#### **SETTING THE SCENE**

The Diamond Head Classic begins on Wednesday in Honolulu, as Stanford opens the holiday event with Wyoming at 2 p.m. PT on ESPNU. The winner plays either Liberty or Northern Iowa in the second round.

#### THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford is 6-4 (1-1 Pac-12) to start the season, with all five non-conference wins coming in double-digit fashion. Harrison Ingram leads the team with 12.8 points and 6.9 rebounds per game, while Jaiden Delaire is close behind Ingram at 12.2 per night. Michael O'Connell paces the squad with 3.5 assists per outing.
- Showcasing the program's depth and balance, 11 Cardinal players have reached double figures in a game this season. The Cardinal is the only Pac-12 program to reach 11 players in this category.
- Stanford is 6-0 at home this season, besting opponents by an average of 11.3 points per game at Maples Pavilion. The Cardinal remained unbeaten in November home games since 2018 (12-0), and are off to a 6-0 start at home for the second time in three seasons. The Cardinal is 12-3 in December home games under Jerod Haase, and 8-1 over the last three-plus seasons.
- The Cardinal has never competed in the Diamond Head Classic, and will play in Hawaii for the first time since the Maui Classic in 2004. Stanford was in last season's Maui Invitational, played in Asheville, N.C.
- The Cardinal has outrebounded its opponent in all 10 games this season, posting a plus-8.9 margin on the glass, which is 18th-best nationally. Stanford is holding foes to 28.8 rebounds per game, and ranks 15th nationally in offensive rebound percentage (37.0%) per KenPom.


#### **MULTI-TEAM EVENT**

Stanford is looking for it's first tournament victory since claiming the title at the 2007 Basketball Travelers Classic, hosted at Maples Pavilion. Stanford was in the Maui Invitational a year ago, besting Alabama in the opening round, while the Cardinal's last trip to Hawaii included a win over BYU - a possible opponent on the opposite side of the Diamond Head bracket. The Cardinal's last trip to Oahu was in the postseason NIT in 1990, which came at Hawaii in a 69-57 defeat.

#### ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In his first five seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.



The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country - He was named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year and an Academic All-American.

The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign.

Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase Joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons and earned a postseason berth with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016. During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015.

#### **CARDIAC CARDINAL**

Jaiden Delaire drained a 3-pointer at the buzzer on Dec. 12 to lead Stanford past Oregon, 72-69. Delaire gave Stanford its first win at the buzzer since Oscar da Silva scored at the horn against UCLA on Jan. 23, 2021, stepping into a deep 3-pointer on the left wing, scoring over Oregon's Eric Williams Jr. The 20 points for Delaire came in a season-best output, as he also pitched in six rebounds and two blocks. Four days later, Harrison Ingram scored inside with 0.7 seconds left on the clock against Dartmouth to send the game to overtime. Three Stanford players tied or set new career-highs in the 89-78 win, as the Cardinal blitzed the Big Green in the extra period, 15-4, to claim an 11-point victory.

#### **THAT'S HIGH PRAISE**

It took no time at all for Harrison Ingram to earn accolades from the Pac-12, as he was named the conference Freshman of the Week for the third time this season, and second consecutively, on Dec. 20. Ingram leads all Pac-12 freshmen with three weekly honors, earning the most recent award after averaging 14.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game against Dartmouth and No. 17/17 Texas.

#### THE NET RESULT

Stanford debuted at No. 143 in the first edition of the NCAA's NET rankings released on Dec. 6 and currently stands at No. 128 as of Dec. 20. Stanford has up to two quad one opportunities (Wyoming, BYU) at the Diamond Head Classic.

#### **INGRAM STANDS ALONE**

Harrison Ingram is the only freshman in the country to post averages of at least 12 points, six rebounds and three assists per game, while nationally he is one of 27 players averaging at least 12/6/3. He is the only true freshman in the Pac-12 averaging double-figure points per game, 6.1 more than second-place Lazar Stefanovic (Utah). Ingram leads all Pac-12 freshmen in rebounds and assists as well, ranking 10th in the conference in rebounds per game among all players, as well as 10th in assists.

#### TAITZ LEADS THE LEAGUE

Noah Taitz has been on fire from 3-point range over the last seven games, going 13-for-24 (54.1%) from deep with multiple threes in five of the seven contests. Taitz leads the Pac-12 in 3-point percentage at 50.0%, and is averaging 7.1 points per night over the last seven games - a mark that ranks fifth on the team. The Cardinal is shooting 35.9 percent from deep as a team over the stretch.

### FRESHMEN SENSATIONS

Stanford has three of the top eight freshmen in the Pac-12 in terms of scoring, with Harrison Ingram the only true freshman in the conference to average in doubles figures (12.8 pts). Maxime Raynaud is fifth with 5.8 points per game, while Isa Silva slots in seventh with 3.8 per night. Ingram paces all freshmen in the conference with 6.9 rebounds and 3.4 assists per game, while Silva ranks third with 1.7 assists and Raynaud third with 4.7 rebounds. Stanford players have six of the top seven, and nine of the top 12 single-game scoring outputs among Pac-12 freshmen, with Ingram holding down the top two spots (19, 19) and Raynaud tied for fourth with 16 (with Ingram twice). Ingram ranks eighth in scoring, fourth in rebounds and fifth in assists among freshmen from major conferences.

#### **LOOKING AHEAD**

In addition to playing seven previous games in program history against Wyoming, Stanford has faced five of the additional seven teams in the field, never taking on South Florida or Liberty. The Cardinal won the only meeting with Northern Iowa in 2012, coming at the Battle 4 Atlantis, while the program has three wins apiece against BYU and Vanderbilt. The Cardinal has faced Hawaii 11 times in program history, going 8-3 in those games, but has not tipped off with the Warriors since 1990.

#### **PLAYER DEVELOPMENT**

Stanford is one of five power conference programs not to take a transfer this year (Stanford, Colorado, UConn, Villanova, Purdue). Only Stanford, Colorado and Purdue don't have a transfer on their entire roster, while Stanford hasn't taken a transfer since Andrew Zimmerman in 2009-10, the longest gap nationally without taking a transfer among power conference teams by 10 years. More than 300 Division I programs took a transfer for the 2021-22 campaign.

#### **FUN WITH SMALL SAMPLE SIZES**

Each team has had its two early season Pac-12 games take place, with the exception of Washington's scheduled outings, as Stanford took on Colorado and Oregon. Early in conference season, Stanford ranks first in free throw percentage (.800) and threes per game (9.0), second in 3-point percentage (.375) and third in field goal percentage (.468), assists per game (14.5) and scoring offense (74.0).

#### **WELCOME TO THE FARM**

Stanford signed a pair of four-star forwards when the early signing period opened in the class of 2022. Jaylen Thompson, from Oakland and rated as high as No. 62 nationally by 247 Sports, and Ryan Agarwal, a four star Rivals shooting guard from Coppell, Texas, join a program that has signed top-20 classes nationally in three of the past four seasons, while this year's class begins with Stanford signing two four-star players for the third consecutive year.

#### **NBA DRAFT**

Ziaire Williams was selected with the 10th overall selection in the 2021 NBA Draft, eventually heading to the Memphis Grizzlies via trade. Stanford is one of 12 programs nationally with a player drafted in each of the last three seasons, while Williams is the fifth top-10 and lottery pick in program history, joining Josh Childress (6th, 2004), Rich Kelley (7th, 1975), Adam Keefe (10th, 1992) and Brook Lopez (10th, 2008).

#### **MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICAN GAME**

Freshman Harrison Ingram became the ninth recruit in program history to earn a spot on the McDonald's All-American game roster, while the Cardinal has a participant for the second-straight year - the first time in program history to accomplish the feat in back-to-back years. Ingram joins Ziaire Williams (2020), Reid Travis (2014), Brook and Robin Lopez (2006), Josh Childress (2001), Casey Jacobsen (1999) and Jarron and Jason Collins (1997) as Stanford athletes with the honor.

#### **OLYMPIAN**

KZ Okpala became Stanford basketball's fifth Olympian when he competed for Nigeria in Tokyo. Okpala, who is in his third season with the Miami Heat in the NBA after two campaigns at Stanford, joins Ron Tomsic (USA, 1956), Jim Walsh (USA, 1956), Andrew Vlahov (Australia, 1988, 1992, 1996, 2000) and Johnny Rogers (Spain, 2000) as Stanford men's basketball Olympians.

#### **FIBA U19 WORLD CUP**

Harrison Ingram was selected by USA Basketball to compete at the FIBA U19 World Cup in Latvia, while Jerod Haase was chosen as an assistant coach for the team. Ingram averaged 4.6 points, 4.1 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.7 steals per game for the United States, which went 7-0 and defeated France to win gold, 83-81. Ingram's 1.7 steals per game led the United States, and ranked 12th overall at the event.

#### SUSTAINED SUCCESS

Stanford has had a first team All-Pac-12 player in each of the last nine years, while no other program has an active streak of more than four years (Arizona State, Oregon State, USC).

### **FLOOR BURNS**

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2021-22 totals (96 combined, 9.6 per game) are as follows:
