### SETTING THE SCENE

Stanford men's basketball begins its first ACC Tournament on Wednesday, March 12 after securing an opening round bye. The Cardinal will face Virginia Tech or California at 4 p.m. PT on ESPN2.

### THE STARTING FIVE

- The Cardinal went 19-12 in the regular season (11-9 ACC), including ACC wins over North Carolina, SMU, California (2x), Virginia Tech, Virginia, Florida State, Syracuse, NC State, Boston College and Miami, including two quadrant one NET wins. The Cardinal went 16-2 at home this season and 9-1 in ACC play.
- Stanford's roster holds an exciting mix of returning players, transfers and freshmen, led by the premier center in the country, Maxime Raynaud. Selected to the All-ACC first team, Raynaud is 16th nationally in scoring at 20.1 points per game and fifth in rebounding with 10.9 per night. He is second in the ACC in scoring and first in rebounding, and his 23 double-doubles this season pace the nation. No other major conference player has more than 19, and he is the only player in the country averaging at least 20 and 10.
- Three players are averaging double figures, paced by Raynaud but also including Oziyah Sellers (13.3) and Jaylen Blakes (12.9). Both players are posting career-best numbers by a comfortable margin.
- Blakes has showcased his clutch gene this season with game winning baskets in the closing seconds against both Santa Clara and North Carolina. Blakes made national headlines on Jan. 18 with his last-second winner against the Tar Heels, while his sister, Mikayla, a freshman at Vanderbilt, scored a game-winner of her own less than 24 hours later against Tennessee.
- Kyle Smith joined the Cardinal from Washington State as the reigning Pac-12 Coach of the Year, where he led the Cougars to 25 wins and the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2023-24.

### TOURNEY TIME

Stanford will have to wait until Tuesday night to learn its opponent in its first ACC Tournament. The Cardinal bested the Hokies, 70-59, on Jan. 8 and swept the regular season series with California. Stanford is 3-3 all-time against the Golden Bears in a conference tournament, including a matchup in three of the past five years. Stanford won in overtime in Las Vegas in 2024, 87-76, led by 21 and 13 from Raynaud.

## THE NATION'S LEADING CENTER

Maxime Raynaud has been the nation's premier center this season, averaging 20.1 points and 10.9 rebounds per game, ranking 16th and fifth nationally, while also leading the country in double-doubles (23). His 21st double-double, coming against Boston College on Feb. 26, set a new Stanford single-season record, passing Adam Keefe (1991-92).

Raynaud is just the fifth major conference player to have at least 23 double-doubles in a season over the past five years, joining Zach Edey (Purdue, 2x), Joel Soriano (St. John's), Oscar Tshiebwe (Kentucky, 2x) and Armando Bacot (North Carolina).

He ranks first in the ACC in rebounding and second in scoring. Stanford has never had a player finish higher than third on the national rebounding leaderboard (Curtis Borchardt, 2001-02), while his scoring average is on pace to be a top-10 mark in program history. The closest statistical comparison at Stanford to Raynaud is Adam Keefe, who was 11th nationally in scoring (25.3) and fourth in rebounds (12.2) in 1991-92.

Raynaud became the program's 51st member of the 1,000-point club at Stanford, and he currently ranks 14th in program history in scoring with 1,539 points. He is five points away from Tim Young '99 in 13th and 52 away from the top-10. He passed Dwight Powell '14 to become the Cardinal's all-time leading scorer among international players. He is also third on the all-time rebound list (955), tied with Kim Belton '80, and 18 rebounds away from tying the program's single-season record. Raynaud is 10th on Stanford's single-season scoring list (623). He is the fourth Stanford player to record at least 1,500 points and 900 rebounds in program history, joining Keefe, Belton and Tim Young.

He is a mainstay in France's national team system, leading Les Bleus to a gold medal at the 2023 FIBA U-20 European Championship in Greece and a silver medal at the 2019 FIBA U-16 European Championship in Italy. Raynaud was also a practice player for France ahead of the 2024 Olympics in Paris.

## SKIP PROSSER AWARD RECIPIENT

Maxime Raynaud has found success not just on the court, but also in the classroom, as the big man was named the Skip Prosser Award recipient as the ACC Scholar-Athlete of the Year on March 5. Raynaud is Stanford men's basketball's fifth consecutive Scholar-Athlete of the Year, as Stanford won the final four Pac-12 awards in the category. Raynaud joins Oscar da Silva (2021), Sam Beskind (2022), James Keefe (2023) and Brandon Angel (2024), extending the program's streak, and he becomes the ninth recipient of the ACC or Pac-12 honor, along with Dorian Pickens (2018), Chasson Randle (2015), Dwight Powell (2014) and Landry Fields (2010). The men's basketball program becomes the first of Stanford's 36 teams to win five consecutive scholar-athlete of the year honors, dating back to the award's inception in the Pac-10 in 2007-08, though women's rowing has a chance to match the five consecutive honors later this spring.

## ALL-ACC

Maxime Raynaud was one of five players selected to the All-ACC first team, as announced by the league office on March 10. Raynaud is the only player in the country averaging at least 20 points and 10 rebounds per game, and just the third ACC player to accomplish the feat since 2000. He is the first major conference player to average 20 and 10 with 50 or more 3-pointers since Kevin Durant (Texas, 2006-07) and Carmelo Anthony (Syracuse, 2002-03).

## BLAKES SEIZES HIS OPPORTUNITY

Jaylen Blakes has been one of the most improved players, not just in the ACC, but in the entire country this season, ranking 30th in the ACC in scoring, sixth in assists and fifth in steals. On the season, Blakes is averaging 12.9 points, 4.6 assists and 1.8 steals per game, making him one of just 17 players nationally to hit each of those benchmarks, and one of seven in a major conference. The only Stanford alumni in the last 30 years to post those numbers is Brevin Knight '97 (three times, 1994-95, 95-96, 96-97). Blakes is 15th all-time at Stanford for steals in a single-season.

Among all power conference players, Blakes ranks fourth in scoring growth from 2023-24 to 2024-25, improving by 11.1 points per game. Only Wisconsin's John Tonje (16.3 ppg improvement) and Purdue's Trey Kaufman-Renn (13.3) and Northwestern's Nick Martinelli (11.4) have more. Blakes also ranked fourth in ACC play at 89.6 percent from the line in conference play.

## PROGRAM STANDARDS

Stanford is on track to break two single-season program records as a team in free throw percentage and turnovers per game. Stanford is currently shooting 78.5 percent from the stripe as a team, which would best the current program record of 76.3 percent, set by the 2005-06 team, and be just the fourth Cardinal program to shoot better than 75 percent as a unit. Stanford is also giving up only 10.7 turnovers per night, its lowest mark on record. The previous record is 10.8 per game, accomplished by the 2014-15 team. Stanford ranks 15th nationally in free throw percentage (78.5%) and leads the ACC in league play at 83.6 percent. The team is also forcing offenses to score one-on-one, ranking ninth nationally in opponent assists per field goal (41.1%, KenPom).

## THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters its second round ACC matchup at No. 83 in the NET rankings (March 10). The matchup, with either opponent, will be in quadrant three. 15 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are quadrant one or two contests, including nine in Q1. Stanford is one of seven in the ACC with multiple quadrant one wins, joining Duke, Clemson, Louisville, Wake Forest, Virginia and Georgia Tech.

## HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Stanford finished the regular season with the ACC's second-best home record at 16-2 overall, including a 9-1 mark in the ACC. Duke went 10-0 in the ACC at home, while the Cardinal are one of three one-loss teams at home in conference play, along with Clemson and Louisville. Stanford outscored all opponents at home by 12.2 points per game and 11.0 points per night in ACC play. The Cardinal locked up its best home record since 2014-15 in terms of wins (16) and since 2007-08 in winning percentage (88.9%).

## SELLERS MARKET

Oziah Sellers has been an explosive and efficient scorer this season, averaging a career-high 13.3 points on 45.2 percent shooting, including a 39.0 percent mark beyond the arc and an 89.3 percent total at the free throw line. Sellers slots in 27th in the ACC in scoring and he ranked fourth in conference games only in the ACC at 41.7 percent from beyond the arc. Sellers is on pace for a top-five single-season mark at Stanford in free throw percentage (min 80 FTA).

## #BEATCAL

On a night when the program honored legendary head coach Mike Montgomery in front of a near sell-out crowd, Stanford completed a regular season sweep over rival California, downing the Golden Bears 66-61 on Feb. 22 at Maples Pavilion. Maxime Raynaud led the offense with 20 points to go with eight rebounds and three blocks. Oziah Sellers finished with 14 points, including a perfect 7-for-7 mark at the free throw line, while Ryan Agarwal scored 11 points and Jaylen Blakes had 10. The Cardinal defense forced 13 California (12-15, 5-11 ACC) turnovers while holding the Golden Bears to 34.5 percent shooting from the floor.

The regular season sweep was Stanford's first over California since 2021, while the unbeaten mark could be the first total sweep over Cal since 2015. Stanford is 4-0 in the last four meetings with its archrival.

## CARDIAC CARDINAL

Jaylen Blakes has led Stanford to a pair of quadrant one wins on the road this season, scoring in the closing seconds to secure wins at Santa Clara (Nov. 23) and at North Carolina (Jan. 18). Stanford rallied from an eight-point deficit in the final four minutes to defeat Santa Clara, 71-69, with Blakes scoring the game-winning basket from 18 feet with two seconds to go, fading away from the elbow and sinking a jump shot. The heroics continued at the Dean Smith Center in Chapel Hill, as Blakes received the ball with just over seven seconds to play before driving coast-to-coast and hitting a fadeaway 12-foot jumper to give Stanford a 72-71 win over the Tar Heels. Ryan Agarwal joined in the late-game fun with the game winning lay-up against NC State with eight seconds left on Feb. 8, 74-73.

## MEET KYLE SMITH

Smith heads to The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 94-71 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 277-205 career record in his 15th season as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. He spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-00).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round. The postseason was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. They also reached the NIT semifinals in 2022 and earned a bid for a second consecutive season in 2023. Smith was the first coach in Washington State history to post a .500 or better record in each of his first four seasons, doing so after taking over a program that was under .500 in each of the previous seven campaigns.

Smith led San Francisco to a 63-40 record from 2016-19, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Preceding his time in the Bay Area, he was at Columbia, where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season.

## LAIPNI LŪDZAM SAIMNIECĪBĀ

Stanford announced its first signee in the class of 2025 on Nov. 18 in Kristers Skrinda from Riga, Latvia. One of the top prospects in Europe, Skrinda is rated as a top-100 (No. 92 overall) four-star prospect from On3. A versatile, 6-10 forward who attended the prestigious Riga State Gymnasium No. 2 in Riga, Skrinda starred for Latvia at the FIBA U18 Eurobasket in Tampere, Finland, where he averaged 17.7 points, 10.4 rebounds and 2.1 assists while shooting 43.9 percent from 3-point range and 96 percent from the line.

## PRO CARD

The Cardinal currently has four players on NBA rosters this season in Brook Lopez (Milwaukee Bucks), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks), Ziaire Williams (Brooklyn Nets) and Spencer Jones (Denver Nuggets).

# KYLE SMITH

## ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL FIRST SEASON AT STANFORD

Kyle Smith was announced as the Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball on March 25, 2024, and begins his first season at Stanford in 2024-25.

Smith heads to The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 94-71 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 258-193 career record across 14 seasons as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. Additionally, he spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-2000).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round, while the postseason event was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. The Cougars also reached the NIT semifinals in 2022 and earned a

bid for a second consecutive season in 2023.

Smith was the first coach in Washington State history to post a .500 or better record in each of his first four seasons, doing so after taking over a program that was under .500 in each of the previous seven campaigns.

A talented coach known for expertise in analytics and player development, Smith's tutelage has included two NBA Draft selections in CJ Elleby (2020) and Mouhamed Gueye (2023) and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year Myles Rice (2024), while three Cougars earned All-Pac-12 recognition this season. Smith also coached San Francisco's Jamaree Bouyea, who made his NBA debut in 2023, and mentored a series of professional athletes as an assistant coach, including NBA players Matthew Dellavedova and Patty Mills at Saint Mary's.

Smith has also seen success on the recruiting trail, landing two top-60 classes, the highest for Washington State in over a decade. He signed a top-100 prospect to Pullman in the class of 2022, the first for the program since Klay Thompson in 2008.

Prior to Smith's tenure at Washington State, he led San Francisco to a 63-40 record, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Smith produced seven All-WCC picks, paced by two-time All-WCC first team selection Frankie Ferrari.

Preceding his time in the Bay Area, he served as the head coach at Columbia where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season. Smith mentored 10 All-Ivy League selections over his six seasons at Columbia, led by Maodo Lo, a two-time first team honoree and the second-leading scorer in school history.

Smith played an integral role in building the Gaels' program into a perennial championship contender in the West Coast Conference under head coach Randy Bennett. In his nine seasons in Moraga, the Gaels made three NCAA Tournament (2005, '08, '10) appearances and earned one NIT bid (2009). Saint Mary's averaged 23 wins over Smith's last six seasons on the staff, including an 81-20 record over his final three seasons. The 2009-10 team finished with a 28-6 record, advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Championship and was ranked 19th nationally in the final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll.

During his one season at Air Force, Smith served as the Falcons' offensive and recruiting coordinator and took a lead role with player development and scouting. He was instrumental in the recruitment of 2003-04 Mountain West Conference Player of the Year Nick Welch along with all-conference players Antoine Hood and A.J. Kuhle.

Before joining the Falcons, Smith served eight seasons as an assistant coach at San Diego from 1992-2000 under Hank Egan and Brad Holland. During his time at San Diego, Smith helped lead the Toreros to their second-highest win total in school history (20 in 1999-2000) and as associate head coach, orchestrated a defense that allowed the lowest opponent scoring average (62.6) in the West Coast Conference (62.6 in 1999-2000).

Born in El Paso, Texas, Smith graduated in 1992 from Hamilton College with a degree in English literature. He also played basketball and helped lead the Continentals to a 26-1 record and the No. 1 ranking in the nation for NCAA Division III as a junior. He shot a school-record 51.3 percent from three-point range and helped Hamilton to an Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) championship.

Smith earned a master's degree in educational leadership from the University of San Diego, where he began his coaching career.

Kyle and his wife, Katie, have three sons, Rocco, Bo, and Luke.
