SETTING THE SCENE

Stanford hits the road for the first time this season, traveling to Wisconsin for the Brew City Battle at American Family Field, home of the Milwaukee Brewers. The action airs at 4:30 p.m. PT on FS1.

THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford went 16-16 last season, which featured Stanford's first win over an AP top-five opponent since 2007 and its first road ranked win since 2014. The Cardinal opened the 2022-23 campaign on Monday at home with an 88-78 win over Pacific.
- Spencer Jones led last year's team with 12.0 points per game, Harrison Ingram paced the squad with 6.7 rebounds per night, and Michael O'Connell dished a team-leading 3.6 assists per game. Stanford is one of two power conference programs to return eight of its top nine scorers (TCU).
- Ingram, who was Stanford's first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year since Casey Jacobsen in 2000, withdrew his name from the 2022 NBA Draft to return to The Farm for his sophomore campaign.
- The Cardinal returns eight of its top nine rotation players from a year ago, while also bringing in the program's first transfer in 12 years and the first graduate transfer in program history in Michael Jones (Davidson).
- Michael Jones had a debut to remember in the season opener, with his 31 points the most by a Stanford player in his team debut on record. The 31 points were a career-high.

THE BREW CITY BATTLE

Stanford will face Wisconsin for the 11th time in program history, with the Cardinal holding a 6-4 margin over the first 10 matchups. The event is the first basketball game at a Major League Baseball stadium since 2015, when Petco Park hosted San Diego and San Diego State. The court will be placed in the infield with baskets near first and third base and center court at the pitcher's mound.

TAMED THE TIGERS

Michael Jones (31) and Maxime Raynaud (22) each tallied career highs in the program's 88-78 seasonopening win over Pacific. The Cardinal shot 60.4% from the floor as a team, which was Stanford's top mark since Dec. 15, 2020 against CSUN. The win was Stanford's 13th straight in a season opener.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In his first six seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 98 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time since 2015. The 2020 team was set to be postseason bound before the cancellation of the NCAA Tournament.

Stanford won 16 games in 2021-22, including the program's first win over an AP top-five opponent since 2007 and its first over a top-25 team on the road since 2014. Harrison Ingram was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year – Stanford's first since 2000 – while Spencer Jones blossomed into an All-Pac-12 conference forward. Sam Beskind was named Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, becoming the program's third honoree in the last five seasons.

The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country as one of two players to average 18 points, six rebounds and two assists per game while shooting over 55 percent from the floor. He was also named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year.

The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (,469) since 2003-04. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign.

Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

JONESING FOR JONES

Spencer Jones garnered his first All-Pac-12 awards with honorable mention selections to the all-conference and all-defense teams last season. The swingman was the team's leading scorer at 12.0 points per game, while averaging 4.5 rebounds per night. He was one of six players league-wide last season to earn all-conference and all-defense honors. Establishing himself as one of the best 3-point shooters in program history, the sniper ended the season in ninth on the all-time Cardinal list with 189 made threes.

Jones, who will be one of the top seniors in the Pac-12 this season, averaged 22.5 points per game in March last season and 27.0 points per game in the Pac-12 Tournament.

FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR RETURNS TO STANFORD

One of the most dynamic and versatile players in the country, Harrison Ingram was Stanford's first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year since 2000, and also garnered All-Pac-12 honorable mention status a year ago. He was Stanford's first Freshman of the Year since Casey Jacobsen, and just the fifth all-time, joining Brevin Knight (1994), Johnny Rogers (1982) and John Revelli (1981). He joins only Jacobsen in program history with all-conference and all-freshman recognition in the same year.

Ingram is the only rising sophomore in the country to have averaged 10 points, six rebounds and three assists per game last season, as he was joined by only Paolo Banchero, the top pick in the 2022 NBA Draft, in meeting those benchmarks as true freshmen. The only first-year player in the league last year to average double-figure scoring, he won six Pac-12 Freshman of the Week awards, which is the secondmost in conference history, behind only USC's Evan Mobley (2020-21), who won the honor seven times.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATION

Stanford was picked fifth in the Pac-12's preseason poll, earning one first place vote while slotting in behind UCLA, Arizona, Oregon and USC. Spencer Jones and Harrison Ingram were each on the Pac-12 preseason first team, with Stanford joining only UCLA and USC with multiple players on the first team. Ingram also earned a selection to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year watch list for the second consecutive season.

STILL TIPPIN', NOW FOR STANFORD

Michael Jones joined the Cardinal program in May in a groundbreaking moment, as Stanford's first graduate transfer in program history and the first transfer of any kind since 2009-10 (Andrew Zimmerman). Jones played his first three seasons at Davidson, and he led the Wildcats to the NCAA Tournament a year ago after averaging 11.8 points and 3.6 rebounds per game while shooting 42.1 percent from 3-point range.

He is one of two returners in college basketball to have scored 400 points while shooting at least 46 percent from the floor, 42 percent from 3-point range and 84 percent from the free throw line (Isiaih Mosley, Missouri) last season. Jones will start his master's degree in statistics at Stanford this fall.

LEADING THE PAC

The Cardinal boasts one of the top returning corps in the country, leading the Pac-12 in returning minutes, scoring and rebounding, while the program is one of just two power conference teams in the country to bring back eight of its top nine scorers from a year ago, joining TCU. Alongside leaders Spencer Jones and Harrison Ingram, Stanford returns its leading assist man, Michael O'Connell, breakout forward Brandon Angel, big men James Keefe and Maxime Raynaud, and former four-star recruits Isa Silva and Max Murrell. 78 percent of the team's scoring and minutes return from the 2021-22 squad.

A CHALLENGING SLATE

Stanford has once again scheduled a rigorous non-conference slate, headlined by a home contest with San Diego State (Nov. 15), neutral contest clashes with Wisconsin (Nov. 11), Texas (Dec. 18) and Loyola Chicago (Dec. 22) and three games in Orlando at the ESPN Events Invitational (Nov. 24-27), which starts with a matchup against Ole Miss on Thanksgiving Day. The contest with Wisconsin will be played at American Family Field, home of the Milwaukee Brewers, and is the first college basketball game to be played on an MLB diamond since 2015.

The Cardinal has faced a top-80 schedule in each of Jerod Haase's six seasons at Stanford, including top-40 slates in each of the last two years, per KenPom.

SEASON OPENING SUCCESS

The Cardinal is 7-0 in season openers under head coach Jerod Haase, and the program has won 13 straight season debuts dating back to the 2010-11 campaign. Pacific was the third WCC team in that stretch to be Stanford's season-opening foe, and the Cardinal is 10-0 at home in season openers since 2010.

OPENING NIGHT AROUND THE LEAGUE

With all 12 Pac-12 programs in action on opening day, no other player league-wide scored as many points (31) or made as many free throws (10) as Michael Jones. Additionally, Raynaud's 22 points are the third most in the conference, as six players had a 20-point night around the Pac-12. Brandon Angel was one of two players to maintain a 100% mark from the floor with at least four attempts, while Harrison Ingram was one of six players to dish at least six assists. The Cardinal joined Arizona in teams making at least 60 percent of their attempts from the floor.

25 YEARS AGO

This season Stanford will celebrate the 25th anniversary of the 1997-98 Cardinal team that went 30-5 and advanced to the Final Four for just the second time in program history, and the first since Stanford won the national championship in 1942. The team was led by leading scorers Arthur Lee and Kris Weems, had four future NBA players: Tim Young, Mark Madsen, Jarron Collins and Jason Collins, and was captained by Peter Sauer, for whom the team's captain patch is named in honor of.

WELCOME TO THE FARM

Adding a trio of highly-rated recruits to the program, Stanford will welcome four-star forwards Jaylen Thompson (Oakland, CA) and Ryan Agarwal (Coppell, TX) and three-star point guard Benny Gealer (San Pedro, CA) this season. A 6-8 small forward, Thompson gives Stanford a top-100 signee for the sixth-straight season under head coach Jerod Haase, who has signed 13 top-100 players at Stanford.

In addition to the new players, Brandon Dunson joins the program as an assistant coach following stints at Nevada, Cal State Fullerton and Denver. Dunson was previously on staff at Stanford as director of basketball development from 2016-18. Additionally, former North Carolina point guard and 2017 national champion Nate Britt II was added to the coaching staff as director of player development.

IN THE PROS

Stanford boasts five NBA alumni entering the 2022-23 season: Ziaire Williams (Memphis Grizzlies), Brook Lopez (Milwaukee Bucks), Robin Lopez (Cleveland Cavaliers), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks) and KZ Okpala (Sacramento Kings), while a plethora of alumni are plying their trade in leagues around the world. Additionally, Chasson Randle spent the preseason with the Denver Nuggets and Landry Fields was promoted to general manager of the Atlanta Hawks in the offseason.

Through games of Nov. 7, Brook Lopez leads the NBA in blocks while anchoring the only one-loss team.

SWEPT USC

One of the highlights of the 2021-22 season was Stanford's sweep of a ranked USC team. The Cardinal's first win over USC was its first over a top-five opponent since 2007 (UCLA), led by 21 points apiece from Harrison Ingram and Spencer Jones, and the second was its first over a top-25 team on the road since 2014 (Texas), with Ingram and Jones ending in double figures once again to lead the effort.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual totals (9 combined, 9.0 per game) are as follows:
