## UW RETURNS TO BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS

- Wisconsin will return to the Bahamas looking to repeat their 2014 Battle 4 Atlantis Championship. The Badgers will play their first of 3 games against Stanford on Wed., Nov. 21 before facing either Florida or Oklahoma.
- After the Battle 4 Atlantis, the Badgers return home to take on NC State on Nov. 27 at the Kohl Center as part of the Big Ten/ACC Challenge. UW is 9-10 all-time in the Challenge, owning the 2nd-most wins in the Big Ten.



**Preseason All-American Ethan Happ is the nation's only player averaging at least 18.0 ppg, 12.0 rpg and 7.0 apg.**

## KEY NOTES TO CONSIDER

- In his fourth season as head coach, Greg Gard has led the Badgers to a mark of 60-36 (.625), the 3rd-highest win percentage in program history (min. 60 games).
- The 4th preseason AP All-American in school history, **Ethan Happ** has opened the season like a *postseason* All-American. After recording just the 2nd triple-double in school history against Coppin State, he followed that up with a 30-point, 13-rebound, 5-assist masterpiece in UW's win at Xavier. He is averaging 18.3 ppg and 12.0 rpg, while leading the Big Ten with 7.7 assists per game. (more on page 4)
- With 911 career boards, senior **Ethan Happ** set UW's all-time rebounding record in Saturday's win. He also currently ranks 7th in UW history in points (1,596), 12th in assists (293), 6th in blocks (114) and 3rd in steals (181). (more on page 8)
- After missing the final 23 games last season with a foot injury, **D'Mitrik Trice** is making up for lost time. The sophomore guard opened the season with back-to-back career highs of 21 points vs. Coppin State and 22 points at Xavier. Trice is shooting 65.0% (13-30) from 3-point range, including a perfect 5-for-5 effort at Xavier.
- Wisconsin is shooting 42.4% from 3-point range this season with 4 players shooting at least 40.0% from downtown. Last season, UW shot just 33.5% from deep.
- Coming off a Big Ten All-Freshman campaign, **Brad Davison** is picking up where he left off. Davison is third on the Badgers in both scoring (11.7 ppg) and rebounding (4.4 rpg).
- UW has demonstrated improved depth this season with its bench combining for 30 points vs. CSU and 41 vs. HBU. UW never had more than 25 bench points in any game last season. Reserve guard **Brevin Pritzl** is averaging 11.0 ppg, shooting 42.9% on 3FGs.
- The Badgers are ranked 14th according to KenPom.com, owning the 14th-ranked offense (113.3 adjusted efficiency) and the 31st-ranked defense (93.5 adjusted efficiency).
- Wisconsin ranks 2nd in the nation averaging just 7.3 turnovers per game. The Badgers also rank 5th in the NCAA with a 2.23 assist-to-turnover ratio (49 dimes, 22 turnovers).
- Wisconsin returns 94.0% (2,074 of 2,206 points) of its scoring in 2018-19, the 7th-highest mark in all of college basketball.

ALL-TIME VS. STANFORD

- Wednesday's Battle 4 Atlantis opener will mark the 10th-ever meeting between Wisconsin and Stanford. The Cardinal lead the all-time series 6-3, but this will be the first meeting since 1994.
Stanford head coach Jerod Haase was the head coach at UAB, when the Badgers and Blazers met in the 2014 Battle 4 Atlantis opener. UW won that meeting, 72-43, en route to the tournament championship.

BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS REWIND

- This will be Wisconsin's second appearance in the Battle 4 Atlantis after winning the tournament in 2014. That year, the Badgers took down UAB (72-43), Georgetown (68-65) and Oklahoma (69-56).
During the 3-game tournament, the Badgers allowed just 54.7 ppg while forcing opponents into 18.3 turnovers per game.
Led by tournament MVP Frank Kaminsky, the Badgers had 4 players average double-figure points -- also Nigel Hayes, Sam Dekker and Duje Dukan.
Wisconsin would go on to win the Big Ten title later that season and advance to the 2015 National Championship Game.
Ethan Happ was a true freshman on that team, sitting out the 2014-15 season as redshirt.

LAST TIME OUT

WISCONSIN 96, HBU 59

Nov. 17, 2018 | Kohl Center | Madison, Wis.

- Wisconsin owned a 54-28 scoring edge in the paint and shot a season-high 60.3% from the field while rolling to a 37-point home win.
With 12 rebounds, senior Ethan Happ set UW's all-time rebounding record, giving him 911 for his career. He also added 15 points and 6 assists, giving him 3 double-doubles in 3 games.
Junior Brevin Pritzl scored a team-high 17 points (5-5 FGs) while sophomore Nate Reuvers posted a career-high 15 points. D'Mitrik Trice (12 points) and Charles Thomas (10 points) also reached double figures.

BADGERS IN NOVEMBER TOURNEYS

The Badgers have played in a non-conference November tournament in 13 of the last 17 years.

- Wisconsin owns a combined record of 22-11 (.667) in November tournaments since 2001.
Wisconsin has won the 2005 Paradise Jam, the 2011 Chicago Invitational, the 2013 Cancun Challenge and the 2014 Battle 4 Atlantis.

- Wisconsin and Stanford haven't met since a 95-78 Cardinal home win in 1994.
The Badgers were in their first season under head coach Stan Van Gundy, following a 2-year stint by Stu Jackson. Mike Montgomery was the Stanford head coach.
This was the return game of a home-and-home series that began with a contest in Madison the year before. In that game, Wisconsin claimed an 80-73 victory on Dec. 27, 1993.
Michael Finley led UW with 19 points and 10 rebounds, while Rashard Griffith tallied 18 points and 9 rebounds.
Brevin Knight led Stanford with 26 points and 9 assists, while Dion Cross added 19 points.
Wisconsin assistant coach Howard Moore was a senior on the Badgers, but did not see action in the game.

### HAPP OFF TO ALL-AMERICAN START

Senior **Ethan Happ** opened the season as just the 4th preseason AP All-American in school history. Through the first 3 games of the season, he's playing like a *postseason* All-American.

- Averaging 18.3 points, 12.0 rebounds and 7.7 assists per game, Happ is the nation's only player averaging even 18.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg and 6.0 apg.
- Happ ranks 6th in the Big Ten in scoring, 3rd in rebounding and leads the B1G in assists.
- Happ posted a triple-double in Wisconsin's opener vs. Coppin State and followed that up with a 30-point, 13-rebound masterpiece in UW's win at Xavier and an efficient 15-point, 13-rebound effort vs. HBU.
- Happ's 30-point performance at Xavier trails only his 32-point effort in 2017 against Rutgers in Madison Square Garden.
- With double-doubles in each of his first 3 games, Happ now has 34 in his career, ranking third behind only Joe Franklin (47 from 1966-68) and Kim Hughes (39 from 1972-74).
- Happ is just the 7th Badger to post multiple games with 30+ points since 1995, joining Devin Harris (3), Nigel Hayes (3), Frank Kaminsky (2), Kirk Penney (2), Jordan Taylor (2) and Alando Tucker (2).

### TRIPLE-DOUBLE HAPP-ENING

- With a pair of swishes at the free throw line with 6:32 remaining in UW's win over Coppin State, **Ethan Happ** authored the second triple-double in UW history. Happ finished with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 12 assists in 26:33 of action.

Josh Gasser is the only other Badger to record a triple-double, posting 10 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists as a freshman at Northwestern on Jan. 23, 2011.

- Happ's is the first triple-double by a Big Ten player since Ohio State's JaQuan Lyle had 16 points, 12 rebounds and 11 assists vs. Rutgers on Jan. 13, 2016.
- Happ's 12 assists signifies a new career high and equals the 3rd-highest total in school history. His 12 assists are the most by a Badger since Mike Kelley dished out 12 vs. Maryland on Nov. 29, 2000.

- Over the last 20 years, Happ is 1 of just 2 players 6-10 or taller to dish out at least 12 assists in a game along with Georgetown's Greg Monroe (12 assists against Providence in 2010).

- Happ is the NCAA's first player to post at least 10p, 11r, 11a and 4b since Dwyane Wade in the 2003 Elite Eight vs. Kentucky (20p, 11r, 11a, 4b).

### TRIPLE-DOUBLE HAPP-ENING

Ethan Happ is putting together one of the greatest careers not only in Wisconsin history, but in Big Ten annals (more on page 8).

- Over the last 20 years, only 2 Big Ten players have totaled at least 1,500 points, 900 rebounds and 250 assists: Ethan Happ and Michigan State's Draymond Green (1,517p, 1,095r, 425a).
- Happ needs 404 points and 89 rebounds to become 4th player in Big Ten history with 2,000 points, 1,000 rebounds -- joining Greg Kelsner (MSU), Joe Barry Carroll (PUR) and Herb Williams (OSU).

## BADGERS WILL BE ROAD-TESTED

■ For the first time since the 2001-02 season, Wisconsin will play a total of 7 games away from home prior New Year's Day.

In addition to 3 games at the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament, the Badgers will play road games at Xavier (Nov. 13), at Iowa (Nov. 30), at Marquette (Dec. 8) and at Western Kentucky (Dec. 29).

■ Over the last 16 seasons, UW has played more than 5 games away from home in Nov./Dec. just twice, playing 6 in 2014 and 2008.

■ UW has not played 4 or more true road games before New Year's in any season since 2001, when the Badgers played 5 true road games.

## HOME ON THE ROAD

■ UW is renowned for its incredible home success, but it has also been quite good on the road lately.

■ Wisconsin is 63-35 (.643) away from home (road and neutral) over the last 6 seasons. That figure ranks 9th in the NCAA for most wins away from home.

■ Since 2001-02, the Badgers have tallied 100 true road wins, the top mark of any Big Ten team. UW's .532 overall road winning percentage is also the top mark among Big Ten teams.

## D'MITRIK THRICE

Sophomore **D'Mitrik Trice** missed the final 23 games of the 2017-18 season with a foot injury, but he's making up for lost time this season.

■ In the first 2 games of the season, Trice posted back-to-back career-high scoring efforts, notching 21 points against Coppin State and 22 points at Xavier. On the season, he is tied with Ethan Happ with a team-high 18.3 ppg (a figure that ranks 6th in the Big Ten).

■ Trice is doing a lot of his damage from 3-point range, shooting a blistering 13-for-20 (65.0%) from long range. That includes a perfect 5-for-5 effort from downtown at Xavier. As a freshman in 2016-17, Trice led the Badgers, shooting 41.8% from 3-point range.

■ Trice ranks 2nd in the Big Ten with 13 3-point field goals through 3 games.

## DANGEROUS DAVISON

Another Badger playing without injury, sophomore **Brad Davison** is looking to build off a debut season that placed him on the Big Ten All-Freshman Team a year ago.

■ Last season, Davison averaged 12.1 points per game while shooting 35.5% from 3-point range.

Through 3 games this season, Davison ranks third on the Badgers with 11.7 ppg and has hit 6-of-15 triples (40.0%). He is also third on the team with 4.0 rebounds per game.

## TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

■ Wisconsin has committed a total of just 22 turnovers in its first 3 games, ranking 2nd in the nation at just 7.3 TOs per game.

■ The Badgers also rank 5th in the NCAA with 2.23 assist-to-turnover ratio, handing out 49 assists to just 22 turnovers.

■ Individually, **Ethan Happ** ranks 7th in the Big Ten with a 3.8 assist-to-turnover ratio (23 assists, 6 TOs). **D'Mitrik Trice** has a 4.0 ratio with 8 assists to just 2 turnovers.

■ For his career, Trice has a 1.81 assist-to-turnover ratio (94-52), a mark that would rank 9th in school history, but he falls 6 dimes short of the minimum 100 to qualify.

■ Since 2001-02, Wisconsin has averaged 10.1 turnovers per game, the nation's lowest mark. Temple is 2nd over that stretch (10.6 TOs / game).

■ In the 2014-15 season, UW led the nation and set an NCAA record averaging a mere 7.40 turnovers per game.

■ In fact, the Badgers hold the NCAA record and 3 of the top 4 spots on the single-season record list for fewest turnovers per game.

### OFF TO A B1G START

- In the first 2 weeks of non-conference play, the Big Ten has amassed a 40-4 combined record (entering 11/18). That .909 winning percentage ranks first among all Division I conferences.
- Big Ten teams have defeated three ranked teams this week: #18 Michigan def. #8 Villanova, Iowa def. #13 Oregon and Indiana def. #24 Marquette. The Big Ten also won the Gavitt Tipoff Games against the Big East with a record of 5-3.

### FORD OUT WITH LEG INJURY

Wisconsin has opened the season without the services of sophomore forward **Aleem Ford**, who is out indefinitely after suffering a leg injury on Oct. 29. Ford is expected to return later this season.

- Ford appeared in all 33 games last season, starting 20. He averaged 5.8 points and 2.8 rebounds, shooting a team-high 40.9% (45-110) from 3-point range. A native of Lawrenceville, Georgia, Ford's 45 3FGs ranked as the fifth-highest freshman total in UW history.

### TOP-10 TAKEDOWNS

- Since taking over as head coach on Dec. 15, 2015, Greg Gard has guided UW to 6 wins over teams ranked in the AP top-10. The Badgers are 6-7 against top-10 teams under Gard. Among Big Ten teams, only Michigan (7-7) has more top-10 wins and a higher win percentage against top-10 teams in that span.

### INDIVIDUAL NOTES

#### Ethan Happ - Senior - Forward

Already one of the most-accomplished players in school history, Ethan Happ returns for his senior season looking to cement his status as one of the Big Ten's all-time greats. A two-time first-team All-Big Ten selection, two-time Big Ten All-Defensive Team pick and 2017 All-American, Happ enters the 2018-19 season with a chance to finish his career ranked in UW's top three of nearly every category. The Milan, Illinois' versatility was on display last season as he became the first Big Ten player to lead his team in points, rebounds, assists, blocks and steals since 1995-96. Known for his hard work and durability (has started all 108 games in his career), Happ earned his bachelor's degree in May of 2018 and will spend his final year of eligibility pursuing a master's degree in Educational Leadership and Policy Analysis.



### RAREST OF FEATS

Ethan Happ is the NCAA's first player 6-10 or taller to record a triple-double with points, rebounds and assists since Northwestern's Evan Eschmeyer (27p, 14r, 10a) did it against Indiana in 1999.

#### ■ Trevor Anderson - Sophomore - Guard

Trevor Anderson is set to make his Wisconsin debut in 2018-19 after sitting out last season as a transfer from Green Bay. In one year with the Phoenix, Anderson started the first 20 games as a true freshman before suffering a back injury that cost him the remainder of the season. A physical point guard who led Stevens Point Area Senior High to back-to-back state championships, Anderson averaged 9.8 points and 2.7 assists per game for Green Bay in 2016-17.

#### ■ Brad Davison - Sophomore - Guard

A relentless competitor and natural-born leader, Brad Davison put together one of the best freshman seasons in recent UW history in 2017-18. A Big Ten All-Freshman Team selection, Davison started the final 29 games of the season and flourished after taking over the point guard reins when D'Mitrik Trice was lost to a season-ending injury. The physical, combo guard scored in double figures 20 times in his debut season, demonstrating the ability to attack the rim and get to the foul line while setting UW's freshman 3-point field goal record (60). A two-sport prep standout on the hardwood and gridiron in Maple Grove, Minnesota, Davison enters his sophomore season healthy after playing 2017-18 with a left shoulder injury that included 8 dislocations during the season.

#### ■ Aleem Ford - Sophomore - Forward

Aleem Ford turned heads last season, appearing in all 33 games (20 starts) and playing 24.4 minutes in his first season of action at Wisconsin. Now a redshirt sophomore, Ford has added 15 pounds and looks to build on a season in which he led the Badgers shooting 40.9% from 3-point range. Ford sustained a leg injury on Oct. 29 and is out indefinitely, but is expected to return later this season. A native of Lawrenceville, Georgia, Ford spent a season at IMG Academy before joining the Badgers. A lengthy wing, Ford combines a soft-shooting touch with a slashing ability to get to the rim.

#### ■ Kobe King - Freshman - Guard

An athletic combo guard, Kobe King returns from an injury-shortened freshman season. King averaged 19.0 minutes and 5.2 points per game during the first 10 games of last season before suffering a season-ending knee injury. King was granted a medical hardship and will retain his freshman eligibility in 2018-19. Even in the short sample size, the former Wisconsin Mr. Basketball showed off a versatile skill set equally adept at attacking the rim and stretching the floor.

#### ■ Khalil Iverson - Senior - Forward

One of the most explosive athletes in the Big Ten, Khalil Iverson broke into Wisconsin's starting lineup last year as a junior and enjoyed the best season of his career. Now entering his senior season in 2018-19, Iverson has expanded his game from above-the-rim athlete to all-around player. In addition to highlight-reel dunks, Iverson has shown a knack for scoring in the lane and getting to the free throw line and embraced the role of defensive stopper last season. The Delaware, Ohio, native has scored 517 career points in 104 games at UW, including 35 starts.

#### ■ Brevin Pritzl - Junior - Guard

After emerging as a starter in 2017-18, junior Brevin Pritzl returns for his fourth year at Wisconsin. The hot-shooting guard began his career with a medical hardship when a broken left foot cost him nearly the entire 2015-16 season. He bounced back to appear in 24 games as a redshirt freshman in 2016-17 before averaging over 29 minutes per game last season. Lethal from long range, Pritzl hit multiple 3-pointers in 13 games last season, including a career-high six triples and 20 points vs. Minnesota. The all-time leading scorer in De Pere High School history, Pritzl has rounded out his game since arriving in Madison, ranking third on the team in rebounds and tops in assist-to-turnover in 2017-18.

#### ■ Nate Reuvers - Sophomore - Forward

Nate Reuvers enters year number two after a season of growth both on and off the court as a freshman. At 6-foot-11, Reuvers brings size to the UW frontcourt and now he has added 25 pounds to that frame. An inside-outside threat, Reuvers started 15 of the final 18 games as a true freshman in 2017-18 and finished the season averaging 5.3 ppg and 2.0 rpg in 16.6 mpg.

#### ■ D'Mitrik Trice - Sophomore - Guard

D'Mitrik Trice returns as a third-year sophomore in 2018-19 after missing the final 23 games and receiving a medical hardship last season with a foot injury. Trice, who debuted with a strong freshman campaign in a sixth-man role in 2016-17, took over the starting point guard reins a year ago for Wisconsin. Starting the first 10 games of the season, Trice averaged a team-high 31.5 minutes per game and responded by ranking third on the team with 9.4 points per game and second with 2.3 assists per game before the injury. A sturdy ball handler and sharp-shooter, Trice shot a team-high 41.8 percent from 3-point range in 37 games as a freshman in 2016-17. The Huber Heights, Ohio, native has earned a reputation as a natural leader after a successful prep career in basketball and quarterbacking his high school football team to a state championship.

► UW has reached the Sweet 16 or better in 4 of the last 5 seasons. No team in the nation has gone more frequently over that span. Kentucky is the only other team with 4 appearances in the last 5 seasons.

The Badgers have also advanced to the Sweet 16 or better in 6 of the last 8 years. No team in the nation has gone more frequently over that span either.

► Wisconsin advanced to the Final Four in both 2014 and 2015, becoming one of 8 Big Ten teams to reach back-to-back Final Fours. The Badgers have advanced to the Final Four a total of 4 times, winning the national championship in 1941 and reaching the national semifinals in 2000.

# HEAD COACH GREG GARD

2016 JIM PHELAN NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR

**A** coaching veteran of more than 20 years, Greg Gard has expertly made the jump from assistant coach to head coach at Wisconsin. After assuming the head coaching reins on Dec. 15, 2015, Gard promptly led the team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons at the helm and will begin his fourth season as the head coach of the Badgers in 2018-19.

Initially an interim head coach, Gard proved quickly he was worthy of the head coaching position and was officially named as such on March 7, 2016. In three seasons, he owns the third-highest winning percentage in UW history, piloting the Badgers to a record of 57-36 (.613).

In his first two seasons with the head coaching title, Gard maintained a level of success that has become synonymous with Wisconsin Basketball. In his inaugural season as head coach, Gard led the Badgers to the 2016 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16, becoming just the second-ever first-year coach to win the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. He followed that up by leading UW to the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history (27-10) and making a second-consecutive visit to the Sweet 16.

Gard is just the third coach in the last 20 years to pilot his team to the Sweet 16 in each of his first two seasons, joining UCLA's Steve Lavin (1996-97) and Gonzaga's Mark Few (2000-01).

Wisconsin maintained its place among the top of the Big Ten during the transition to Gard as well. In his first season, the Badgers finished the regular season in a tie for third place in the Big Ten standings — extending its streak of top-four finishes to a league-record 16th-consecutive season — with a 12-6 conference record. Gard led the Badgers to the most Big Ten wins by a first-year coach since 2004 (Bruce Weber, Illinois).

Gard's Badgers would follow that up with another 12-6 conference campaign in 2017, finishing second in both the regular season and the Big Ten tournament. Wisconsin would cap off its 27-win season with a signature win in the NCAA tournament, knocking off the nation's No. 1 team Villanova, 65-62, to advance to the Sweet 16.

Gard's first two seasons as head coach at Wisconsin continued a trend of lofty academic success, placing 15 players on the Academic All-Big Ten list. Over his 17 years in Madison, UW has boasted a total of 63 Academic All-Big Ten honors, trailing only Purdue and Northwestern over that span.

Long considered one of the top assistant coaches in the game, Gard served as an assistant at Wisconsin for 14-plus seasons, including the final seven as the associate head coach. In 2015, Gard was ranked as the fourth-best "X&O" assistant coach in college basketball by coachstat.net. In 2012, Gard was named No. 3 on the list of top assistant coaches in college basketball according to Bleacher Report. FOX Sports also listed Gard No. 10 on its list of the nation's top 25 assistant coaches.

Prior to coming to Wisconsin in 2001, Gard spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at UW-Milwaukee and served as an assistant coach at UW-Platteville from 1993-99.

Prior to joining Ryan's staff in Platteville, Gard spent three seasons at Southwestern High School and one at Platteville High School, where he served in junior high and assistant varsity coaching capacities.

In 2016, Gard and his wife, Michelle, partnered with the University of the Wisconsin and Wisconsin Foundation and Alumni Association, to launch Garding Against Cancer. This fundraising initiative raises funds and awareness for cancer research and care within the state of Wisconsin. In its first two years of hosting fundraising events across the state, GAC raised more than \$2 million dollars in the fight against cancer.

Gard is a 1995 graduate of UW-Platteville with a degree in physical and health education. He received a master's degree in counselor education from Platteville in 2007. Gard and his wife, Michelle, have two daughters, Mackenzie and Peyton, and a son, Isaac.
