2025 NOTABLES

- » The Cardinal returns an All-America and All-MPSF selection in **West Temkin**, as well as an All-MPSF Honorable Mention pick in **Will Schneider**.
- » Now entering his fourth season at the helm, Dunlevie Family Director of Men's Water Polo **Brian Flacks** has compiled a 61-18 (.772) overall record.
- » The Cardinal entered the 2025 season picked third in the MPSF coaches poll, and third in the ACWPA poll.
- » The sophomore class had a strong introduction in 2024. **Ryan Ohl**, **Botond Balogh**, **Ben Forer** and **Will Schneider** combined for 120 points (79 goals 41 assists).
- » The class has already started hot in 2025, with **Balogh** scoring six goals in the first game of the season. **Forer** posted a hat trick, as did fellow sophomore **Max Zelikov** – **Zelikov** redshirted last season.
- » **Ohl** and junior **Alex Gheorghe** each competed at the World Aquatics World Championships in Croatia this summer. **Ohl** represented the US, while **Gheorghe** competed for Romania.
- » The Cardinal has made 35 all-time NCAA appearances, boasting 11 NCAA titles and 12 national titles overall, with its most recent victory coming in 2019.
