SETTING THE SCENE

Remaining at Maples Pavilion for the third time in the last four games, Stanford men's basketball is set to host Colorado on Thursday, Feb. 11. The 4 p.m. contest will air on ESPNU.

THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford is off to a 12-7 start (8-5 Pac-12), with league wins vs. Arizona (twice), Oregon State, Washington, Washington State, UCLA and California (twice).
- Senior captain Oscar da Silva is stating his case as the Pac-12's top player through 13 games, averaging 19.8 points, 7.8 rebounds and 2.5 assists per night in conference play.
- The Cardinal earned its second regular season sweep on Saturday vs. California, having also swept Arizona earlier this season. Additionally, Stanford won its only contest this season against UCLA.
- Through 19 games, Stanford ranks 21st nationally in defensive efficiency (per KenPom, as of Feb. 9) while limiting opponents to 40.1 percent shooting from the field this season. Stanford ranked seventh nationally in defensive efficiency a year ago, while boasting the nation's 16th-ranked scoring defense.
- Stanford was the final power conference program to play at its home facility this season. Prior to last Tuesday's clash with USC, the Cardinal's only "home" games had been played in Santa Cruz. The Cardinal is also one of two power conference teams to boast multiple road wins in non-conference play, joining Oklahoma State.
- The team hasn't missed a beat with players out of the lineup, as Michael O'Connell and Lukas Kisunas have emerged in the starting five. Jaiden Delaire is averaging 16.3 points per game over the last 11 outings.

ELITE COMPANY

Senior captain Oscar da Silva is posting numbers that rival the best in all of college basketball this season. He is the only player nationally averaging at least 19 points, 7 rebounds and 2 assists per game while shooting better than 55% from the field, and he joins only Luka Garza (Iowa) and Corey Kispert (Gonzaga) - two locks for All-America status - in averaging 19 points and shooting 56% or better from the field.

**ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH
DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL
JEROD HAASE**



In four seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and self-less attitude into the program.

Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 68 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I.

In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Several players have flourished under Haase's tutelage. KZ Okpala became Stanford's latest NBA Draft pick in 2019. Along with Okpala's first team all-conference selection and Josh Sharma's All-Pac-12 nod, Reid Travis was a two-time First Team All-Pac-12 selection in 2018 and a two-time NABC All-District pick. Dorian Pickens was named an all-conference player for his performance on the court and the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year for his efforts in the classroom in 2018.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to the 2016 regular-season Conference USA championship and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase was 80-53 overall in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Prior to UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. Haase is a 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration.

THE NET RESULT

Stanford debuted at No. 55 in the first edition of the NCAA's NET rankings released on Jan. 4, and currently stands at No. 58 as of Feb. 5. Stanford is the fifth-highest rated team in the Pac-12, following Colorado (15), USC (16), UCLA (37) and Arizona (44). Stanford is one spot ahead of Oregon (59).

EXTENDED ROAD TRIP

Stanford played its first 16 games away from Maples Pavilion & Stanford's campus to start the season, doing so for the first time in program history. Stanford's previous road trip lasted 24 days, as the team has temporarily relocated out of Santa Clara County, and the second trip stood at 35 days, with the team staying on the road for 59 of 64 days, from Nov. 27 to Jan. 30.

AT THE BUZZER

Taking down #24/20 UCLA, 73-72 (ot), on Jan. 23, Stanford earned its first win at the buzzer since Jan. 7, 2018, when Daejon Davis scored from beyond midcourt against USC. Underneath the basket with 0.8 seconds to go, Oscar da Silva scored the final two of his 26 points when he scored on a layup as time expired.

THE OSCAR GOES TO...

Oscar da Silva, the Pac-12's leading scorer, is the only Pac-12 player this season to have two 30-point outings (32 at CSUN, Dec. 15 & 31 at Oregon State, Jan. 4) and he leads the league with nine 20-point outings. da Silva has finished in double figures in all but one game this season. He is the first Stanford player with multiple 30-point outings in the same season since Chasson Randle had four in 2014-15, and he joins Landry Fields (3, 2009-10), Brook Lopez (4, 2007-08) and Anthony Goods (2, 2006-07) in having multiple 30-point games since 2006.

da Silva ranks in the top five in the conference in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage, and he leads the league in scoring, field goals made and free throws made. He is the only player with six double-doubles in Pac-12 play.

FRESH PRINCE OF DELAIRE

Jaiden Delaire has made the most of his opportunity in Pac-12 play, averaging 14.7 points and 4.4 rebounds per game, including six outings with at least 19 points. Delaire, who tallied three straight games with 20 or more points from Jan. 28-Feb. 2, has improved to 13.1 points per game on the season. He ranks 11th in the Pac-12 in scoring in conference play, and 16th overall. Among the top-20 scorers in the conference, he joins Noah Williams (WSU) and Jarod Lucas (OSU) in doubling their scoring average from a season ago.

PINK SHADE OF CARDINAL

Thursday's battle with Colorado will be Stanford men's basketball's annual Breast Cancer Awareness Game, presented by Stanford Medicine. Stanford, which also will do a Pediatric Cancer Awareness Night later this season, will be wearing pink socks for the game, while the staff will put on pink masks to raise awareness to the fact that one in eight U.S. women will develop breast cancer over the course of her lifetime, and that there are more than 3.5 million breast cancer survivors in the United States.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

The Cardinal posted a 14-4 mark at home last season inside Maples Pavilion, and is looking for its second this season (1-1) after beating Cal on Sunday night. Stanford has won 73.5 percent (50-18) of its home contests at Maples under head coach Jerod Haase, and boasts an all-time mark of 554-223 (.713) at Maples, dating back to 1968. The Cardinal went 5-0 in Santa Cruz at its temporary home facility, Kaiser Permanente Arena, home of the Golden State Warriors' G-League affiliate.

PAC-12 WEEKLY HONORS

Michael O'Connell became the third Stanford player honored with a Pac-12 weekly award on Feb. 1, earning Freshman of the Week after his strong performances at Arizona and Arizona State. He averaged 13.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game against Arizona and Arizona State, with a 7 to 1 assist to turnover ratio. He joined Oscar da Silva (Player of the Week, twice) and Ziaire Williams (Rookie of the Week, once) with Pac-12 accolades this season.

O'Connell has been one of the top freshman guards in the conference this season, averaging 8.1 points per game against Pac-12 foes. Only Josh Christopher (ASU) and Benedict Mathurin (ARI) average more per game in league play among first year guards, while O'Connell leads all freshmen point guards. Earlier this season he went 99 minutes without a turnover against Oregon State, Washington and Washington State, and had an active streak of 109 minutes without vs. UCLA, Arizona and Arizona State end vs. ASU.

TRIPLE DOUBLE

Ziaire Williams led a high octane offensive effort against Washington with the second triple-double in program history, and the first using assists as one of the categories. He finished with 12 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists, becoming the fifth freshman in Pac-12 history to tally a triple-double. The first Stanford triple-double came on Jan. 25, 2007, when Brook Lopez had 18 points, 11 rebounds and 12 blocks vs. USC. Williams' triple-double is the first in any conference matchup since Lopez's effort in 2007, and he earned the Naismith Trophy Player of the Week Award for the performance.

ATTACK FOR MY TEAMMATE

Stanford is 10-1 this season when multiple players tally at least three assists - a mark that has held true in all but two of its wins. Stanford has recorded at least 15 assists in four of its six Pac-12 wins, including a season-high 20 as a team against Washington on Jan. 7.

HERE COMES JONES

Spencer Jones has returned to form since departing Asheville, North Carolina, shooting 38.1 percent from 3-point range while averaging 8.3 points per game. He ranks 16th in the Pac-12 in conference play with a 38.0 percent clip from 3-point range, and he tied a career-high on Jan. 7 with 18 points against Washington. He has finished in double figures four times in conference play.

HISTORY AT AN HBCU

Stanford's matchup on Sunday, Dec. 6 marked the first time in program history that Stanford traveled to a historically black college or university (HBCU), earning a win at North Carolina A&T, 78-46. It was also the first time in North Carolina A&T history that it hosted a power five opponent. The Cardinal moved to 12-0 all-time against HBCUs, which is spread across nine opponents. Stanford has faced an HBCU in back-to-back seasons, while men's basketball was the first Stanford team to travel to an HBCU since women's volleyball played at Howard in 2018, and the first men's basketball program in the Pac-12 to do so since Oregon State went to Howard in 2010.

SIGNING DAY

The Cardinal has added a pair of top-35 RSCI prospects in the class of 2025. Harrison Ingram gives Stanford a five-star recruit for the second-consecutive season, joining the Cardinal as the consensus No. 12 recruit, though he is ranked as high as ninth in the country by Rivals, and the top-ranked signee from the state of Texas. A crafty guard and gifted passer with a supreme feel for the game, Isael Silva is a four-star recruit and the consensus No. 31 signing in the country, though is ranked as high as No. 26 by Rivals. Stanford is one of seven programs nationally to have signed two top-35 prospects.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2020-21 totals (191 combined) are as follows:
