SETTING THE SCENE

Capping its abbreviated home schedule this week, Stanford men's basketball hosts Oregon on Thursday, Feb. 25. The 6 p.m. contest will air on ESPNU.

THE OPENING TIP

ESPN2

- Stanford is 14-9 (10-7 Pac-12) on the season, with league wins vs. Arizona (twice), Oregon State, Washington (twice), Washington State, UCLA, California (twice) and Utah.
- Senior captain Oscar da Silva is stating his case as the Pac-12's top player through 17 games, averaging 18.9 points, 7.1 rebounds and 2.5 assists per night in conference play.
- Through 23 games, Stanford ranks 25th nationally in defensive efficiency (per KenPom, as of Feb. 23) while limiting opponents to 40.4 percent shooting from the field this season. Stanford ranked seventh nationally in defensive efficiency a year ago, while boasting the nation's 16th-ranked scoring defense.
- The Cardinal is looking for its second-straight win over Oregon at Maples Pavilion, and the third in four games, after upending the No. 11/12 Ducks a year ago.
- Stanford was the final power conference program to play at its home facility this season. The Cardinal is also one of two power conference teams to boast multiple road wins in non-conference play, joining Oklahoma State, and leads the power conferences in playing 19 road + neutral games, four more than second-place Colorado.
- Jaiden Delaire has emerged as one of the most improved players in the Pac-12, averaging 14.0 points per game in conference action. He has reached double-figure scoring in 13 of the last 15 games, including three-straight with 20 or more points from Jan. 28-Feb. 2.

BUILDING A RESUME

Stanford is one of just seven teams nationally with at least four Q1 wins and six road wins, joining Gonzaga, Baylor, Illinois, Ohio State, West Virginia and Oklahoma State. Only 21 teams have four Q1 wins in the country, while Stanford is the only program in the Pac-12 to reach the threshold.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In four seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.



Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 68 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I.

In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Several players have flourished under Haase's tutelage. KZ Okpala became Stanford's latest NBA Draft pick in 2019. Along with Okpala's first team all-conference selection and Josh Sharma's All-Pac-12 nod, Reid Travis was a two-time First Team All-Pac-12 selection in 2018 and a two-time NABC All-District pick. Dorian Pickens was named an all-conference player for his performance on the court and the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year for his efforts in the classroom in 2018.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to the 2016 regularseason Conference USA championship and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase was 80-53 overall in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Prior to UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. Haase is a 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration.

THE NET RESULT

Stanford debuted at No. 55 in the first edition of the NCAA's NET rankings released on Jan. 4, and currently stands at No. 57 as of Feb. 23. Stanford is the sixth-highest rated team in the Pac-12, following USC (14), Colorado (22), UCLA (42), Arizona (44) and Oregon (45), while eight teams are in the top-100.

ELITE COMPANY

Senior captain Oscar da Silva is posting numbers that rival the best in all of college basketball this season. He is the only player nationally averaging at least 18.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game while shooting 55% or better from the field. He is one of six players nationally averaging at least 18.5 points while shooting 55% or better, joining three likely All-Americans in Luka Garza (lowa), Corey Kispert and Drew Timme (Gonzaga), and mid-major stars Taevion Kinsey (Marshall) and Ryan Davis (Vermont). He has the second-highest field goal percentage in the group at 58.0 from the floor.

EXTENDED ROAD TRIP

Stanford played its first 16 games away from Maples Pavilion & Stanford's campus to start the season, doing so for the first time in program history. Stanford's previous road trip lasted 24 days, as the team has temporarily relocated out of Santa Clara County, and the second trip stood at 35 days, with the team staying on the road for 59 of 64 days, from Nov. 27 to Jan. 30.

MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICAN GAME

Stanford signee Harrison Ingram became the ninth recruit in program history to earn a spot on the McDonald's All-American game roster, while the Cardinal has a participant for the second-straight year the first time in program history to accomplish the feat in back-to-back years. Ingram joins Ziaire Williams (2020), Reid Travis (2014), Brook and Robin Lopez (2006), Josh Childress (2001), Casey Jacobsen (1999) and Jarron and Jason Collins (1997) as Stanford athletes with the honor.

THE OSCAR GOES TO...

Oscar da Silva, the Pac-12's second-leading scorer, is one of three Pac-12 players this season to have two or more 30-point outings (32 at CSUN, Dec. 15 & 31 at Oregon State, Jan. 4) and he leads the league with 10 20-point outings. da Silva has finished in double figures in all but one game this season. He is the first Stanford player with multiple 30-point outings in the same season since Chasson Randle had four in 2014-15, and he joins Landry Fields (3, 2009-10), Brook Lopez (4, 2007-08) and Anthony Goods (2, 2006-07) in having multiple 30-point games since 2006.

da Silva ranks in the top five in the conference in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage, and he leads the league in scoring, field goals made and free throws made. He is the one of two players with six double-doubles in Pac-12 play, joining Evan Mobley (USC).

ATTACK FOR MY TEAMMATE

Stanford is 12-2 this season when multiple players tally at least three assists - a mark that has held true in all but two of its wins. Stanford has recorded at least 15 assists in five of its Pac-12 wins, including a season-high 20 as a team against Washington on Jan. 7 and 19 last Saturday vs. Utah on Feb. 13. Five players average multiple assists per game, led by Daejon Davis' 3.4 per appearance.

AT THE BUZZER

Taking down #24/20 UCLA, 73-72 (ot), on Jan. 23, Stanford earned its first win at the buzzer since Jan. 7, 2018, when Daejon Davis scored from beyond midcourt against USC. Underneath the basket with 0.8 seconds to go, Oscar da Silva scored the final two of his 26 points when he scored on a layup as time expired.

HERE COMES JONES

Spencer Jones has returned to form since departing Asheville, North Carolina, shooting 41.9 percent from 3-point range while averaging 8.7 points per game. He ranks fifth in the Pac-12 in conference play with a 42.5 percent clip from 3-point range, and first among players with at least 30 made threes. Jones tied a career-high on Jan. 7 with 18 points against Washington, and has finished in double figures six times in conference play.

FRESH PRINCE OF DELAIRE

Jaiden Delaire has made the most of his opportunity in Pac-12 play, averaging 14.0 points and 4.1 rebounds per game, including six outings with at least 19 points. Delaire, who tallied three straight games with 20 or more points from Jan. 28-Feb. 2, has improved to 12.9 points per game on the season. He ranks 14th in the Pac-12 in scoring in conference play, and 18th overall. Among the top-20 scorers in the conference, he joins Noah Williams (WSU) and Jarod Lucas (OSU) in doubling their scoring average from a season ago.

PAC-12 WEEKLY HONORS

Michael O'Connell became the third Stanford player honored with a Pac-12 weekly award on Feb. 1, earning Freshman of the Week after his strong performances at Arizona and Arizona State. He averaged 13.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game against Arizona and Arizona State, with a 7 to 1 assist to turnover ratio. He joined Oscar da Silva (Player of the Week, twice) and Ziaire Williams (Rookie of the Week, once) with Pac-12 accolades this season.

O'Connell has been one of the top freshman guards in the conference this season, averaging 8.4 points per game against Pac-12 foes. Only Josh Christopher (ASU) and Bennedict Mathurin (ARI) average more per game in league play among first year guards, while O'Connell leads all freshman point guards. Earlier this season he went 99 minutes without a turnover against Oregon State, Washington and Washington State, and had an active streak of 109 minutes without vs. UCLA, Arizona and Arizona State end vs. ASU.

CLIMBING THE RECORD BOOKS

Oscar da Silva has moved into 16th all-time in scoring at Stanford, and is just seven points from moving into 15th. He also stands eighth in blocks, 13th in made field goals, 13th in minutes played, 15th in rebounds, 15th in games started and is on pace to finish 14th in field goal percentage. Daejon Davis, meanwhile, ranks fifth all-time at Stanford in steals and sixth in assists, and will crack the top-15 for minutes played and games started by the end of the season.

TRIPLE DOUBLE

Ziaire Williams led a high octane offensive effort against Washington on Jan. 7 with the second triple-double in program history, and the first using assists as one of the categories. He finished with 12 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists, becoming the fifth freshman in Pac-12 history to tally a triple-double. The first Stanford triple-double came on Jan. 25, 2007, when Brook Lopez had 18 points, 11 rebounds and 12 blocks vs. USC. Williams' triple-double is the first in any conference matchup since Lopez's effort in 2007, and he earned the Naismith Trophy Player of the Week Award on Jan. 11 for the performance.

SIGNING DAY

The Cardinal has added a pair of top-35 RSCI prospects in the class of 2025. Harrison Ingram gives Stanford a five-star recruit for the second-consecutive season, joining the Cardinal as the consensus No. 12 recruit, though he is ranked as high as ninth in the country by Rivals, and the top-ranked signee from the state of Texas. A crafty guard and gifted passer with a supreme feel for the game, Isael Silva is a four-star recruit and the consensus No. 31 signing in the country, though is ranked as high as No. 26 by Rivals. Stanford is one of seven programs nationally to have signed two top-35 prospects.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2020-21 totals (238 combined) are as follows:
