2023 NOTABLES

- No. 4 Stanford (8-4, 0-1 MPSF) will play its first home game of the year, welcoming No. 14 Santa Clara to The Farm on Friday at 7 p.m. before hosting the annual Alumni Game on Saturday at 11:30 a.m.
- The Cardinal is coming off a 2-2 week at the Overnight MPSF Invitational where it finished fourth behind UCLA, California and USC. Jackson Painter led the Cardinal offense with 14 goals and four multi-goal contests last week, including five against then-No. 1 California. Griffen Price played every minute in goal for Stanford, finishing the four games with 43 saves and seven steals while contributing three assists. Posting double-digit saves in three of the four games on the weekend, Price also managed a 47.8 save percentage. Price opened the weekend with 13 saves, a steal and two assists in a 20-10 victory over Cal Baptist on Friday. Turning in a career day against No. 4 Princeton on Saturday morning, Price totaled 14 saves and four steals while allowing just six goals and posting a 70% save percentage in an 11-6 victory. Facing No. 1 California on Saturday afternoon in the semifinals, Price made 12 saves, added two steals and contributed one assist as the Cardinal pushed the two-time reigning NCAA champion to two sudden-victory overtime periods before eventually falling 18-17.
- Riley Pittman, who ranked sixth on the team in goals (33) last season, leads the Cardinal with 32 goals through 12 games. Pittman is second on the team in multi-goals (8) - trailing only Jackson Painter with nine.
- Collecting the first All-America honor of his career in 2022, Jackson Painter returns for his final season following a year in which he led the MPSF with 67 goals and 99 points while also recording 32 assists. Painter has scored 31 goals with nine multi-goal performances through 12 games, and has now scored 25 goals in his last seven contests.
- The Cardinal has split time between Nolan Krutonog and Griffen Price in goal, with Price totaling 90 saves to Krutonog's 36.
- Stanford's 2023 schedule includes seven home contests at Avery Aquatic Center, beginning this week against Santa Clara. In addition to the Overnight MPSF Invitational (2-2), the Cardinal will also compete at the MPSF Championships in Berkeley (Nov. 17-19).
- In his second season at the helm, head coach Brian Flacks has compiled a 30-9 (.769) overall record Flacks arrived at Stanford with over a decade of coaching experience at both the prep and national team levels.
- Stanford is coming off a 22-5 campaign in 2022, in which it was ranked No. 1 nationally and raced out to a 17-0 start, the best debut in school history since the 2001 squad also opened 17-0. The Cardinal also won the MPSF Invite at Avery Aquatic Center, including a victory over UCLA and the first of two against eventual national champion California, while advancing to the MPSF Championship game.
- Stanford owns 11 NCAA championships all-time, its last coming in 2019. The Cardinal has advanced to the NCAA Tournament 34 times and has won eight MPSF titles.
