SETTING THE SCENE

Kicking off the new year in Eugene, Stanford men's basketball is set to face No. 21/17 Oregon on Jan. 2 at Matthew Knight Arena. The 7 p.m. tip-off will be broadcast on ESPNU.

THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford is off to a 5-2 start, including four consecutive wins after a fourth-place finish in the Maui Invitational (Asheville, N.C.). The Cardinal defeated Alabama in the opening round of the tournament, 82-64, which stands as the only Pac-12 win to this point over a ranked opponent, as the Crimson Tide was slotted at No. 25 in the week one USA Today Coaches' Poll.
- The Cardinal outlasted Arizona, 78-75, in its conference opener, as four players scored in double figures. Oscar da Silva scored 20 or more for the third straight outing, as Stanford stopped a 20-game win streak in the series by the Wildcats.
- Through seven games, Stanford ranks eighth nationally in defensive efficiency (as of Dec. 31) while playing the nation's 62nd-toughest schedule, per KenPom. Stanford ranked seventh nationally in defensive efficiency a year ago, while boasting the nation's 16th-ranked scoring defense.
- Stanford is one of two power conference programs yet to play at its home facility this season, joining South Carolina. The Gamecocks are set to open at home on Jan. 2 against Florida A&M.
- The Cardinal is also one of two power conference teams to boast multiple road wins in non-conference play, joining Oklahoma State. Stanford is 2-0 on the road, winning by an average of 21.5 points per game.
- Stanford's first game on the road trip, at Oregon State (Dec. 31), was postponed due to COVID issues at OSU.

CONFERENCE OF CHAMPIONS

In the Pac-12 opener for both teams, Stanford led for all but 83 seconds in a 78-75 win over Arizona. Oscar da Silva led the team with 21 points, while Ziaire Williams (16) and Spencer Jones (9) added three triples apiece. Bryce Wills (13) and Daejon Davis (11) also finished in double figures, as Stanford won against Arizona for the first time since 2009.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In four seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.



Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 68 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I.

In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Several players have flourished under Haase's tutelage. KZ Okpala became Stanford's latest NBA Draft pick in 2019. Along with Okpala's first team all-conference selection and Josh Sharma's All-Pac-12 nod, Reid Travis was a two-time First Team All-Pac-12 selection in 2018 and a two-time NABC All-District pick. Dorian Pickens was named an all-conference player for his performance on the court and the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year for his efforts in the classroom in 2018.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to the 2016 regularseason Conference USA championship and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase was 80-53 overall in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Prior to UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. Haase is a 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration.

DA SILVA'S DOMINANT DAY

Oscar da Silva set a new career high on Dec. 15 at Cal State Northridge, finishing with 32 points on just 11 shots, including a perfect 14-for-14 performance at the free throw line. Per STATS, da Silva is the only player in college basketball in the last 25 years to average 20 or more points per game while shooting above 65 percent from the field and 95 percent from the line over his first 5 games of a season. Only one other player (Justin Turner, Bowling Green - 15/15) has made more free throws in a game this season without a miss, and da Silva's 14 makes at the stripe are the most for a Stanford player without a miss since 1995, when Brevin Knight went 14-for-14. He trails only Todd Lichti all-time, who holds the top two performances, 15-for-15 and 18-for-18.

Through seven games the Munich, Germany native paces the team with 18.9 points per game this season, while shooting 66.7 percent from the floor, 41.7 percent from 3-point range and 81.6 percent at the line.

EXTENDED ROAD TRIP

Stanford is set to play its eighth straight game away from Maples Pavilion to start the season, doing so for the first time since the building opened in 1969. Stanford's previous road trip lasted 24 days, as the team temporarily relocated out of Santa Clara County from Nov. 30-Dec. 21.

LAST YEAR'S WIN

Stanford earned a 10-point win, 70-60, over No. 11/12 Oregon a year ago at Maples Pavilion on Feb. 1. Oscar da Silva posted a then-career high with 27 points to go with 15 rebounds, leading the Cardinal to its highest-ranked win since also taking down a No. 11/12 Oregon team in 2016. Stanford limited the Ducks to just six made field goals in the second half, with the visitors shooting just 20 percent from the floor over the final 20 minutes.

HISTORY AT AN HBCU

Stanford's matchup on Sunday, Dec. 6 marked the first time in program history that Stanford traveled to a historically black college or university (HBCU), earning a win at North Carolina A&T. It was also the first time in North Carolina A&T history that it hosted a power five opponent. The Cardinal moved to 12-0 all-time against HBCUs, which is spread across nine opponents. Stanford has faced an HBCU in back-to-back seasons, while men's basketball was the first Stanford team to travel to an HBCU since women's volleyball played at Howard in 2018, and the first men's basketball program in the Pac-12 to do so since Oregon State went to Howard in 2010.

TURN IT OVER

The Cardinal has forced 118 turnovers across its first six games (16.9 per game), including a season-best 24 against North Carolina on Dec. 1. Four players are averaging at least one steal per game: Spencer Jones, Daejon Davis, Bryce Wills and Oscar da Silva, while da Silva and Jones are each North of 1.0 blocks per contest. The Cardinal defense is forcing turnovers on 23.2 percent of possessions, and ranks third in the conference with 7.9 steals per game.

FRESHMAN DEBUT

Freshman Ziaire Williams poured in 19 points in his Stanford debut against Alabama, doing so on 8-for-15 shooting, including a 3-for-5 mark from downtown. His 19 points were the most for a Stanford player in his debut in over 40 years, and the second-most in program history behind Mark Pitchford, who had 28 vs. Cal Poly on Nov. 25, 1977. Williams is averaging 12.0 points per game this season.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior Oscar da Silva and freshman Ziaire Williams helped Stanford sweep Pac-12 weekly honors on Dec. 21, as da Silva earned his second-career Player of the Week honor, while Williams was named Freshman of the Week. Stanford is just the second team to sweep the awards over the last two seasons, joining USC.

DAEJON IN "MAUI"

Opening his senior campaign with a bang, Daejon Davis led the Cardinal with 16.3 points per game at the Maui Invitational, while shooting 40 percent from 3-point range and 83 percent from the free throw line. He also contributed 4.0 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 2.0 steals per game, and drew 19 fouls on the opposition.

NBA BOUND

After a prolific freshman season, point guard Tyrell Terry was selected with the first pick (31st overall) of the second round by the Dallas Mavericks in the NBA Draft on November 18. He gives Stanford a draft selection for the second-straight year, as KZ Okpala was selected by the Miami Heat in 2019. He joins four Stanford second round picks since 2010, all of which went on to have productive NBA careers: Landry Fields (39th, 2010), Dwight Powell (45th, 2014), Anthony Brown (34th, 2015) and KZ Okpala (32nd, 2019).

Terry joins Powell as a member of the Dallas Mavericks, and he scored his first career basket on Christmas night against the Los Angeles Lakers.

WELCOME TO THE FARM

Adding five highly-sought-after players to a team on the rise, Stanford men's basketball has added freshmen Ziaire Williams, Noah Taitz, Max Murrell, Brandon Angel and Michael O'Connell for the 2020-21 campaign. Stanford's recruiting class was ranked No. 10 nationally per 247Sports and ESPN, and No. 11 by Rivals, while all three platforms praise the Cardinal as a top-two class in the Pac-12. ESPN ranks Stanford as the No. 1 recruiting class in the conference.

A five-star signing and top-five national recruit, Williams is the top rated prospect to choose Stanford since the recruiting databases began. A versatile, three-level scorer, he is the top-rated small forward in the high school class of 2020. Williams is joined by four players, each rated four stars or higher by at least one platform.

CREATING FOR EACH OTHER

Stanford is 5-0 this season when multiple players tally at least three assists - a mark that has held true in each of its wins this season. Stanford tallied 17 assists in the Pac-12 opener vs. Arizona, as Daejon Davis finished with a season-high seven and Ziaire Williams and Bryce Wills totaled four apiece. The team dished a season-best 19 helpers against North Carolina A&T.

SIGNING DAY

The Cardinal has continued its strong recruiting, adding a pair of top-35 RSCI prospects in the class of 2025. Harrison Ingram gives Stanford a five-star recruit for the second-consecutive season, joining the Cardinal as the consensus No. 12 recruit, though he is ranked as high as ninth in the country by Rivals, and the top-ranked signee from the state of Texas. A crafty point guard and gifted passer with a supreme feel for the game, Isael Silva is a four-star recruit and the consensus No. 31 signing in the country, though is ranked as high as No. 26 by Rivals. Stanford is one of seven programs nationally to have signed two top-35 prospects, joining Duke, Kentucky, Oregon, Florida State, Michigan and Baylor.

EYES ON YOU

Senior Oscar da Silva and freshman Ziaire Williams have been mainstays on the national watch lists, with both players earning a nod as two of 50 players on the Naismith and Wooden Trophy watch lists. The Cardinal was one of nine schools nationally to have multiple players recognized on the Naismith watch list, and the only team in the Pac-12. Additionally, da Silva is the only player from the Pac-12 on the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year watch list, and Ziaire Williams is one of three freshmen on the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year watch list.

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2020-21 totals (73 combined) are as follows:
