SETTING THE SCENE

3-1, 0-0 Pac-12

Stanford hits the road for the second time this season, heading to No. 9/8 Baylor on Saturday, Nov. 20 for a 10 a.m. PT tip-off on ESPN+.

THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford is 3-1 to start the season, with all three wins coming in double-digit fashion. Harrison Ingram leads the team with 14.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game, while Jaiden Delaire is also averaging double figures with 11.8 per night. Seven players are scoring at least five points a night.
- Delaire was named last season's Pac-12's Most Improved Player of the Year after more than doubling his sophomore scoring mark to 13.4 points per game in conference action. He reached double-figure scoring in 15 of the last 19 games in 2020-21.
- The Cardinal has scheduled a challenging non-conference slate led by defending national champion Baylor, beginning a home-and-home series, and a trip to Honolulu for the Diamond Head Classic. Stanford will play three teams this season in the AP preseason top-eight, four in the top-13 and eight that were either in the top-25 or received votes.
- Stanford tallied a pair of ranked wins a year ago, downing No. 25 Alabama in the Maui Invitational and beating No. 24/20 UCLA at the buzzer in Santa Cruz. The program is looking for its first top-10 win on the road since winning at No. 9/9 Texas, 74-71, on Dec. 23, 2014.
- Jerod Haase played Baylor once as a player at Kansas (W, 87-68) on Jan. 11, 1997, scoring 18 points.

THAT'S HIGH PRAISE

It took no time at all for Harrison Ingram to earn accolades from the Pac-12, as he was named the conference Freshman of the Week for the opening salvo to the college basketball season. Ingram averaged 17.5 points per game over two outings over Tarleton State and Santa Clara, and the five-star recruit has scored at least 16 points in each of his three games this season. Ingram's 17.5 point-per-game scoring average led all freshmen in the Pac-12 in week one, and was 12th nationally among true freshmen.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In his first five seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 82 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time since 2015. The 2020 team was set to be postseason bound before the cancellation of the postseason.

The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country - He was named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year and an Academic All-American.

The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign.

Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons and earned a postseason berth with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016. During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015.

RANKINGS REPORT

Stanford has won four of its last nine games against ranked opponents, including victories over Oregon, Colorado, Alabama and UCLA. The Cardinal's last win over a ranked opponent in a true road game was also its last win over a top-10 opponent: Dec. 23, 2014 at Texas (74-71, ot). Anthony Brown scored 25 points to lead the way, while Chasson Randle had 22 on that evening in Austin.

HOMECOMING FOR HARRISON

The one-off contest in Texas offers a homecoming of sorts for freshman Harrison Ingram, who hails from Dallas and starred at St. Mark's school prior to his arrival on The Farm. Ingram was the Texas State Private School Player of the Year and the second-ranked player from Texas in the recruiting class of 2021, trailing only Kentucky's Daimion Collins. Stanford returned to the Dallas area in its 2022 recruiting class, as Ryan Agarwal (Coppell, TX) signed a national letter of intent earlier this month.

BATTLE OF THE BOARDS

The Cardinal and Bears each rank in the top-10 nationally per KenPom in limiting opponents offensive rebounds. Stanford ranks seventh nationally in defensive rebound percentage at 83.1%, while Baylor checks in third at 84.1%. Stanford and Baylor are also each in the top-50 nationally in offensive rebound percentage. The Cardinal sports a +10.0 rebound margin, and are holding foes to 27 boards per game.

BEARS, PART ONE

The Cardinal squares off with the Bears on the same day that Stanford football hosts the California Golden Bears in the 124th edition of the Big Game. Stanford football kicks off six hours after basketball begins.

SQUAD GOALS

Stanford returns 61.3 percent of its minutes from a year ago, including four players who drew at least 14 starts last season. Jaiden Delaire (12.5 pts) leads the way as the Pac-12's Most Improved Player and an honorable mention All-Pac-12 selection a year ago, while Spencer Jones (8.2 pts) and Michael O'Connell (6.7 pts) saw significant minutes last year. Lukas Kisunas (3.3 pts) started 14 games as a junior in the middle, while three four-star recruits from a year ago, Brandon Angel, Max Murrell and Noah Taitz will look to continue their progression. In addition to five-star signee Harrison Ingram, Stanford added four-star and consensus top-60 national recruit Isa Silva (G, Sacramento, Calif.), three-star Jarvis Moss (G, Concord, N.C) and seven-footer Maxime Raynaud (F, Paris, France). Stanford has its third top-20 national recruiting class in the last four years.

NBA DRAFT

Ziaire Williams was selected with the 10th overall selection in the 2021 NBA Draft, eventually heading to the Memphis Grizzlies via trade. Stanford is one of 12 programs nationally with a player drafted in each of the last three seasons, while Williams is the fifth top-10 and lottery pick in program history, joining Josh Childress (6th, 2004), Rich Kelley (7th, 1975), Adam Keefe (10th, 1992) and Brook Lopez (10th, 2008)

MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICAN GAME

Freshman Harrison Ingram became the ninth recruit in program history to earn a spot on the McDonald's All-American game roster, while the Cardinal has a participant for the second-straight year - the first time in program history to accomplish the feat in back-to-back years. Ingram joins Ziaire Williams (2020), Reid Travis (2014), Brook and Robin Lopez (2006), Josh Childress (2001), Casey Jacobsen (1999) and Jarron and Jason Collins (1997) as Stanford athletes with the honor.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

Stanford is one of five power conference programs not to take a transfer this year (Stanford, Colorado, UConn, Villanova, Purdue). Only Stanford, Colorado and Purdue don't have a transfer on their entire roster, while Stanford hasn't taken a transfer since Andrew Zimmerman in 2009-10, the longest gap nationally without taking a transfer among power conference teams by 10 years. More than 300 Division I programs took a transfer for the 2021-22 campaign.

FIRST TRIP TO THE FERRELL CENTER

Saturday's contest marks the third meeting between Stanford and Baylor, but the first trip to Waco for the Cardinal in program history. The first meeting came on Stanford's campus on Dec. 19, 1950 - an 83-67 win - while the second came on Nov. 29, 1988 in the Maui Classic's fifth-place game, which Stanford won 69-56.

WELCOME TO THE FARM

Stanford signed a pair of four-star forwards when the early signing period opened in the class of 2022. Jaylen Thompson, from Oakland and rated as high as No. 62 nationally by 247 Sports, and Ryan Agarwal, a four star Rivals shooting guard from Coppell, Texas, join a program that has signed top-20 classes nationally in three of the past four seasons, while this year's class begins with Stanford signing two four-star players for the third consecutive year.

PAC-12 SHOWS OUT AT THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Pac-12 performed at an admirable level in the postseason, going 13-5 in the NCAA Tournament, including 10 double-digit victories and seven against AP Top-25 competition. Stanford hovered near the top of the conference table for a majority of the 2020-21 campaign before derailing late in the year after a series of injuries and absences.

FIBA U19 WORLD CUP

Harrison Ingram was selected by USA Basketball to compete at the FIBA U19 World Cup in Latvia, while Jerod Haase was chosen as an assistant coach for the team. Ingram averaged 4.6 points, 4.1 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.7 steals per game for the United States, which went 7-0 and defeated France to win gold, 83-81. Ingram's 1.7 steals per game led the United States, and ranked 12th overall at the event.

OLYMPIAN

KZ Okpala became Stanford basketball's fifth Olympian when he competed for Nigeria in Tokyo. Okpala, who is in his third season with the Miami Heat in the NBA after two campaigns at Stanford, joins Ron Tomsic (USA, 1956), Jim Walsh (USA, 1956), Andrew Vlahov (Australia, 1988, 1992, 1996, 2000) and Johnny Rogers (Spain, 2000) as Stanford men's basketball Olympians.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS

Stanford has had a first team All-Pac-12 player in each of the last nine years, while no other program has an active streak of more than four years (Arizona State, Oregon State, USC).

FRESH PRINCE OF DELAIRE

Jaiden Delaire made the most of his opportunity in Pac-12 play a year ago, averaging 13.4 points and 4.4 rebounds per game, including six outings with at least 19 points. Delaire was one of three players to more than double their scoring average from 2019-20 among the top-20 scorers in the conference, along with Noah Williams (WSU) and Jarod Lucas (OSU), and was became the third player in program history to be named Pac-12 Most Improved Player, joining Dwight Powell (2013) and Anthony Brown (2014).

Delaire's 13.4 points per night last year in Pac-12 action ranks fourth among all returners league-wide, trailing only Johnny Juzang (UCLA), Noah Williams (WSU) and Azuolas Tubelis (ARI). He opened with 14 points against Tarleton State on Nov. 9, and had a season-high 19 last time out against San Jose State on Nov. 15. He ranks second on the team through four games with an 11.8 scoring average.

IN THE NBA

Stanford has five active NBA players to start the season: Brook Lopez (MIL), Robin Lopez (ORL), KZ Okpala (MIA), Dwight Powell (DAL) and Ziaire Williams (MEM).

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2021-22 totals (38 combined, 9.5 per game) are as follows:






