SETTING THE SCENE

Hitting the road for the final trip of the regular season slate, Stanford men's basketball heads to Utah for a 5:30 p.m. PT matchup on Feb. 29. The game will be broadcast on Pac-12 Network.

THE OPENING TIP

• Stanford is 12-15 this season (7-10 Pac-12) with conference wins over then-No. 4 Arizona, Arizona State, Utah, UCLA, USC, Washington and Oregon State. Stanford entered the week as one of nine major conference teams with five players in double-figure scoring: Maxime Raynaud, Kanaan Carlyle, Brandon Angel, Spencer Jones and Michael Jones.

• Raynaud leads the Cardinal with 15.3 points per night and a team-leading 9.9 rebounds per game, while Angel is next at 13.4 points per game. Raynaud is 12th in the Pac-12 in scoring and third in rebounds.

• Michael Jones and Angel both rank in the top-20 nationally in effective field goal percentage and the top-15 in true shooting percentage. Stanford is the only program with multiple players fitting both categories, while both Cardinal players are in the top-50 nationally in 3-point shooting (KenPom).

• Stanford once again welcomed a top-20 recruiting class, led by five-star signee and McDonald's All-American Andrej Stojakovic and top-50 rated Kanaan Carlyle. Stojakovic is averaging 8.2 points per game, including five performances of at least 16 points, while Carlyle has scored in double figures in 11 appearances this season, including 31 points against Washington State on Jan. 18.

THE FIRST BATTLE WITH THE UTES

Stanford bested Utah on Jan. 14 at Maples Pavilion, 79-73. Maxime Raynaud led four players in double figures with 20 points, tallying his then-fifth double-double of the season with 11 rebounds as well as three blocked shots. Brandon Angel pitched in 16 points with seven rebounds and three assists, while Michael Jones scored 15 points with four assists. Kanaan Carlyle was in double figures for the fifth time in his first six Pac-12 games, ending the afternoon with 12 points.

Stanford has picked up three straight wins over Utah, which was NET 19 at the time of the Jan. 14 win.

HISTORY FOR SPENCER JONES

Spencer Jones became the program's 50th member of the Stanford 1,000-point club a year ago, and he has moved into 12th on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,558 points. Jones is eight points away from tying for 10th, and he would pass Anthony Brown '15 (1,562) and Claude Terry '72 (1,566) along the way.

Establishing himself as one of the best 3-point shooters in program history, the sniper has 306 career threes, breaking the program record previously held by Chasson Randle '15 and ranking seventh in Pac-12 history. He remains 40 away from beating former Oregon guard Tajuan Porter for the all-time Pac-12 record. Next up on the Pac-12 list in sixth place are former UCLA wing Jason Kapono at 317 threes and former Arizona guard Jason Gardner in fifth at 318.

Jones also tied the Stanford single-game 3-point record with eight makes against Washington on Jan. 20, and he became first player in program history to make the Stanford top-10 in both steals (6th) and blocks (10th).

3-POINT SHOOTING

Stanford returns one of the leading 3-point shooting teams in the country. The Cardinal paced the Pac-12 in 3-point proclivity in conference play a year ago (37.9%), while the team led the country after Jan. 19 last season with a 42.6 percent clip from deep.

Stanford shoots 38.1 percent from three this season, second-best in the Pac-12 and ranking 13th in the country. The Cardinal is eighth in the nation in 3-point percentage (40.2%) since Pac-12 play began on Dec. 29. The Cardinal is led by four players at over 37.5 percent: Brandon Angel (45.3%), Michael Jones (44.2%), Spencer Jones (39.8%) and Maxime Raynaud (37.5%). Michael Jones leads the team with 50 triples and is one of four Cardinal over 41% in Pac-12 play (49.2%), joining Angel (46.7%), Raynaud (47.1%) and Spencer Jones (41.2%).

Stanford ranks first in the Pac-12 with 9.3 made triples per game, increasing its output at home (10.2 per game, 41.6% as a team). The Cardinal hit a program-record 19 triples against USC (Feb. 10), breaking a mark of 16 it set earlier this season against then No. 4 Arizona (Dec. 31, on just 25 attempts, 64%). Stanford has at least 10 threes this season on 11 occasions.

Stanford leads the Pac-12 in conference games with 9.97 made triples per night, doing so on a league-best 40.2% shooting.

MR. EFFICIENCY

Brandon Angel continues to be one of the most versatile and efficient players in the country. He is averaging 13.4 points per game on shooting splits of 57.6/45.3/86.6, and he is the only player nationally meeting all four benchmarks. He is sixth nationally in true shooting percentage (69.0%) and 19th in effective field goal percentage (64.8%), per KenPom.

Angel ended the 2022-23 season in similar fashion, posting 14.1 points, 5.3 rebounds and 2.4 assists per game from Feb. 1 through the end of the season while shooting 64.5 percent from the field and 69.0 percent from 3-point range – making him the only player nationally to hit those benchmarks over that time frame. Angel is a star in the classroom as well, earning CSC Academic All-America status in 2022-23 and completing an honors thesis as a senior in 2023-24.

CAUGHT FIRE VS. USC

Setting a program record with 19 made 3-pointers, including a program-best 12 in the first half, Stanford men's basketball routed USC, 99-68, in front of a sold-out crowd at Maples Pavilion on Feb. 10. Stanford went 19-for-38 from 3-point range, besting its previous all-time best of 16 from earlier this season (Dec. 31 vs. Arizona). The Cardinal was 12-for-19 in the first half, while the 19 total makes are tied for the most nationally this season by any team against a Division I opponent. The mark also tied the record for most made threes by a Pac-12 team in the Pac-12 era (since 2011-12).

RAYNAUD DOUBT ABOUT IT

Maxime Raynaud has tallied 10 double-doubles this season, including seven of the last 13 games. He ranks third the Pac-12 in conference play with 10.3 rebounds per game and is 20th nationally with 9.9 per game over the entire season (third in the Pac-12). He has three games of at least 15 points and 15 rebounds and is the first Stanford player since Curtis Borchardt (6, 2001-02) to have four games of at least 15 rebounds in one season and the first since Reid Travis (16, 2016-17) to have at least 10 double-doubles in a season. He scored a career-high 29 points twice, and would be the first Cardinal player to average a double-double in conference play since Borchardt in 2001-02.

Raynaud is posting 15.7 points and 10.3 rebounds in Pac-12 play, including six games at 20 or more points. He is making a strong case for Pac-12 Most Improved Player of the Year: Among the top-15 scorers and rebounders in the Pac-12 (no transfers), no player grew more in the scoring column (6.5 per game) or rebound column (3.8 per game) than Raynaud, through games of Feb. 27.

The seven-footer returned to campus this summer with a gold medal around his neck, earning top honors with France at the FIBA U20 European Championship. Raynaud led France in scoring (14.0) and rebounding (5.0) while shooting 66.7 percent from the field and 87.5 percent (7-for-8) from 3-point range. He capped the event with a 26-point showing in the championship game against Israel.

A FRESHMAN RECORD FALLS

Kanaan Carlyle is off to a tremendous start to his Stanford career, breaking the Cardinal's single-game freshman scoring record with 31 points against Washington State. The mark, previously 30, was held by Chasson Randle (March 7, 2012 vs. Arizona State) and Todd Lichti (Dec. 22, 1985 vs. Seton Hall). The 31 points are the fourth-most by a true freshman in any major conference this season and the eighth-most by any freshman in the country – true or redshirt. The last Pac-12 true freshman to have at least 31 in a game was Arizona's Benedict Mathurin on Jan. 14, 2021 (31 vs Oregon State).

CARD DOWNS TOP-5 ARIZONA, AGAIN

Stanford knocked off a top-five Arizona team for the second season in a row, winning 100-82 over the No. 4 Wildcats on New Year's Eve. Stanford has scored a top five AP victory in each of the past three seasons, having also downed No. 5 USC in 2021-22. The Cardinal joined Arizona as the only two programs in the country with a top five win in each of the last three seasons. The win was the third for Stanford over Arizona in the last four meetings in the Bay Area. The Cardinal has eight ranked wins since the calendar turned to 2020, including five wins at Maples Pavilion. The 100 Stanford points were its most in program history over an AP ranked foe, and the most against Arizona in program history.

THROWBACK UNIFORMS

Stanford tipped off against the Trojans in throwback red uniforms, honoring the Cardinal teams from the late 1990s and early 2000s. It matches Stanford's throwback white version, which was unveiled a year ago. The uniform is noted for its parallel stripes, number-within-a-number and a men's basketball-specific Stanford 'S' that was seen during the era. Worn intermittently the rest of the season, the uniform was previously featured on the covers of Sports Illustrated and ESPN's College Hoops 2K5 video game.

NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kanaan Carlyle introduced himself to the college basketball world with a then-career-high 28 points to lead Stanford to victory over Arizona on Dec. 31. The 28 points were the most for a Stanford freshman since Chasson Randle scored 30 against Arizona State at the 2012 Pac-12 Tournament, and his 28 points off the bench are the most for Stanford since Aaron Bright had 29 points in 2012 against Illinois State. Carlyle was honored as the Associated Press National Player of the Week, Dick Vitale's Diaper Dandy of the Week and the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week.

SEASON OF GIVING

Stanford is sharing the ball at an elite level, averaging 16.7 assists per night - behind a school record 18.3 per game in 1988-89 and the most for Stanford since averaging 17.1 per game in 1999-00. The Cardinal offense has benefitted as a result, scoring 76.9 points per game - which is on pace for the eighth-best average in program history. Only four Stanford teams have averaged more than 80 points per game in program history, the last in 2001-02. Stanford ranks 23rd nationally in assists per game.

STOJAKOVIC STANDS OUT

Andrej Stojakovic earned his first weekly honor from the Pac-12 on Dec. 18 as he was named the league's Freshman of the Week. In his fifth start of the campaign, the Carmichael, California native poured in 17 points on 7-for-11 shooting with a trio of makes from 3-point range. The honor was Stanford's 11th Freshman of the Week since award's inception in 2019-20, trailing only USC's 13 (now 14-12). He joins Tyrell Terry (2), Ziaire Williams (1), Michael O'Connell (1) and Harrison Ingram (6) as past Cardinal recipients, and Kanaan Carlyle (1) in 2024. Stanford is the only Pac-12 school with multiple unique winners this season.

BEST OF BOTH WORLDS

Stanford's success extends beyond the court and into the classroom, where the Cardinal captured a series of major academic awards a year ago. Brandon Angel and Michael Jones joined a select group of men's basketball alumni before them with selections to the College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-America third team. It was the first year in program history with multiple selections, with Angel and Jones becoming the 13th and 14th Stanford players to be awarded the accolade. James Keefe was Stanford's third straight Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, making the Cardinal the first basketball program in conference history - men or women - to earn the award in three consecutive seasons. There have been 12 teams of any sport to win three straight times, with eight of those being Stanford programs, and the program would be the fifth to win four straight, joining only Stanford programs (M Rowing, W Soccer, W Swimming, W Volleyball - 1x each).

GOING GLOBAL

Stanford embarked on a foreign tour from August 20-30 in France and Greece. The trip was the second for the Cardinal under head coach Jerod Haase, with the program previously visiting Italy and Germany in 2019. The Cardinal spent five days in Paris, including contests with Nanterre 92 and Tremblay, and four days in Athens, with a game against Lavrio. Stanford also visited Normandy's historic World War II beaches and famous historical sites in Paris, such as the Eiffel Tower and Sacre Couer, among others, and in Athens, including the Acropolis.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season (4.6 per game). Stanford's individual totals from this season (203 combined, 7.5 per game) are as follows:

JEROD HAASE

Anne and Tony Director of Men's Basketball Eighth Season at Stanford

In his first seven seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 112 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time since 2015. The 2020 team was set to be postseason bound before the cancellation of the NCAA Tournament.

The Cardinal won 14 games in 2022-23 and closed the season as one of the top offensive programs in the country. Stanford downed a top-five opponent for the second consecutive year and ended the season with a top-25 offense nationally. James Keefe was Stanford's third straight Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, while Brandon Angel and Michael Jones were named CSC Academic All-Americans. Spencer Jones was an All-Pac-12 forward for the second season in a row.

The streak of elite recruiting continued for Haase and his program, with Stanford signing Andrej Stojakovic, the team's third McDonald's All-American in four years, and Kanaan Carlyle, a top-40 signee. The top-tier class is Stanford's first with two top-40 recruits since 2006 (Brook & Robin Lopez).

Stanford added 16 wins in 2021-22, including the program's first win over an AP top-five opponent since 2007 and its first over a top-25 team on the road since 2014. Harrison Ingram was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year – Stanford's first since 2000 – while Spencer Jones blossomed into an All-Pac-12 conference forward. Sam Beskind was named Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year, becoming the program's third honoree in the last five seasons.

The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country as one of two players to average 18 points, six rebounds and two assists per game while shooting over 55 percent from the floor. He was also named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year. The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20 and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04 and was led by junior Oscar da Silva (15.7 ppg, 6.4 rpg) and Tyrell Terry (14.6 ppg, 4.5 rpg, 3.2 apg), who emerged as one of the nation's top freshmen. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Several players have flourished under Haase's tutelage. KZ Okpala became Stanford's latest NBA Draft pick in 2019. Along with Okpala's first team all-conference selection and Josh Sharma's All-Pac-12 nod, Reid Travis was a two-time First Team All-Pac-12 selection in 2018 and a two-time NABC All-District pick. Dorian Pickens was named an all-conference player for his performance on the court and the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year for his efforts in the classroom in 2018. Daejon Davis was named to the five-member Pac-12 All-Freshman Team in 2018.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase compiled an 80-53 overall record in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Tabbed the 2016 Gene Bartow Conference USA Coach of the Year, Haase led the Blazers to a 26-5 overall record and a 16-2 conference mark while capturing their first regular-season title since 2011. Along the way, UAB established school records for overall victories (26), conference wins (16), road wins (10) and consecutive victories (14). Also named the 2016 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Coach, Haase directed the Blazers to an NIT berth for the 12th time in school history. UAB also finished 16-0 at home in Haase's final season, extending the nation's fifth-longest home winning streak to 25, while ranking among the nation's best in field goal percentage (.478 – 24th), assists per game (18.4 – 4th) and blocks per game (4th – 6.1).

Under Haase's guidance, UAB returned to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, shocking No. 3 seed Iowa State 60-59 in the second round for the Blazers' first NCAA victory since 2005. UAB reached the Big Dance after claiming the program's first Conference USA Tournament title despite being seeded No. 4. The triumph marked UAB's first league tournament title since 1987, when the Blazers won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. More impressively, Haase successfully developed a roster comprised of 10 underclassmen – all players recruited by Haase and his staff – and finished 20-16 overall while guiding the third-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

The Blazers made impressive strides under Haase's leadership during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing 18-13 overall while notching three victories against teams that qualified for the NCAA Tournament. Of UAB's 18 victories, perhaps none were more impressive than the Blazers' 63-59 home win against No. 16 North Carolina. UAB was ranked in the top five nationally in rebounding throughout the season and finished the year ranked second in the country at 44.5 boards per game. During Haase's first year with the Blazers in 2012-13, UAB won six of its final nine regular-season Conference USA games and collected a victory in the conference tournament.

Prior to UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. A 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration, Haase got his start as Kansas' Director of Operations from 1999-2003. During that time, the Jayhawks reached the 2002 Final Four and the national championship game in 2003. When Williams was named head coach at North Carolina prior to the 2003-04 season, he brought Haase with him as an assistant coach and director of operations, a title Haase held from 2003-09. Haase then served exclusively as an assistant coach during his final three seasons with the Tar Heels.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, Calif., Haase attended California in 1992-93, starting 23 games as a freshman and playing alongside Jason Kidd in the backcourt. Haase then transferred to Kansas, where he helped lead the Jayhawks to three consecutive conference titles and finished his career ranked in the school's top 10 in assists, three-point field goals and steals. Haase started 99 of 101 games at Kansas and scored 1,264 points, averaging 12.5 per game and reaching double figures 74 times. While at Kansas, Haase was a candidate for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.

As a senior in 1996-97, Haase started alongside Jacque Vaughn, Scot Pollard, Paul Pierce and Raef LaFrentz as Kansas finished with a 34-2 record while averaging 12.0 points per game despite playing with a broken wrist. As a sophomore in 1994-95, Haase averaged 15.0 points and was named the Big Eight Conference Newcomer of the Year and also tabbed a second-team all-conference selection. Haase was a first-team GTE Academic All-American as a senior, a second-team Academic All-American as a junior and a three-time academic all-conference pick. The Jayhawks' Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 1997, Haase later earned a master's degree in business at Kansas in 2000.

Haase and his wife, the former Mindy Meidinger, have three children: Gavin (17), Garrett (14) and Gabrielle (11).
