THE GAME: No. 1 Stanford (9-0) continues its storied rivalry with No. 23 Tennessee (8-1) in Maples Pavilion on Wednesday, Dec. 18 at 7 p.m. PT. Krista Blunk and Mary Murphy have the call on Pac-12 Networks and Jordan Watkins will handle the radio broadcast on TuneIn and GoStanford.com.

THE RUNDOWN: Stanford will be playing Tennessee as the nation's No. 1 team for the fourth time (2012, 1996, 1992) and is 2-1 in those three previous meetings ... On Sunday against Ohio State, the Cardinal became the fifth program in women's college basketball history to win 1,100 games ... Haley Jones won her second Pac-12 Freshman of the Week award after going for 15 points, seven rebounds and six assists in the victory ... Stanford's 9-0 start is its best since it went 11-0 to begin 2012-13 ... Of Stanford's 24 McDonald's All-Americans all-time, nine are on this year's Cardinal roster and 12 players were rated as five-star talents coming out of high school ... Tara VanDerveer has a 1,076-247 (.813) record as a collegiate head coach and is 23 victories shy of passing Pat Summitt (1,098) as the winningest coach in women's college basketball history ... Stanford is 11th in the country in scoring offense (82.3), 12th in field goal percentage (.478), 67th in scoring defense (58.2) and seventh in field goal percentage defense (.315) ... Stanford, Baylor, Indiana and Arizona are the only four teams in the country in the top 12 in both field goal percentage and field goal percentage defense ... The Cardinal is one of four Pac-12 schools in the top 10 along with No. 3 Oregon, No. 4 Oregon State and No. 10 UCLA.

VS. TENNESSEE: Stanford is 11-25 all-time against the Lady Vols, but has won five of the last eight. Eight of Stanford's 11 wins in the series have come in Maples Pavilion. Following an 11-game Lady Vol win streak from 1997-2006, Stanford is 7-6 against Tennessee since 2007. The No. 7 Lady Vols beat No. 18 Stanford in their last visit to The Farm on Dec. 21, 2017, 83-71, to end Stanford's five-game home winning streak against Tennessee.

STORIED RIVALRY »

- Wednesday's match-up will be the 37th all-time in a series that began December 1988, when the Cardinal traveled to Knoxville and lost to the Lady Volunteers, 83-60.
- The teams have met annually since, in some cases twice a year and in the case of 1990-91, three times. Tennessee took control with an 11-game winning streak from 1997-2006, but since a 73-69 overtime win on Dec. 22, 2007, Stanford has won five of the past eight and six of the past 10.
- Including Wednesday, the two have met as ranked opponents 35 times and one of the two has been the AP No. 1 on 10 occasions. The top-ranked team is 6-3 in those previous nine match-ups and the Cardinal is 2-1 all-time against Tennessee as the nation's No. 1.

- Stanford won its first two national titles in Knoxville, knocking off Auburn 88-81 on April 4, 1990.
- Eight of Stanford's 11 wins have come in Maples Pavilion.
- Last season, on the 30th anniversary of the first meeting in their storied rivalry, No. 8 Stanford went on the road and beat No. 9 Tennessee in Knoxville, 95-85, on Dec. 18, 2018.
- In the first top-10 matchup between the schools since 2013, the Cardinal collected its third win against the Lady Vols in Thompson-Boling Arena. Its previous road victories in Knoxville came on Dec. 22, 2012 (73-60) and Dec. 15, 1996 (82-65).
- Stanford shot 14-of-24 (.583) from 3-point range, an opponent record for Thompson-Boling Arena and a record-tying number of makes from deep against the Lady Vols all-time.
- The Cardinal's 95 points were the most against Tennessee in Knoxville in 13 seasons and just two shy of the opponent record in Thompson-Boling Arena. Texas beat the Lady Vols 97-78 on Dec. 9, 1987.
- Stanford shot 55 percent overall (33-of-60) to score its 95 points, a program record for scoring on the road against a top-10 team.
- DiJonai Carrington led five Cardinal in double figures with a career-high 33 points and 13-rebounds. Carrington was 11-of-15 (.733) from the floor and 4-of-5 (.800) from deep and became just the second player in the last 20 years to have 33 points, 13 rebounds and four made 3-pointers against a ranked opponent. Missouri's Evan Unrau had 40/15/4 against No. 8 Kansas State on Feb. 22, 2014, a game that went into double-overtime.

WHAT JUST HAPPENED »

- For the first time since heading to The Farm, Tara VanDerveer hosted her former team in Maples Pavilion and Stanford beat Ohio State, 71-52.
- VanDerveer led the Buckeyes to a 110-37 record and three NCAA Tournaments from 1981-85, including the Elite Eight in her final season, before making the admittedly difficult decision to take the job at Stanford. VanDerveer was twice named Big Ten Coach of the Year (1984, 1985).

- Haley Jones had 15 points, seven rebounds and six assists in the victory and was voted Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the second time on Monday.
- Lexie Hull had seven first-half steals, a total which is tied for fourth in Stanford single-game history with six others. The last one to do it? Sister Lacie on Nov. 24, 2018 against American.
- The game was Stanford's first following its annual two-week break for final exams. Since first taking the exam hiatus in 1999-2000, Stanford is now 17-4 in its first game back.
- It was also the 1,100th win in program history and Stanford became the fifth school to reach that milestone, joining Tennessee, UConn, Louisiana Tech and James Madison.

STILL NO. 1 »

- Following Stanford's title at the Greater Victoria Invitational on Nov. 30 and combined with losses by Oregon and Baylor, the Cardinal moved up to No. 1 in the AP poll released on Dec. 2.
- Stanford remained No. 1 in the poll released on Dec. 16 and has now been the nation's top team for 18 out of 775 all-time AP polls.
- The Cardinal's ascent to No. 1 was the program's first in seven seasons. Following a 71-69 victory over No. 1 Baylor in Hawaii on Nov. 16, 2012, Stanford topped the next poll on Nov. 19 and stayed at No. 1 for six weeks, before a 61-35 loss to No. 2 UConn on Dec. 29 dropped the team to No. 4 in the rankings released on Dec. 31, 2012.
- Stanford is one of four Pac-12 schools in the top 10 along with No. 3 Oregon, No. 4 Oregon State and No. 10 UCLA and five of the country's 12 remaining undefeated teams are from the conference (Stanford, Oregon State, UCLA, Arizona, Colorado).
- The Cardinal is third all-time in total appearances in the AP poll with 556 behind Tennessee (732) and Texas (561). Its 415 appearances in the top 10 are also third, trailing Tennessee (617) and Connecticut (481) and its 242 appearances in the top five are fourth behind Tennessee (464), Connecticut (437) and Louisiana Tech (278).
- The Cardinal had been ranked in 312 consecutive polls, the third-longest streak all-time, until it fell out on Dec. 25, 2017. Stanford has appeared in each of the past 34 AP polls, the ninth-longest active streak in the country.

TOP TALENT »

- Stanford returns four starters and 11 letterwinners to a team that went 31-5, won its 13th Pac-12 Tournament title and advanced to the program's 20th Elite Eight in 2018-19.
- Joining that group is the nation's second-ranked recruiting class, which includes the nation's No. 1 player Haley Jones, No. 15 Ashton Prechtel, No. 19 Francesca Belibi and No. 50 Hannah Jump.
- All four are in the top seven on the team in scoring and Jump is 15th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.488). All but two of her attempts from the floor this season have been from deep.
- Of Stanford's 24 McDonald's All-Americans all-time, nine are on this year's Cardinal roster and 12 players were rated as five-star talents coming out of high school.

TARA 1.1K? »

- A four-time national coach of the year (1988, 1989, 1990, 2011) and 15-time Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Tara VanDerveer, who prior to coming to Stanford served as head coach for a combined seven seasons at Idaho (1978-80) and Ohio State (1980-85), has accumulated a 1,076-247 (.813) record as a collegiate head coach and a 924-196 (.825) record at Stanford.
- VanDerveer has more wins to her name than 341 of the NCAA's 348 Division I programs and is 23 victories shy of passing Pat Summitt (1,098) as the winningest coach in women's college basketball history.
- VanDerveer owns the sixth-highest winning percentage (.813) among Division I women's basketball coaches all-time and her 34 20-win seasons are second to Summitt (36) and C. Vivian Stringer (36).
- She has accounted for 924 of Stanford's 1,100 total victories since its first varsity season in 1975.
- In Dec. 2018 the Women's Sports Foundation announced the creation of The Tara VanDerveer Fund for the Advancement of Women in Coaching and in Aug. 2019 its inaugural class of grant recipients.
- A total of \$200,000 was awarded to 10 universities and colleges to support a female coach on the rise, assisting with living expenses, professional development and mentorship. The institutions will use funding to support coaching fellows across a myriad of women's sports including field hockey, wrestling, basketball and volleyball, as well as softball and strength and conditioning.
- The WSF created the VanDerveer Fund to directly address the alarming decline of women in coaching. In the 1970-71 academic year, 90% of all head coaches for women's college teams were women. By 2017, 45 years after the passage of Title IX, women's share of these positions in women's NCAA sports had dropped to 40%.

BALANCE »

- Stanford is 11th in the country in scoring offense, averaging 82.3 points per game, and 12th in field goal percentage, shooting 47.8 percent (283-of-592).
- At the other end of the floor, the Cardinal is 67th in scoring defense (58.2), but seventh in field goal percentage defense (.315).

OFFENSE TO START »

- Stanford scored at least 90 points in each of its first three games of the season, wins over Eastern Washington (92-27), San Francisco (97-71) and Northern Colorado (90-36).
- It was the first time the Cardinal had scored 90+ in three consecutive games in nearly 18 years when it had conference victories against Oregon State on Jan. 10, 2002 (91-54), Oregon on Jan. 13, 2002 (91-76) and Washington State on Jan. 17, 2002 (104-57).

SCOUTING REPORT »

- Stanford, which relies heavily on its detailed scouting reports to stop its opponents, is again locking up opposing offenses to the tune of 31.5 percent shooting, which is seventh in the nation.
- The Cardinal has finished in the top 15 in the country in field goal percentage defense in 10 of the last 13 years, but in neither of the past two seasons. It was 29th in 2017-18 (.367) and 16th in 2018-19 (.358).
- Stanford opened its season with a 92-27 romp over Eastern Washington on Nov. 5.
- The margin of victory (65) was the third largest in program history, trailing only a 77-point win against Washington on Jan. 8, 2009 and a 73-point win against Long Beach State on Dec. 8, 1993.
- Eastern Washington's 27 points were the fifth-fewest for a Stanford opponent all-time and the lowest total since Pacific managed to score just 26 on Nov. 21, 2004.
- The Eagles also shot 14.1 percent from the floor (9-of-64), the worst clip for a Cardinal foe since at least 1999-00 (the beginning of readily available records). It was the lowest for a team in a game between two NCAA Division I opponents since Cincinnati shot 13.8 percent (8-of-58) against Connecticut on March 5, 2018. South Florida has since held St. Francis (PA) to 13.5 percent shooting on Nov. 24, 2019.

SUMMERS AROUND THE WORLD »

- Francesca Belibi, Kiana Williams and Alyssa Jerome all represented their countries across the globe in various tournaments this summer.
- Belibi won her third international gold medal with the United States at the FIBA U19 World Cup in Bangkok, Thailand in late July. She averaged 7.7 points on 68.8 percent shooting (22-of-32) and 7.3 rebounds in seven games.
- Belibi is the 11th Cardinal to appear in a FIBA U19 World Cup and the eighth to win a gold medal. Sonja Henning (1989), Julie Zeilstra (1989), Rachel Hemmer (1993), Carolyn Moos (1997), Candice Wiggins (2005), Kayla Pedersen (2007) and Nneka Ogwumike (2009) all finished atop the podium with the United States. Nicole Powell and the U.S. finished third in 2001, Alanna Smith took home bronze with Australia in 2015 and Alyssa Jerome captained Canada to another bronze in 2017.
- Williams and the United States won silver at the Pan American Games in Lima, Peru in mid-August.
- The Stanford junior, playing in her first event with USA Basketball, averaged 5.2 points, 2.4 assists and 1.6 steals in 17.8 minutes per game.
- Jerome was also in Lima with Canada, which finished sixth. She started all four games and averaged 4.0 points and 5.3 rebounds in 18.3 minutes per outing.
- Lacie Hull, Lexie Hull, Estella Moschkau and Anna Wilson represented Stanford at the 2019 USA Basketball Women's 3x3 National Championship in Las Vegas in May 2019, advancing to the quarterfinals.




