SETTING THE SCENE

2-2, 0-0 Pac-12

After opening the 2020-21 campaign with a 12-day venture to North Carolina, Stanford men's basketball travels to Cal State Northridge on Tuesday, Dec. 15 at 2 p.m. The contest will be broadcast on ESPN3

THE OPENING TIP

- Stanford is off to a 2-2 start after a fourth-place finish in the Maui Invitational (Asheville, N.C.) and a win at NC A&T. The Cardinal defeated Alabama in the opening round of the tournament, 82-64, as four players finished in double figures. The win over Alabama is the only Pac-12 win to this point over a ranked opponent, as the Crimson Tide was slotted at No. 25 in the USA Today coaches' poll.
- The Cardinal finished 20-12 overall and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a 2019-20 season shortened by the COVID-19 global outbreak.
- Through four games, Stanford ranks fourth nationally in defensive efficiency while playing the nation's 31st-toughest schedule, per KenPom. Stanford ranked seventh nationally in the category a year ago, while boasting the nation's 16th-ranked scoring defense.
- The Cardinal returns 74 percent of its scoring from a year ago, and adds to it with ESPN's 10th-rated recruiting class in the country, led by five star small forward Ziaire Williams. All five of Stanford's freshmen were rated four stars or higher by at least one recruiting service.
- The contest with the Matadors was slated to be Stanford's second in Los Angeles, but its Pac-12 opener with USC was postponed. Stanford will now open Pac-12 play Dec. 19 in Santa Cruz against Arizona.
- Stanford is 5-0 all-time against CSUN, including a 96-69 win in Jerod Haase's second game at the helm in 2016, and his first at Maples Pavilion.

EXTENDED ROAD TRIP

Stanford is set to play its fifth straight game away from home to start the season, doing so for the first time since the 1996-97 campaign. The 96-97 team ended up going to the Sweet 16. As of Dec. 16, Stanford's road trip has lasted 18 days, as the team temporarily relocated out of Santa Clara County until Dec.

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL JEROD HAASE

In four seasons as Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Jerod Haase has instilled an invested, tough and selfless attitude into the program.



Since arriving on The Farm, the Cardinal has won 68 games, recorded its best conference finish and most league wins in a decade and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04.

Fueled by back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes, Haase's 2018-19 squad featured freshmen and sophomores accounting for 80 percent of the scoring and rebounding. With one of the youngest rosters in the nation, Stanford won 15 games facing one of the toughest road schedules in Division I.

In 2017-18, Haase guided Stanford to a third-place finish in the Pac-12 with 11 conference wins, the program's highest finish and most league victories in 10 seasons. Competing without two starters for half the season, Stanford won 19 games overall and earned a postseason berth for the first time in three years with a second-round appearance in the NIT.

Several players have flourished under Haase's tutelage. KZ Okpala became Stanford's latest NBA Draft pick in 2019. Along with Okpala's first team all-conference selection and Josh Sharma's All-Pac-12 nod, Reid Travis was a two-time First Team All-Pac-12 selection in 2018 and a two-time NABC All-District pick. Dorian Pickens was named an all-conference player for his performance on the court and the Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year for his efforts in the classroom in 2018.

During Haase's first season in 2016-17, Stanford posted 14 wins against a challenging schedule and finished among the nation's top-10 percent in the classroom. Haase was appointed Stanford's 18th head coach in school history on March 25, 2016.

At UAB, Haase led the Blazers to the 2016 regularseason Conference USA championship and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament berth in 2015. Haase was 80-53 overall in four seasons while improving the Blazers' win total every year.

Prior to UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. Haase is a 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration.

INSIDE THE SERIES

Stanford will be just the second Pac-12 opponent that CSUN has hosted in its history, joining Cal in 1995. The Matadors are 5-58 all-time against Pac-12 schools, including a forfeit by Cal in the 1995 game in Northridge. Stanford is 5-0 in the all-time in the series, with the Cardinal prevailing 96-69 in the last meeting on Nov. 15, 2016 at Maples Pavilion.

HISTORY AT AN HBCU

Stanford's matchup on Sunday, Dec. 6 marked the first time in program history that Stanford traveled to a historically black college or university (HBCU), earning a win at North Carolina A&T. It was also the first time in North Carolina A&T history that it hosted a power five opponent. The Cardinal moved to 12-0 all-time against HBCUs, which is spread across nine opponents. Stanford has faced an HBCU in back-to-back seasons, while men's basketball was the first Stanford team to travel to an HBCU since women's volleyball played at Howard in 2018, and the first men's basketball program in the Pac-12 to do so since Oregon State went to Howard in 2010.

TURN IT OVER

The Cardinal has forced 68 turnovers across its first four games (17.0 per game), including a season-best 24 against North Carolina on Dec. 1. Five players are averaging at least one steal per game: Spencer Jones, Daejon Davis, Oscar da Silva, Bryce Wills and Ziaire Williams, while da Silva paces the squad with 1.5 blocks per game. The Cardinal defense is forcing turnovers on 22.8 percent of possessions, and leads the conference with 8.8 steals per game.

FRESHMAN DEBUT

Freshman Ziaire Williams poured in 19 points in his Stanford debut against Alabama, doing so on 8-for-15 shooting, including a 3-for-5 mark from downtown. His 19 points were the most for a Stanford player in his debut in over 40 years, and the second-most in program history behind Mark Pitchford, who had 28 vs. Cal Poly on Nov. 25, 1977.

OSCAR'S HOT START

Senior Oscar da Silva is off to a strong start, averaging 17.3 points on a shooting slash line of 64/56/91 over four games. The forward has filled the stat sheet with at least 13 points in every game, including a season-high 26 against North Carolina A&T in just 24 minutes. He also ranks second on the team in rebounds and assists, third in steals and he leads the way with six blocked shots.

DAEJON IN "MAUI"

Opening his senior campaign with a bang, Daejon Davis led the Cardinal with 16.3 points per game at the Maui Invitational, while shooting 40 percent from 3-point range and 83 percent from the free throw line. He also contributed 4.0 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 2.0 steals per game, and drew 19 fouls on the opposition.

NBA BOUND

After a prolific freshman season, point guard Tyrell Terry was selected with the first pick (31st overall) of the second round by the Dallas Mavericks in the NBA Draft on November 18. He gives Stanford a draft selection for the second-straight year, as KZ Okpala was selected by the Miami Heat in 2019. He joins four Stanford second round picks since 2010, all of which went on to have productive NBA careers: Landry Fields (39th, 2010), Dwight Powell (45th, 2014), Anthony Brown (34th, 2015) and KZ Okpala (32nd, 2019).

Terry joins Powell as a member of the Dallas Mavericks, and selected jersey No. 1 for his rookie campaign. **GUESS WHO'S BACK?**

The Cardinal returned to the Peninsula in August with one of its deepest teams in the Jerod Haase era. Stanford returns four of five starters, and seven of the nine players that were consistently in the rotation throughout 2019-20. Nearly 74% of Stanford's scoring is back, to go with 81% of its rebounds and 70% of its assists from last season. The returners combined to shoot 47.9% from the field, which together would have been a top-12 national mark a year ago.

WELCOME TO THE FARM

Adding five highly-sought-after players to a team on the rise, Stanford men's basketball has added freshmen Ziaire Williams, Noah Taitz, Max Murrell, Brandon Angel and Michael O'Connell for the 2020-21 campaign. Stanford's recruiting class was ranked No. 10 nationally per 247Sports and ESPN, and No. 11 by Rivals, while all three platforms praise the Cardinal as a top-two class in the Pac-12. ESPN ranks Stanford as the No. 1 recruiting class in the conference.

A five-star signing and top-five national recruit, Williams is the top rated prospect to choose Stanford since the recruiting databases began. A versatile, three-level scorer, he is the top-rated small forward in the high school class of 2020. Williams is joined by four players, each rated four stars or higher by at least one platform.

SIGNING DAY

The Cardinal has continued its strong recruiting, adding a pair of top-35 RSCI prospects in the class of 2025. Harrison Ingram gives Stanford a five-star recruit for the second-consecutive season, joining the Cardinal as the consensus No. 12 recruit, though he is ranked as high as ninth in the country by Rivals, and the top-ranked signee from the state of Texas. A crafty point guard and gifted passer with a supreme feel for the game, Isael Silva is a four-star recruit and the consensus No. 31 signing in the country, though is ranked as high as No. 26 by Rivals. Stanford is one of seven programs nationally to have signed two top-35 prospects, joining Duke, Kentucky, Oregon, Florida State, Michigan and Baylor.

SUCCESS IN SEASON OPENERS

Stanford has won 11-straight season openers dating back to the 2010-11 seasons, each of which came against a different opponent. The Cardinal have won its season openers under Jerod Haase by an average of 15.1 points per game, with wins over Montana, Seattle, Cal Poly, Harvard and Alabama, who Stanford defeated on Nov. 30, 82-64.

EYES ON YOU

Senior Oscar da Silva and freshman Ziaire Williams have been mainstays on the national watch lists, with both players earning a nod as two of 50 players on the Naismith and Wooden Trophy watch lists. The Cardinal was one of nine schools nationally to have multiple players recognized on the Naismith watch list, and the only team in the Pac-12. Additionally, da Silva is the only player from the Pac-12 on the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year watch list, and Ziaire Williams is one of three freshmen on the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year watch list.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATION

Stanford men's basketball has been selected fourth in the preseason Pac-12 poll, including one first place vote. Additionally, senior Oscar da Silva and freshman Ziaire Williams were named to the Pac-12 Preseason Media All-Conference first team. The fourth-place preseason ranking is Stanford's highest under head coach Jerod Haase, and the program's uppermost ranking since the start of the 2012-13 campaign. Stanford was one of two schools, joining Oregon, to get multiple players on the preseason All-Pac-12 first team.

D, D, D, DEFENSE

Daejon Davis and Bryce Wills team up to form one of the best defensive backcourts in all of college basketball. Wills ranked No. 1 in the country last season with 0.613 points per possession allowed, per synergy sports, while allowing his opponents to shoot just 30.4 percent from the floor against him. Davis totaled 1.7 steals per game last year, which ranked third in the Pac-12, and he is the active career leader

FLOOR BURNS

During his playing career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court. Whether it be diving for loose balls or taking charges, Haase's trademark hustle was always on display. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" statistic was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 floor burns during the 1996-97 season. Stanford's individual 2020-21 totals (40 combined) are as follows:
