OFF THE TOP

- Arizona will head to the Bay Area for its first Pac-12 trip of the season. The Cats open with Stanford on Wednesday night, before traveling to Cal to take on the Golden Bears on Saturday.
- The Wildcats have won 17 straight games against Stanford dating back to 2009. Arizona's last loss to Stanford came on Jan. 4, 2009 in Palo Alto.
- Arizona has started 2-0 in Pac-12 play for the sixth time in the past seven seasons.
- Following Wednesday's game at Stanford, Arizona will join Gonzaga and Mississippi Valley State as the only programs in the country to have played at least one game in five different time zones. The Cats have played in the Maui Invitational, at Connecticut, at Alabama and will play its first game in the Pacific Time Zone on Wednesday. Tucson is in the Mountain Standard Time Zone.
- Under Coach Sean Miller, Arizona is 123-41 in Pac-12 play. His .748 winning percentage is the third-best all-time in the conference for coaches with a minimum of six seasons in the Pac-12. The Wildcats are 50-31 (.617) in Pac-12 road games under Miller.
- Sophomore Brandon Randolph scored 21 points in Saturday's overtime win over Utah. He has scored in double figures in all 15 games this season, joining Kris Wilkes (UCLA) and Tres Tinkle (Oregon State) as the only players in the Pac-12 to have scored in double figures in each of their team's games this season.
- Randolph leads the Pac-12 in free throw shooting at .902.
- Redshirt junior Chase Jeter tied his career high with 21 points Saturday and established new career highs in rebounds (13) minutes (39) and assists (4).
- Jeter is second in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage at .650.

JETER STRONG FROM THE FLOOR

Chase Jeter arrived at Arizona prior to the 2017-18 season after transferring from Duke, but had to sit out the season per NCAA rules. In his first 15 games as a Wildcat, Jeter has been a presence in the paint and a threat down low. Jeter is averaging 13.0 points per game and 7.5 rebounds a contest with four double-doubles. Jeter is shooting 65 percent from the floor, having connected on 78 of 120 shot attempts. He entered Pac-12 play with a percentage of 65.7, which is the best by any Arizona player in pre-conference play since Jordan Hill also shot 65.7 percent on 99 attempts in 2007. Jeter has scored in double figures in 11 of the 15 games. Jeter had one of the finest games of his career in Saturday's overtime win over Utah. The junior tied his career high with 21 points, and established new career highs in rebounds (13) and assists (4). He also played a career-high 39 minutes against the Utes. In the final non-conference game of the season, Jeter posted 16 points and five rebounds in a two-point win over UC Davis. The game prior, against Montana, Jeter had 21 points on 9 of 15 shooting. He knocked in three of four free throws and added six rebounds. He registered a then career-high 19 points against Alabama and grabbed nine rebounds, missing a double-double by one board.

CHASE IN CHARGE

Not only has Chase Jeter been productive scoring and rebounding, he's also been Arizona's top charge-getter this season. A play Coach Sean Miller values as much as any in basketball, Jeter has taken 19 charges in 15 games this season. Jeter took four charges in the finale in Maui against Auburn. Jeter had taken at least one charge in every game this season, until the Montana game. He also has at least two charges in four of the 15 games. Jeter has taken more than half of Arizona's charges this season. As a team, the Wildcats have drawn 37 charges, with Jeter drawing 19.

A LOOK AT ARIZONA'S STREAKS

Not only does Arizona have the longest intra-conference winning in the Pac-12 with 17 consecutive wins versus Stanford, but UA owns the top two active head-to-head winning streaks within the Pac-12 Conference.

RANDOLPH'S IMPROVEMENT

Sophomore Brandon Randolph has started his sophomore season in style. Randolph has scored in double figures in all 15 games this season and is averaging a team-leading 16.5 points per game. He's one of three players in the Pac-12 to have scored in double figures in each of his team's games this season, joining Tres Tinkle (Oregon State) and Kris Wilkes (UCLA). As a freshman last season, Randolph played in 31 games, drawing four starting assignments. He averaged 3.7 points per game, scoring a total of 116 points. Randolph's scoring increase of 12.8 points per game is the biggest of any player in a Power 5 Conference. Jordan Nwora from Louisville is second with an increase of 12.2. It's also the largest increase from one season to the next by any Arizona player since at least 1977. The previous best was a 12-point increase by Khalid Reeves in 1993-94. Randolph has also surpassed his rebounding total as a freshman. He had 26 rebounds last season and already has 47 this year. Randolph is the first Arizona guard to score in double figures in each of the first 15 games of the season since Hassan Adams in 2005-06. He's the first Wildcat, regardless of position, to score in double figures in the first 15 games since Derrick Williams in 2010-11. Here's a closer look at Randolph's production so far as a sophomore versus his time as a freshman.

GETTING HOT FROM 3

A pair of upperclassmen have given Arizona a lift from deep over the past three games. Combined, senior Ryan Luther and Dylan Smith have connected on 10 of their last 16 3-point attempts. Luther is 5 for his last 6 over the past three games, while Smith is 5 of 10. Smith is actually 5 of his last 8 in the past two games after going 0 for 2 from 3-point range against UC Davis in the non-conference finale. In two conference games, Smith is averaging nine points per game with his 5 of 8 shooting from deep. Luther connected on three of four 3-point attempts in last weekend's conference games and hit two big 3s in the second half of Arizona's 84-81 overtime win over Utah.

ONE OF THE WINNINGEST PROGRAMS OVER THE LAST FIVE YEARS

With the 2018-19 season underway, Arizona has solidified itself as one of the winningest programs in the nation in the past five seasons. Arizona, Villanova, Gonzaga and Kentucky have jockeyed for the title of winningest program in the nation during this five-year span.

In Miller's nine seasons entering this year, UA has averaged 27.4 wins per season. Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Wildcats have a 232-59 (.797) record, both the most wins and best winning percentage in the Pac-12 in that span.

DOUTRIVE DOES IT

Freshman Devonaire Doutrive saw extended action in Arizona's Pac-12 opener Thursday versus Colorado. Doutrive played a career-high 12 minutes, scoring 8 points and grabbing four rebounds. He had three offensive rebounds and was 2 of 2 from the free throw line. The Cats were plus-11 when Doutrive was in the game, the highest mark of any Wildcat against the Buffs. Doutrive played more than 10 minutes in just one of Arizona's 13 non-conference games. Doutrive followed that up against Utah with two points and an offensive rebound in six minutes. He has four offensive rebounds in his last 16 minutes played.

BRANDON FIVE-ZERO

Freshman Brandon Williams entered conference play with exactly 50 assists in 13 games. He's the first Arizona player to have 50 or more assists in pre-conference play since Jason Gardner posted 73 assists in 1999, before opening conference play. Williams is the only freshman in the Pac-12 this season to have 50 or more assists on the season and has 59 after a six-assist performance in the Pac-12 opener versus Colorado and three more dimes against Utah. The freshman has 59 assists to just 23 turnovers and is the team's third-leading scorer at 11.2 points per game. Williams has especially excelled in eight games at McKale Center, where he has 46 assists to just 10 turnovers.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

In Arizona's 61-42 win over Montana, the Wildcats held their opponent under 45 points for the 13th time under Sean Miller. The Wildcats hadn't held an opponent under 45 since beating NAU 92-37 on Dec. 13, 2015. Arizona's previous low this season had been 46 points allowed against UTEP in a November win. The Wildcats are allowing 65.9 points per game, which is third-best in the Pac-12. KenPom.com ranks the Wildcats 35th in adjusted defensive efficiency at 94.1. That mark is second in the Pac-12 to Oregon. The Wildcats have also forced 231 turnovers, which is the most in the Pac-12. The next closest is USC at 209.

AKOT IMPROVING AS A STARTER

Sophomore forward Emmanuel Akot came off the bench for the first six games this year for the Wildcats before being inserted into the starting lineup. In the six games as a reserve, Akot averaged 2.8 points per game, 2.7 rebounds a contest and was 1 of 9 from 3-point range and 6 of 20 overall from the floor. In nine games as a starter, Akot has seen an increase in production. He's averaging 4.3 points per game, 2.9 rebounds per game and is 5 for 11 from 3-point range and 16 of 37 overall from the floor. He's averaging 21.2 minutes per game as a starter, up from 16.9 as a reserve.

MCKALE CENTER DOING WHAT IT ALWAYS DOES

The 2017-18 Arizona Basketball season was yet another year of UA leading the Pac-12 Conference in attendance as Arizona averaged 14,434 fans per home game. Arizona has led the conference in average attendance for 34 consecutive seasons and did so by over 2,000 fans per game last season. Arizona ranked 16th nationally in the 2017-18 season.

COLEMAN WOVES IN MAUI

In three games at the Maui Invitational, senior guard Justin Coleman averaged 20.7 points per game and landed on the All-Tournament team. Coleman's 20.7 points per game at the Maui Invitational are the most by an Arizona player since Khalid Reeves averaged 27 a game in 1993. The previous five trips to Maui, no Arizona player averaged better than Nic Wise's 17.3 points per game in 2009. Coleman was extremely efficient in his time in Maui. He was 20 for 35 from the field (.571) and 14 of 24 from 3-point range (.583). He had nine assists to five turnovers and played 99 of a possible 120 minutes in three games in three days. On the season now, Coleman is averaging 13.3 points per game and is 15 of 30 from 3-point range and 11 of 13 from the free throw line.

Not only did Arizona play three games in three days at the Maui Invitational, they played a pair of Top 10 teams in back-to-back games against then No. 3 Gonzaga and No. 8 Auburn. Arizona hadn't played multiple Top 10 teams in their non-conference portion of the regular season schedule since 2007 when the Wildcats played No. 2 Memphis, No. 4 Kansas and No. 9 Texas A&M. Arizona hadn't played two Top 10 teams in November since 2001 when the Cats beat No. 2 Maryland and No. 5 Florida in back-to-back games at the Coaches vs. Cancer IKON Classic in New York.

"C" IS FOR CAPTAIN

Senior guard Justin Coleman and junior big man Chase Jeter were elected co-captains of the Wildcats prior to the season. And in a new wrinkle, both players will wear a "C" on their jerseys to display the honor. Jeter missed the opening exhibition game with an injury that coach Sean Miller labeled as "short-term." Coleman started and played 22 minutes, leading the team with six assists. He also added five rebounds and four points in the win. Interestingly, both players are transfers and have yet to play a regular season game for the Wildcats.

PETERS AND GAINNEY JOIN STAFF

Arizona added two new assistants to Coach Sean Miller's staff this season in Danny Peters and Justin Gainney. Peters is in his second stint with Arizona. He served as a graduate manager for two seasons and the assistant director of basketball operations for two. He was a four-year letterwinner at Ohio State, where he played for head coach Thad Matta. After his time at Arizona, Peters joined former Miller assistant James Whitford at Ball State as an assistant, where he helped the Cardinals earn their first postseason bid in 14 years. Gainney played at NC State, where Miller was an assistant at the time. He played for the Wolf Pack from 1996 to 2000. Gainney then spent time at NC State as an administrative coordinator and director of basketball operations. He joined the Elon University staff in 2009, before moving on to Appalachian State from 2010 to 2014. He also spent time at Marquette, before spending last season at Santa Clara as an assistant.

ARIZONA: A FREQUENT HOME FOR MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICANS

A pair of McDonald's All-Americans joined Arizona as part of the 2017 recruiting class. Deandre Ayton, an incoming freshman and top recruit nationally for the class, is joined by Duke transfer Chase Jeter. Jeter was a McDonald's All-American as part of the 2015 recruiting class. Ayton and Jeter give UA 24 McDonald's All-Americans in program history. After landing 15 All-Americans from 1984 to 2007, Arizona has inked nine since 2012.

MILLER AMONG NATION'S ELITE AT ADVANCING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Head coach Sean Miller has directed Arizona to its 18th Sweet 16 appearance in 2017, marking the program's fourth Sweet 16 appearance in the last five seasons. He also has a 15-2 (.882) career record in the NCAA Tournament against lower-seeded teams.
