SETTING THE SCENE

Stanford returns to the court in 2021-22 with an exciting mix of returning players and a highly-regarded recruiting class. Jerod Haase begins his sixth season at the helm of the program, which looks to rise to the top of the Pac-12 in this year, and reach the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2014.

THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford went 14-13 (10-10 Pac-12) last season, including three victories over eventual Sweet 16 teams and two over Elite Eight programs.
- Jaiden Delaire was named the Pac-12's Most Improved Player of the Year after more than doubling his sophomore scoring mark to 13.4 points per game in conference action. He reached double-figure scoring in 15 of the last 19 games in 2020-21.
- Harrison Ingram joins the Cardinal as a consensus top-15 recruit, as Stanford's second-consecutive five-star addition and McDonald's All-American. He is one of two top-60 additions, joining Isa Silva.
- The Cardinal has scheduled a challenging non-conference slate led by defending national champion Baylor, beginning a home-and-home series, and a trip to Honolulu for the Diamond Head Classic. Stanford will play three teams this season in the AP preseason top-eight, four in the top-13 and eight that were either in the top-25 or received votes.
- Stanford's defense was once again one of the best in the Pac-12, as well as nationally, a year ago. After finishing 7th in 2019-20 in KenPom adjusted defensive efficiency, the Cardinal finished 28th last year.

NBA DRAFT

Ziaire Williams was selected with the 10th overall selection in the 2021 NBA Draft, eventually heading to the Memphis Grizzlies via trade. Stanford is one of 12 programs nationally with a player drafted in each of the last three seasons, while Williams is the fifth top-10 and lottery pick in program history, joining Josh Childress (6th, 2004), Rich Kelley (7th, 1975), Adam Keefe (10th, 1992) and Brook Lopez (10th, 2008).

**ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH
DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL
JEROD HAASE**



In his first five seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 82 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time since 2015. The 2020 team was set to be postseason bound before the cancellation of the postseason.

The 2020-21 campaign was turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, and Stanford showed its resilience and tenacity with a 14-13 overall record and 10 Pac-12 wins. The season included three wins over eventual Sweet 16 teams, two over Elite Eight programs, and a sweep of Arizona for the first time since 2008. Oscar da Silva established himself as one of the top forwards in the country - He was named the Pac-12 Scholar Athlete of the Year and an Academic All-American.

The Cardinal signed its third top-20 recruiting class in four seasons, led by five-star forward Harrison Ingram. Ingram gives the program a McDonald's All-American for the second-straight year, the first time in Stanford history the feat has been accomplished.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04. The 20 wins marked Stanford's first such season since the 2014-15 campaign.

Haase and his staff capped the season with a top-10 national recruiting class for 2020 - it's second top-10 class since Haase joined the Cardinal - including top-five signee Ziaire Williams and four players rated at least four stars by one outlet.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I. In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons and earned a postseason berth with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016. During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015.

MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICAN GAME

Freshman Harrison Ingram became the ninth recruit in program history to earn a spot on the McDonald's All-American game roster, while the Cardinal has a participant for the second-straight year - the first time in program history to accomplish the feat in back-to-back years. Ingram joins Ziaire Williams (2020), Reid Travis (2014), Brook and Robin Lopez (2006), Josh Childress (2001), Casey Jacobsen (1999) and Jarron and Jason Collins (1997) as Stanford athletes with the honor.

SQUAD GOALS

Stanford returns 61.3 percent of its minutes from a year ago, including four players who drew at least 14 starts last season. Jaiden Delaire (12.5 pts) leads the way as the Pac-12's Most Improved Player and an honorable mention All-Pac-12 selection a year ago, while Spencer Jones (8.2 pts) and Michael O'Connell (6.7 pts) saw significant minutes last year. Lukas Kisunas (3.3 pts) started 14 games as a junior in the middle, while three four-star recruits from a year ago, Brandon Angel, Max Murrell and Noah Taitz will look to continue their progression.

In addition to the aforementioned Ingram, Stanford added four-star and consensus top-60 national recruit Isa Silva (G, Sacramento, Calif.), three-star Jarvis Moss (G, Concord, N.C) and seven-footer Maxime Raynaud (F, Paris, France). Stanford has its third top-20 national recruiting class in the last four seasons.

FIBA U19 WORLD CUP

Harrison Ingram was selected by USA Basketball to compete at the FIBA U19 World Cup in Latvia, while Jerod Haase was chosen as an assistant coach for the team. Ingram averaged 4.6 points, 4.1 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.7 steals per game for the United States, which went 7-0 and defeated France to win gold, 83-81. Ingram's 1.7 steals per game led the United States, and ranked 12th overall at the event.

FIGHTING THROUGH ADVERSITY

A season turned upside down by the COVID-19 global outbreak and subsequent restrictions in Santa Clara County, Stanford men's basketball showed its resilience and tenacity during the 2020-21 season. The season began with hoops set up outdoors at Taube Family Tennis Center, with the first day in Maples not allowed until October 14.

Stanford departed for its season opener at the Maui Invitational, which had been relocated to Asheville, North Carolina, and learned en route to the tournament that Santa Clara County announced restrictions that would prevent the team from returning home to campus. The team wound up staying in Chapel Hill, North Carolina for an additional week after the tournament, and then made Santa Cruz, California its temporary home. In total, Stanford spent 59 of the first 64 days of the season on the road from Nov. 28-Jan. 30, with stays in nine cities and six states. 10 games were either canceled or postponed to a new date throughout the campaign.

FRESH PRINCE OF DELAIRE

Jaiden Delaire made the most of his opportunity in Pac-12 play a year ago, averaging 13.4 points and 4.4 rebounds per game, including six outings with at least 19 points. Delaire was one of three players to more than double their scoring average from 2019-20 among the top-20 scorers in the conference, along with Noah Williams (WSU) and Jarod Lucas (OSU), and was became the third player in program history to be named Pac-12 Most Improved Player, joining Dwight Powell (2013) and Anthony Brown (2014). Delaire's 13.4 points per night in Pac-12 action ranks fourth among all returners league-wide, trailing only Johnny Juzang (UCLA), Noah Williams (WSU) and Azuolas Tubelis (ARI).

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

Stanford is one of five power conference programs not to take a transfer this year (Stanford, Colorado, UConn, Villanova, Purdue). Only Stanford, Colorado and Purdue don't have a transfer on their entire roster, while Stanford hasn't taken a transfer since Andrew Zimmerman in 2009-10, the longest gap nationally without taking a transfer among power conference teams by 10 years. More than 300 Division I programs took a transfer for the 2021-22 campaign.

LAST TIME ON THE OC

Michael O'Connell flourished in his first season on campus, averaging 8.2 points per game as a starter and 7.5 points per game across all conference matchups. The first prospect to be rated top-100 in both hoops (247Sports) and lacrosse (Inside Lacrosse) at the time of his signing, O'Connell ranks third among all returners in conference play with 3.4 assists per game and second with 1.6 steals.

OLYMPIAN

KZ Okpala became Stanford basketball's fifth Olympian when he competed for Nigeria in Tokyo. Okpala, who has spent the last two seasons with the Miami Heat in the NBA after two campaigns at Stanford, joins Ron Tomsic (USA, 1956), Jim Walsh (USA, 1956), Andrew Vlahov (Australia, 1988, 1992, 1996, 2000) and Johnny Rogers (Spain, 2000) as Stanford men's basketball Olympians.

GET A STOP

Stanford has been one of the top defensive programs in the country over the past two seasons, ranked as the 7th best defensive team in 2019-20 and the 28th best in 2020-21 per KenPom. Stanford is one of just nine teams nationally to rank in KenPom's top-30 in each of the last two years, joining Kansas, Memphis, Texas Tech, San Diego State, Wisconsin, USC, Houston and Michigan. Stanford's adjusted defensive efficiency marks the last two seasons are the Cardinal's best since the 2007-08 campaign.

IN THE NBA

Stanford has five active NBA players to start the season: Brook Lopez (MIL), Robin Lopez (ORL), KZ Okpala (MIA), Dwight Powell (DAL) and Ziaire Williams (MEM).

PAC-12 SHOWS OUT AT THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Pac-12 performed at an admirable level in the postseason, going 13-5 in the NCAA Tournament, including 10 double-digit victories and seven against AP Top-25 competition. Stanford hovered near the top of the conference table for a majority of the 2020-21 campaign before derailing late in the year after a series of injuries and absences.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS

Stanford has had a first team All-Pac-12 player in each of the last nine years, while no other program has an active streak of more than four years (ASU, OSU, USC).

WELCOME TO THE FARM

Former UAB head coach Rob Ehsan joined the staff as assistant coach over the summer, replacing new Denver head coach Jeff Wulbrun. Ehsan joins the Cardinal following a four-year stint as the head coach at UAB, where his teams averaged 19 wins a season at 76-57 overall. He spent four years as an assistant under Jerod Haase, and was part of Haase's staff that advanced to the second round of the 2015 NCAA Tournament, and went to the postseason a total of four times in eight years while at UAB. He previously spent time as an assistant at Virginia Tech (2011-12) and at Maryland (2007-11).

THE OSCAR GOES TO...

Oscar da Silva finished a tremendous career on campus in 2021, emerging as one of the most productive players in the country, averaging 18.5 points, 6.7 rebounds and 2.4 assists per game while shooting 56.9 percent from the floor as a senior. da Silva was honored with third team CoSIDA Academic All-America honors while also earning first team All-Pac-12 and all-district praise. da Silva's legacy was forever enshrined through a generous gift from an anonymous donor, creating an assistant coach endowment. Adam Cohen is the first to hold the title of Oscar da Silva Associate Head Men's Basketball Coach. da Silva will play this season for Alba Berlin in Germany.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2020-21 totals (274 combined, 10.1 per game) were as follows:
