac-12 play, Stanford finished the season fourth in the conference, the highest since 2013

The Stanford Super Regional

- Stanford hosted Oregon State in a NCAA Super Regional. This was the Cardinal's sixth appearance in the Super Regional and first time hosting since 2009.
- The last time Stanford had hosted postseason softball was the 2011 season for the regional round – also Stanford's most-recent postseason appearance.
- The Stanford Super Regional was one of two unseeded super regionals last season as Stanford-Oregon State is joined by Arizona-Mississippi State
- The Cardinal fell to Oregon in two tight games, losing 3-1 in game one and 2-0 in game two.
- Stanford has made two appearances to the Women's College World Series in program history – 2001 and 2004. Both WCWS appearances came during Jessica Allister's playing career.

Fun in Tuscaloosa

- Stanford won the Tuscaloosa Regional in convincing fashion, going 3-1 – with two victories coming against host and sixth-seeded Alabama.
- The Cardinal outscored opponents 15-5 on the weekend and shutout the Crimson Tide twice – the first time Alabama has been shutout in the regional round since 2004, and the first time the team has been shut out all season.
- Saturday's victory against Alabama snapped a 44-game win streak in the regional round for the host team, and was the first time Alabama had failed to qualify for the Super Regional round.
- The last time Stanford advanced out of the regional round as an unseeded team was 2008 at the Amherst Regional.

NOTABLES

This Defense is Legit

- The Cardinal built its success in the 2022 season on the backs of its pitching and defense.
- Stanford allowed 2.17 runs per game and had a run-differential of +116 (244-128) and ranked in the top 20 nationally in shutouts (4th, 21), ERA (13th, 1.97) and fielding percentage (18th, .975).
- Stanford was one of six programs to rank in the top 20 in all three categories, and one of three Super Regional teams to rank in the top 20 of those three categories (Oklahoma, Oklahoma State)
- The Cardinal allowed 10+ runs in a game only twice this season (11- Utah, April 1; 10- at Arizona, May 12) and limited opponents to under three runs in 37 games, going 35-2 in those games.
- With Alana Vawter being a drop-ball pitcher and not registering a high number of strikeouts, Stanford's infielders led the way.
- Among teams in the top-20 in fielding percentage, Stanford's 509 assists leads the way. The next highest team is Florida State (second) with 477 assists. Emily Young (153), Sydney Steele (120) and Sydnee Huff (94) all ranked in the top 10 in the Pac-12 in assists.
- Stanford turned 21 double plays last season – second in the Pac-12. Its the most double plays in a season as far as program records go back (2008).

Queens of Threes

- Known for its speed and aggressiveness, Stanford again hit a plethora of triples in 2022.
- Stanford's 24 triples last season led the Pac-12 and was nearly double the next-highest team's total (UCLA- 12).
- The 24 triples was third nationally, trailing Louisiana's (26) and Jackson State (26).
- The Cardinal was one triple shy of matching the school record of 25 triples, achieved by the 2019 squad.
- Sydnee Huff and Taylor Gindlesperger led the team with six triples hits last season. Ellee Eck and Kaitlyn Lim both had four, Emily Young had three and Chloe Doyle had one.
- The five with multiple triples all rank in the top six in the conference.
- Stanford's Boyd & Jill Smith Family Stadium is a park built for triples. With a high fence, 205 feet down the lines, a facility at sea level with high wind, not many home runs are hit at home. 11 of Stanford's 24 triples have been hit at home this season.

Year Six

- Stanford is led by six year head coach and program alum, Jessica Allister.
- She is joined by Jessica Mendoza Associate Head Softball Coach, Jessica Merchant, and pitching coach Tori Nyberg – who have been with Allister since she returned to The Farm in 2019.
- Allister has led the Cardinal to postseason appearances in all but one season as the program's head coach.
- Allister owns an overall record of 441-206 (.682) after spending seven years as the head coach at Minnesota, and a

151-99 record at Stanford.

- Since 2019, Allister's second season at Stanford, she has led the program to a 127-68 record.
- Allister has led Stanford to 10 postseason appearances as a player (2001-04), an assistant coach (2007-09) and as a head coach (2019, 2021-22).
- Stanford's coaching staff has made eight Women's College World Series appearances as players and coaches. Allister made two appearances as a player for Stanford (2001, 2004), Merchant made three appearances as a player at Michigan, including captaining the Wolverines to a national title in 2005. Nyberg made a WCWS appearance as a player at Stanford in 2001 and led Northwestern to back-to-back appearances in 2006 and 2007 as the pitching coach – highlighted by a runner-up finish in 2006.

All-Conference Cardinal

- Four players earned five All-Pac-12 honors for Stanford in 2022
- Alana Vawter earned first-team all-conference honors for the second straight season, while Taylor Gindlesperger landed on the second team – also for the second straight season.
- Sydnee Huff earned the first Pac-12 honors of her career, landing on the third team and the all-defensive team.
- Emily Young was named to the all-defensive team.

The Company You Keep

- The Pac-12 has continuously led the nation in the advancement of women's sports – and that success is evident in the league's softball coaches.
- All nine of the conference's softball-playing schools are led by a woman after Arizona hired Caitlin Lowe to replace the legendary Mike Candrea this past offseason.
- Six of the nine schools, including Stanford with Jessica Allister, are led by an alum of their program.
- Allister is the fourth-longest tenured alum at her school – ahead of Lowe and California's Chelsea Spencer.
- All nine of the league's programs were postseason eligible with a .500 or better record this season – the only conference in the country to achieve the feat.

Ranked Opponents Beware

- Stanford has picked up six wins over national seeds this season, including five against Super Regional hosts.
- The Cardinal has won nine games against teams which advanced to a Super Regional this season: Oklahoma State, Oregon State, UCLA, Arizona State, Arizona – winning multiple games against the last three schools.
- The Cardinal split two-game series against No. 7 seed Oklahoma State and No. 14 Mizzou
- Stanford also won Pac-12 series against No. 5 UCLA and No. 8 Arizona State, winning two games in each series.
- Overall, the Cardinal has won nine games against Top-25 teams and 12

Aces in the Circle

- Alana Vawter was dominant for the Cardinal in the circle for the second-consecutive season.
- Her 25 victories leads the Pac-12 last season while she also has an ERA of 1.97 good for 56th nationally.
- This was the second season Vawter had 20+ wins, making her the first Cardinal pitcher to accomplish the feat since Teagan Gerhart (2010-12).
- The junior ranked fifth nationally with 11 shutouts – also tied for sixth in school history.
- Vawter ranked 33rd in the country in walks per seven innings (1.26) and 80th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.00).
- Sophomore Regan Krause joins Vawter as a 1-2 punch for the Cardinal. Krause ranks 23rd nationally in ERA (1.66) and 64th in hits allowed per seven innings (5.04).
- Krause has won a career-high 11 games.

A Successful Pac-12 Season

- Stanford was in the midst of one of its best seasons in recent memory.
- The Cardinal entered the postseason with a 36-19 record and an 11-13 record in Pac-12 play this season, finishing fourth in the Conference of Champions.
- The fourth place finish is the best conference finish for Stanford since finishing fourth in 2013 with a 13-11 record in Pac-12 play.
- The 36 overall wins and 11 conference wins are the most wins the Cardinal has had since the 2013 season (39-21, 13-11 Pac-12).
- Stanford picked up the series victory over Utah, No. 2/3 UCLA, No. 10/13 Arizona State and No. 25/RV Arizona during the Pac-12 season.

National Honors for Vawter

- Junior pitcher Alana Vawter began to catch the eyes of the nation following her start to Pac-12 play in 2022
- Following her performance over 15 innings against No. 2 UCLA (April 8-10), Vawter was honored as the NFCA Division I Pitcher of the Week, the D1 Softball Pitcher of the Week and the Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week.
- She is the first Cardinal player to garner national weekly honors from the NFCA since Teaghan Cowles (March 5, 2019).

Perfection (Nearly) in the Circle

- At the DeMarini Invitational, Stanford's pitching staff had a historic outing. The trio of Regan Krause, Alana Vawter and Molly Millar each had a perfect game or no-hitter in three consecutive games.
- Krause opened the weekend with a no-hitter – allowing only one walk in the fifth inning – against Mount St. Mary's. The following

day, Vawter had a perfect game – the first by a Stanford pitcher since 2013 – in a 10-0 victory over Fresno State. Less than two hours later, Millar threw a no-hitter in six innings against Mount St. Mary's, striking out a career high 14 batters in the process.

- It is the first time three separate pitchers have had a no-hitter in back-to-back-to-back games, and the first time any school has had three no-hitters in a row since Auburn accomplished the feat in 2014.
- The last time Stanford had three consecutive no-hitters was Tegan Gerhart in 2010 (March 19-20). The ace had a perfect game followed by back-to-back no-hitters the following day.

The Support Grows

- As head coach Jessica Allister returns the Cardinal to prominence, Stanford has seen increased support for the sport of softball.
- The program sold out four games last season – the first time its had a sellout since the 2019 season.
- Stanford had a total attendance of 14,548 for 25 home games this season – its fourth-highest total attendance dating back to 2008.
- The Cardinal averaged 581 fans a game – its highest average attendance since 2008.
- An anonymous donor also made a generous donation to endow a coaching position in honor of program great and trailblazer, Jessica Mendoza. Jessica Merchant serves as the inaugural Jessica Mendoza Associate Head Softball Coach.
- Since Allister's return, Smith Family Stadium has seen several improvements. A new clubhouse was built behind the outfield wall, new covered pitching lanes and hitting cages were built down the right and left field lines, a new state-of-the-art lighting system was installed, and branded turf was put behind home plate down the first and third base lines.
