SETTING THE SCENE

Stanford is set to face a familiar foe in an unfamiliar situation, as Oregon visits the Bay Area for a non-conference game on Saturday, Dec. 21 in the San Jose Tip-Off at SAP Center. The action will tip at 5 p.m. on Big Ten Network.

THE STARTING FIVE

- The Cardinal is off to a 9-2 start with wins over Denver, Cal State Fullerton, Northern Arizona, UC Davis, Norfolk State, Santa Clara, Utah Valley, Merrimack and Cal. Stanford has won nine of its first 11 games for the first time since 2019-20, when it started 15-2.
- Stanford's roster holds an exciting mix of returning players, transfers and freshmen, led one of the best centers in the country, Maxime Raynaud. The Pac-12 Most Improved Player last season, Raynaud is ninth nationally in scoring at 21.5 points per game and third in rebounding with 11.7 per night. He leads the ACC in scoring and is second in rebounding, and his nine double-doubles this season pace the nation.
- Three players are averaging double figures, paced by Raynaud but also including Jaylen Blakes (16.3) and Ozzyah Sellers (14.7). Blakes is posting 18.6 per night over the last five games on 52 percent shooting.
- Stanford opened ACC action with an 89-81 victory on the road over California. Blakes and Raynaud had 20 points each, helping Stanford to its first win at Haas since 2021 and its third straight overall in the series.
- Kyle Smith joined the Cardinal from Washington State as the reigning Pac-12 Coach of the Year, where he led the Cougars to 25 wins and the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2023-24. Smith brought his entire staff from Washington State to the Farm along with program icon Eric Reveno, who was at Oregon State from 2022-24 and was previously on the Cardinal bench from 1997-2006.

DUCKS IN THE SHARK TANK

Stanford welcomes a top-10 Oregon team to SAP Center for a neutral site clash, with the Cardinal looking for its fourth win in the last five games over the Ducks in the Bay Area. A win would also be Stanford's third straight against an AP top-10 opponent, as Stanford downed No. 4 Arizona in both 2023 and 2024. Kyle Smith went 5-4 against Oregon during his tenure at Washington State.

THE NATION'S LEADING CENTER

Maxime Raynaud has been the nation's premier center this season, averaging 21.5 points and 11.7 rebounds per game, ranking ninth and third nationally, while also leading the country in double-doubles (9). He was the first Stanford player with seven consecutive double-doubles since Reid Travis accomplished the same feat from Feb. 24-March 19, 2018.

He ranks first in the ACC in scoring, second in rebounding and fifth in field goal percentage. Stanford has never had a player finish higher than third on the national rebounding leaderboard (Curtis Borchardt, 2001-02), while his scoring average is on pace to be a top-four average in program history. The closest comparison at Stanford is Adam Keefe, who was 11th in scoring (25.3) and fourth in rebounds (12.2) in 1991-92.

Raynaud became the program's 51st member of the 1,000-point club at Stanford, and he currently ranks 36th in program history in scoring with 1,153 points. Next up is Mark Madsen '00 with 1,176. Raynaud is also 12th on the all-time rebound list (747) and is 11 away from the top-10 (Reid Travis, 758).

He is also a mainstay in France's national team system, leading Les Bleus to a gold medal at the 2023 FIBA U-20 European Championship in Greece and a silver medal at the 2019 FIBA U-16 European Championship in Italy.

MEET KYLE SMITH

Smith heads to The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 94-71 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 267-195 career record in his 15th season as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. He spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-00).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round. The postseason was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. They also reached the NIT semifinals in 2022 and earned a bid for a second consecutive season in 2023. Smith was the first coach in Washington State history to post a .500 or better record in each of his first four seasons, doing so after taking over a program that was under .500 in each of the previous seven campaigns.

Prior to Smith's tenure at Washington State, he led San Francisco to a 63-40 record, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Preceding his time in the Bay Area, he served as the head coach at Columbia, where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season.

THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters the matchup with the Ducks at No. 78 in the NET rankings (Dec. 18). The matchup is currently a quadrant one contest, as Oregon slots in at No. 16. 13 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are currently slated to be in quadrant one or two, including eight in Q1.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

Stanford announced the signing of Alexander Papakostas through Team IMPACT on Dec. 14. Alexander, who is 11, is currently in remission from B Cell Lymphoblastic Lymphoma. He joined the program through Team IMPACT, a national nonprofit that connects children facing serious illnesses with college athletic teams, forming life-long bonds and life-changing outcomes.

#BEATCAL

Stanford rolled to an 89-81 victory over rival California on Dec. 7 in the inaugural ACC game for both programs. Five players finished in double figures for Stanford, led by 20 points apiece from Jaylen Blakes and Maxime Raynaud. The 20-point game was the seventh of the season for Raynaud. Blakes also fished six assists and blocked two shots, while Raynaud recorded a career-best five blocks. Oziyah Sellers chipped in 16 points, including a trio of 3-pointers, while Ryan Agarwal and Chisom Okpara had 11 points apiece.

Stanford's defense at the rim was elite, with the players combining for 13 blocks. The 13 blocks were the most for the Cardinal since blocking a program-record 19 shots on Jan. 25, 2007 against USC. Tallis Toure added a career-high three blocks while Aidan Cammann had two and Agarwal one.

BLAKES CALLS GAME

On the road for the first time on Nov. 23, Stanford rallied from an eight-point deficit in the final four minutes to defeat Santa Clara, 71-69. Jaylen Blakes scored the game-winning basket from 18 feet with two seconds to go, fading away from the elbow and sinking a jump shot. Blakes scored eight points and dished a career-high 10 assists in the win.

Blakes has been one of the most improved players, not just in the ACC, but in the entire country this season, ranking 11th in the ACC in scoring, fifth in assists, third in steals and second in free throw makes and attempts, while ranking in the top-20 nationally in free throw makes and attempts as well.

On the season, Blakes is averaging 16.3 points, 5.5 assists and 2.2 steals per game, making him one of just three players nationally to hit each of those benchmarks, along with Bennett Stirtz (Drake) and Sebastian Thomas (Rhode Island). He has improved to 18.6 points per game over the last five contests.

TAKING POSSESSION

Stanford has maximized possessions on both ends of the floor through 11 games, with the Cardinal recording 8.0 steals per game, and forcing 13.0 turnovers per game, while having just 9.7 turnovers per night offensively. Stanford is on pace for its lowest turnovers per game mark in 50 years, as far back as sports reference has the data, and the only mark under 10 per game. Stanford holds a plus-3.3 turnover margin per game and the third best offensive steal percentage (6.3) in the country, per KenPom. Additionally, Stanford ranks 20th in the country in taking care of the ball.

LAIPNI LŪDZAM SAIMNIECĪBĀ

Stanford announced its first signee in the class of 2025 on Nov. 18 in Kristers Skrinda from Riga, Latvia. One of the top prospects in Europe, Skrinda is rated as a top-100 (No. 91 overall) four-star prospect from On3. A versatile, 6-10 forward who attended the prestigious Riga State Gymnasium No. 2 in Riga, Skrinda starred for Latvia at the FIBA U18 Eurobasket in Tampere, Finland, where he averaged 17.7 points, 10.4 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game while shooting 43.9 percent from 3-point range and 96 percent from the free throw line.

SELLERS MARKET

Oziyah Sellers has been an explosive and efficient scorer over the first 11 games, averaging a career-high 14.7 points on 48.4 percent shooting, including a 37.4 percent mark beyond the arc. Sellers slots in 16th in the ACC in points - Stanford is the only ACC program with three of the top-16 scorers in the league - and seventh in field goal percentage. He is one of four ACC players, along with Raynaud, to have 10 or more field goals in a single game twice or more this season.

FUN WITH SMALL SAMPLE SIZES - ACC EDITION

Stanford was one of four schools with multiple 20-point scorers in the ACC openers, along with Florida State, NC State and Syracuse. Maxime Raynaud's eight field goals were tied for the second most on the opening day in the conference, while his four threes were tied for third most. Jaylen Blakes ranks second in assists (6.0), while no player blocked more than Raynaud's five shots against Cal.

As a team, Stanford's 89 points were the most in the league, and the Cardinal also led the way in field goal percentage, 3-point percentage, assists, assist-to-turnover ratio and blocked shots.

ACC AND NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Maxime Raynaud became the program's first to win ACC Player of the Week honors on Nov. 18, and he added to it as a USBWA National Player of the Week on Nov. 19. Raynaud averaged 27.5 points and 12.5 rebounds per game while shooting 56 percent from the floor and 55 percent from beyond the arc in wins over Northern Arizona (Nov. 12) and UC Davis (Nov. 17). He tallied a career day against the Aggies, totaling a career high 33 points to go with a season-high matching 14 rebounds. He also had 22 points and 11 rebounds against Northern Arizona. He was Stanford's first national player of the week since Kanaan Carlyle won AP honors in January last season.

PRO CARD

The Cardinal currently has four players on NBA rosters this season in Brook Lopez (Milwaukee Bucks), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks), Ziaire Williams (Brooklyn Nets) and Spencer Jones (Denver Nuggets).

DOWNED DAVIS

Maxime Raynaud scored a career-high 33 points and grabbed 14 rebounds as Stanford men's basketball defeated UC Davis, 79-65, on Nov. 17 at Maples Pavilion. Raynaud's 33 points were the most for Stanford in a single game since Reid Travis had 33 against Washington on Feb. 22, 2018, and his 33-point double-double was the program's first since Landry Fields had 35 points and 10 rebounds against UCLA and Feb. 4, 2010. Jaylen Blakes finished one point shy of his career high, scoring 17 on 5-for-8 shooting and six made free throws, while Ryan Agarwal set a new career best with 11 rebounds.

KAREEM ABDUL-JABBAR WATCH LIST

Stanford's Maxime Raynaud was one of 20 players named to the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year watch list, and one of four players in the ACC, joining Khama Maluach (Duke), Eddie Lampkin (Syracuse) and Efton Reid II (Wake Forest). He is the third Cardinal player to be on this preseason watch list, joining Stefan Nastic (2015) and Michael Humphrey (2017).

THE (BAY)CC

Stanford was announced on Sept. 1, 2023 as a new member of the Atlantic Coast Conference, along with rival Cal and SMU. This move provided the opportunity for Stanford student-athletes to continue pursuing excellence at the national level, both in the classroom and on the court, which was a core priority for the university throughout the realignment process. Stanford is positioned with universities aligned in vision for the scholar-athlete model and broad-based excellence.

KYLE SMITH

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL FIRST SEASON AT STANFORD

Kyle Smith was announced as the Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball on March 25, 2024, and begins his first season at Stanford in 2024-25.

Smith heads to The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 94-71 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 258-193 career record across 14 seasons as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. Additionally, he spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-2000).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round, while the postseason event was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. The Cougars also reached the NIT semifinals in 2022 and earned a

bid for a second consecutive season in 2023.

Smith was the first coach in Washington State history to post a .500 or better record in each of his first four seasons, doing so after taking over a program that was under .500 in each of the previous seven campaigns.

A talented coach known for expertise in analytics and player development, Smith's tutelage has included two NBA Draft selections in CJ Elleby (2020) and Mou-hamed Gueye (2023) and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year Myles Rice (2024), while three Cougars earned All-Pac-12 recognition this season. Smith also coached San Francisco's Jamaree Bouyea, who made his NBA debut in 2023, and mentored a series of professional athletes as an assistant coach, including NBA players Matthew Dellavedova and Patty Mills at Saint Mary's.

Smith has also seen success on the recruiting trail, landing two top-60 classes, the highest for Washington State in over a decade. He signed a top-100 prospect to Pullman in the class of 2022, the first for the program since Klay Thompson in 2008.

Prior to Smith's tenure at Washington State, he led San Francisco to a 63-40 record, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Smith produced seven All-WCC picks, paced by two-time All-WCC first team selection Frankie Ferrari.

Preceding his time in the Bay Area, he served as the head coach at Columbia where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season. Smith mentored 10 All-Ivy League selections over his six seasons at Columbia, led by Maodo Lo, a two-time first team honoree and the second-leading scorer in school history.

Smith played an integral role in building the Gaels' program into a perennial championship contender in the West Coast Conference under head coach Randy Bennett. In his nine seasons in Moraga, the Gaels made three NCAA Tournament (2005, '08, '10) appearances and earned one NIT bid (2009). Saint Mary's averaged 23 wins over Smith's last six seasons on the staff, including an 81-20 record over his final three seasons. The 2009-10 team finished with a 28-6 record, advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Championship and was ranked 19th nationally in the final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll.

During his one season at Air Force, Smith served as the Falcons' offensive and recruiting coordinator and took a lead role with player development and scouting. He was instrumental in the recruitment of 2003-04 Mountain West Conference Player of the Year Nick Welch along with all-conference players Antoine Hood and A.J. Kuhle.

Before joining the Falcons, Smith served eight seasons as an assistant coach at San Diego from 1992-2000 under Hank Egan and Brad Holland. During his time at San Diego, Smith helped lead the Toreros to their second-highest win total in school history (20 in 1999-2000) and as associate head coach, orchestrated a defense that allowed the lowest opponent scoring average (62.6) in the West Coast Conference (62.6 in 1999-2000).

Born in El Paso, Texas, Smith graduated in 1992 from Hamilton College with a degree in English literature. He also played basketball and helped lead the Continentals to a 26-1 record and the No. 1 ranking in the nation for NCAA Division III as a junior. He shot a school-record 51.3 percent from three-point range and helped Hamilton to an Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) championship.

Smith earned a master's degree in educational leadership from the University of San Diego, where he began his coaching career.

Kyle and his wife, Katie, have three sons, Rocco, Bo, and Luke.
