NEED TO KNOW

As the month of December comes to an end, the Golden Bears look toward the beginning of Pac-12 play, opening the conference slate at Stanford on Saturday. California men's basketball takes on the Cardinal at 7 p.m. from Maples Pavilion, with the game broadcasted live on FS1 and KGO 810 AM.

Cal is 7-3 in Pac-12 openers in the last 10 season. Over that span, the Golden Bears have faced Stanford thrice to open conference action. Cal's most recent win at Maples Pavilion was also a conference-opening contest, coming as a 69-62 victory on the Farm.

The Bears wrapped up nonconference play with a 6-7 record, falling to Portland State 106-81 in the finale. Cal went a perfect 2-0 in true road games, bringing back wins against San Diego State (63-62) and Seattle (81-59). The Bears averaged 76 points, 37.1 rebounds, 6.7 steals and 6.2 blocks during the slate.

Cal begins its Pac-12 campaign leading the league in blocked shots (81), offensive rebounds (163) and offensive rebound percentage (35.4 percent), while also ranking in the top five for steals (4th, 6.7 per game). Four Bears are scoring in double figures through 13 games this season, with Don Coleman leading the charge at 20.5 points per game. Darius McNeill is one of two freshmen averaging in the double digits at 13.4 ppg alongside classmate Justice Sueing's 11.5 ppg. Marcus Lee is averaging 12.2 points and 7.8 rebounds.

HOW TO FOLLOW THE ACTION: Golden Bear action airs on FS1 for the first time this season, with the call coming from Aaron Goldsmith and Steve Lavin. Fans can also follow the action via FoxSportsGo.com or the Fox Sports Go app. The California Golden Bears Sports Network will offer play by play and analysis, as well as post-game interviews, from Todd McKim and Jay John live on KGO 810 AM. Live stats, full broadcast details and more can be accessed via the Cal men's basketball schedule page on CalBears.com, and fans can follow the Bears on social media via @CalMBball on Twitter and Instagram, and at Facebook.com/CalMBball.

BY THE NUMBERS

+1.4 The Golden Bears wrapped up the nonconference season averaging 6.7 steals per game, up from 5.3 through the end of nonconference last year. Cal averaged 9.5 steals in the last four games of the nonconference slate.

6.2 Cal is averaging 6.2 blocked shots per game with 81 total blocks. The Golden Bear record is 161 blocks, which Cal set in 2013 at a pace of 4.88 swats per game in 33 total contests.

2013-14 Cal's last win at Maples Pavilion came in the 2014 Pac-12 opener. The Bears won 69-62 on Jan. 2, 2014. Since then, the Bears have dropped three straight at the Farm.

7 Kingsley Okoroh recorded a school-record seven blocked shots in a game against Portland State, marking the second time this season he matched the record. Golden Bear Michael Stewart recorded 7 blocks thrice in his career from 1994-97.

12 Darius McNeill's 12-game three-pointer streak ended against Portland State on Dec. 21. Prior to that, the rookie hit at least one trey in each game of his collegiate career, including nine games with multiple three-pointers.

LAST TIME OUT

Cal wrapped up nonconference play with a 6-7 record after falling to Portland State 106-81 in Haas Pavilion
 • Cal allowed 100 points for the first time since a 109-77 loss at Washington on Feb. 10, 2011.
 • For the second time this season, Kingsley Okoroh tied the single-game blocked shots record with seven blocks.
 • Deschon Winston scored a career-best 10 points coming off the bench for the Bears.
 • Nick Hamilton tallied a personal-best 5 rebounds.
 • Darius McNeill's 12-game three-pointer streak came to an end, but the frosh put up double figures for the 10th time this season.

ROOKIES RISING TO THE CHALLENGE

With one of the youngest squads in the national, California's newcomers have been pushed to step up and contribute major minutes to the lineup. Two freshmen are averaging double figures for the Bears, with Darius McNeill (13.4 points per game) and Justice Sueing (11.5 ppg) averaging above 11.0 points.

McNeill, a Houston, Texas product poured in back-to-back career-high point totals, starting with 18 points against Chaminade and improving to 22 points against CSUN, then topped it four games later with a 30-point outing against CSU Fullerton. McNeill became the 40th player in Cal basketball history to score 30 points in a game. Against the Titans, he also recorded career-high totals for assists (6), steals (5) and rebounds (6). Following his 30-point outing against the Titans, McNeill added 20 points – all in the second half – at Seattle. The rookie carried a 12-game three-pointer streak before it was snapped in Cal's nonconference finale against Portland State. During that span, he logged nine games with multiple three-point makes.

Sueing scored a career-high 23 points against Chaminade, including 19 in the second half, and has scored in double figures in seven games this season. His output comes after missing most of the preseason due to a stress fracture.

Juhwan Harris-Dyson has also stepped up with solid minutes off the bench for the Bears, averaging 4.5 points and 3.2 rebounds. He came up clutch in Cal's 63-62 win at San Diego State, icing a pair of free throws with less than 8 seconds in the game to lift Cal to the win.

BIG KIDS ON THE BLOCK

California's senior big men are among the country's best players on the block, with Kingsley Okoroh and Marcus Lee combining for 66 blocks so far this season. The Bears rank among the Top 20 nationally for total blocks (10th, 81) and blocked shots per game (12th, 6.2).

Okoroh and Lee are both in the top 30 individually for total blocks and blocked shots per game. Okoroh is 17th with 36 total blocks, and 20th with 2.77 blocked shots per game. Lee is 26th for his 30 total blocks and 29th at 2.31 blocks per game.

The 7-1 Okoroh has tied the Cal single-game record for blocked shots twice this season, recording 7 blocks against UC Riverside and against Portland State. He ties the number set by Michael Stewart (1994-97), which Stewart recorded thrice in his Golden Bear career. Okoroh has 171 career blocks, currently ranked third among Cal's career leaders. Stewart ranks second with 207 blocks, and David Kravish (2012-15) leads with 226 career blocked shots.

The Cal team record for blocked shots in a season is 161 blocks through 33 games in 2013, an average of 4.88 per game. The Bears are currently swatting shots at a pace of 6.2 blocks per game, with 81 total blocks.

NEXT UP

The Golden Bears return to Berkeley to open Pac-12 home action with USC and UCLA from Jan. 4-6. The weekend series kicks off with USC on Thursday, Jan. 4 at 7 p.m., followed by UCLA on Saturday, Jan. 6 at 3 p.m. Both games air live on the Pac-12 Network.

BEARS AMONG YOUNGEST IN NATION

After a busy offseason, the Golden Bears boast among one of the youngest squads in the country, ranking among the Top 10 fewest returning starts from 2016-17 (7th, 45), fewest returning letterwinners (1st, 2), fewest minutes played by returnees in 2016-17 (3rd, 1,167) and most scholarship freshmen (5th, 6).

CAL IN THE PAC-12 PRESEASON POLL

The Golden Bears were projected to finish 11th in the Pac-12 in 2017-18, according to a preseason vote by media who regularly cover the conference.

Arizona is the favorite to win the conference, followed by USC and UCLA in the top 3. Washington State is predicted to finish behind the Bears at 12th.

Cal's worst finish in the last decade came in 2007-08, when the Bears went 17-16 overall and 6-12 in the Pac-10 to earn 9th place.

OKOROH ON KAREEM ABDUL JABBAR AWARD WATCH LIST

Kingsley Okoroh is on the shortlist of the best

collegiate centers in the nation. The Cal big man was named one of 20 players on the 2018 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award.

Okoroh enters his senior season following Pac-12 All-Defensive Honorable Mention laurels last year. He logged 74 blocks to become Cal's single-season blocked shots leader. The Derby, England native started 24 contests in 2016-17 – appearing in all 34 games – en route to averaging a career-best in points (4.6) and rebounds (5.5). During his junior season, Okoroh also averaged 2.2 blocks per a game and recorded four or more blocks in six outings, while also setting single-game career-highs with five blocks against Wyoming and 13 rebounds against No. 4 UCLA.

The list will be narrowed down to 10 candidates by mid-February, with five finalists announced in March and the winner crowned in April.

BEARS SIGN TOP 25 CLASS

Head coach Wyking Jones first recruiting class is off to a strong start, signing a consensus Top 30 class, with three outlets listing Cal's 2018 signees as a Top 25 group. Top 100 recruits Jacobi Gordon (Houston, Texas) and Matt Bradley (San Bernardino, Calif.) and three-star California standout Andre Kelly have signed with the program. 247Sports and Scout gave the Bears the 18th-best class in the country. ESPN ranks the class 22nd. More notes on the class:

- Matt Bradley – 97th in the ESPN 100, four-star shooting guard
- Jacobi Gordon – 89th in the ESPN 100, No. 22 small forward in the country
- Andre Kelly – Stockton Record's reigning All-Area Player of the Year who averaged 24.1 points, 15.2 rpg, 2.7 assists and 1.9 blocks as a junior.

CAL TO OPEN NEXT SEASON IN CHINA

California men's basketball will open the 2017-18 season against Yale in China in the fourth edition of the Pac-12 China Game presented by Alibaba Group. The flagship event of Pac-12 Global is designed to grow the global popularity of Pac-12 athletic programs and universities, fostering cultural exchange through sport, and creating unique educational experiences for Pac-12 student-athletes. In addition to the game, the trip will include educational and cultural experiences for student-athletes and university delegations. Specific date and location information will be announced at a later date.

HAMILTON NAMED TO NABC HONORS COURT

Senior guard Nick Hamilton was recognized for his exemplary work in the classroom this summer, earning NABC Honors Court laurels. The Honors Court recognizes student-athletes who excelled in academics during the 2016-17 season, carrying a 3.2 GPA or higher.

Hamilton boasts a 3.74 cumulative GPA as a double major in legal studies and media studies. The Inglewood, Calif. product saw action in 12 games during the Bears' 2016-17 campaign after recovering from a knee injury during the 2015-16 season.

OKOROH'S OFFSEASON

In preparation for Wyking Jones' style of press, Kingsley Okoroh spent his summer becoming a leaner, more mobile and more conditioned athlete. From June 19 to Aug. 28, Okoroh dropped 14 lbs. of weight, improving his lean body mass from

245.8 to 252 -- a gain of 7 lbs. of muscle. His fat measured at 8.4, down from 18.7 in June, including a nearly four percent drop in body fat from 9 percent to 5.1 percent.

Okoroh worked with men's basketball strength and conditioning coach Jordan Jackson, with a primary area of focus in his mobility -- including the ability to stay into basketball stances and positions for longer periods of times, and opening up his hips to move better. Ankle strength for the 7-footer was also a focus. Okoroh's conditioning to lean out included utilizing the underwater treadmill at Cal's Simpson High Performance Center to put less pressure on his joints, and participating in low-impact cardio such as intervals on the elliptical. Okoroh, Jackson and team nutritionist Elizabeth McNear also met several times throughout the summer to tighten up Okoroh's diet and nutrition plan.

WORKOUT WAYS

In order to prepare for a new style of offense this year, the Golden Bears were hard at work this offseason adapting to Strength & Conditioning Coach Jordan Jackson's workouts. Along with Olympic style weightlifting and conditioning, the Bears also participated in unique sessions such as hot yoga, conditioning on the campus beach volleyball courts and running the California Memorial Stadium steps.

HEAD COACH WYKING JONES

With more than 15 years of collegiate coaching experience, Wyking Jones was introduced as California's head coach on March 24, 2017.

Prior to his tenure as head coach, Jones served as an assistant coach at Cal for two seasons under Cuonzo Martin in 2015-16 and 2016-17.

Charged with coaching Cal's big men, Jones helped forward Ivan Rabb become a two-time All-Pac-12 performer and Jaylen Brown earn All-Pac-12 and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year honors in 2015-16. In addition, center Kingsley Okoroh set a school record with 74 blocks in 2016-17.

In his first season with the Golden Bears, Jones helped steer Cal to the program's first NCAA Tournament bid since 2013 and the program's highest tournament seeding, a No. 4 seed. Cal's defense earned top marks, leading the Pac-12 with just 67.3 points allowed per game and finishing in the top three for rebounding. The Bears went 23-11 and extended their home winning streak to 19 games, dating back to the 2014-2015 season.

The Bears continued their success in 2016-17 by pushing their home winning streak to a program-record 27 games and once again led the league in defense, limiting opponents to 63.4 ppg and 40.0 percent shooting. Cal finished the season with a 21-13 record and earned the top seed in the National Invitation Tournament.

Throughout his career, Jones has also been instrumental in the development of 11 current and former NBA players, including standout Golden Bear Jaylen Brown, plus Terry Rozier, Gorgui Dieng, Montrezl Harrell, Tony Snell, Russ Smith and Peyton Siva.

Jones, a native of Inglewood, Calif., returned to his home state with 12 years of experience as a coach at the collegiate level and was introduced as Martin's assistant on April 23, 2015. He joined the Golden Bears' staff after serving as an assistant coach at Louisville for four seasons. During his time on the Cardinals' coaching staff, UofL's combined record was 123-30. Louisville captured the 2013 NCAA Championship and reached two Final Fours over the past four seasons. The Cardinals completed the 2014-15 season with a 27-9 record, reaching the NCAA Tournament regional final.

Prior to Louisville, Jones served two seasons on the coaching staff at New Mexico where the Lobos won 52 games in two seasons, including a school-record 30-win campaign in 2010. New Mexico finished the 2010 season ranked eighth in the Associated Press national poll.

Jones served as an assistant coach for five seasons from 2002-06 at Pepperdine, where he was the Waves' recruiting coordinator. He got his start in coaching at his alma mater, Loyola Marymount, during the 1996-97 season.

As an assistant coach, Jones boasts one national championship, two Final Four runs, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, an Elite Eight and Sweet 16 run and 10 NBA Draft selections.

He was a standout at LMU from 1991-95 under head coach John Olive, where his 1,076 career points rank 24th all-time in the program's history. Jones also collected 493 career rebounds during his career with the Lions. He was a two-time All-West Coast Conference selection, highlighted by a 19.7 ppg average as a junior. He earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from Loyola Marymount in 1995.

Jones played professional basketball from 1995-2001 in Italy, France, Japan, Lebanon and South Korea. He also served on the staff at Nike Elite Youth Basketball for three years, where he was the Travel Team Manager for more than 45 programs.

Jones and his wife, Estrella, have a son, Jameel and a daughter, Zoe.

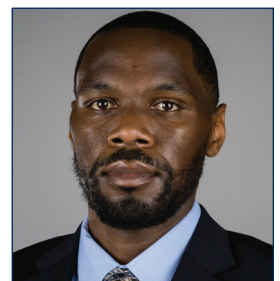
