Named UNCW's 11th head coach on April 3, 2017...Came to the coast after 14 seasons on the staff of Hall of Fame Coach Roy Williams at North Carolina...Lettered four years as a point guard for Williams at Kansas and served on his staff in Lawrence for four years before moving with his mentor to Chapel Hill...Has coached in seven Final Fours and owns rings for three national championships (2005, 2009 and 2017) with Tar Heels...Multi-sport athlete at Topeka West High School...Named Kansas Basketball Player-of-the-Year in 1994...1998 graduate of Kansas...Native of Indianapolis, Ind...Age 42.

► **HEAD COACH JEROD HAASE OF STANFORD**

Overall Record: 114-86 (.570), 7th Season

Record at SU: 34-33 (.507), 3rd Season

In third season in Palo Alto after heading up the program at UAB for four years...Named Stanford's head coach on March 25, 2016, succeeding Johnny Dawkins...Led UAB to back-to-back 20-win seasons in 2015 and 2016...Piloted the Blazers to third round of NCAA Tournament in 2016...Also took UAB to NIT in 2016...Led Cardinal to second round of 2018 NIT, finishing with a 19-16 overall record and third place finish in Pac-12...Began collegiate career at California before transferring to Kansas...Served four years on bench for Roy Williams at KU and then followed Williams to North Carolina for an eight-year stay in Chapel Hill...Native of South Lake Tahoe, Nev...Age 44.

Head Coach C.B. McGrath

Colin Bryan (C.B.) McGrath, an assistant coach on The University of North Carolina's 2005, 2009 and 2017 national championship teams, was named the 11th men's basketball history in UNCW history on April 3, 2017.

In his first season on the coast, McGrath piloted the Seahawks to an 11-21 record and sixth place finish in the Colonial Athletic Association, fashioning an 8-5 home mark and reaching the semifinals of the CAA Tournament.

A native of Indianapolis, McGrath, 42, spent 14 seasons with Hall of Fame Coach Roy Williams at North Carolina. He lettered four years as a point guard under Williams at Kansas and served on his staff in Lawrence for four years before moving with his mentor to the Tar Heel state.

McGrath is recognized as one of the nation's foremost recruiters and bench coaches. In addition, McGrath oversaw UNC's clinics and coached the junior varsity team in Chapel Hill.

McGrath's association with Williams goes back to his days as a walk-on player at Kansas. McGrath earned a scholarship before the start of his freshman season and was a top reserve behind First-Team All-American Jacque Vaughn 27354in 1994-95 and Ryan Robertson as a senior.

The Jayhawks did not lose a home game during McGrath's time in Lawrence, going a perfect 58-0 during his career.

A tri-captain for KU in 1997-98 and a two-time Academic All-Big 12 selection, McGrath appeared in 112 games for the Jayhawks, scoring 82 points, with 35 steals and 113 assists, including a better than 2:1 assist-turnover ratio. McGrath's first collegiate bucket was a three-pointer at N.C. State's Reynolds Coliseum.

McGrath is one of 20 members of his family who attended Kansas.

Overall, McGrath has served on Williams' staff in seven Final Four appearances, including the last two with the Tar Heels. McGrath was an assistant coach on UNC's 2005, 2009 and 2017 NCAA Championship teams.

McGrath was a multi-sport standout at Topeka West High School and earned a total of 13 varsity letters in basketball, cross country, track and field and golf from 1991-94. He was named the Kansas Basketball Player-of-the-Year as a senior, placed in the top-10 in the state in cross country and golf and was inducted into the Topeka West High School Hall of Fame in 2001.

McGrath earned his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Human Biology from the University of Kansas in 1998 and completed his Master's Degree in Education at KU in 2000.

McGrath's wife, Kris, played tennis at KU, where she was the Big-12 Player-of-the-Year in 1999. The couple has twin daughters, Kate and Addison, and a son, Hunter.

The C.B. McGrath Timeline

April 3, 2017: The UNCW Board of Trustees approves the appointment of University of North Carolina assistant coach C.B. McGrath as UNCW's new head men's basketball coach.

April 6, 2017: C.B. McGrath is introduced as the 10th head men's basketball coach in the program's history during a press conference in Trask Coliseum.

April 12, 2017: Mercer assistant coach Doug Esleek becomes the first member of C.B. McGrath's new coaching staff.

April 14, 2017: Former North Carolina defensive standout Jackie Manuel is named assistant men's basketball coach.

April 27, 2017: C.B. McGrath completes his on-the-floor coaching staff with the hiring of former North Carolina star and NBA veteran Joe Wolf.

April 28, 2017: C.B. McGrath begins to build his first recruiting class with the signing of talented guard Jay Esteime to a National Letter of Intent.

May 11, 2017: Former Youngstown State staffer Matt Lynch joins the Seahawks as video coordinator on C.B. McGrath's staff.

May 17, 2017: Long distance shooter Jeffrey Gary of Colorado Springs, Colo., signs a NLI to play for C.B. McGrath in 2017-18.

May 18, 2017: Coffeyville (Ks.) Community College seven-footer Trey Kalina becomes the fourth recruit for C.B. McGrath.

May 24, 2017: Rob Burke joins the staff of C.B. McGrath as Director of Basketball Operations.

Nov. 11, 2017: C.B. McGrath picks up his first career victory and first home win as the Seahawks crush NCAA Division II N.C. Wesleyan, 105-81, at Trask Coliseum.

Jan. 2, 2018: C.B. McGrath notches his first Colonial Athletic Association victory when the Seahawks steamroll Drexel, 107-87, at Trask Coliseum.

Jan. 11, 2018: C.B. McGrath picks up his first CAA road victory in an 80-78 thriller at Elon in UNCW's final appearance at Alumni Gym.

Feb. 24, 2018: The Seahawks win a thriller, 83-82, at Drexel in the final regular season game in C.B. McGrath's first season on the bench.

Mar. 4, 2018: UNCW upsets No. 3 Hofstra, 93-88, in the semifinals of the 2018 CAA Tournament to give McGrath his first conference tournament victory.

► NATIONAL TREASURE

Devontae Cacok became only the fourth player in NCAA Division I history to lead the nation in separate statistical categories in back-to-back years, joining Shaquille O'Neal (1991-rpg, 1992-bpg), Jason Kidd (1993-spg, 1994-apg) and Stephen Sir (2006-3pct, 2007-3pt) in the elite category.

► CACOK SETS SINGLE SEASON MARK

With 17 rebounds in the win over Elon on Feb. 15 at Trask Coliseum, junior forward Devontae Cacok smashed the longtime record of 345 rebounds set by all-time great Brian Rowsom in 1986-87, finishing with 431 boards.

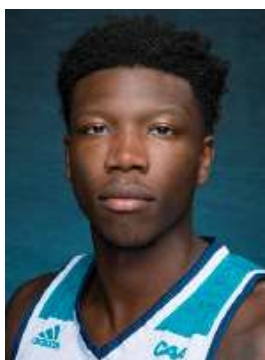

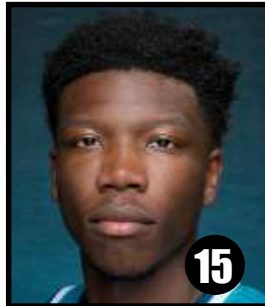
