SETTING THE SCENE

5-11, 0-6 Pac-12

Stanford finishes its two-game stretch in the Evergreen State, taking on Washington State on Saturday, Jan. 14 at 5 p.m. The contest will be broadcast on Pac-12 Network.

THE OPENING TIP

- The Cardinal is 5-11 (0-6 Pac-12) to open the campaign, including home wins over Pacific (88-78), Cal Poly (80-43) and Green Bay (85-40) and neutral site wins over Florida State (70-60) and Loyola Chicago (75-62).
- Through 16 games, Spencer Jones leads the team with 12.3 points per game, and joined Stanford's 1,000-point club on Dec. 29 with a 25-point outing against Colorado. Jones paces the program in Pac-12 play with 16.2 points per game, which ranks fourth in the league. He also ranks fourth in made triples, sixth in free throw percentage and third in offensive rebounds.
- Harrison Ingram, who was Stanford's first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year since Casey Jacobsen in 2000, withdrew his name from the 2022 NBA Draft to return to The Farm for his sophomore campaign. He is the first Pac-12 Freshman of the Year to return since Jahii Carson (Arizona State) in 2013-14.
- The Cardinal returns eight of its top nine rotation players from a year ago, ranking sixth nationally in minutes continuity, per KenPom, while also bringing in the program's first transfer in 12 years and the first graduate transfer in program history in Michael Jones (Davidson). Jones had a game to remember in the season opener, with his 31 points the most by a Stanford player in his team debut on record. The 31 points remain tied for the best single-game mark by a Pac-12 player this season.
- Stanford has won 10 of the last 12 meetings with the Cougars, and five of the last six matchups in Pullman. The Cardinal won on the Palouse by five a year ago, 62-57.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES

Stanford is led in the scoring column by Spencer Jones and Michael Jones, with the former ranking fourth in Pac-12 play at 16.2 points per game. Michael Jones averages 9.0 points and a team-leading 2.8 assists per game in conference action, and 9.9 points overall on the season. Both Jones are among the four Stanford players averaging at least one steal per game in conference action, while Spencer Jones is posting 1.0 blocks per game to lead the team. Stanford is making 7.7 threes per game in Pac-12 play, which ranks second overall, and is second in offensive rebounds (12.2) and third in steals (7.5) per night.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH **DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE**

In his first six seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 98 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time since 2015. The 2020 team was set to be postseason bound before the cancellation of the NCAA Tournament.

Stanford won 16 games in 2021-22, including the program's first win over an AP top-five opponent since 2007 and its first over a top-25 team on the road since 2014. Harrison Ingram was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year – Stanford's first since 2000 - while Spencer Jones blossomed into an All-Pac-12 conference forward. Sam Beskind was named Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, becoming the program's third honoree in the last five seasons.

The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country as one of two players to average 18 points, six rebounds and two assists per game while shooting over 55 percent from the floor. He was also named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year.

The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the ment berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign.

Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase Joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearage in the NIT. appearance in the NIT.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters the matchup with the Huskies at No. 149 in the NET Rankings (Jan. 13), with a NET SOS of 42 and an average opponent NET rank of 38. The matchup is currently a quadrant one contest, as Washington State slots in at No. 68. 20 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are currently slated to be in quadrant one or two, and 10 of the remaining 15. Stanford has six remaining Q1 opportunities.

PALOUSE PATTERNS

Stanford has controlled the recent history with the Cougars, winning 10 of the last 12 matchups and five of the last six at Beasley Coliseum. Spencer Jones averaged 20.0 points per game against Washington State last season, and averages 11.8 in his career against the Cougars, while Michael O'Connell averages 7.8 for his career in the series. O'Connell also set a program record in Pullman in 2021 with 52 minutes played in the second-longest game in program history, a 30T thriller.

A BALANCING ACT

Stanford has had balanced scoring through 15 games, as 11 different players have had at least one game in double-figure scoring, which ranks second among all power conference teams (Ole Miss, 12). Five players have had a 20-point game this season, a total which is matched in the Pac-12 only by Arizona.

50TH TO REACH 1,000

A high-scoring weekend against Colorado and Utah helped Spencer Jones cross the 1,000 point threshold. Jones scored a season-high 25 points against Colorado, his eighth-career 20-point outing, and added 16 against Utah. The senior became the program's 50th member of the 1,000-point club, and has moved into 42nd on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,053 points. He is eight points away from breaking into the top-40 by passing Josh Childress.

FIVE-STAR CLASS OF 2023

Adding a pair of highly-touted student-athletes to the program in the class of 2023, Stanford signed Kanaan Carlyle (Atlanta, Ga.) and Andrej Stojakovic (Carmichael, Calif.) to national letters of intent. Carlyle is rated a five-star prospect by Rivals and the 247 composite, ranking as high as the 19th-rated recruit in the country from Rivals. Stojakovic is also a five-star signee via the 247 composite rankings and is ranked No. 17 overall nationally by 247 Sports. Both prospects are rated in ESPN's top-30 overall, with Stanford one of just four schools nationally with multiple top-30 signees, joining Kentucky, Duke and Oregon. Stanford has multiple top-25 signees in the same class for the first time since 2006, when Brook and Robin Lopez committed to play on the Farm.

FORCING TURNOVERS

The Cardinal defense has escalated its pressure over the past 11 games, forcing at least 15 turnovers six times and a season-best 27 against Green Bay, which were the most for Stanford under head coach Jerod Haase, and the most for the Cardinal since causing 27 against UC Davis on Nov. 28, 2006. The Cardinal is averaging 7.3 steals per game over the last 11 outings, led by at least one per game from three players: Spencer Jones, Michael Jones and James Keefe. The Cardinal has forced four Pac-12 opponents into at least 16 turnovers, with the opponents averaging 14.5 per game in conference play, and boasts the league's third-best turnover margin at plus-2.2. The 14.5 turnovers forced per night ranks second in the league, behind only Colorado (14.7).

THREE BALL, AGARWAL

Ryan Agarwal has had a great start to his career from beyond the arc, ranking third in the Pac-12 in 3-point percentage at 47.1% and fourth in Pac-12 games at 45.5%. He is one of five players league wide to have at least 10 made threes while shooting 40 percent in Pac-12 play, with Agarwal connecting on multiple treys against UCLA, Colorado and Washington State.

IN THE PROS

Stanford boasts five NBA alumni entering the 2022-23 season: Ziaire Williams (Memphis Grizzlies), Brook Lopez (Milwaukee Bucks), Robin Lopez (Cleveland Cavaliers), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks) and KZ Okpala (Sacramento Kings), while a plethora of alumni are plying their trade in leagues around the world. Additionally, Chasson Randle spent the preseason with the Denver Nuggets and Landry Fields was promoted to general manager of the Atlanta Hawks in the offseason.

The Cardinal has had an NBA Draft selection in three of the past four seasons, one of 17 teams nationally to have done so.

Brook Lopez is an early candidate for NBA Defensive Player of the Year honors as the league leader in blocks with 2.6 per game, to go along with 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game, through games on Jan. 13, while shooting a slash line of 50/38/78. Dwight Powell is coming off a season-high 19 points on Dec. 29 against Houston, going 8-for-8 from the field. Powell is shooting 73.5% from the field this season. Williams has started to emerge over his last four games, averaging 11.3 points per game.

SANTA CRUZ SUCCESS

The Cardinal continued its run of success at Kaiser Permanente Arena, beating Loyola Chicago in Santa Cruz on Dec. 22 by 13 points. Stanford went 5-0 in the arena during the COVID-affected 2020-21 slate, including wins over Arizona, UCLA, Washington, Washington State and Cal State Bakersfield.

Harrison Ingram scored 15 points to lead the win over the Ramblers, while James Keefe added 14 points. eight rebounds and three steals. Michael Jones had 12 points and Michael O'Connell had a season-high 10 in the win, as the team shot 50 percent from the field with 11 different players on the scoresheet.

JONESING FOR JONES

Spencer Jones garnered his first All-Pac-12 awards with honorable mention selections to the all-conference and all-defense teams last season. The swingman was the team's leading scorer at 12.0 points per game, while averaging 4.5 rebounds per night. He was one of six players league-wide last season to earn all-conference and all-defense honors. Establishing himself as one of the best 3-point shooters in program history, the sniper has 214 career threes, which ranks sixth all-time in program history. He is now four triples away from matching Anthony Brown 15 for fifth place and eight away from fourth, currently held by Casey Jacobsen '02.

Jones is averaging 12.3 points, 4.4 rebounds and 1.3 blocks per game through 15 appearances, the last of which ranks seventh in the Pac-12 and first among perimeter players. Jones is tied with Lawrence Hill '09 for 15th on the program's all-time blocks list with 83.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATION

Stanford was picked fifth in the Pac-12's preseason poll, earning one first place vote while slotting in behind UCLA, Arizona, Oregon and USC. Spencer Jones and Harrison Ingram were each on the Pac-12 preseason first team, with Stanford joining only UCLA and USC with multiple players on the first team. Ingram also earned a selection to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year watch list for the second consecutive season, as well as nods to the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award watch lists.

FROM THE BACKCOURT TO HEAD COACH

Head coach Jerod Haase played with a pair of star guards in his collegiate career at California and Kansas, occupying a starting spot in the backcourt alongside Dallas Mavericks head coach Jason Kidd at Cal and Brooklyn Nets head coach Jacque Vaughn at Kansas.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season (4.6 per game). Stanford's individual totals (155 combined, 9.7 per game) are as follows:
