SETTING THE SCENE

Looking for its first road sweep of the desert schools since 2003-04, Stanford men's basketball travels to Arizona State on Saturday night. The 7 p.m. PT contest will be televised on ESPN2.

THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford is off to an 10-5 start (6-3 Pac-12), with league wins vs. Arizona (twice), Oregon State, Washington, Washington State and UCLA. A win on Saturday would be Stanford's third Pac-12 road win.
- The Cardinal opened conference action with a 78-75 win over Arizona, which snapped a streak of 20 straight defeats in the series. Stanford finished its Wildcat sweep on Thursday in Tucson, 73-64.
- Through 15 games, Stanford ranks ninth nationally in defensive efficiency (per KenPom, as of Jan. 29) while posting the 29th-best field goal defense in the country (39.4%). Stanford ranked seventh nationally in defensive efficiency a year ago, while boasting the nation's 16th-ranked scoring defense.
- The Cardinal is 8-0 this season when winning the rebounding battle, and 9-0 when scoring at least 70
- Stanford is the only power conference program yet to play at its home facility this season. The Cardinal's only "home" games have been played in Santa Cruz. The Cardinal is also one of two power conference teams to boast multiple road wins in non-conference play, joining Oklahoma State.
- Oscar da Silva is stating his case as the Pac-12's top player through nine games, averaging 20.3 points, 7.8 rebounds and 2.6 assists per night in conference play.
- Stanford picked up its first win in the McKale Center since Feb. 16, 2008 on Thursday. A victory on Saturday would be Stanford's first in Tempe since 2018 (84-83).

AT THE BUZZER

Taking down #24/20 UCLA, 73-72 (ot), on Jan. 23, Stanford earned its first win at the buzzer since Jan. 7, 2018, when Daejon Davis scored from beyond midcourt against USC. Underneath the basket with 0.8 seconds to go, Oscar da Silva scored the final two of his 26 points when he scored on a layup as time expired.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In four seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.



Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 68 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I.

In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Several players have flourished under Haase's tutelage. KZ Okpala became Stanford's latest NBA Draft pick in 2019. Along with Okpala's first team all-conference selection and Josh Sharma's All-Pac-12 nod, Reid Travis was a two-time First Team All-Pac-12 selection in 2018 and a two-time NABC All-District pick. Dorian Pickens was named an all-conference player for his performance on the court and the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year for his efforts in the classroom in 2018.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to the 2016 regularseason Conference USA championship and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase was 80-53 overall in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Prior to UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. Haase is a 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration.

THE NET RESULT

Stanford debuted at No. 55 in the first edition of the NCAA's NET rankings released on Jan. 4, and currently stands at No. 53 as of Jan. 29. Stanford is the sixth-highest rated team in the Pac-12, following Colorado (17), USC (23), UCLA (31), Arizona (42), and Oregon (51).

"HOME" COURT ADVANTAGE

Stanford is one of three Pac-12 teams without a blemish on its home record, despite the Cardinal's home games being played in Santa Cruz to this point. UCLA and Colorado join Stanford without a defeat on their home floor.

EXTENDED ROAD TRIP

Stanford is set to play its 16th and final game away from Maples Pavilion & Stanford's campus to start the season, doing so for the first time in program history. Stanford's previous road trip lasted 24 days, as the team has temporarily relocated out of Santa Clara County, and the current trip will stand at 35 days as of Jan. 30, and as of game day the team will have been on the road for 59 of the last 64 days. The Cardinal is one of five teams nationally to have played at least four games with none at its home venue, including San Jose State, New Mexico, New Mexico State and Jackson State.

THE OSCAR GOES TO...

Oscar da Silva, the Pac-12's leading scorer, is the only Pac-12 player this season to have two 30-point outings (32 at CSUN, Dec. 15 & 31 at Oregon State, Jan. 4) and he leads the league with seven 20-point outings. da Silva has finished in double figures in every game this season. He is the first Stanford player with multiple 30-point outings in the same season since Chasson Randle had four in 2014-15, and he joins Landry Fields (3, 2009-10), Brook Lopez (4, 2007-08) and Anthony Goods (2, 2006-07) in having multiple 30-point games since 2006.

He is one of three players in the country averaging at least 19 points while shooting over 59 percent from the floor (min. 8 GP), joining Iowa's Luka Garza and Vermont's Ryan Davis, and is the only player nationally averaging at least 19 points and two assists per game with a field goal percentage above 59 percent.

ATTACK FOR MY TEAMMATE

Stanford is 9-0 this season when multiple players tally at least three assists - a mark that has held true in all but one of its wins. Stanford has recorded at least 15 assists in four of its six Pac-12 wins, including a season-high 20 as a team against Washington on Jan. 7.

TRIPLE DOUBLE

Ziaire Williams led a high octane offensive effort against Washington with the second triple-double in program history, and the first using assists as one of the categories. He finished with 12 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists, becoming the fifth freshman in Pac-12 history to tally a triple-double. The first Stanford triple-double came on Jan. 25, 2007, when Brook Lopez had 18 points, 11 rebounds and 12 blocks vs. USC. Williams' triple-double is the first in any conference matchup since Lopez's effort in 2007.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

For the second time this season, Oscar da Silva was honored as the Pac-12 Player of the Week on Jan. 11. da Silva averaged 25.0 points and 11.0 rebounds per game in leading Stanford to a 3-0 record with wins over Oregon State, Washington and Washington State. He was the first Stanford player with three double-doubles in a row since Josh Sharma did the same to end the 2018-19 campaign. Additionally, Ziaire Williams was honored as the Naismith Trophy Player of the Week on Jan. 11 after averaging 11.3 points, 6.3 rebounds and 5.0 assists on the week, including the program's second-ever triple double.

O'CONNELL EMERGES

Pressed into action following injuries in the backcourt, freshman guard Michael O'Connell has been a steady floor general over the past seven games, averaging 7.3 points, 3.7 rebounds and 3.9 assists while posting a 6.75:1 assist-to-turnover ratio. He went 99 minutes without a turnover against Oregon State, Washington and Washington State, and has an active streak of 78 minutes without vs. UCLA and Arizona.

FRESH PRINCE OF DELAIRE

Jaiden Delaire has made the most of his opportunity in Pac-12 play, averaging 13.8 points and 5.4 rebounds per game, including four outings with at least 19 points. Delaire, who tied his career-high with 21 points against both Washington and Arizona, has improved to 11.9 points per game on the season.

NBA UPDATE

Brook Lopez - 10.6 pts, 5.3 reb, 1.5 blk per game. Five straight games in double figures for 11-6 Bucks. Robin Lopez - 7.4 pts, 4.2 reb, 1.1 ast per game. Season-best 14 points last time out vs. Pelicans. KZ Okpala - 3.0 pts, 1.8 reb per game. First NBA start Jan. 16 vs. Detroit, four starts this year for the Heat. Dwight Powell - 4.5 pts, 3.5 reb, 1.1 stl per game. Had season-high 11 points on Christmas vs. LA Lakers. Tyrell Terry - 1.1 pts, 0.6 ast per game. Played career-high 15 min on Jan. 17 vs. Chicago, had four points.

HERE COMES JONES

Spencer Jones has returned to form since departing Asheville, North Carolina, shooting 42.0 percent from 3-point range while averaging 9.0 points per game. He ranks 10th in the Pac-12 in conference play with a 43.2 percent clip from 3-point range, and the third-best percentage among players with at least two made triples per game. He tied a career-high on Jan. 7 with 18 points against Washington.

HISTORY AT AN HBCU

Stanford's matchup on Sunday, Dec. 6 marked the first time in program history that Stanford traveled to a historically black college or university (HBCU), earning a win at North Carolina A&T, 78-46. It was also the first time in North Carolina A&T history that it hosted a power five opponent. The Cardinal moved to 12-0 all-time against HBCUs, which is spread across nine opponents. Stanford has faced an HBCU in back-to-back seasons, while men's basketball was the first Stanford team to travel to an HBCU since women's volleyball played at Howard in 2018, and the first men's basketball program in the Pac-12 to do so since Oregon State went to Howard in 2010.

TURN IT OVER

The Cardinal has forced 226 turnovers through 15 games (15.1 per game), including a season-best 24 against North Carolina on Dec. 1. Five players are averaging at least one steal per game: Spencer Jones, Daejon Davis, Jaiden Delaire, Ziaire Williams and Bryce Wills, while the team leads the Pac-12 with 110 steals. The Cardinal defense is forcing turnovers on 20.8 percent of possessions.

SIGNING DAY

The Cardinal has continued its strong recruiting, adding a pair of top-35 RSCI prospects in the class of 2025. Harrison Ingram gives Stanford a five-star recruit for the second-consecutive season, joining the Cardinal as the consensus No. 12 recruit, though he is ranked as high as ninth in the country by Rivals, and the top-ranked signee from the state of Texas. A crafty point guard and gifted passer with a supreme feel for the game, Isael Silva is a four-star recruit and the consensus No. 31 signing in the country, though is ranked as high as No. 26 by Rivals. Stanford is one of seven programs nationally to have signed two top-35 prospects, joining Duke, Kentucky, Oregon, Florida State, Michigan and Baylor.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2020-21 totals (156 combined) are as follows:
