CARDINAL HEADS TO THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST

After eight games and 45 consecutive days in the state of California, Stanford will leave the Golden State this week to head to the Pacific Northwest. The Cardinal face Washington State in Pullman, Washington, Thursday night in its first Pac-12 road contest of the season.

BIG COMEBACKS LEAD TO SWEEP OF LA SCHOOLS

In two very entertaining games at Maples Pavilion this past week, Stanford erased multiple double-digit second-half deficits to earn wins over UCLA and USC.

Down by as many as 13 with nine minutes to go against UCLA, the Cardinal stormed back to tie the game on a Dorian Pickens three-pointer at the end of regulation. Stanford outscored the Bruins, 22-14, in two overtime sessions to pull out the victory.

The Cardinal erased a 15-point second-half deficit to earn the victory over USC. Down by two with three seconds remaining, freshman Daejon Davis provided the heroics with a half-court shot for the game-winner as the buzzer sounded.

ON THE ROAD IN CONFERENCE PLAY

Stanford is 1-5 in its first conference road game over the past six seasons. The Cardinal is 3-15 on the road in in Pac-12 play over the last two seasons, defeating Oregon State in Corvallis for its lone conference win of the 2016-17 campaign. The Cardinal earned a 72-56 victory over Washington State in its last trip to Pullman, Washington, on Feb. 18, 2016. Stanford and WSU played just once last year on The Farm, due to Pac-12 scheduling.

AGAINST WASHINGTON STATE

Stanford leads the all-time series against Washington State, 76-60. The Cardinal has won seven of the last eight games between the two teams. Stanford defeated WSU in its last trip to Pullman, Washington, on Feb. 18, 2016. In Stanford's Jan. 31, 2015 road loss to the Cougars, Michael Humphrey and Dorian Pickens (then freshmen) scored a combined 10 points. In the 2016 matchup in Pullman, the sophomore duo combined for 40 points.

LAST TIME OUT

Freshman Daejon Davis hit a 50-foot three-pointer at the buzzer and Stanford shocked USC 77-76 on Sunday night at Maples Pavilion, erasing a 15-point second-half deficit to earn the win. Jordan McLaughlin, who scored 16 points and recorded seven assists, had given the Trojans a 76-74 edge with 1.7 seconds left on an acrobatic shot under the basket. Davis took the inbound pass, dribbled twice and let it fly, hitting nothing but net as time expired. Reid Travis matched his career-high with 29 points, adding 10 rebounds for his fifth double-double of the season.

DAVIS' BUZZER-BEATER FIRST FOR THE CARDINAL IN 14 SEASONS

Freshman Daejon Davis' 50-foot heave to win the game as the buzzer sounded against USC last time out was the first buzzer-beater for Stanford in 14 seasons. On March 3, 2004, Matt Lottich hit a desperation three-pointer as time expired to give No. 1 and undefeated Stanford a 63-61 victory over Washington State at Beasley Coliseum, the same venue for Thursday night's contest against the Cougars. Davis' buzzer-beater at home last week was the first for the Cardinal at Maples Pavilion since Nick Robinson connected on a 35-foot running jumper at the buzzer to give No. 2 Stanford an 80-77 victory over No. 12 Arizona on Feb. 7, 2004.

TRAVIS AMONG NATION'S BEST POST PLAYERS

Junior forward Reid Travis, a preseason All-American and candidate for several national player of the year awards, ranks second in the Pac-12 in scoring at 21.3 ppg. He averaged nearly 23 ppg over his final six nonconference games. The forward has matched his career-high with 29 points (first recorded against Kansas last season) in victories over USC last time out and San Francisco on Dec. 17. He became the 45th member of Stanford's 1,000-point club earlier this season and enters Thursday's game at Washington State with 1,085 points and 573 rebounds in his 79-game career so far. Travis ranks ninth in the Pac-12 in rebounding (7.6 rpg).

PICKENS' OUTSIDE TOUCH

Dorian Pickens showed his shooting prowess in the win over UCLA last week, finishing with six three-pointers. The total, one shy of his career-high, is the most of any Cardinal in a game this season. The senior missed 11 games after injuring his left foot in the second game against Pacific on Nov. 12. He returned to action three games ago against California on Dec. 30. Pickens owns 138 career three-pointers, closing in on the top-15 threepoint field goal totals in school history (Aaron Bright ranks 15th with 147).

The forward, the only player to start all 31 games last season, posted at least one three-pointer in all but four games, with multiple three-pointers in 19 contests his junior season. He ranked ninth in the Pac-12 in three-point field goals made in conference play (39, 2.2) and 11th overall (67, 2.2) as Stanford's leading three-point shooter (67-of-169, 39.6 percent) last year.

POST PRESENCE

Stanford's starting post players, Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey, have combined to average 33.5 points and 16.0 rebounds per game. The duo is second in the conference among starting post players in both combined scoring and combined rebounding, the only pair to rank in the top-three in both categories in the conference. Travis is second in the Pac-12 in scoring at 21.3 ppg, to go along with 7.6 rpg. Humphrey ranks third in the conference in rebounding at 8.4 rpg, to go along with 12.2 ppg.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

Stanford's roster has played 638 combined games. The Cardinal entered the season with the fifthmost veteran roster (games played) in the nation. While fourth-year players Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey anchor the post, injuries limited several veteran perimeter players early on. This has given one of the nation's top recruiting classes a chance to play important minutes as freshmen. All four members of Stanford's freshman class have started at least one game and three freshmen -Daejon Davis, Oscar da Silva and Isaac White - started together in six games earlier this season.

All four freshmen on the roster average more than 24 minutes per game. Davis leads the Cardinal in assists per game (4.4 apg), White leads the Cardinal in three-pointers (30) and da Silva ranks third on the roster in rebounding (5.4 rpg), is tied for the team lead in blocks (16) and is tied for third in steals (11). Fellow freshman Kezie Okpala made his collegiate debut four games ago. He is averaging 10.3 ppg in 31.0 mpg over those four contests.

Prior to this season, Stanford last started three freshmen on January 27, 1983 (at Washington) with Keith Ramee, Andy Fischer and Earl Koberlein earned the starting nod in that contest.

OKPALA MAKING IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Freshman Kezie Okpala made his collegiate debut four games ago and has made an immediate impact. The forward is averaging 10.3 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals in 31.0 minutes per game in those four contests against Kansas, California, UCLA and USC. He has started the last three games, recording a season-best 13 points against the Bruins.

HUMPHREY CONTROLLING THE GLASS

Michael Humphrey, who was among the Pac-12 leaders in rebounding last season, ranks third in the Pac-12 in rebounding with an average of 8.4 rpg. The average is 77th nationally. The forward ranks third in the conference and 40th nationally in defensive rebounds per game (6.8 drpg). He posted a career-high 18 rebounds against Pacific on Nov. 12. The senior, who is averaging 12.2 ppg, has four double-doubles this year.

DAVIS TAKING CONTROL OF THE POINT

Freshman Daejon Davis has started all 14 career games he has played in. After averaging 7.0 ppg in his first five games, he is averaging 10.9 points in his last nine contests. He had a career-best 22-point performance, that included 13 in the second half alone, in the win over UCLA and drained the game-winning buzzer-beater from beyond half court in the win over USC last week. Davis has registered 13 assists in his last two games against the Bruins and Trojans.

CARTWRIGHT WITH CAREER-BEST NUMBERS

After averaging 4.1 ppg over the first two seasons (67 games) of his career, junior Robert Cartwright is averaging 8.2 ppg in 14 games this season. He had a season-high 19 points against Portland State. He ranks sixth in the Pac-12 in assist/turnover ratio (2.2). Cartwright has started six games this season.

FLOOR BURNS STAT COMES TO THE FARM

During his standout collegiate career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court, diving for loose balls and taking charges, whatever he could do to help his team win. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" stat was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 in the 1996-97 season. For the second season, Stanford is tracking floor burns as an official stat throughout the year.

After averaging 5.9 three-pointers per game through its first 10 games, Stanford nearly set a school single-game record with 13 three-pointers in the Dec. 15 win over Denver. The school record for three-pointers in a game is 15. The Cardinal had averaged 17.1 three-point attempts per game in its first 10 games, before attempting 43 over its last six contests, including 32 against Denver. Isaac White owns a team-best 30 three-pointers. Dorian Pickens, who missed 11 games with an injury, posted six three-pointers in the win over UCLA two games ago.

MOST POWER FIVE OPPONENTS IN FIVE YEARS

Stanford's challenging nonconference schedule included four opponents from power five conferences. The Cardinal played North Carolina (ACC), Florida (SEC), Ohio State (Big Ten) and Kansas (Big 12), with all but the UNC contest taking place away from Maples Pavilion. It's the most power five conference opponents in five years, since the Cardinal faced Missouri (SEC), Minnesota (Big Ten), NC State (ACC) and Northwestern (Big Ten) during its 2012 slate. Stanford went 1-3 in those games, defeating Northwestern (70-68) on the road.

WIN NO. 100 FOR HAASE

The Dec. 17 victory over San Francisco was head coach Jerod Haase's 100th career coaching victory. He is in his sixth season as a head coach and second with Stanford, following four successful seasons at UAB. The win was Haase's 20th at the helm of the Cardinal.

THE FOURTH-YEAR CLASS

The four members of Stanford's fourth-year class - Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens, Michael Humphrey and Robert Cartwright - accounted for 62.6 percent of the team's scoring and 55.4 percent of the team's rebounding last season. Pickens and Humphrey are true seniors, while Travis and Cartwright have each had their medical hardship waivers granted and are redshirt juniors with another year of eligibility remaining after this season. Cartwright missed the entire 2015-16 season with a compound fracture of his right forearm sustained in preseason practice on Nov. 2, 2015. Travis was forced to miss the final 22 games of the 2015-16 season with a right leg injury.

WHITE POSTS BEST DEBUT MARK SINCE 1977

Freshman Isaac White's 17-point performance against Cal Poly in the season opener on Nov. 10 was the second-most points by a true freshman in his collegiate debut in the 103-year history of the program. White ranks sixth on the team in scoring at 8.8 ppg.

PETER SAUER CAPTAINSHIP

Head coach Jerod Haase announced the establishment of the Peter Sauer Captainship in September, naming Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens and Michael Humphrey captains. The three wear patches on their uniforms honoring the legacy of the late Peter Sauer, a team captain and leader of Stanford's 1998 Final Four team. Stanford will celebrate the 20-year anniversary of the 1998 Final Four team Feb. 24, 2018, against Washington State.

TOP-TIER RECRUITING CLASS

After signing a consensus top-25 national recruiting class last season, the Cardinal once again inked one of the nation's top classes for 2018. On Nov. 8, Stanford announced the signing of 6-5 guard Cormac Ryan from New York, New York, and 7-0 forward Keenan Fitzmorris of Overland Park, Kansas, Fitzmorris is the younger brother of Stanford women's volleyball All-American Audriana Fitzmorris.

SEEING DOUBLE

Stanford individuals have totaled 11 double-doubles in the first 16 games, with five from Reid Travis, four Michael Humphrey, and one each from Dorian Pickens and Oscar da Silva.

Stanford was selected fifth in the Pac-12 Conference media preseason poll. The Cardinal totaled 182 points to place fifth in a vote of the media members. Stanford was also picked fifth in the 2014-15 preseason poll. The Cardinal finished ninth in the conference last season.

HERENTON VISITED INDIA AS PART OF ACE PROGRAM

Sophomore Rodney Herenton visited New Delhi, India, July 21 through Aug. 12 of 2017 as part of the Rubenstein-Bing Student-Athlete Civic Engagement Program (ACE). He was part of a group of 10 studentathletes from both Stanford and Duke that taught classes at the Vidya School, giving lessons on English and different sports to children in seventh and eighth grades. Three days out the week, the group visited Earth Saviors, a shelter home for the sick, disabled, and abandoned. At Earth saviors, they helped paint walls, decorate the living quarters, among other tasks.

The ACE program provides one-time funding for accepted Stanford-Duke ACE student-athletes to participate in three-week, immersive summer service experiences with an international community partner. Each summer, 40 student-athletes participate in one of four international group programs with service themes like education, coaching, environmental sustainability and conservation, and health outreach and education.

After being introduced as the Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball by Jaquish & Kenninger Director of Athletics Bernard Muir on March 25, 2016, Jerod Haase developed a strong relationship with his program and instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude among his student-athletes.

In his first year at the helm of the Cardinal program, Stanford posted 14 wins against one of the toughest schedules in the nation. Redshirt sophomore Reid Travis earned First Team All-Pac-12 and NABC All-District honors, developing into one of the top players in the conference on both ends of the court. His program finished in the top-10 percent among men's basketball programs nationally in the classroom as well.

Haase and his staff signed a top-tier recruiting class that is rated as high as No. 10 nationally in the 2017 rankings, welcoming the four-member class to The Farm for the 2017-18 season.

Haase arrived on The Farm prior to the 2016-17 season after completing his fourth season as the head coach at UAB, where he led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament appearance in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Tabbed the 2016 Gene Bartow Conference USA Coach of the Year, Haase led the Blazers to a 26-5 overall record and a 16-2 conference mark while capturing their first regular-season title since 2011. Along the way, UAB established school records for overall victories (26), conference wins (16), road wins (10) and consecutive victories (14). Also named the 2016 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Coach, Haase directed the Blazers to an NIT berth for the 12th time in school history. UAB also finished 16-0 at home in his final season at the helf of the Blazers, extending the nation's fifth-longest home winning streak to 25, while ranking among the nation's best in field goal percentage (.478 – 24th), assists per game (18.4 – 4th) and blocks per game (4th – 6.1).

Under Haase's guidance, UAB returned to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, shocking No. 3 seed Iowa State, 60-59, in the second round for the Blazers' first NCAA victory since 2005. UAB reached the Big Dance after claiming the program's first Conference USA Tournament title despite being seeded No. 4. The triumph marked UAB's first league tournament title since 1987, when the

Blazers won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. More impressively, Haase successfully developed a roster comprised of 10 underclassmen – all players recruited by Haase and his staff – and finished 20-16 overall while guiding the third-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

The Blazers made impressive strides under Haase's leadership during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing 18-13 overall while notching three victories against teams that qualified for the NCAA Tournament. Of UAB's 18 victories, perhaps none were more impressive than the Blazers' 63-59 home win against No. 16 North Carolina. UAB was ranked in the top five nationally in rebounding throughout the season and finished the year ranked second in the country at 44.5 boards per game.

During Haase's first year with the Blazers in 2012-13, UAB won six of its final nine regular-season Conference USA games and collected a victory in the conference tournament.

Prior to arriving at UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. A 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration, Haase got his start as Kansas' Director of Operations from 1999-2003. During that time, the Jayhawks reached the 2002 Final Four and the national championship game in 2003.

When Williams was named head coach at North Carolina prior to the 2003-04 season, he brought Haase with him as an assistant coach and director of operations, a title Haase held from 2003-09. Haase then served exclusively as an assistant coach during his final three seasons with the Tar Heels.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, Haase attended California in 1992-93 before transferring to Kansas. He helped lead the Jayhawks to three consecutive conference titles and finished his career ranked in the school's top 10 in assists, three-point field goals and steals. Haase started 99 of 101 games at Kansas and scored 1,264 points, averaging 12.5 per game and reaching double figures 74 times. While at Kansas, Haase was a candidate for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.

As a senior in 1996-97, Haase started alongside Jacque Vaughn, Scot Pollard, Paul Pierce and Raef LaFrentz as Kansas finished with a 34-2 record while averaging 12.0 points per game despite playing with a broken wrist. As a sophomore in 1994-95, Haase averaged 15.0 points and was named the Big Eight Conference Newcomer of the Year and also tabbed a second-team all-conference selection.

Haase was a first-team GTE Academic All-American as a senior, a second-team Academic All-American as a junior and a three-time academic all-conference pick. The Jayhawks' Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 1997, Haase later earned a master's degree in business at Kansas in 2000.

Haase started 23 games in 1992-93 as a freshman at California, teaming with Jason Kidd in the backcourt.

In 2017, Haase joined the National Advisory Board of the Positive Coaching Alliance, the organization that uses the power of positive reinforcement to pursue winning and the more important goal of teaching life lessons through sports.

Haase, 42, and his wife, the former Mindy Meidinger, have three children: Gavin (11), Garrett (7) and Gabrielle (4).






