TEAM

- Stanford improved to 6-5 under David Shaw against Notre Dame ... it was Stanford's second win at Notre Dame Stadium under Shaw and just its fifth all-time ... the Cardinal is now 14-22 against the Fighting Irish and snapped a three-game losing streak in the series
- Four different starting OL combination in the last five games ... RG Drake Metcalf made first career start ... LT Myles Hinton (12th career start) made his first career start at the position ... RT Jack Leyrer made his second straight start at the position ... was replaced by true freshman Fisher Anderson after injury late in the third quarter ... LT Walter Rouse's streak of 34 consecutive games started came to an end (all games since week two of 2019 season)
- Stanford improved to 82-8 under Shaw when leading at halftime and 78-8 when leading at the end of the third quarter
- The Cardinal led 10-0 at half ... it was the second straight game Stanford has not allowed any points in the first quarter ... Notre Dame was scoreless until the 6:22 mark of the third quarter, it's longest scoreless streak to start a game since Oct. 2, 2021 vs. Cincinnati ... first time this season Notre Dame has punted on each of its first two drives
- Tonight marked David Shaw's 95th career win, tied with Arizona's Dick Tomey for ninth-most wins in Pac-12 history

INDIVIDUAL

K JOSHUA KARTY

- Matched career high going 3-for-3 on field goal attempts (45-43-43) and improved to 7-for-7 on the season to date

RB CASEY FILKINS

- Rushed a career-high 32 times for 91 yards and a touchdown
- Previous career high in carries was 21 (10/8/22 vs. Oregon State)
- Fourth rushing touchdown of the season and has scored a touchdown in five of six games this season
- Added four receptions for 46 yards to finish with 137 all-purpose yards

WR MICHAEL WILSON

- Eight first-half catches and nine total (second-most in career) for 66 yards
- Now has 134 career catches (19th all-time) to surpass Luke Powell (2000-03, 133 receptions) on Stanford's career lists

QB TANNER MCKEE

- 26-of-38 for 288 yards ... season-highs in both completions and attempts ... 26 completions was one off career high 27
- Moved up to 15th on Stanford's career passing lists with 3,929 passing yards, surpassing Dick Norman (1958-60) and T.C. Ostrander (2004-07)

S JONATHAN MCGILL

- Four tackles (one for loss), a fumble recovery and the game-sealing pass breakup

EDGE STEPHEN HERRON

- Second career forced fumble

DL ANTHONY FRANKLIN

- First career fumble recovery

S KENDALL WILLIAMSON

- Forced fumble in fourth quarter which led to Stanford's final field goal
