#### SETTING THE SCENE

The Cardinal returns to non-conference action after two consecutive Pac-12 contests, facing Dartmouth on Thursday, Dec. 15 at 7 p.m. The game will be broadcast on Pac-12 Network.

#### THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford is 5-3 (1-1 Pac-12) to start the season, with all four non-conference wins coming in double-digit fashion. Harrison Ingram leads the team with 12.5 points, 6.9 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game, while Jaiden Delaire is also averaging double figures with 11.4 per night.
- Showcasing the program's depth and balance, 10 Cardinal players have reached double figures in a game this season. The Cardinal is one of two Pac-12 teams (WSU) to reach double digit players in this category.
- Stanford is 5-0 at home this season, besting opponents by an average of 11.4 points per game at Maples Pavilion. The Cardinal remained unbeaten in November home games since 2018 (12-0), and are off to a 5-0 start at home for the third time in four seasons. The Cardinal is 11-3 in December home games under Jerod Haase, and 7-1 over the last three-plus seasons.
- The Cardinal is 32-8 all-time against lvy League opponents, including wins in each of the last 24 matchups since a Dec. 5, 1981 loss to Penn. Stanford is 6-1 against Dartmouth, winning the last six games.
- The Cardinal has outrebounded its opponent in all eight games this season, posting a plus-8.9 margin on the glass, which is 19th-best nationally. Stanford is holding foes to 28.5 rebounds per game, and ranks 13th nationally in offensive rebound percentage (37.6%).

#### AT THE BUZZER

Jaiden Delaire drained a 3-pointer at the buzzer on Dec. 12 to lead Stanford past Oregon, 72-69. Delaire gave Stanford its first win at the buzzer since Oscar da Silva scored at the horn against UCLA on Jan. 23, 2021, stepping into a deep 3-pointer on the left wing, scoring over Oregon's Eric Williams Jr. The 20 points for Delaire came in a season-best output, as he also pitched in six rebounds and two blocks.

# ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In his first five seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.



The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country - He was named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year and an Academic All-American.

The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign.

Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons and earned a postseason berth with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016. During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015.

#### INGRAM STANDS ALONE

Harrison Ingram is the only qualified freshman in the country to post averages of at least 12 points, six rebounds and three assists per game, while nationally he is one of 32 players averaging at least 12/6/3. He is the only true freshman in the Pac-12 averaging double-figure points per game, 5.3 more than second-place Lazar Stefanovic (Utah). Ingram leads all Pac-12 freshmen in rebounds and assists as well, ranking 11th in the conference in rebounds per game among all players, and eighth in assists.

#### THE NET RESULT

Stanford debuted at No. 143 in the first edition of the NCAA's NET rankings released on Dec. 6 and currently stands at No. 152 as of Dec. 14. Stanford has up to three quad one opportunities (Texas, Wyoming, BYU) this month.

#### THAT'S HIGH PRAISE

It took no time at all for Harrison Ingram to earn accolades from the Pac-12, as he was named the conference Freshman of the Week for the second time this season on Dec. 13. Ingram leads all Pac-12 freshmen with two weekly honors, earning the most recent award after putting up 16 points, eight rebounds and five assists against Oregon.

#### FRESHMEN SENSATIONS

Stanford has three of the top six freshmen in the Pac-12 in terms of scoring, with Harrison Ingram the only true freshman in the conference to average in doubles figures (12.5 pts). Maxime Raynaud is fourth with 6.8 points per game, while Isa Silva slots in sixth with 4.0 per night. Ingram paces all freshmen in the conference with 6.9 rebounds and 3.6 assists per game, while Silva ranks third with 1.8 assists and Raynaud third with 4.9 rebounds. Stanford players have five of the top six, and seven of the top 10 single-game scoring outputs among Pac-12 freshmen, with Ingram holding down the top two spots (19, 19) and Raynaud tied for fourth with 16 (with Ingram twice). Ingram ranks ninth in scoring, fourth in rebounds and fifth in assists among freshmen from major conferences.

#### **TAITZ TIME**

Noah Taitz has been on fire from 3-point range over the last five games, going 10-for-17 (58.8%) from deep with multiple threes in four of the five contests. Taitz now ranks second in the Pac-12 in 3-point percentage at 52.6%, and is averaging 7.4 points per night over the last five games - a mark that ranks fourth on the team. The Cardinal is shooting 37.6 percent from deep as a team over the stretch, and has the fourth-best 3-point percentage as a team in the conference this season (34.3%, through Dec. 14).

#### **HOSTING AN HBCU**

Stanford moved to 13-0 all-time against HBCUs with a win over NC A&T on Tuesday, Nov. 23. Last season, Stanford travels to its first such program a year ago, also at NC A&T, where Stanford was the first power conference team the Aggies ever hosted in men's basketball. The Pac-12 announced an educational and basketball scheduling partnership in September with the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) which will see Stanford participate in a home-and-home series with a SWAC school in 2024 and 2025. This marks the third-straight season Stanford has scheduled an HBCU.

#### **FUN WITH SMALL SAMPLE SIZES**

Each team has had its two early season Pac-12 games take place, with the exception of Washington's scheduled outings, as Stanford took on Colorado and Oregon. Early in conference season, Stanford ranks first in free throw percentage (.800) and threes per game (9.0), second in 3-point percentage (.375) and third in field goal percentage (.468), assists per game (14.5) and scoring offense (74.0).

#### PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

Stanford is one of five power conference programs not to take a transfer this year (Stanford, Colorado, UConn, Villanova, Purdue). Only Stanford, Colorado and Purdue don't have a transfer on their entire roster, while Stanford hasn't taken a transfer since Andrew Zimmerman in 2009-10, the longest gap nationally without taking a transfer among power conference teams by 10 years. More than 300 Division I programs took a transfer for the 2021-22 campaign.

#### **RANKINGS REPORT**

Stanford has won four of its last 10 games against ranked opponents, including victories over Oregon, Colorado, Alabama and UCLA. The Cardinal came up short in its first attempt this season, on the road at Baylor, but will face four more ranked teams, and three in the top 10, in the current AP poll this season. The Cardinal's next opportunity to face a ranked team will be Dec. 19 vs. No. 17/17 Texas in a neutral site contest in Las Vegas. Stanford had two neutral ranked victories last season, and its last win over a top-10 opponent also came against the then-No. 9/9 Longhorns on Dec. 23, 2014 (74-71, ot).

#### **WELCOME TO THE FARM**

Stanford signed a pair of four-star forwards when the early signing period opened in the class of 2022. Jaylen Thompson, from Oakland and rated as high as No. 62 nationally by 247 Sports, and Ryan Agarwal, a four star Rivals shooting guard from Coppell, Texas, join a program that has signed top-20 classes nationally in three of the past four seasons, while this year's class begins with Stanford signing two four-star players for the third consecutive year.

#### NRA DRAFT

Ziaire Williams was selected with the 10th overall selection in the 2021 NBA Draft, eventually heading to the Memphis Grizzlies via trade. Stanford is one of 12 programs nationally with a player drafted in each of the last three seasons, while Williams is the fifth top-10 and lottery pick in program history, joining Josh Childress (6th, 2004), Rich Kelley (7th, 1975), Adam Keefe (10th, 1992) and Brook Lopez (10th, 2008).

#### **MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICAN GAME**

Freshman Harrison Ingram became the ninth recruit in program history to earn a spot on the McDonald's All-American game roster, while the Cardinal has a participant for the second-straight year - the first time in program history to accomplish the feat in back-to-back years. Ingram joins Ziaire Williams (2020), Reid Travis (2014), Brook and Robin Lopez (2006), Josh Childress (2001), Casey Jacobsen (1999) and Jarron and Jason Collins (1997) as Stanford athletes with the honor.

#### **FIBA U19 WORLD CUP**

Harrison Ingram was selected by USA Basketball to compete at the FIBA U19 World Cup in Latvia, while Jerod Haase was chosen as an assistant coach for the team. Ingram averaged 4.6 points, 4.1 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.7 steals per game for the United States, which went 7-0 and defeated France to win gold, 83-81. Ingram's 1.7 steals per game led the United States, and ranked 12th overall at the event.

#### **OLYMPIAN**

KZ Okpala became Stanford basketball's fifth Olympian when he competed for Nigeria in Tokyo. Okpala, who is in his third season with the Miami Heat in the NBA after two campaigns at Stanford, joins Ron Tomsic (USA, 1956), Jim Walsh (USA, 1956), Andrew Vlahov (Australia, 1988, 1992, 1996, 2000) and Johnny Rogers (Spain, 2000) as Stanford men's basketball Olympians.

#### SUSTAINED SUCCESS

Stanford has had a first team All-Pac-12 player in each of the last nine years, while no other program has an active streak of more than four years (Arizona State, Oregon State, USC).

#### **FLOOR BURNS**

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2021-22 totals (76 combined, 9.5 per game) are as follows:
