#### SETTING THE SCENE

After its Thursday bout with USC was postponed, Stanford men's basketball continues the week in Santa Cruz against UCLA on Saturday at Kaiser Permanente Arena. The 2 p.m. contest will be televised on Fox.

#### THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford is off to an 8-5 start (4-3 Pac-12), with league wins over Arizona, Oregon State, Washington and Washington State. Stanford is 4-0 this season in Santa Cruz, including a 3-0 mark in conference play.
- The Cardinal's second-straight scheduled meeting with USC has been postponed. The first was scheduled for Dec. 13 in Los Angeles, but was postponed to Feb. 2. Yesterday's clash was delayed, as was the first, due to Covid-19 related issues in the Trojans program.
- Through 13 games, Stanford ranks 12th nationally in defensive efficiency (per KenPom, as of Jan. 22) while posting the 26th-best field goal defense in the country (39.1%). Stanford ranked seventh nationally in defensive efficiency a year ago, while boasting the nation's 16th-ranked scoring defense.
- Stanford is the only power conference program yet to play at its home facility this season. The Cardinal's only "home" games have been played in Santa Cruz. The Cardinal is also one of two power conference teams to boast multiple road wins in non-conference play, joining Oklahoma State.
- Oscar da Silva is stating his case as the Pac-12's top player through seven games, averaging 20.0 points, 8.6 rebounds and 2.3 assists per night in conference play.
- The Cardinal snapped a 15-year drought in Pauley Pavilion a year ago, besting the Bruins by 15 points. Stanford, which has won two of the last three in the series, was led by 24 points from Tyrell Terry, now of the Dallas Mavericks.

#### "HOME" COURT ADVANTAGE

Stanford is one of four Pac-12 teams without a blemish on its home record, despite the Cardinal's home games being played in Santa Cruz to this point, UCLA, Oregon and Colorado join Stanford without a defeat on their home floor.

#### ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In four seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.



Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 68 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I.

In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Several players have flourished under Haase's tutelage. KZ Okpala became Stanford's latest NBA Draft pick in 2019. Along with Okpala's first team all-conference selection and Josh Sharma's All-Pac-12 nod, Reid Travis was a two-time First Team All-Pac-12 selection in 2018 and a two-time NABC All-District pick. Dorian Pickens was named an all-conference player for his performance on the court and the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year for his efforts in the classroom in 2018.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to the 2016 regularseason Conference USA championship and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase was 80-53 overall in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Prior to UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. Haase is a 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration.

#### THE NET RESULT

Stanford debuted at No. 55 in the first edition of the NCAA's NET rankings released on Jan. 4, and currently stands at No. 60 as of Jan. 22. Stanford is the sixth-highest rated team in the Pac-12, following Colorado (16), Oregon (25), USC (26), UCLA (34) and Arizona (35).

#### **EXTENDED ROAD TRIP**

Stanford is set to play its 14th straight game away from Maples Pavilion & Stanford's campus to start the season, doing so for the first time in program history. Stanford's previous road trip lasted 24 days, as the team has temporarily relocated out of Santa Clara County, and the current trip will stand at 28 days as of Jan. 23, and as of game day the team will have been on the road for 52 of the last 57 days. The Cardinal is one of four teams nationally to have played at least five games with none at its home venue, including San Jose State, New Mexico and Jackson State.

#### TRIPLE DOUBLE

Ziaire Williams led a high octane offensive effort against Washington with the second triple-double in program history, and the first using assists as one of the categories. He finished with 12 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists, becoming the fifth freshman in Pac-12 history to tally a triple-double. The first Stanford triple-double came on Jan. 25, 2007, when Brook Lopez had 18 points, 11 rebounds and 12 blocks vs. USC. Williams' triple-double is the first in any conference matchup since Lopez's effort in 2007.

#### **PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

For the second time this season, Oscar da Silva was honored as the Pac-12 Player of the Week on Jan. 11. da Silva averaged 25.0 points and 11.0 rebounds per game in leading Stanford to a 3-0 record with wins over Oregon State, Washington and Washington State. He was the first Stanford player with three double-doubles in a row since Josh Sharma did the same to end the 2018-19 campaign. Additionally, Ziaire Williams was honored as the Naismith Trophy Player of the Week on Jan. 11 after averaging 11.3 points, 6.3 rebounds and 5.0 assists on the week, including the program's second-ever triple double.

#### THE OSCAR GOES TO...

Oscar da Silva tallied his second 30-poing outing this season, pouring in 31 at Oregon State (Jan. 4) after tallying a career-best 32 at CSUN (Dec. 15). He is the first Stanford player with multiple 30-point outings in the same season since Chasson Randle had four in 2014-15, and he joins Landry Fields (3, 2009-10), Brook Lopez (4, 2007-08) and Anthony Goods (2, 2006-07) in having multiple 30-point games since 2006. He is the only Pac-12 player this season to have two 30-point outings.

Only one other player (Justin Turner, Bowling Green - 15/15) has made more free throws in a game this season without a miss, and da Silva's 14 vs. CSUN makes at the stripe are the most for a Stanford player without a miss since 1995, when Brevin Knight went 14-for-14. He trails only Todd Lichti all-time, who holds the top two performances, 15-for-15 and 18-for-18. He is one of three players in the country averaging at least 19 points while shooting over 60 percent from the floor, joining lowa's Luka Garza and Vermont's Ryan Davis, and is the only player nationally averaging at least 19 points and two assists per game with a field goal percentage above 60 percent.

#### ATTACK FOR MY TEAMMATE

Stanford is 7-0 this season when multiple players tally at least three assists - a mark that has held true in all but one of its wins. Stanford has recorded at least 16 assists in three of its four Pac-12 wins, including a season-high 20 as a team against Washington on Jan. 7.

#### **NBA UPDATE**

Brook Lopez - 9.3 pts, 5.3 reb, 1.6 blk per game. Helped Bucks to 9-4 record to start the year (1st in East). Robin Lopez - 6.5 pts, 4.2 reb, 0.5 blk per game. First double-double of the year on Jan. 11 vs. Phoenix. KZ Okpala - 4.2 pts, 1.8 reb per game. Earned first NBA start Jan. 16 vs. Detroit and scored 16 points. Dwight Powell - 5.0 pts, 3.6 reb, 1.2 stl per game. Had season-high 11 points on Christmas vs. LA Lakers. Tyrell Terry - 1.1 pts, 0.6 ast per game. Played career-high 15 min on Jan. 17 vs. Chicago, had four points.

#### O'CONNELL EMERGES

Pressed into action following injuries in the backcourt, freshman guard Michael O'Connell has been a steady floor general over the past five games, averaging 6.4points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.6 assists while posting a 4.5-1 assist-to-turnover ratio. He went 99 minutes without a turnover against Oregon State, Washington and Washington State, and is averaging 30.5 minutes over the past five outings.

#### ZIAIRE WITH THE FLAIR

Freshman Ziaire Williams poured in 19 points in his Stanford debut against Alabama, doing so on 8-for-15 shooting, including a 3-for-5 mark from downtown. His 19 points were the most for a Stanford player in his debut in over 40 years, and the second-most in program history behind Mark Pitchford, who had 28 vs. Cal Poly on Nov. 25, 1977. Williams is averaging 11.8 points per game this season.

Williams has turned it on in conference play, where he is averaging 13.4 points and 5.0 rebounds per game and shooting 38.2 percent from 3-point range. He is averaging 16.7 points over the past three outings, and has finished in double figures during six of seven Pac-12 matchups.

#### FRESH PRINCE OF DELAIRE

Jaiden Delaire has made the most of his opportunity in Pac-12 play, averaging 11.8 points and 6.5 rebounds per game while shooting 48.1 percent from the floor. Delaire, who tied a career-high with 21 points against Washington, is one of four players averaging at least 11 points during conference games, and is up to 10.0 points per game on the season

#### **HISTORY AT AN HBCU**

Stanford's matchup on Sunday, Dec. 6 marked the first time in program history that Stanford traveled to a historically black college or university (HBCU), earning a win at North Carolina A&T, 78-46. It was also the first time in North Carolina A&T history that it hosted a power five opponent. The Cardinal moved to 12-0 all-time against HBCUs, which is spread across nine opponents. Stanford has faced an HBCU in back-to-back seasons, while men's basketball was the first Stanford team to travel to an HBCU since women's volleyball played at Howard in 2018, and the first men's basketball program in the Pac-12 to do so since Oregon State went to Howard in 2010.

#### PAC-12 OPENER ENDS WITH A WIN, AND THE END OF A STREAK

In the Pac-12 debut this season for both teams, Stanford led for all but 83 seconds in a 78-75 win over Arizona. Oscar da Silva led the team with 21 points, while Ziaire Williams (16) and Spencer Jones (9) added three triples apiece. Bryce Wills (13) and Daejon Davis (11) also finished in double figures, as Stanford won against Arizona for the first time since 2009. The win snapped a stretch of 20 straight defeats to Arizona.

#### **HERE COMES JONES**

Spencer Jones has returned to form since departing Asheville, North Carolina, shooting 44.7 percent from 3-point range while averaging 8.4 points per game. He ranks sixth in the Pac-12 in conference play with a 48.0 percent clip from 3-point range, and the third-best percentage among players with at least 12 made triples. He tied a career-high on Jan. 7 with 18 points against Washington.

#### **FLOOR BURNS**

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2020-21 totals (138 combined) are as follows:
