#### **SETTING THE SCENE**

Opening its 2020-21 season at the Camping World Maui Invitational, in Asheville, North Carolina, Stanford will face Alabama (1-0) in the first round at 6:30 p.m. (PT) on ESPN2. Alabama took down Jacksonville State in its opener, 81-57, while the Cardinal's season debut against Utah Valley was canceled.

#### THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford finished 20-12 overall and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a 2019-20 season shortened by the COVID-19 global outbreak.
- Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense a year ago, and KenPom No. 7 defense, the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04 and was led by Oscar da Silva (15.7 pts, 6.4 reb) and Tyrell Terry (14.6 pts, 4.5 reb, 3.2 ast), a 2020 draft selection by the Dallas Mavericks.
- Stanford returns four of five starters from a year ago, with Daejon Davis (8.8 pts, 3.7 ast), Bryce Wills (7.8 pts, 4.0 reb) and Spencer Jones (8.8 pts, 3.2 reb) joining da Silva among returners. da Silva (first team) and Wills (all-defense) take the floor as all-conference selections from last season.
- This is the fourth matchup in program history against Alabama, and the first in series history taking place outside of a postseason tournament. The last meeting came in the second round of the 2013 NIT.
- The Cardinal returns 74 percent of its scoring from a year ago, and adds to it with ESPN's 10th-rated recruiting class in the country, led by five star small forward Ziaire Williams. All five of Stanford's freshmen were rated four stars or higher by at least one recruiting service.

#### **MAINLAND MAU**

This will be Stanford's first appearance in the Maui Invitational since 2004, and the fourth time Stanford has competed in the event having also participated in 1987 and 1992. Traditionally played at the Lahaina Civic Center, the 2020 edition will be the first in its 37-year history to be played on the mainland, relocating to Asheville, North Carolina's Harrah's Cherokee Center. Stanford is 3-6 all-time, going 1-2 in 2004 (win vs. BYU), 0-3 in 1992, and 2-1 in 1987 (wins vs. Chaminade and Baylor).

#### ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In four seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.



Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 68 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I.

In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Several players have flourished under Haase's tutelage. KZ Okpala became Stanford's latest NBA Draft pick in 2019. Along with Okpala's first team all-conference selection and Josh Sharma's All-Pac-12 nod, Reid Travis was a two-time First Team All-Pac-12 selection in 2018 and a two-time NABC All-District pick. Dorian Pickens was named an all-conference player for his performance on the court and the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year for his efforts in the classroom in 2018.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to the 2016 regularseason Conference USA championship and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase was 80-53 overall in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Prior to UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. Haase is a 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration.

#### **NBA BOUND**

After a prolific freshman season, point guard Tyrell Terry was selected with the first pick (31st overall) of the second round by the Dallas Mavericks in the NBA Draft on November 18. He gives Stanford a draft selection for the second-straight year, as KZ Okpala was selected by the Miami Heat in 2019. He joins four Stanford second round picks since 2010, all of which went on to have productive NBA careers: Landry Fields (39th, 2010), Dwight Powell (45th, 2014), Anthony Brown (34th, 2015) and KZ Okpala (32nd, 2019).

#### GUESS WHO'S BACK?

The Cardinal returned to the Peninsula in August with one of its deepest teams in the Jerod Haase era. Stanford returns four of five starters, and seven of the nine players that were consistently in the rotation throughout 2019-20. Nearly 74% of Stanford's scoring is back, to go with 81% of its rebounds and 70% of its assists from last season. The returners combined to shoot 47.9% from the field, which together would have been a top-12 national mark a year ago.

#### **TWO SHADES OF RED**

The Cardinal and Crimson Tide have met three times in program history, each of which came in a posteason tournament. Alabama knocked Stanford out of the 1992 (Cincinnati, Ohio, 80-75) and and 2004 (Seattle, Washington, 70-67) NCAA Tournaments, and most recently the 2013 NIT (Tuscaloosa, Alabama, 66-54).

#### WELCOME TO THE FARM

Adding five highly-sought-after players to a team on the rise, Stanford men's basketball has added freshmen Ziaire Williams, Noah Taitz, Max Murrell, Brandon Angel and Michael O'Connell for the 2020-21 campaign. Stanford's recruiting class was ranked No. 10 nationally per 247Sports and ESPN, and No. 11 by Rivals, while all three platforms praise the Cardinal as a top-two class in the Pac-12. ESPN ranks Stanford as the No. 1 recruiting class in the conference.

A five-star signing and top-five national recruit, Williams is the top rated prospect to choose Stanford since the recruiting databases began. A versatile, three-level scorer, he is the top-rated small forward in the high school class of 2020. Williams is joined by four players, each rated four stars or higher by at least one platform.

#### **SIGNING DAY**

The Cardinal has continued its strong recruiting, adding a pair of top-35 RSCI prospects in the class of 2025. Harrison Ingram gives Stanford a five-star recruit for the second-consecutive season, joining the Cardinal as the consensus No. 12 recruit, though he is ranked as high as ninth in the country by Rivals, and the top-ranked signee from the state of Texas. A crafty point guard and gifted passer with a supreme feel for the game, Isael Silva is a four-star recruit and the consensus No. 31 signing in the country, though is ranked as high as No. 26 by Rivals. Stanford is one of seven programs nationally to have signed two top-35 prospects, joining Duke, Kentucky, Oregon, Florida State, Michigan and Baylor.

#### **EYES ON YOU**

Noah TAITZ

Senior Oscar da Silva and freshman Ziaire Williams have been mainstays on the national watch lists, with both players earning a nod as two of 50 players on the Naismith Trophy watch list. The Cardinal was one of nine schools nationally to have multiple players recognized, and the only team in the Pac-12. Additionally, da Silva is the only player from the Pac-12 on the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year watch list, and Ziaire Williams is one of three freshmen on the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year watch list.

#### PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATION

Stanford men's basketball has been selected fourth in the preseason Pac-12 poll, including one first place vote. Additionally, senior Oscar da Silva and freshman Ziaire Williams were named to the Pac-12 Preseason Media All-Conference first team. The fourth-place preseason ranking is Stanford's highest under head coach Jerod Haase, and the program's uppermost ranking since the start of the 2012-13 campaign. Stanford was one of two schools, joining Oregon, to get multiple players on the preseason All-Pac-12 first team.

Additionally, Stanford received votes in the Associated Press and Coaches' preseason top-25s. The Cardinal is one of four teams earning votes from the Pac-12, joining Oregon, Arizona State and UCLA.

#### **SUCCESS IN SEASON OPENERS**

Stanford has won 10-straight season openers dating back to the 2010-11 seasons, each of which came against a different opponent. The Cardinal have won its season openers under Jerod Haase by an average of 14.8 points per game, with wins over Montana, Seattle, Cal Poly and Harvard.

#### IN THE RECORD BOOKS

The Stanford record books required a sizeable number of edits following the 2019-20 season, as senior Daejon Davis continued his ascent through the all-time steals and assists lists. He now ranks seventh in program history in career steals, with 134, and eighth in program history for career assists, with 391. If Davis duplicated his marks from 2019-20, he would end up in the top four in both categories, while he is also 70 points shy of joining the 1,000-point club.

Oscar da Silva, who reached 1,000 career points in the Pac-12 Tournament, moved into 10th on the Cardinal career blocks list with 96. Spencer Jones, meanwhile, tallied the seventh-most made 3-pointers in a single season (81), and second most among freshmen players, trailing only Chasson Randle. Tyrell Terry entered the freshman record books in 13 categories, including the second-highest scoring average (14.6), which trails only Todd Lichti (17.2, 1985-86).

#### **HOME COURT ADVANTAGE**

The Cardinal posted a 14-4 mark at home last season inside Maples Pavilion, including eight consecutive victories to begin the season. Stanford has won 74.2 percent (49-17) of its home contests under head coach Jerod Haase, and boasts an all-time mark of 553-222 (.713) at Maples, dating back to 1968.

#### D, D, D, DEFENSE

Daejon Davis and Bryce Wills team up to form one of the best defensive backcourts in all of college basketball. Wills ranked No. 1 in the country last season with 0.613 points per possession allowed, per synergy sports, while allowing his opponents to shoot just 30.4 percent from the floor against him. Davis totaled 1.7 steals per game last year, which ranked third in the Pac-12, and he is the active career leader in the conference with 134 total swipes.

#### **OUICK HITTERS**

- Stanford-Utah Valley, scheduled for Nov. 25, was one of 32 games canceled or postponed on the opening day of the college basketball season. The Cardinal is the only team in the Maui tournament field that will make its season debut in Asheville.
- Stanford was 100% registered to vote as a team for the 2020 election in November.
- Former Stanford great Landry Fields '10 was hired as assistant general manager for the Atlanta Hawks, while one of Maples' favorite floor generals, Mitch Johnson '09, was named assistant coach for the San Antonio Spurs.
- KZ Okpala, a 2019 draft selection, reached the NBA Finals with the Miami Heat after a long stay in the NBA's bubble. While Okpala didn't see the floor in the playoffs, he was notably tasked with playing as Giannis Antetkounmpo on Miami's scout team.
- Robin Lopez, one of six active Stanford alumni in the NBA, departed from the Milwaukee Bucks to sign with the Washington Wizards.

#### **FLOOR BURNS**

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2019-20 totals (246 combined) are as follows:
