LEADING OFF

» **STANFORD** is currently ranked No. 23 in the USA Today Coaches Poll, No. 24 according to NCBWA and No. 25 by Collegiate Baseball ... is hitting .319 with 47 runs scored, 10 doubles and nine homers over the last five games and .309 with 79 runs scored, 22 doubles and 13 home runs over the last 10 games ... hit seven home runs in the first three games of the season, and has launched 31 through 21 games, after connecting for just two in 16 games a year ago ... is 20-10 in the month of February, 37-11 in March and 29-8 in April under the Clarke and Elizabeth Nelson Director of Baseball David Esquer ... welcomed the seventh-ranked recruiting class according to Perfect Game and Baseball America (11th according to D1Baseball) ... returned to campus on Jan. 23 to begin its mandatory 10-day travel quarantine and medical onboarding process in preparation for the 2021 season.

» **DREW BOWSER** is hitting .353 (12 for 34) with five runs scored, three doubles and 11 RBIs over the last 10 games.

» **NICK BRUESER** hit safely in 12 straight games from March 7 through April 1 (.435, 9 R, 3 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBIs) ... has driven in four runs while hitting .385 (15 for 39) over the last 10 games ... has amassed seven multi-hit games.

» **ADAM CRAMPTON** is hitting .524 (11 for 21) with five runs scored, two doubles, a home run and six RBIs over the last five games.

» **DAVID ESQUER** won his 100th game at the helm of the program on March 4 as Stanford walked off with a 7-6 victory over San Francisco in 10 innings ... now in his fourth season, he has amassed a 112-42 overall record at Stanford and owns a 637-509-2 record as a Division I head coach (18 seasons at California).

» **ZACH GRECH** has made a team-best 13 appearances and has factored into the decisions in all 13 games - compiling a 4-2 record and a Pac-12-best seven saves to rank second in the nation for saves ... has compiled a .69 WHIP to lead the Pac-12 and rank sixth nationally.

» **KODY HUFF** hit safely in each of the first nine games to start the season (.361, 7 R, 2 2B, HR, 6 RBIs), and has a hit in 14 of the 20 games he has played so far ... has reached safely in all but three games he's played this year ... three-run home run vs. Santa Clara on Feb. 27 was the first of his career and came in the eighth inning to add insurance in a 10-6 victory.

» **BROCK JONES** was named Collegiate Baseball national player of the week on March 8 after going 8 for 18 (.444) with four runs scored, two doubles, a triple and three homers to the tune of 12 RBIs and a 1.167 slugging percentage in a series sweep over San Francisco ... hit a pair of home runs in the opening weekend series with Santa Clara before adding three more, including his first career multi-homer game on March 7, in the series vs. San Francisco... has reached safely in all 21 games this year and is hitting .329 with a Pac-12-best nine home runs, a team-high 27 RBIs and 20 runs scored ... has amassed 13 extra-base hits, including three doubles and a triple, while compiling a .750 slugging percentage ... has hit .389 (7 for 18) with five runs scored, two homers and eight RBIs over the last five games ... has connected for four home runs over the last 10 games while hitting .344 with 10 runs scored and 11 RBIs ... has recorded six multi-hit and six multi-RBI games ... has drawn more walks (20) than times he has struck out (19) this year.

» **VINCENT MARTINEZ** homered in three straight games beginning on March 7 at San Francisco and ending with game one of a doubleheader against UC Irvine on March 13 ... hit safely in eight straight games from March 6 to March 20 (.452, 9 R, 3 HR, 5 RBIs) ... is hitting .421 (16 for 38) with 14 runs scored, four doubles, a homer and seven RBIs over the last 10 games ... has hit safely in 16 of the 19 games with an at bat this year ... has amassed eight multi-hit games.

» **CHRISTIAN ROBINSON** has driven in 18 runs to rank third on the team ... has a hit in 13 of the 19 games with an at bat this year ... contributed a walk-off single in the 10th to beat San Francisco 7-6 on March 4 ... 4 for 4 with a double, a home run, two runs scored and three RBIs vs. San Francisco on March 6 ... has four multi-RBI games.

» **TIM TAWA** hit safely in nine straight games from March 4 to March 20 (.464, 8 R, 5 2B, 3 RBIs) ... has hit safely in 15 of the 20 games he's played this year ... is batting .435 (10 for 23) with eight runs scored, a double, three homers and 12 RBIs over the last five games and .359 (14 for 39) with 13 runs scored, three doubles, three homers and 13 RBIs over the last 10 games ... has amassed nine multi-hit games, including three straight and four of the last five.

» **TOMMY TROY** has hit a pair of home runs in his last five games played (three starts).

THIS WEEK

Stanford will host four games from Sunken Diamond this week, welcoming California to campus on Tuesday for a 6:05 p.m. first pitch in a non-conference game between the two Bay Area rivals. The Cardinal will then host UCLA in Pac-12 play beginning on Friday at 2:05 p.m. Game two with the Bruins is set for 2:05 p.m., while Sunday's finale will begin at 1:05 p.m.

A LOOK BACK

Stanford opened the week with a 3-2 setback on the road at Sacramento State on Monday of last week. The Cardinal remained on the road from there, visiting Washington State for a three-game Pac-12 series from Thursday through Saturday. Stanford took the first two games 18-3 and 7-5, but dropped the finale 10-9 in 10 innings. The Cardinal hit .347 as a team in the three-game series, led by Adam Crampton and Tommy Troy who both hit .500. Crampton, who collected six RBIs, contributed two doubles and his first career home run, while Troy connected for a go-ahead two-run homer in Friday night's victory. Senior Tim Tawa also drove in six runs while posting a double and a home run, while Brock Jones blasted two homers of his own and finished the series with eight RBIs.

ON TOP EARLY

The Cardinal is 12-3 when scoring first in a game this season, including 6-0 when scoring in the first inning. Stanford is outscoring opponents 46-11 in the first two innings of games this season – 24-9 in the first and 22-2 in the second.

FREE PASSES AND MISSED OPPORTUNITIES

Stanford drew 15 walks and three hit-by-pitches in a 10-9 setback in 10 innings at Washington State on April 3. The 15 walks are the most drawn by the Cardinal since at least 2000, with the previous high being 13 at Cal Poly on January 21, 2001. While the opportunities were there throughout the contest, Stanford stranded 20 runners in the loss – the most since at least 2000 (previous high over the span was 18 at California on May 25, 2012).

OFFENSIVE UPTICK

Stanford's offensive output has been impressive through 21 games this year, as the Cardinal has batted .291 with 153 runs scored on 213 hits – including 40 doubles, a triple and 31 home runs. In 16 games played in 2020, the Cardinal managed a 5-11 record and hit .207 with 47 runs scored, 29 doubles, two triples and two home runs. Stanford is averaging 7.29 runs per game this year after averaging 2.94 runs per game a year ago. The Cardinal has scored 10-plus runs in seven of the 21 games, and six-plus in 13 of 21, this year after finishing with eight or fewer in each of the 16 contests a year ago.

EARLY SEASON LONG BALLS

Stanford hit just two home runs over 16 games played in 2020, but connected for seven in the first three games this season – including four on Opening Day vs. Santa Clara. Held homerless just six times this year, the Cardinal has launched 31 through 21 games this season to rank first in the conference and 16th in the nation for home runs per game (1.48 per game). The 31 round-trippers are the most for the Cardinal through 21 games since at least 2000, as Stanford's previous high-water mark over that span was 28 in 2004. Stanford's game high for home runs this season is four – managing the feat twice (Feb. 25 vs. Santa Clara; March 7 at San Francisco). Stanford is 14-1 when hitting at least one home run in a game this season.

THIEVES ON THE BASES

Stanford has swiped 27 bases in 32 attempts this year to rank third in the Pac-12 for stolen bases. Senior Tim Tawa is 8 for 9 in steal attempts to lead the way for the Cardinal. Brock Jones is 6 for 9, Christian Robinson is 5 for 5, and Tommy Troy and Adam Crampton are 3 for 3 to round out the Cardinal with multiple steals. The Cardinal was successful on its first 14 attempts this year.

CASHING IN ON OPPORTUNITIES

The Cardinal is hitting .323 (72 for 223) with nine doubles, 11 home runs and 114 RBIs with runners in scoring position this season. Senior Tim Tawa is hitting .556 (10 for 18) with a pair of homers and 14 RBIs while hitting with runners in scoring position, while freshman Drew Bowser is 11 for 23 (.478) with two doubles, a home run and 15 RBIs. Senior Christian Robinson has delivered 17 RBIs while hitting .429 (9 for 21) in the situation, highlighted by a grand slam on February 25. Sophomore Brock Jones has also cashed in, hitting .417 (10 for 24) with two doubles, four homers and a team-best 20 RBIs in run-producing situations. The trend doesn't dip too much with two outs, as the Cardinal is hitting .258 (24 for 93) with five home runs while batting with two away and runners in scoring position. Overall, Stanford has produced 41 two-out RBIs – guided by eight apiece from Jones, Robinson and Tawa.

NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Sophomore Brock Jones was selected as one of *Collegiate Baseball's* national players of the week on March 8 after leading Stanford to a four-game sweep of San Francisco from March 4-7. Jones was 8 for 18 (.444) with four runs scored, two doubles, a triple and three homers to the tune of 12 RBIs and a 1.167 slugging percentage over the four games against the Dons. The native of Fresno, Calif. managed a pair of homers in the series finale on Sunday – the first multi-homer game of his career.

WELCOME TO THE FARM

Stanford's freshman class arrived on The Farm as the seventh-ranked recruiting class in the nation according to Perfect Game and Baseball America. The class features three of the top seven recruits in the Pac-12 according to Perfect Game, as Ryan Bruno, Drew Bowser and Tommy Troy enter ranked No. 2, No. 3 and No. 7, respectively. Eddie Park, Joey Dixon and Drew Dowd are also ranked in Perfect Game's Top 20. D1Baseball tabbed the class, which did not lose a player to the shortened 2020 MLB Draft, 11th overall and second in the Pac-12. The 2020 class is the first top-10 class under David Esquer at Stanford after taking over the program in 2018.

CARDINAL PICKED FIFTH IN PRESEASON POLL

Stanford was picked to finish fifth in the conference according to the Pac-12 Baseball Preseason Coaches Poll. UCLA, which opened the season ranked No. 2 nationally, emerged as the preseason favorite after receiving all 10 available first-place votes and totaling 100 points. Arizona was picked to finish second in the preseason poll with a total of 85 points. The Wildcats narrowly edged Arizona State (83 points) for the runner-up position. Oregon State came in fourth place with 59 points, closely followed by the Cardinal (58 points) in fifth and USC (55 points) in sixth. Oregon (47 points), Washington (45), California (39), Washington State (20) and Utah (14) rounded out the poll.

A STACKED PAC

Perennially one of the top conferences in the nation, the Pac-12 boasted three teams in the Top 25 rankings to open the season. UCLA, which won the most recent Pac-12 regular-season title in 2019, entered the year ranked No. 2 nationally, while Arizona was tabbed a top 10 team according to Collegiate Baseball's preseason poll. Arizona State also found a spot in the Collegiate Baseball preseason poll, checking in at No. 15. UCLA earned the national top seed in 2019, headlining five NCAA Tournament participants from the Conference (No. 11 seed Stanford, No. 16 seed Oregon State, Arizona State and California). UCLA and Stanford each reached Super Regional play, with the Cardinal's berth into the Supers serving as its 11th trip.

'PALISCH'ED PROSPECT

Senior left-handed pitcher Jacob Palisch is listed among Baseball America's top college draft prospects entering the 2021 season. The native of Richardson, Texas checks in at No. 97 on the list despite not taking the hill for the Cardinal in 2020. Palisch posted a 1.29 ERA over 35 innings with 38 strikeouts as a starter in the Cape Code League in 2019 after logging 56 1/3 innings over 26 appearances (seven starts) for the Cardinal that year. Palisch burst onto the scene as a reliever in 2018, pitching to a 3-1 record and a 1.72 ERA with four saves over 26 appearances and 47 innings of work to earn Freshman All-America honors.

THE 2020 SEASON

Stanford finished the 2020 campaign at 5-11 overall, completing nearly one month of nonconference play before the season was shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. The Cardinal maintained a top-25 ranking for the first two weeks of the season despite underclassmen accounting for 60 percent of its overall roster. Stanford took two of three against Grand Canyon for its lone series win, while its signature victory was a 5-4 upset of No. 16 Michigan on March 3 at Sunken Diamond. Stanford's season was then canceled prior to the Pac-12 opener against California following its annual break for final exams.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

There was a youth movement on The Farm in 2020, as 11 freshmen made their collegiate debuts, including six position players who made at least six starts. The group was led by Brock Jones, who was the only Cardinal player to start all 16 games. Jones finished with a share of the team lead in hits (13) and ranked second in total bases (18) while contributing one of two Cardinal home runs a year ago. Cole Hinkelman also enjoyed offensive success in his first season, finishing second on the team in average at .269 while contributing four doubles.

STARTING ROTATION

Stanford's pitching staff showed well in 2020, as the group combined for a 3.50 ERA to rank fourth in the Pac-12. The Cardinal boasted a consistent weekend rotation of right-hander Brendan Beck (3 GS, 2.82 ERA, 22 1/3 IP, 18 H, 6 BB, 25 K), left-hander Quinn Mathews (4 GS, 4.71 ERA, 21 IP, 4 BB, 14 K) and righty Alex Williams (3 GS, 0.51 ERA, 17 2/3 IP, 11 H, 4 BB, 18 K). Prior to being sidelined for the remainder of the season due to injury, Williams' 0.51 ERA led the Pac-12 and ranked 20th in the nation. After producing a quality start in a 2-1 victory over Cal State Fullerton during the season's opening weekend, Williams was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week. Working primarily as a midweek starter, Max Meier finished his inaugural campaign with a 3.07 ERA over six appearances (four starts) and 14 2/3 innings of work. The Cardinal returns 80% of its innings from 2020 (119 1/3 of 149) and all 16 starts.

DEPENDABLE BULLPEN

The Cardinal showcased a dependable bullpen in 2020, as five different relievers compiled sub-4.00 ERAs over the shortened 16-game season. Leading the pack were Nathan Fleischli (1.29 ERA, 14 IP, 9 H, 8 K) and Jackson Parthasarathy (1.69 ERA, 10 2/3 IP, 10 K), who both finished with ERAs below 2.00. Zach Grech (4.15 ERA, 13 IP, 11 K) led the Cardinal in appearances (9) and saves (2).

ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

Eleven Stanford baseball players earned a spot on the Pac-12 Spring Academic Honor Roll after maintaining a cumulative grade-point average of 3.30 or above. NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Often called the most beautiful college baseball facility in the country, Klein Field at Sunken Diamond is the home to Stanford baseball. The "Sunken Diamond" name comes from the excavation to provide fill for the earthen berm within which Stanford Stadium was built in 1921, leaving a large, sunken field. The fixed seating capacity of Klein Field at Sunken Diamond is 2,113. With the addition of disabled seating and general admission lawn seating, the total capacity of the facility is 4,000. The original dimensions were 360 feet to left field, 350 to right, and 500 feet to center. In 1978, a new seven-foot high fence was installed, bringing the dimensions to the current 335 to both left and right field, and 400 to center. The outfield fence height was increased to 10 feet in 1995.

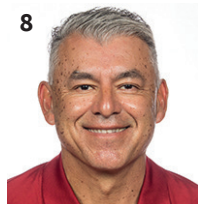
