SETTING THE SCENE

On a night where Stanford will honor the 25th anniversary of the Final Four squad from 1998, the Cardinal welcomes California on Saturday, Jan. 28 at 7 p.m. The action will be broadcast on ESPNU.

THE OPENING TIP

- The Cardinal is 8-12 (2-7 Pac-12) this year, including home wins over Pacific, Cal Poly, Green Bay, Chicago St., Oregon St. and Oregon and neutral site wins over Florida St. (Orlando) and Loyola Chicago (Santa Cruz).
- Through 20 games, Spencer Jones leads the team with 13.4 points per game, and joined Stanford's 1,000-point club on Dec. 29 with a 25-point outing against Colorado. Jones paces the program in Pac-12 play with 16.1 points per game, which ranks fourth in the league. He also ranks second in threes per game and sixth in offensive rebounds and in free throw percentage.
- Harrison Ingram, who was Stanford's first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year since Casey Jacobsen in 2000, withdrew his name from the 2022 NBA Draft to return to The Farm for his sophomore campaign. He is the first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year to return since Jahii Carson (Arizona State) in 2013-14.
- The Cardinal returns eight of its top nine rotation players from a year ago, ranking sixth nationally in minutes continuity, per KenPom, while also bringing in the program's first transfer in 12 years and the first graduate transfer in program history in Michael Jones (Davidson). Jones had a game to remember in the season opener, with his 31 points the most by a Stanford player in his team debut on record. The 31 points remain tied for the best single-game mark by a Pac-12 player this season.
- Stanford is coming off of a weekend sweep over Oregon and Oregon State, where the Cardinal allowed just 55.0 points per game and a 36.4 percent mark from the floor while shooting 47.3 percent itself.

THREE WINS IN A ROW

Stanford men's basketball picked up a pair of wins last weekend, downing the Beavers, 67-46, and the Ducks, 71-64. The 46 points allowed matched the lowest in a Pac-12 game under head coach Jerod Haase, matching the total in the win at Oregon State in 2017. Spencer Jones led the effort with 17 points per game while Michael Jones was close behind at 14 per night, including a 62.5 percent clip from 3-point range. The momentum carried into Wednesday's win over Chicago State, with Spencer Jones scoring 21 points, including six threes, while Maxime Raynaud had a double-double with 17 points and 13 boards.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In his first six seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 98 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time since 2015. The 2020 team was set to be postseason bound before the cancellation of the NCAA Tournament.

Stanford won 16 games in 2021-22, including the program's first win over an AP top-five opponent since 2007 and its first over a top-25 team on the road since 2014. Harrison Ingram was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year – Stanford's first since 2000 – while Spencer Jones blossomed into an All-Pac-12 conference forward. Sam Beskind was named Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, becoming the program's third honoree in the last five seasons.

The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country as one of two players to average 18 points, six rebounds and two assists per game while shooting over 55 percent from the floor. He was also named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year.

The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (,469) since 2003-04. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign.

Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

CELEBRATING 1998

Stanford is welcoming back members of its 1997-98 team, which won 30 games for the first time in program history and advanced to the Final Four. Arthur Lee, who led the 1998 team in scoring, will be Stanford's honorary captain. The 1998 team was ranked as high as No. 4 in the country and won 18 consecutive games during the course of the season. The team featured four future NBA players: Jason & Jarron Collins, Mark Madsen and Tim Young.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES

Stanford is led in the scoring column by Spencer Jones and Michael Jones, with the former ranking fourth in Pac-12 play at 16.1 points per game. Michael Jones averages 9.7 points and 2.2 assists per game in conference action, while both Jones players are shooting at least 38 percent from 3-point range against Pac-12 foes. Spencer Jones paces the team in steals and blocks, both in conference play and overall, while both Jones contribute heavily to Stanford's 7.9 threes per game in Pac-12 play, which leads the Pac-12. The team is also fourth in offensive rebounds per game (11.4), second in defensive rebound percentage (73.7) and third in turnover margin (+1.8).

THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters the matchup with the Golden Bears at No. 126 in the NET Rankings (Jan. 27), with a NET SOS of 71 and an average opponent NET rank of 75. The matchup is currently a quadrant four contest, as Cal slots in at No. 285. 19 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are currently slated to be in quadrant one or two, including 12 in Q1, and eight of the remaining 11. Stanford has six remaining Q1 opportunities.

CHICAGO'S PAC-12 TEAM

The Cardinal finished off a season sweep of teams from the city of Chicago, besting Loyola Chicago on Dec. 22 in Santa Cruz, 75-62, and Chicago State in the Pac-12's final non-conference contest on Jan. 25, 71-64. The matchups were the first in program history against both opponents. Michael O'Connell and Harrison Ingram finished in double figures against both teams, with Ingram averaging 15.0 points.

50TH TO REACH 1,000

A high-scoring weekend against Colorado and Utah helped Spencer Jones cross the 1,000-point threshold. Jones scored a season-high 25 points against Colorado, his eighth-career 20-point outing, and added 16 against Utah. The senior became the program's 50th member of the 1,000-point club and has moved into 37th on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,122 points. He passed Matt Haryasz '06 against Chicago State, and is six away from passing Ed Schweitzer '76 for 36th.

Establishing himself as one of the best 3-point shooters in program history, the sniper has 228 career threes, which ranks third all-time in program history, tied with Jeremy Green '11. He is 13 away from matching Dion Cross '96 for second. Jones is averaging 13.4 points, 4.7 rebounds, 1.2 steals and 1.2 blocks per game through 19 appearances, the last of which ranks 10th in the Pac-12 and second among perimeter players (Keion Brooks, UW). Jones is tied with Josh Owens '12 for 14th on the program's all-time blocks list with 85, and can tie Kim Belton '80 for 13th with one more.

Jones earned his first All-Pac-12 awards with honorable mention selections to the all-league and all-defense teams last season. He was one of six players league-wide to earn both distinctions.

McDONALD'S ALL-AMERICAN

Andrej Stojakovic became the 10th recruit in program history to earn a spot on the McDonald's All-American game roster, as announced on Jan. 24. The Cardinal will have a participant for the third time in four years - the first time in program history to accomplish the feat over a four-year stretch. Stojakovic joins Harrison Ingram (2021), Ziaire Williams (2020), Reid Travis (2014), Brook and Robin Lopez (2006), Josh Childress (2001), Casey Jacobsen (1999) and Jarron and Jason Collins (1997) as Stanford athletes with the honor.

FIVE-STAR CLASS OF 2023

Adding a pair of highly-touted student-athletes to the program in the class of 2023, Stanford signed Kanaan Carlyle (Atlanta, Ga.) and Andrej Stojakovic (Carmichael, Calif.) to national letters of intent. Carlyle is rated a five-star prospect by Rivals and the 247 composite, ranking as high as the 19th-rated recruit in the country from Rivals. Stojakovic is also a five-star signee via the 247 composite rankings and is ranked No. 17 overall nationally by 247 Sports. Both prospects are rated in ESPN's top-30 overall, with Stanford one of just four schools nationally with multiple top-30 signees, joining Kentucky, Duke and Oregon. Stanford has multiple top-25 signees in the same class for the first time since 2006, when Brook and Robin Lopez committed to play on the Farm.

IN THE PROS

Stanford boasts five NBA alumni entering the 2022-23 season: Ziaire Williams (Memphis Grizzlies), Brook Lopez (Milwaukee Bucks), Robin Lopez (Cleveland Cavaliers), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks) and KZ Okpala (Sacramento Kings), while a plethora of alumni are plying their trade in leagues around the world. Additionally, Chasson Randle spent the preseason with the Denver Nuggets and Landry Fields was promoted to general manager of the Atlanta Hawks in the offseason. The Cardinal has had an NBA Draft selection in three of the past four seasons, one of 17 teams nationally to have done so.

Brook Lopez is an early candidate for NBA Defensive Player of the Year honors, ranking second in blocks with 118 (2.5 per game), to go along with 14.5 points and 6.2 rebounds per game, through games on Jan. 26, while shooting a slash line of 50/38/78. Dwight Powell is coming off a season-high 22 points on Jan. 24 against Washington, and is shooting 72.9% from the field this season. Ziaire Williams has had nine or more points in seven of his last 11 outings, including 16 against Orlando and Phoenix.

A BALANCING ACT

Stanford has had balanced scoring through 19 games, as 11 different players have had at least one game in double-figure scoring, which ranks second among all power conference teams (Ole Miss, 12). Five players have had a 20-point game this season, a total which is matched in the Pac-12 only by Arizona.

THREE BALL, AGARWAL

Ryan Agarwal has had a great start to his career from beyond the arc, ranking first in the Pac-12 in 3-point percentage at 47.1% and fourth in Pac-12 games at 45.5%, though he has fallen off the Pac-12 leaderboards after missing the last four games. Agarwal has connected on multiple treys against three Pac-12 opponents, UCLA, Colorado and Washington, and two non-league foes, Cal Poly and Green Bay, Agarwal is on pace for a top-three single-season mark by a freshman in 3-point percentage in program history (min. 25 FGA).

Agarwal ranks third nationally among true freshmen in 3-point percentage (min. 1 3PM per game), and is third for first among all power conference freshmen, along with St. John's guard AJ Storr.

FORCING TURNOVERS

The Cardinal defense has escalated its pressure over the past 15 games, forcing at least 15 turnovers seven times and a season-best 27 against Green Bay, which were the most for Stanford under head coach Jerod Haase, and the most for the Cardinal since causing 27 against UC Davis on Nov. 28, 2006. The Cardinal is averaging 6.8 steals per game in Pac-12 play, led by at least one per game from Spencer Jones, Michael Jones and Michael O'Connell. The Cardinal has forced five Pac-12 opponents into at least 16 turnovers, with the opponents averaging 13.7 per game in conference play, and boasts the league's third-best turnover margin (+1.8).

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season (4.6 per game). Stanford's individual totals (194 combined, 9.7 per game) are as follows:
